ORGANIC MELONS OUTLOOK





Organic Seedless Watermelons continue in season from California. Quality has been nice, however extremely high freight rates have kept prices much higher than past years.

PA local **Organic Seedless Watermelon** production is expected to start with light volume by the end of July and pickup in August. Traditional **Organic Red Seedless**, a few **Yellow** and **Orange Seedless**, and **Sangria-style Seeded Watermelon** varieties will be available.

PA locally grown **Organic Mini Watermelons** will start as early as mid-July with very light volume. Supplies are expected to ramp up in early August with **Organic Red Seedless**, Yellow Seedless, and Red Seeded varieties.

Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons continue in season from Arizona and California. Quality is excellent and harvests are expected to remain steady through August.

"Navajo Pride" **Organic Mini Melons** from New Mexico will be available at the end of August. Quality is excellent on this melon program while also helping support the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry. Look for more information in mid-August as to when the program will begin.

Organic Cantaloupes are steady but not in heavy supply right now. Sizing is standard with 9s and 12s overall. Average pricing is steady on 9s and a couple of bucks higher on 12's.

Organic Honeydews are slightly more limited with 5ct and a few 6ct available.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Organic Broccoli production from California continues to have excellent volume in mid-July. Main supplies have shifted back to California during July after a very strong PA season! Québec growers have begun harvesting and to supplement the CA supplies. Pricing remains promotable and quality has been outstanding from California.

Organic Cauliflower from California continues to yield strong volume and excellent quality. Mid-July has seen some vendors tighten on supplies, however overall supplies are plentiful, and pricing has remained promotable.



OG BERRIES

Organic Raspberries are in good supply with improving quality now that the temperature has cooled down, and we are through the heatstressed fruit.

Organic Strawberries are firming as well now that the heat has subsided. Expect prices to begin to increase, and quality should improvve.

California **Organic Blackberries** have become very limited due to heat damage with great product loss, sporadic product gaps, and rising prices. There is a small amount of New Jersey fruit available.

Organic Blueberries have ended out of New Jersey, but good supplies are now available out of the Pacific Northwest and are expected to continue in good supply through mid-August. Peru is expected to kick in with a good crop at the end of August or early September, and then right into Chilean product.



OG PEPPERS

Local **Organic Purple Peppers** from Pennsylvania have begun, make sure to add this specialty item and pop of color to your pepper line up today!

Organic Red, Orange, and **Yellow Bell Peppers** from Canada and Holland are seeing supplies increase in late July. Quality from both growing regions have been outstanding throughout July and with aggressive pricing, late July is the perfect time to promote **Organic Peppers**!

Organic Green Peppers continue production from the Carolinas and are yielding excellent quality. Local production is expected to begin in late July!

Organic Mini Sweet Peppers are tightening from Mexico as we approach late July. Expect significant price increases and supplies to become limited as we move deeper into the summer. Look for local supplies in late July or August!



OG ONIONS

Locally grown **Organic Sweet Onions** are now available! Locally grown **Organic Red Onions** should get started the week of 7/19, once we cleanup CA grown **Organic Red Onions**.

Organic Yellow Onions will continue to come out of CA, and there shouldn't be a gap in supply until Nevada-grown **Organic Onions** get started. But time will tell the effects of the hot weather out west – the good news is onion plants like hot heat when growing. Medium-sized are a bit limited and cost almost as much as the jumbos.



OG BEANS

Organic Green Beans from Pennsylvania began harvests the week of July 11th. Although yields have remained limited in the first week, production is expected to increase quickly.

Also look for PA grown **Organic Yellow Beans** and **Fava Beans!** These specialty beans will add additional options for customers and a pop of color to your displays!



OG CABBAGE

Local **Organic Cabbage** remainS in strong production! As we approach August, expect supplies to begin to shift to New York production. Peak supply volume and quality are expected to remain throughout the summer months!



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumber production from Pennsylvania and New York have begun! Promote locally grown Organic Cucumbers in late July as supplies will increase quickly. Expect steady, plentiful supplies and strong quality in late July and early August.

Lady Moon Farm's Pennsylvania **Organic Cucum**ber crop is expected to begin in late July. Expect consistent supplies and excellent quality from Lady Moon!

Organic Euro Seedless Cucumber prices are rising some here in mid-July as supplies slow down due to a stretch of rain and cloudy weather. Quality has been nice.



OG MANGOS

July is an exciting month to promote **Organic Mangos.** Four Seasons and Crespo Organics are teaming up with a great Display Contest through the month of July.

Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos will see supplies tighten as the July progresses. Many growers are now done for the season.



OG EGGPLANT

Organic Eggplant harvests have begun in New Jersey in mid-July and will be followed shortly by Pennsylvania and New York! In mid-July, expect to see a mix of Carolina and New Jersey product as northern production is still growing. Expect improved pricing, strong quality, and consistent supplies in July. Lady Moon Farms' PA crop is expected to start at the end of July!



OG LETTUCE

Organic Leaf and **Romaine Lettuces** are now in strong consistent supplies from New York, Vermont, and Canada. For the remainder of July, expect to see steady supplies and improved pricing! Quality and availability from all 3 growing regions are strong - expect no interruptions in supplies for the rest of the month!

Organic Iceberg and **Romaine Hearts** will have steady production from both California and Québec in July. Quality from California has been outstanding in July, while Québec product is only beginning but is expected to be equally strong. Promotional opportunities on both will be available during July.



OG HASS AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico saw field prices spike sharply as supplies were down for the middle of July. There is a short gap expected between the Negra Crop and the Flor Loca crop out of Mexico, and this has affected field prices by \$4-5/case at the border. California and Peru are also viable options for those looking for a steady supply on fruit.



OG LEMONS

Organic Lemons have arrived in a very limited supply out of Argentina and the first new crop out of Mexico is expected here in mid-July. Supplies out of Mexico are expected to ramp up weekly and prices should stay high due to 30-40% of the crop was lost to a freeze a few months ago.



OG SQUASH

Organic Zucchini and **Yellow Squash** are in peak local production as late July approaches! Strong harvests, steady pricing, and outstanding quality make for the prefect summer promotion.



OG STONE FRUIT

Organic Apricots have transitioned to Washington and are expected to wrap up for the season by the end of July.

Organic Dark Sweet Cherries are in good supply with nice quality. Prices are expected to be steady until the end of July when supplies will dwindle quickly, and prices will rise. Organic Rainier Cherries are done for the season.

Organic Peaches and **Nectarines** will be available from both California and Washington for July as we move into the Washington peak season in August with promotional opportunities expected.

Organic White Peaches and Nectarines, Red Plums, Black Plums, and Pluots should be in steady supply out of California.

• We should see new crop **Organic Russet Pota**toes get started out of the Pacific Northwest in late July. **Organic Red** and Gold Potatoes will also get started in mid-July and will also bring some slight pricing relief to the higher priced California product.

• Organic Asparagus prices will ease off more here in mid-July as production out of Mexico continues to ramp up. Quality has been excellent, and supplies will be steady.



OG JACKFRUIT

Organic Jackfruit from Florida are now available and will be steady through the month of July! Be sure to take advantage of this domestic organic season to try this popular meat substitute.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Grape Tomatoes continue to be steady from North and South Carolina. Tennessee farms have just begun new harvests as well. Lady Moon Farms will begin with very light volume here in mid-July and volume with ramp up in early August. Quality has been nice from all areas.

Organic Cherry Tomatoes continue to be available from South Carolina in the Watsonia label. Quality has been excellent. Lady Moon Farms will begin from their PA farm on Organic Cherry and Rainbow Cherry varieties with light volume but should increase heading into August. New Jersey has also started with light harvests.

Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes will be available with light volume from PA grower King Family Farms. Quality is expected to be excellent on the crown picks with big sizing. Volume will increase heading into August.

Organic Roma Tomatoes will continue to be available from North and South Carolina here in mid-July. Quality has been nice. Locally grown product will start with light volume by the end of July and ramping up heading into August.

OTHER STORIES

• **Organic Pineapples** will be steady through July. We will offer both 6ct and 8ct Pines during this time.

• Organic Black Mission Figs will be available for the beginning of July from Mexico. The California early season has come to an end and will not resume until closer to the end of July.

• Organic Celery and Celery Hearts from California remains plentiful in supplies, and quality has been stellar with promotable pricing through-



OG GRAPES

Fresh crop California Organic Black Grapes, Champagne Grapes, Green Grapes, and Red Grapes are starting to arrive to the East Coast here in mid-July. An excellent crop is expected with some newer premium varieties.



OG SWEET POTATOES

An **Organic Sweet Potato** transition to new crop is right around the corner!

Organic Murasaki (Japanese Sweets) Sweet Potatoes will be the first variety to transition into new crop. These fields have been targeted as the highest priority due to the shortage of inventory and therefore will be started first. They should be available for the end of July.

Organic Red (Garnets) and Orange (Jewels) Sweet Potatoes will transition between the 2nd and 3rd weeks of August. Organic White Sweet Potatoes will transition toward the end of August or early Sept. There shouldn't be a gap in supply between old crop and new crop on the Orange, Red, and Whites.

Organic Purple Stoke Sweet Potatoes should be starting back up the 2nd week of September.

• Organic Baby Bok Choy production from Pennsylvania and New Jersey has slowed down in July. Look for main supplies to switch back to production from California.

NEW JERSEY PEACHES:

New Jersey **Yellow Peaches** are in good supply on 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and limited on 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and 3", but they are starting to size up more.

White Peaches have not come in yet, most likely to pop up in late July.



CV PEPPERS

Green Pepper prices will be steady here in mid-July. Locally grown production from NJ and PA have started. Quality and size will be excellent from the crown picks.

111b Red, Yellow, and Orange Peppers remain steady here in mid-July out of Canada. Orange and Yellow varieties keep higher prices as there is less volume available. Red will be rising some as harvests begin to slow down. Quality has been very nice. Mexico will also begin with light volume.

Mini Sweet Pepper prices will be high mid-July with tight supplies. Extreme heat out west and rain back east has supplies very tight right now. Quality has been nice on what is available.



CV BLUEBERRIES

Blueberries continue to be in good supply from New Jersey, and in mid-July we have the opportunity to carry the new **Barbara Ann** variety from Driscoll's. Get ready for these locally NJ grown, jumbo, flavorful, and simply phonemical **Blueberries**. These will be hands down the best of the season.

Michigan has also started to harvest along with growers in Washington and Oregon. From now, until August 1st, will be an excellent time to promote **Blueberries**.



CV BERRIES

Supplies on **Strawberries** are beginning to tighten slightly from Salinas, Watsonville, and Castroville, CA areas as we head into the week of 7/19. Quality has been improving over the past few weeks as these areas have had cooler weather. Look for pricing to rise slightly here in mid-July on both 8/1 lb and 4/2 lb **Strawberries**.

Blackberries and **Raspberries** will be in steady supply the week of July 19th. Quality has improved, but we're still seeing some soft fruit in our arrivals, and that's due to the growing conditions in California. Pricing will remain promotable on both berries.



CV CUCUMBERS

Super Select Cucumber prices will be rising in mid-July as farms are in transition to new plantings. Supplies will be tight, and demand has been strong. Quality has been very nice.

Mini Seedless Cucumber prices will start to ease off here in mid-July as Canadian production is expected to ramp up. Look for very promotable prices at the end of July. Quality has been excellent.

Euro Seedless Cucumber prices will ease off some here in mid-July as harvest numbers improve. Growing conditions are expected to improve, leading to better supplies. Quality has been nice.



CV GRAPES

California **Grapes** started shipping here in mid-July out of Arvin. We will get Pretty Lady Sugar Drops that will have the size and flavor expected from Dulcich on the road for in mid-July.

Red Flames don't have the size, so it will be the first or second week of August, before we see the high-end **Reds (Scarlett Royals)**. The heat has pushed everything off. For now, do not expect better than a large on **Red Seedless Grapes**.



CV TROPICALS

Mangos are promotable for the month of July! Take advantage of some cheaper prices this month and promote!

Hass Avocado prices jumped sharply here in mid-July as Mexico supplies were way down. There is a small gap expected in Mexico as a transition takes place in crops. There are plenty of deals on Peruvian fruit, especially larger sizes if needed.

Pineapples have seen supplies tighten as we get into the heart of the summer. Pricing was up again slightly for in mid-July.



CV WATERMELONS

Watermelons will remain steady here in mid-July. Georgia is finishing up as North and South Carolina start up, keeping supplies steady.

Delaware and Maryland are expected to begin lightly very soon here in July. Pennsylvania is expected to start at the end of July with light volume as well. Quality has been exceptional with excellent taste and sugar.



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

CA **Broccoli Crown** quality has been top notch! Maine and Quebec have started to harvest.

California **Cauliflower** quality has been good. Quebec and Maine are harvesting but are starting with lower supply numbers than expected.



CV LETTUCE

California Lettuce is readily available, but pricing is unstable as weather has influenced production. Quebec had some rain that pushed back and limited harvests. Iceberg Lettuce, in particular, is starting to jump up in price.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus prices will ease off here in mid-July as Mexico and Peru start to ramp up production. Quality has been excellent from both growing areas.



CV GREEN BEANS

Green Bean prices will be promotable here in mid-July from New Jersey and Pennsylvania. Quality has been excellent, and supplies are plentiful.



CV SWEET CORN

Sweet Corn will remain promotable as local regions continue to harvest excellent quality and supplies. PA, DE, and NJ are all in peak season.



CV CABBAGE

Green Cabbage remains promotable for mid-July from local PA and NJ farms. Quality continues to be excellent.



CV SQUASH

Green and **Yellow Squash** prices have firmed up here in mid-July as some areas begin to finish up harvests. PA growers continue to harvest, and quality has been very nice on arrival.



CV FIGS

Black Mission Figs are available in mid-July from Mexico. California fruit will return in a few weeks. **Black, Brown**, and **Green Fig** varieties will be available.



CV POTATOES

White Potatoes out of North Carolina will get started in mid-July. New crop NJ White Potatoes should begin in late August or early September. Prince Edward Island (PEI) Red, White, and Gold Potatoes are all but finished.

New crop **Red** and **White Potatoes** are transitioning here in mid-July from NC to VA – and there will be no gap in supply.

With our next loading on both bagged **Red** and **Gold Potatoes** we will be getting into new crop growing regions. 10/5lb **Gold Potatoes** out of VA, which will get started around (7/19). Expect a small gap between the PEI product and the new VA product. And the 10/5lb **Red Potatoes** will be product of VA and should arrive to us by mid-July.

Idaho Potatoes have tightened up here in mid-July as old crop **Potatoes** are winding down. New crop product is expected to start in mid-August and this market will likely tighten up a bit with even more limited supplies for the remainder of the season.



CV TOMATOES

Cluster Tomatoes will be steady here in mid-July. Quality from Canada and US have been excellent. New crops from Mexico will begin to come in with light volume as well.

Beefsteak Tomato prices will begin to ease off here in mid-July. Canadian greenhouses are beginning to replant, however new crops from Mexico are coming on and demand is easing off as local tomatoes continue to come on.

Roma Tomato markets have come up some as areas begin to transition. Tennessee is starting up and steady volume is expected going into late July. Quality is expected to be excellent.



CV LOCAL TOMATOES

Local Vine Ripe Tomato prices will ease off here in mid-July as production picks up from Delaware and PA. Quality has been excellent on these high-tunnel grown Tomatoes.

Grape Tomato prices are steady. Product is very tight as field growers continue to transition to new regions and weather delayed harvests. PA volume has been coming in light. Tennessee production has started, and quality should be excellent.
