MARCH ORGANIC CITRUS PROMOS



March will be a fantastic time to promote **Organ**ic Citrus!

Supplies are plentiful and quality is outstanding on California Organic Navel Oranges, Cara Cara Oranges, Mandarins, Minneola Tangelos, and Lemons.

Check out our Sunkist Display Contest on page 4. Free point of sale pop up bins are available.

Organic Blood Oranges, Grapefruit, Kumquats, Meyer Lemons, and Pummelos all continue in season as well, but these varieties are less primed for "big display" than those mentioned earlier.

ALERT! Organic Limes from Mexico continue to be in extremely short supply, with fair quality and high pricing.



OG PEPPERS

Organic Mini Sweet Peppers from Mexico have promotable volumes and pricing for March. Now's the time to build bigger displays on this snackable item.

Organic Red, Yellow, and Orange Bell Peppers from both Mexico and Israel continue to see steady volumes. The Mexican product is trading at a discount. Quality remains outstanding from both countries!

Don't forget to add **Organic Specialty Peppers** for variety in your set! There's a large complement of **Organic Chili Peppers**, plus **Shishito** and **Padron** for appetizers in season this month.

Organic Green Peppers from Lady Moon Farms in Florida continue to see both strong quality and yields in March. Expect conditions to continue through mid-March.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Grape Tomatoes remain promotable coming from Florida. Quality has been excellent. Supplies should continue to be excellent through the month of March. <u>youtu.be/nHduCoKOIG8</u>

New crop **Organic Roma Tomato** prices will remain steady out of Mexico. These will start the spring season and quality should be strong.

Organic Beefsteak Tomato prices are starting to come off as production ramps up ahead of the spring crop transition. Quality has been excellent out of Canada. New crop Mexican product has also started with nice quality.

Organic "Darkloom" Tomatoes will continue to be promotable from Covilli Brand Organics. Quality has been excellent. Organic Mixed Heirloom Tomato prices will be a little higher as availability is tighter due to a skip in crops.



OG BERRIES

Good news! **Organic Strawberry** supplies have begun to improve and prices are finally decreasing. Early to mid-March will be a great time to get back to promoting these berries!

Expect to see this harvest flush straighten out ahead of late March as prices are expected to return to more normal early spring levels.

Organic Blueberry prices are moving up as supplies out of Chile are slowing down and new crop product out of Mexico and CA are limited with much stronger quality fruit.

NOTE: Organic Blackberries are expected to be in tight supply for the month of March, improving slightly each week. April is when Organic Blackberries will return to promotability.

NOTE: Organic Raspberry supplies remain limited, but there is a light at the end of the tunnel as we move into April. Supplies are expected to ramp up going into next month with more promotable pricing after Easter.

OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli from SoCal and Yuma, AZ have seen a significant change in both pricing and availability during the first week of March. Although quality will remain strong, as the month continues, we will see volumes continue to decrease as vendors prepare transition back north to Central California. Pricing is up.

Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli and Organic Broc-

coli Rabe will start to wind down in the southern growing regions during March, and pricing is expected to go up ahead of the transition to Central California later in spring.



OG APPLES

Organic Pink Lady and **Fuji Apples** will be in excellent supply with promotional opportunities available through mid-April on 80/100ct and 12/3lb bags.

Organic Opal and **Envy Apples** will be promotable through March. Ask your rep about opportunities. Then, **Opals** will wind down for the season during mid-April.



OG CAULIFLOWER

From the winter southern growing regions, **Organic Cauliflower** is starting to drop in harvest volume and inch up in price as we head towards mid-March.

NOTE: Organic Cauliflower is more susceptible to damage, so quality issues are expected to arise sooner as the southern season winds down, causing growers to end the season. Pay close attention to rising prices as mid-March approaches.



OG SQUASH

Organic Zucchini and Yellow Squash from Mexico have begun to see availability and pricing tighten during the first week of March. Quality is expected to be average before seeing improvements as March concludes.

The third week of March also will mark the start of Lady Moon Farm's Georgia **Organic Zucchini** season! Look supplies to start slow and volumes to grow and the month continues.



OG CUCUMBERS & EGGPLANT

Organic Eggplant is in season from Florida and Mexico, but there's not a lot of volume coming so pricing is on the higher side, particularly out of Florida. Quality on the Lady Moon has been very nice.

Organic Cucumbers from Mexico will be limited during early to mid-March.



OG KIWIFRUIT

Organic Jumbo Green Kiwifruit will be promotable through mid-March from Homegrown Organic, but then be done for the season, leaving only import fruit.

Organic Green Kiwifruit will be available for early March from Italy. Prices are starting to creep up just a bit as supplies have tightened in various sizes. Greece and Italy will be finishing in a few weeks. Chile will be the next country that begins to ship higher volume to the United States.



OG GREEN BEANS

Organic Green Beans from Mexico and Florida are both beginning to see steady supply. As volumes increase in mid-March, expect pricing to improve and potential promotion opportunities to arise. Quality will remain strong for the coming weeks!

Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples will finish for the season the second week of March.



OG CABBAGE

Organic Green Cabbage from Lady Moon Farms in Florida is ramping up just in time for St. Patrick's Day! Look for excellent quality and promotable prices to be a perfect recipe for large displays to push mass volume during the holiday push!



OG CELERY

Organic Celery continues to see steady volumes. Look for promotional opportunities to arise throughout the month!



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Euro Seedless Cucumbers will be promotable as Mexico continues a heavy flush of product. Supplies and quality are excellent.

Organic Mini Seedless Cucumbers will be available out of Canada and Mexico. Supplies are steady and quality has been very nice.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus prices will start to rise as the harvest flush starts to finish and supplies become steadier. Quality continues to be excellent.

We will host a display contest starting 3/21-4/3 to lead right into Easter with Hippie Organics.



OG STONE FRUIT

Chilean **Organic Nectarines** have been selling well, but the season will wrap up during early March.

Organic Red Plums are expected to continue until mid-March.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts remain promotable for the beginning of March! Look for pricing to remain affordable and volumes strong during the second week of March. Quality will remain excellent. Try adding in-store packaged **Organic Brussels Sprouts** to display as a convenient grab & go option.

Organic Purple Brussels Sprouts are also available at a shape price to add a pop of color to displays!



OG HASS AVOCADOS

NOTE: Organic Hass Avocados continue to increase in price with demand outweighing supply. Some winter storms have slightly affected the quality of fruit. Expect to see prices continue to increase a bit right into early April and the Easter holiday.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes will be in sporadic supply during March, with occasional arrival volumes limited supply of South African Black Grapes and Peruvian Green Seedless, Red Seedless, and Red Globe Seeded.

Organic Sweet Sapphire Grapes (elongated Black) are available from Peru. Right now, this variety has decent volumes.

Overall, **Organic Grapes** will be in and out of stock at higher prices until new crop fruit starts out of Mexico in mid to late April.



OG PINEAPPLES

Organic Pineapple supplies continued to be strong arriving into the east coast ports. This will be a promotable item through most of March. Quality has been good.



OG MANGOS

Organic Kent Mangos are very promotable as the Peruvian season winds down in mid-March. Mexico continues to ramp up for their season and more Organic Tommy Atkins Mangos are crossing each week. This is driving the Peruvian prices down as they finish up - take advantage with promos while you can!

Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos will be steady in supply through March. Quality should be excellent.



OG CARROTS

Cal-Organic has a nice variety of **Organic Bunched Carrots** available for your wet veg display, including the standard **Orange** and the popular **Rainbow**. Also in season for March are **Organic Bunched Red Carrots**!

Superior Fresh's farm in Hixton, WI, is an aquaponic ecosystem, each organism playing an important role in the balance of life. Their fish thrive in the water that feeds their organic leafy greens, their greens purify the water that is then returned to their fish. And their people nurture this ecosystem, maintaining the delicate balance.

With their ecosystem, they work in harmony with nature by recirculating 99.9% of their water with zero runoff, harness the sun for the bulk of the growing, and do it on a fraction of the land using a fraction of the water required to sustain a conventional farm. They can grow as much food on the farm as it would take a traditional farm to produce on 300 acres.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

STRAWBERRY OUTLOOK



Strawberries are in excellent supply right now from Florida and California. To kick off March, there were a lot of spot buys from Florida growers that didn't have any promotions lined up that suddenly came on.

Heading into the week of 3/8, Florida volumes are expected to remain steady and promotable. New crop **Strawberries** in Santa Maria, CA have also started, and the quality is phenomenal.

By the end of March, **Strawberries** from Florida and Mexico will come to an end, and we'll shift to 100% California new crop production. Expect the market price to climb gradually over the remainder of the month.



CV BERRIES

Blueberries are in steady supply from Chile and Mexico. But the Chilean imports arriving to the States lately are not ideal - weak quality and soft berries.

The best fruit is definitely from Mexico, and we've shifted our sourcing to all Mexican **Blueberries**. Pricing is higher, but it's clearly the best move for the consumers' eating experience.

Believe it or not, Florida just started harvesting their first **Blueberries** of the 2021 season in a small way. Get ready, the domestic season is right around the corner!

Blackberries and **Raspberries** are starting to improve in volume, but we wouldn't call them promotable just yet. Expect even more supplies as we head into the weeks of 3/15 and 3/22, and for the pricing to decline to more promotable levels at that time. Quality has been excellent on both berries.



CV TOMATOES

Beefsteak Tomatoes will remain promotable for the foreseeable future. Mexico and US greenhouses continue to produce good volume with great quality. Canada is also starting as well. Quality has been nice from all areas.

Grape Tomato prices are rising a few dollars due to some increased demand. Farms are transitioning and supplies are a little bit tighter. Markets should remain promotable however as this is a small transition period and Mexico will start heavy production mid to late March.

New this week, Florida grown **Golden Grape** Tomatoes.

Good news! **Campari Tomato** prices are starting to ease off as production starts to pick up. Quality has been excellent look for promotable pricing at the end of March.

Roma Tomato prices remain promotable from Mexico or Florida. Quality has been excellent.



CV TROPICALS

Ataulfo Honey Mangos from Mexico will be in season with steady supplies for March. We will be promoting the **Chamagne Brand Ataulfos** this season in the premium 14ct pack. Stay tuned for April promotions.

Round Mango prices dropped slightly as Mexico begins to ramp up **Tommy Atkins** volume and growers from Peru are trying to close out their season with the **Kent** variety on a high note. Pricing is promotable for early March!

Pineapples continue to be in a bit of a volume flush with highly promotable pricing expected through March! Ask about deals on all sizes.

NOTE: Hass Avocados markets rose for the 3rd week in a row. Demand is currently exceeding supply and grower/packers are warning of further increases in price due to this. This will likely last through March and right into April where we will see Easter and Holy Week also affect picking and supply in early April.



CV CITRUS

California **Navel Oranges** are in good supply with great color and flavor! Prices remain up over some years as demand is very strong. It's a good time to promote large sizes in bulk bins (36-40sz, 750ct) and 48ct cartons. Small sizes for 4lb bags are also promotable.

Blood Oranges and **Cara Cara Oranges** are in good supply with great flavor! Sunkist quality is fantastic.

It is the height of the season on **Minneola Tangelos.** They have good orange color and are cutting really nice. Flavor is outstanding.

The **Grapefruit** deal got completely knocked out in Texas by the winter storms, so we're transitioned to new crop California fruit.

ALERT! Lime supplies are very light crossing over from Mexico. Prices are going up and will continue to rise in March.



CV CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: 12ct cello wrap **Cauliflower** prices took a sharp turn up. As we head into the first few weeks of March, pricing has doubled, and availability is limited. There are hopes of freight prices coming off over the next few weeks which will help ease the pain of landed pricing.



CV GRAPES

The **Grape** market remains steady for now out of South America.

The best fruit is coming out of Peru on **Green**, which is getting a premium price on the **Sugar Crisp** and **Sweet Globe** varieties, which is what we will have in our XLG line. **Thompson Seedless Grapes** are available at lower prices but not as nice - we'll carry these at a value in our MD/LG lines.

There are plenty of **Red Seedless Grapes** available with the best varieties being **Jack Salute** and **Sweet Celebration**, which is what you'll get when you buy our XLG line. **Crimsons** are available at cheaper a price, which is what we'll have in our MD/LG value lines.



CV PEPPERS

Mini Mixed Sweet Peppers are promotable out of Mexico. Quality should be excellent as harvests flush.

Green Bell Peppers should continue to be promotable coming from Florida. Quality has been excellent. Mexico has lighter supplies, but overall demand is weak, keeping prices promotable.

111b **Peppers** will be steady and possibly rise some as spring sets out of Mexico and Canada are coming on late. By mid-March, we should see promotable prices coming out of Mexico. Quality has been very nice.



CV BROCCOLI

Broccoli Crowns are arriving beautiful. Prices remain reasonable but are slowly starting to shift as cooler temps settle in Yuma, AZ. The transition is expected to start rolling into Salinas, CA in April.



CV MELONS

Honeydews are in good supply and prices are coming off. There's mostly 6ct available.

NOTE: Cantaloupe supplies are still very light coming in from Central America and prices are very strong. There's mostly 9ct available.



CV CABBAGE

Green Cabbage continues to be steady coming from Florida. Markets will tighten up as Texas tries to rebound from their freeze a few weeks back. Quality has been nice coming from Florida.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus continues to be promotable, but prices should start to rise in mid-March from the deep discounts of late as demand from Easter picks up and also some big ads across the country kick in. Quality has been excellent coming from Mexico.



CV GREEN BEANS

CV CUCUMBERS

Super Select Cucumber prices are starting to ease off some as Mexico's spring crop slowly starts. Product is still limited somewhat but volume is expected to get better each week. Product from Honduras is still coming in and shipping out Florida. Florida is still planning mid-March start on USA grown product.

Euro Seedless Cucumber markets will be promotable as the Canadian crop comes on strong. Quality will be excellent on this new crop.



CV ONIONS

The **Onion** market continues to strengthen due to tightening of product caused by the freezing weather in Texas. Preliminary estimates from South Texas are that roughly 15-30% of the South Texas onion crop has been damaged due to the freeze.

Onion pricing has started to firm up again with this news. The biggest jump in price will be on the medium **Yellow Onions**, and all smaller bagged product.



CV SWEET CORN

Florida **Sweet Corn** will be available in both tray pack and bulk crates starting the week of 3/8. As temperatures start to go up here in the Northeast, it is expected that shoppers will be eager to get outside and start grilling!

OUTLOOK: Promotable volume from Florida could be a late start due to freezing temps in early February. Temperatures have rebounded nicely since then and growers are looking for a mid-April start with program pricing and volume.



CV LETTUCES

Iceberg, Red & Green Leaf, Romaine, and Romaine Hearts are seeing modest price increases from the early March deals due to temps, higher demand, and freight. That said, price points should still allow for plenty of promoting during mid-March.



CV ARTICHOKES

12ct Jumbo **Artichokes** are still arriving with great quality! Promotional pricing continues, but will start to turn around to more normal levels by mid to late March.



CV POTATOES

With Saint Patrick's Day on the horizon, we have been gearing up for some heavy **Potato** demand. Local PA-grown bagged **White Potatoes** will be in abundant supply heading into St. Patty's Day. Talk with your rep today about some promotable pricing!



CV FRESH EXPRESS SALADS

Fresh Express is launching 4 new Salad Kits in March: Balsamic Italian, Spinach & Bacon, Chopped Bacon Thousand Island, and Chopped Kickin' Bacon Ranch.

NOTE: Fresh Express has been having some labor and production challenges at plants supplying the east coast. This has caused some unfortunate out-of-stocks and cuts during late February and early March.



CV MANDARINS

Gold Nugget Mandarins are now in season from California in 10/3lb Sunkist bags!

Snag some **MandaRosa Red Flesh Mandarins** while this sweet and juicy variety is in season.

California easy peel **Tango** and **Murcott Mandarins** are what's being packed into the Halos and Sunkist Delites brands. There are some spot buys on Moroccan grown bagged **Mandarins** coming through east coast ports.



CV SPECIALTY TROPICALS

Sweet tasting **Yellow Pitahaya Dragon Fruit** will be promotable in March with prices dropping as volume become available out of Ecuador. **White Flesh Dragon Fruit** is also arriving with excellent quality!

Young Thai Coconut prices remain higher as volume is extremely low this time of year from Thailand and Vietnam.

Jackfruit will be available for early March from Mexico in a 2ct carton.
