EW CROP ORGANIC APPLE OUTLOOK







The 2021 USA fresh crop Organic Apple season is about to begin! The overall outlook in Washington is that it should be a good volume crop, but due to high heat during much of the summer, the sizing profile will be much heavier to smaller apples. This means we can expect plenty of promo opportunities on 100ct and smaller bulk fruit, along with bags and pouches.

Organic Gala Apple 2020 storage crop and import supplies are wrapping up for the season and volumes will smoothly transition into new crop early Galas out of California and Washington across mid-August.

Organic Honeycrisp will clean up on the storage fruit and imports during the week of 8/16, just in time for fresh crop Washington Organic Honeycrisp Apples to arrive around 8/20. Organic SweeTango Apples should be in stock and ready to promote ahead of Labor Day.

Out of Oregon, Heirloom Orchard Apples have begun shipping with their first variety of the season, Gravenstein. Organic Pink Pearls and Ribston Apples are due the first week of September.

On import Organic Apples from New Zealand:

Organic Diva Apples will sell out by during the third week of August. Organic Fuji Apples will continue to be available through early September. Organic Pink Lady/Cripps Pink are on the limited side but NZ supply should continue into September. Import Organic Granny Smith Apples are dwindling quickly and may sell out before new crop Washington starts in late September.



OG PEPPERS

Organic Color Bell Peppers supplies from Canada are bountiful. Improved aggressive pricing and superb quality is the makings of an August promotion!

Group Red, Yellow and Orange Peppers together on display at mix and match pricing to drive additional sales in August!

Local Organic Green Peppers remain plentiful in volume with excellent quality from Lady Moon's Pennsylvania farm for August.

Add a little spice to display by including PA Organic Jalapeños from Lady Moon.

Local Organic Mini Sweet Peppers in 8/1pt clamshells from Lancaster Farm Fresh are selling well, plus local Organic Chili Pepper varieties are in season from growers in NJ and PA.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes will be in season from Ohio grower coop, Green Field Farms. Quality will be excellent and supplies should be steady on this 15lb single layer tray pack as peak season has just begun.

Local Organic Vine Ripened Tomatoes remain available with promotable supplies this week from King Family Farms grown in Lancaster County, PA. Quality has been excellent.

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes will be available with promotable supplies this week from Lady Moon Farms grown in Pennsylvania. Quality has been exceptional.

Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes will be promotable from Lady Moon Farms this week grown in Pennsylvania. Quality has been excellent and the flush is just beginning.

Organic Tomatoes on the Vine pricing remains steady this week out of Canada. Supplies are heavy and the quality has been excellent.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blackberries are in excellent supply out of California with some promotional opportunities available during mid to late August.

Organic Raspberries out of California are in good steady supply and improving quality.

Organic Blueberries out of the Pacific Northwest will be wrapping during August. After some rain they just had, expect pricing to take steep inclines until new crop import fruit begins in early September out of Peru and Chile.

Organic Strawberry supplies are firming, pricing is moving up as we are finishing in Salinas, CA and moving to new crop in Santa Maria and Oxnard, CA.



OG MANGOS

Organic Mangos are coming from portions of Mexico that have been determined as "Fruit Fly Free Zones" and do not require a hot water dip before entering the United States. This enables growers to let fruit on the tree just a little longer to capture full flavor and ripeness!

10/12ct sizing has tightened as larger 6-9ct fruit proves to be more prevalent as the season wanes. As August progresses look for opportunities to get non-hot water-treated fruit!

Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos will be done in the middle to end of August from Mexico.



OG CORN

Organic Bi-Color Sweet Corn yields have drastically increased in early August. Promote! NY and PA grown product will be great additions to local displays.

Colder weather, followed by a heatwave, has pushed plantings together cause an abundance of supplies in mid-August.





OG SPECIALTY FRUITS

Mid-August will be the best time of the year to promote peak season **Organic Black Mission Figs** from California!

Popular Florida grown organic specialties that are back in stock for the week of 8/16 include Organic Starfruit/Carambola, Longan Fruit, and Green Skin Avocados.



OG MELONS

Organic Mini Watermelons pricing remains steady this week out of California. Quality has been outstanding and expected to stay excellent as new crops have started.

Organic Watermelons will be available this week in bins and cartons. Quality from California continues to be excellent. Pennsylvania harvests have started but are very limited so far.

California Organic Cantaloupe and Honeydew continue in peak season with nice quality and flavor.



ALERT! Organics Unlimited has announced they will be out of Organic Plantains and Coconuts from Mexico indefinitely until their trees can recover from the Tropical Storm that hit them about a month ago. The damage appears to be more serious than originally thought! Stay tuned for more information.



OG HASS AVOCADOS

ALERT! Organic Hass Avocados have tightened considerably, and prices are rising fast. Rain and low maturity levels in the fruit have delayed harvests in Mexico's summer growing region. California volumes are not big enough to keep the price stable.

48ct and larger fruit is very tight! 60ct and smaller fruit is steadier. Consider taking 60ct fruit or product from Peru for the time being to stay in stock.



OG SQUASH

Local **Organic Zucchini** continues in peak production for August. Volumes, pricing and quality have all remained consistent in August.

Lady Moon PA **Organic Zucchini** continue to see superb quality and aggressive pricing; promote and highlight locally grown **Organic Squash!**

NOTE: Organic Yellow Squash is limited from all growing regions currently, however, Organic Gold Bar Zucchini is available to supplement the lack of Yellow Squash supply.



OG ARTICHOKES

Organic Artichokes from California are once again available in mid-August.

Make sure to add **Organic Artichokes** back to displays!



OG STONE FRUIT

Organic Peaches and **Nectarines** continue in peak season with great flavor and quality from California and Washington!

LAST CALL: Late crop **Organic Dark Sweet Cherries** will sell out during mid-August. Promote while you can!

Organic Black and Red Plums, as well as new Dapple Dandy Pluots, should be in good supply.



OG CUCUMBER

Organic Cucumber supplies from Pennsylvania and New York have slowed in August.

Pricing is expected to slightly increase with supply limitations, however, quality will remain top-notch.



OG SHIITAKE MUSHROOMS

ALERT! Mushroom growers are facing lots of difficulties in keeping up with Organic Shiitake Mushroom production. Most of the log blocks that product is grown on comes from Asia and these supply chains have been disrupted. We anticipate temporary price increase in September. Stay tuned.



OG PEARS

Organic Bartlett and Bosc Pears out of California are in season, and Washington/Oregon Organic Bartlett and Starkrimson Red Pears should be in stock by the week of 8/23.

The first **Organic Asian Pears** of the season will arrive from California the week of 8/16.



OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Cauliflower continues to experience limited harvest yields causing gaps from some suppliers and limited overall availability.

NOTE: Pricing is expected to remain elevated through mid-August, and much like broccoli, quality is expected to be less than ideal from California.

Quebec supplies will also be available throughout August to supplement limited Western supplies.



OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli from California will begin to see supplies tighten, and pricing increase.

NOTE: Due to growing conditions, harvests will remain limited and quality will be less than ideal.

ALERT! Organic Broccoli Crowns have seen supplies worsen already. Expect gaps in supplies and substantial price increases.



OG LETTUCE

Organic Romaine and **Leaf Lettuce** production from Quebec remains consistent in August.

Supplies and quality remain strong and consistency is expected throughout August. Supplementary supplies from both New York and California will also be available.

Organic Romaine Hearts and **Organic Iceberg** continue decent supplies from both California and Quebec at promotable pricing.

As the month continues, **Romaine Hearts** are expected to increase in price.

OTHER STORIES

- Organic Celery remains promotable in August.
 Org
 With abundant supplies and aggressive pricing, large displays should remain intact to encourage additional sales. Organic Celery Hearts have also seen promotable pricing in August.
- The Organic Lemon crop is finally starting to ramp up out of Mexico, we should see more consistency over the next few weeks with pricing easing some.
- Organic Shallots and Okra will be back in stock again the week of 8/16 from Coke Farms in California.
- Organic Kiwifruit from New Zealand is in full swing all summer long. Look to stay in stock with Green and SunGold fruit in both bulk and clamshell options!
- Organic Green Beans from Elizabethtown, Pa are seeing plentiful supplies for the remainder of August. Expect improved pricing, excellent quality, and consistent supply for the perfect local product promotion. Include in-store prepackaged green beans as a grab and go option for consumers.
- We will see our first arrival of new crop Organic Russet Potatoes arrive to us this week from Washington state. Price will increase with the start of new crop but the quality is also expected to be very nice.

Smaller **Organic Russet Potatoes**, suitable for bagging, are move plentiful at the moment but with enough notice, there are enough count russets being generated to fulfill our needs.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

CALIFORNIA GRAPE SEASON

California **Grapes** are in peak season! August, September, and October will be an outstanding time to feature some of the best snacking **Grapes** of the year in prominent displays.

On **Green Seedless Grapes**, we will be promoting "Sheegene", "Sugar Drop", and "Stella Bella" varieties in our premium XL lines; and "Sugarone" variety is abundant for the regular large line during August.

"Flame" **Red Seedless Grapes** have not colored up as well for many growers this year, so **Red Grapes** are a little tighter than usual, particularly on the premiums. By late August, we will be transitioned into "Scarlett Royal" and "Krissy" varieties, which should be much better.

August is a great time for **Specialty Grapes**. **Cotton Candy Grapes** are now in season, as well as **Gum Drops Grapes** from The Grapery. **Thomcord Grapes** (a seedless Concord) will be available from California in "Jammers" brand bags.











CV HASS AVOCADOS

ALERT! Hass Avocado prices have jumped significantly as Mexico experienced rain and fruit is not maturing as quickly as anticipated in the new growing region.

With the delays to growth, this means that largesized fruit is not ready to be harvested. Markets have responded dramatically with huge jumps in price. Very little 48ct and larger fruit will be available in the marketplace during mid-August.

Peru and Colombia are in season, but there will not be enough retailers willing to switch over or supply to fill all the needs.

60ct **Hass Avocados** from Mexico will be expensive, but at least they will be available. Bags will be in ok supply since they're packed with 70-84ct fruit, which is mainly what is coming off the trees in Mexico right now.



CV FIGS & POMEGRANATES

Fresh Figs are in peak season from California!

The **Black Mission Fig** variety will be promotable in 12/8oz clamshells during August.

There will be other varieties coming along throughout the month and into September, including Sierra and Kadota Green-skin Figs, as well as Striped Tiger Figs. These specialty varieties are available for pre-book by request.

Early crop **Granada** variety **Pomegranates** are coming into season from California and are expected to arrive the week of 8/23.



CV BERRIES

Raspberries and Blackberries are in steady supply, but growers expect increased production throughout the end of August. Quality has been solid, and the pricing looks to remain steady as we head into September.

Blueberries are definitely in tighter supply heading into mid-August. Supplies from British Columbia are finishing much quicker than expected, and overall demand exceeds supply at the current time. New Jersey and Michigan are also coming to an end, and the Peruvian imports have been slow to get started. Expect higher pricing for the next couple of weeks.

NOTE: Supplies on **Strawberries** are starting to tighten as production winds down in the Salinas and Watsonville, CA areas. Pricing will begin to rise as we head into the middle of August. Promotions will be limited as we head into September. Quality continues to be good on all strawberries.



CV MANGOS

Mangos from Mexico are winding down for the season, and many grower shippers are finishing with the smaller 10 and 12ct fruit, leaving much larger 6-9ct fruit to finish the season.

By September, nice new crop fruit from Brazil is expected to start making its way into the marketplace.



CV STONE FRUIT

Supplies are ample on local Yellow and White Peaches from New Jersey. NJ Yellow Nectarines are also available to include in displays for August.

There are also plenty of excellent quality and size Peaches and Nectarines out of California. Pluots have some of the best varieties of the year with Green/Yellow, Red, Black, and Speckled types in stock.



CV CHERRIES

Mid-August still provides an opportunity to promote high quality, late season, high-altitude grown **Dark Sweet Cherries.** These special **Cherries** come from Stemilt Hill as part of the "A Half-Mile Closer to the Moon" program.



CV SHIITAKE MUSHROOMS

ALERT! Mushroom growers will not be able to keep up with demand on **Shiitake Mushrooms** due to production challenges.

Most of the log blocks that the **Shiitake** variety is grown on come from Asia, and the supply chains for these logs have been drastically disrupted. We anticipate temporary price increases in September. Stay tuned.



CV PEPPERS

Green Bell Peppers will remain promotable as harvests continue to be strong from local farms. Quality and size have been excellent.

11lb Hothouse Peppers pricing is coming down to promotable levels. Quality out of Canada has been very nice and supplies are coming in strong. Mexico is also harvesting new crops as well.

Locally Grown Hot Peppers are available from Pennsylvania and New Jersey farms. Jalapeno, Poblano, Serrano, Cubanelle's, and Habaneros are all available with good supplies and quality.



CV PINEAPPLES

Pineapples pricing will stay higher as the summer continues here on the East Coast. Expect to see more limited fruit in larger sizing as well.



CV ASPARAGUS

California vine-ripened **Honeydews** from "King O'the West" are in peak season! Sizing is peaking on 5ct and 6ct, and we'll be into some Jumbo 5ct for mid-August promotions. Expect some of the sweetest and most fragrant fruit of the year.

California **Cantaloupes** in the Peacock brand have great quality and are sizing mostly to 9ct for August-September promotion. Delaware is winding down on **Bin Athena-style Cantaloupes** for the season.
