## NEW CROP ORGANIC POTATOES & SWEETS



The 2021 harvests of **Organic Sweet Potato** started out a bit slower this season but are now ramping up to full blast and the race to get the crop out of the ground before the cold winter weather sets in is on!

AV Thomas (Natural Beauty brand) expects good quality products as the dry conditions in California have been favorable for controlled production rates with precision irrigation via drip systems. **Organic Sweet Potatoes** are expected to be abundant for fall/winter promotions on bulk #1 size and mini microwave packs.

**RED:** Transition to new crop has already occurred for Garnet/Diane varieties. Quality has been excellent!

**ORANGE:** A smooth transition is anticipated to new crop Jewel/Covington/Beauregard around mid-September with zero interruption in availability.

**WHITE:** Storage crop has been good and there will be zero interruption in availability on Hannah Sweet/O'Henry/Bonita.

**JAPANESE:** New crop has been tender and getting Oriental/Murasaki varieties to size up has been somewhat of a challenge. Skinning reduced during late August as the crop has had additional time to ground cure, however packing by hand is required. The skinning will be minimized as the season progresses.

**STOKES PURPLE:** Storage crop medium size finishing up soon—new crop is slated to begin around the middle of September.



New crop **Organic Russet Potatoes** are in season and quality is very nice from growers in Washington. Large counts continue to be more limited than smaller sizes product that is suitable for bagging.

**Organic Red Potato** bags are more plentiful this week, but most growers in Washington are struggling with their **Organic Red Potato** crop. **NOTE:** **Organic Red A-size Potatoes** will be more limited for September.

**Organic Gold Potatoes** from Washington, on the other hand, are in very nice supply and quality.

Out of California, **Organic Baby Potatoes** from Tasteful Selections are in peak season on all colors.



### OG APPLES & PEARS

The Pacific Northwest new crop **Organic Apples** and **Pears** transition is underway with storage crop packing winding down and a full transition to packing fresh crop varieties like **Organic Gala** and **Honeycrisp Apples** (bulk and bagged), as well as **Organic Bartlett** and **Starkrimson (Red) Pears** (bulk).

Due the first week of September is Stemilt's proprietary **Organic SweetTango Apple**.

By the end of September, we expect to be in excellent supplies of new crop **Organic Gold Delicious**, **Red Delicious**, **Fuji**, and **Granny Smith Apples**, as well as **Organic Anjou** and **Bosc Pears**.



### OG TROPICALS

We'll be offering a new **Organic Papaya** variety for September called **Organic Royal Star Papayas**. This variety has the flavor of popular Hawaiian papayas, only it's bigger in size, similar to a Maradol. Sizing will range from 9-12ct per box and will be sold as a 24lb net weight box!

**NOTE:** **Organic Formosa Papayas** will gap for most of September from our partner HLB in Mexico.

**Organic Mangos** have been affected by rains and this could really impact pricing in the final few weeks of the Mexico season. We continue to offer both 8 and 9ct **Non-Hot Water Treated** fruit for the beginning of September. **NOTE:** Ecuador fruit is not expected to until October so the month of September could be very tricky.

**Organic Magenta Dragon Fruit**, **Kiwano Melons**, and **Passion Fruit** have started in California and limited volumes will be in stock following Labor Day.



### OG MELONS

**Organic Mini Watermelons** are beginning to firm up out of California as harvests begin to finish up for the season. New plantings will start in September but there will be a gap in production as we transition areas. Quality has been excellent.

**Organic Watermelons** continue in season for the beginning of September from PA and Ohio but will be slowing down very quickly.

**ALERT!** **Organic Cantaloupes** are in extremely short supply as we head into Labor Day. Growers in California are in a gap, and they're not planning on harvesting again until the second week of September.

**Organic Honeydew** from California have nice quality and are in better supply than cantaloupes.



### OG CABBAGE

**Organic Red and Green Cabbage** continues to see steady supplies with excellent quality from New York. In addition, supplies from Lancaster, PA will begin harvests in late September.

**Organic Savoy Cabbage** will be available from Vermont. **Organic Napa Cabbage** will have limited availability to begin September because of quality from California and limited availability from Vermont.



### OG SQUASH

**NOTE: Local Organic Zucchini** has experienced a significant drop in volume, and the rains from Hurricane Ida are likely to draw the season to a close in early September. Fortunately, Lady Moon Farms' Florida **Organic Zucchini** is expected to begin harvesting in the second week of September, while the Carolinas and Georgia supplies have begun in a limited fashion.

**Organic Yellow Squash** are back in stock from the Carolinas and Georgia in early September after many local vendors were without supplies for late August.



### OG GRAPES

California **Organic Grapes** are arriving with exceptional quality. This is the organic fruit item to highlight most prominently in September while the crop is at its best!



### OG CUCUMBERS

**NOTE: Organic Cucumber** supplies have dropped for the beginning of September from Lady Moon Farms in PA and other local supplies due to the rain from Hurricane Ida. Supplies are expected to end in early September.

Product in the Carolinas and Georgia have begun but are very limited and expensive. Mexican supplies are also available in a limited fashion.



### OG HASS AVOCADOS

**ALERT!** Rain has been the big story in Mexico with heavy rains preventing **Organic Hass Avocados** from being picked. This has made an already tight market worse.

There are virtually no 48ct or larger fruit. 60ct have been trickling across the border, keeping people in supply. Mexico's Aventajada crop will not start until around the middle of September, so this will be a difficult product until October.

Peru and California are pretty much done for the season.



### OG ASPARAGUS

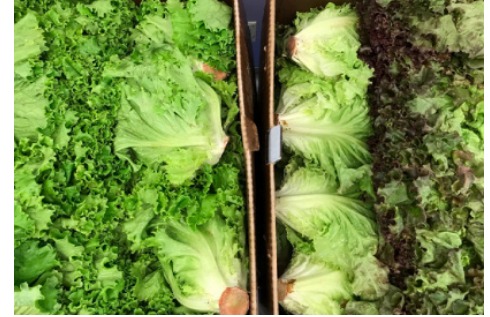
**Organic Asparagus** prices will be rising for the beginning of September as supplies have slowed way down. Mexico is in a transition period as Baja is expected to start new fields in mid-September. Quality has been good.



### OG EGGPLANT & GREEN PEPPERS

**Organic Eggplant and Green Peppers** from Lady Moon Farms in PA continue with superb quality. Promote local **Organic Eggplant and Green Peppers** during the first week of September.

**NOTE:** The heavy rains from Hurricane Ida may affect supplies in early September and finish the season early.



### OG LETTUCE

**NOTE: Organic Lettuces** from California continues to be a struggle as we enter September. Many suppliers are experiencing light supplies or gapping completely due to heat and other quality defects. Conditions are expected to remain limited until mid to late September. Quebec product will be a steady supplemental product in September.

**NOTE: Organic Romaine Hearts** from California are also suffering, causing pricing to rise. Supplies are expected to be more limited as September continues.

**NOTE: Organic Iceberg Lettuce** from Quebec will be gapping in supplies for the first week of September. Supplies from California will be limited and expensive.



### OG PEPPERS

**Organic Red, Orange, and Yellow Bell Peppers** from Canada continue to see excellent supplies, while Holland has begun harvesting again. Pricing is elevated slightly from August but remains promotable in September, while quality is outstanding.



## OG GREENS

Local fall crop **Organic Greens** from Lady Moon Farms in PA will get started around 9/9! **Organic Kales, Collards, and Dandelion Greens** will begin the first, followed by **Organic Parsley**. Expect volumes to grow as the month continues.



## OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

**NOTE: Organic Broccoli** from California is in flux. Pricing is on the rise, and due to heat and bug pressure, quality issues are present with less volume available. Early to mid-September will be a difficult time for Broccoli.

**NOTE: Organic Broccoli Crowns** have already seen pricing rise and less availability. Expect this to continue for early September.

**NOTE: Organic Broccoli Rabe** is also seeing struggles with quality and availability.

**NOTE: Organic Cauliflower** from California is experiencing many of the same difficulties as Organics Broccoli. Although we have yet to see extreme pricing increases, supplies are becoming limited, and quality is subpar. Quebec product will be available to help supplement California product.

- **Organic Artichokes** from California have seen supplies tighten. Expect pricing to rise in early September.

- **Organic Celery** continues to see steady supplies as September begins. Much like August, early September will experience strong supplies and excellent quality. Continue to promote in September with large displays.

- **NOTE:** Between trouble in fields, production challenges, and logistics issues, **Organic Carrot** availability will be disrupted here and there during September on both cellos and value-added packs.



## OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

**Organic Brussels Sprouts** from Mexico continue to see study supplies as September begins. Expect supplies to continue to improve, as well as pricing, with promotional opportunities to arise.



## OG TOMATOES

**Local Organic Snacking (Cherry, Rainbow Cherry, and Grape) Tomatoes** continue to be available from Lady Moon Farms in PA. Quality has been excellent.

**Organic Heirloom Tomatoes** from local growers, like Lady Moon Farms, will still be around for the beginning of September with good quality. Supplies will begin to slow down during September as the peak season is ending.

**Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes** grown in PA from King Family Farms continue in season for the beginning of September. Quality has been excellent on this high tunnel grown product. Supplies are expected to be steady through September.

**Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes** will be promotable for the beginning of September. Locally grown product continues to be available, and Canada is starting their new crops with limited availability to start. Quality has been nice from both areas. **Organic Cluster Tomatoes** also remain steady for the beginning of September out Canada. Quality has been excellent.

## OTHER STORIES

- Local **Organic Green Beans** supply volumes should go back down during early September, due to planting interruptions and weather conditions caused by Hurricane Ida.

- **Organic Kiwi Berries** from Oregon will be available around the second week of September!

- **ALERT! Organic Bi-color Sweet Corn** from NY and PA has finished for the season. Although supplies were strong for most of August, due to rain during the planting season, quality issues began to arise causing the season to end about a month earlier than usual. Expect to see gaps in supplies as we wait for southern product to begin.



## OG POMEGRANATES

**Organic Pomegranates** from California will be in stock around 9/7! We will offer a 30-36ct box of fruit to start and expand to some larger sizing as they become available.



## OG BERRIES

**Organic Blackberries** are in steady supply for the beginning of September but expect much shorter supplies heading towards the middle of the month as we begin to transition from California to Mexico.

**ALERT! Organic Blueberries** continue to be extremely tight as California, Washington, and Oregon ramp down and Mexico and Peru will start to pick up in late September, markets are currently very strong but should level off as we move into October.

**NOTE: Organic Raspberries** out of California are declining in production. Expect prices to start climbing until Baja gets started in November.

**NOTE: Organic Strawberries** are in firm supply with high prices. This trend should continue until Mexico begins in November. Prorates should be expected, along with some occasional quality challenges.

- **Organic Yellow Nectarines and Peaches** are in good supply from Washington and California. **Organic Peaches** could be available into early October.

- **Organic Black Plums, Red Plums, and Pluots** are in the home stretch with only sporadic arrivals and high prices left for until the middle of September, and then done for the season.

- **NOTE: Organic Shiitake Mushrooms** are seeing a decline in production due to a lack of growing logs arriving to the US. Growers have taken their price up to slow down movement.

# CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

## TIME FOR PUMPKINS & FALL ORNAMENTALS!



**Pumpkins and Ornaments** will be in stock and available for delivery starting around 9/9!

Quality has been looking excellent from early reports via our Pennsylvania growers. **NOTE:** However, with the remnants of Hurricane Ida moving through the growing regions and dumping heavy rains along the way, we could see some early fields affected by that flooding and less supplies to start off the season (stay tuned!).

We will be offering a wide range of **Pumpkin Heirloom** varieties like **Cinderella**, **Peanut**, **Warty Goblin**, and many more in Mixed Bins. We will have all the complementary items like **Jack-Be-Littles**, **Baby Boo's**, **Baby Pam's**, **Corn Stalks**, and **Hay Bales**, plus more to enhance your fall displays.

Pricing will be a little higher than last year as farmers' expenses are up for labor and packaging materials. The varieties will be available through early October, as farmers plant to finish up around then to focus on selling **Face Pumpkins (Jack-O-Lantern)**, which will be available through late October.



### CV APPLES

The **Eastern Apple** portfolio will expand for the first week of September.

We'll start to receive some new varieties such as **Sweetango**, **McIntosh**, and **Red Delicious**. As a reminder, this is in addition to the **Gala**, **Ginger Gold**, and **Honeycrisp Apples** that are already started for the season. The quality has been awesome in all formats - trays, poly bags, and totes. Later this month - **Cortland**, **Jonagold**, **Empire**, and **Fuji Apples!**

Washington is ramping up for the **Apple** season as well, but we're still in transition for many varieties, and these markets will be very tight heading into the first two weeks of September. Be prepared for extremely short supplies on **Golden Delicious** and **Granny Smith**, but this will be short term.

Washington **Honeycrisp Apples** have started for the season, and they're absolutely beautiful. Sizing is currently running mostly 72's, 80's, and 88's.



### CV MELONS

**Cantaloupes** are in excellent supply from California, and the quality is outstanding. Size is running mostly to Jumbo 9ct on the "Peacock" brand right now with minimal supplies on 12ct. We're definitely receiving some of the best fruit of the year right now.

**NOTE:** Local **Bin Cantaloupes** are winding down for the season and will be completely finished after Labor Day.

**Honeydew** supplies are now improving as we head into the first week of September. We had a short-lived gap as we transitioned fields, but we're back in good supplies with both 5ct and 6ct - "King of the West" label.

**Watermelon** prices remain steady for the beginning of September. With all the heavy rain, expect local PA fields to be finished up. DE will continue with some volume as well, while most shippers start back up in North Carolina as demand softens to start making room for fall decor. Quality has been excellent from all areas.



### CV BERRIES

**Raspberries** and **Blackberries** are in steady supply as we head into September. We will close out the month sourcing from California, and then begin to transition into Mexico in October. Quality has been good.

**ALERT! Strawberries** will continue to be in tighter supply after Labor Day. Volumes will still decline from California, but it sounds like volumes could improve as we head into October. For now, expect higher pricing than normal, and be aware that Strawberries will be showing more bruising than normal due to the growing conditions in Santa Maria, Salinas, and Watsonville.

**NOTE: Blueberries** continue to be in extremely tight supply, and pricing will reflect this shortage. Peruvian imports have been looking great but are delayed coming through backed up ports. Volumes are expected to be okay in the month of September if product gets through the ports quick enough.

We'll begin to see **Blueberry** imports from Columbia arrive mid-September and product from Argentina will arrive the last week of September.



### CV GRAPES

Grapes from California are absolutely beautiful! Now is a great time to promote all colors – **Black**, **Green**, and **Red**, as growers are in some of their better varieties and good growing conditions have created excellent size and sugars.

On XL **Green Seedless Grapes**, the Stella Bella, Ivory, and Milano varieties are peaking for early September.



### CV CUCUMBERS

**Super Select Cucumber** prices continue to increase for the beginning of September as supplies start to slow down from local growers, especially after Hurricane Ida rains.

**Euro Seedless Cucumber** prices have firmed up a bit as the flush has finished but will remain promotable. Quality has been very nice out of Canada.

**Mini Seedless Cucumber** prices continue to increase as harvests slow down out of Canada. Quality has been excellent.



### CV GREENHOUSE TOMATOES

**Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes** will be very promotable for the beginning of September. Harvests continue to increase, and demand has been very light leading to promotable markets. Quality has been nice.



### CV SPECIALTY GRAPES

From The Grapery, **Cotton Candy Grapes** continue in peak season with impressive sweetness and memorable branding. We're also pleased to offer their **Moon Drops Grapes** this month - sweet, firm, elongated black seedless.

New! **"Candyland" Candy Snap Red Seedless Grapes** will be available in 10/1lb clamshells. This variety is crunchy, with a juicy explosion of tropical and fruity flavors.



### CV PEPPERS

**Green Bell Pepper** prices will start to increase some for the beginning of September. With the recent weather events, harvests started to become affected due to extreme heat and rain. Quality has been decent, but availability has gotten tighter.

11lb **Red**, **Orange**, and **Yellow Pepper** prices will remain steady for the beginning of September out of Canada. **Orange** continues to be a tight color. Mexico is harvesting with sporadic movement to start, so expect some spot deals out of Mexico going into September. Quality has been nice from both regions.



### CV ASPARAGUS

**Asparagus** will continue to be short for the beginning of September as Peru and Mexico are both experiencing limited harvests. Prices will continue to increase slightly before easing off as the Baja deal begins in mid-September with promotable volume expected headed into October. Quality has been nice.



### CV FIGS

**Black Mission Figs** from California remain promotable for early September. Look to take advantage of some peak freshness and flavor!

We will have some **Tiger Stripe/Panache Figs** available in limited supply for early September as well in a 12/8oz pack.



### CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Quebec is experiencing some field gaps on **Broccoli Crowns**, and Maine and California still have availability for now. Quality is still very nice. California growers are expecting harvest numbers to drop across late September.

California cello **Cauliflower** continues to have great availability. There are spot buys here and there on naked **Cauliflower** from Quebec.

**Purple**, **Orange**, and **Green Cauliflower** is available from the west coast.



### CV BIN BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Local PA **Bin Jacket Cauliflower** and **Bin Stem Broccoli** transplants are in the ground and are looking good. The first harvests are expected by the end of September with peak promotion in October.

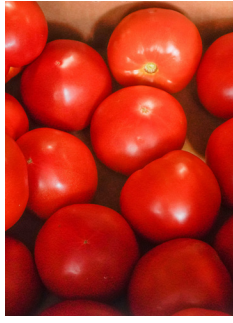
The impacts of Hurricane Ida rains have not been fully assessed.



### CV CITRUS

Import **Navel Oranges** look to remain in steady supply for the month of September. There seems to be plenty of volume from Chile and South Africa, and there's an excellent range of sizing. We'll have good supplies on 48's, 56's, 72', 88's, and 9/3lb bags.

**NOTE: Mandarins** will begin to tighten up as we head into September. We're already beginning to see pricing rise on both 10/3lb and 15/2lb, and this is mostly due to port delays. This delay at the port is absolutely slowing the amount of supply being released into the market, and packinghouses can't keep up with the demand. Unfortunately, the port delays aren't looking to improve anytime soon.



### CV FIELD TOMATOES

**NOTE: Grape Tomato** prices will be strong for the beginning of September. Locally grown product is slowing down tremendously, and all major growing regions have been impacted by Hurricane Ida's rain. Quality has been very nice.

**NOTE: Roma Tomato** prices are expected to rise as all major growing regions have been impacted by Hurricane Ida's rain. Mexico production is very light. Quality has been nice.

Locally grown **Vine Ripe Tomato** prices are getting stronger as harvest numbers slow down. Peak season is over, and harvests are expected to be much lighter. Quality has been excellent.



### CV STONE FRUIT

Late season **Rose Apriums**, along with multiple **Pluot** varieties are available to promote for early September.

**Italian Prune Plums** are in peak season.

**Nectarines** from California will be in good supply through mid-September, but then the season will wind down for the year. We have good supplies on both volume fill and 2-layer options.

**Peaches** will be in steady supply from California for the next couple weeks until they wind down for the season. Currently, we're sourcing mostly 2-layer premium **Peaches** from California and volume fill 25lb cartons from New Jersey. New Jersey has had an excellent season so far, and they're expecting great weeks of harvesting heading into mid-September. Quality has been excellent from both locations.



### CV TROPICALS

**Pineapples** supplies are steady for the beginning of September. Some growers are offering very promotable deals and others are focused on their special varieties. Look to promote some bigger 5 and 6ct fruit.

**Mangos** from Mexico are winding down and we have transitioned into fresh new arrivals of Brazilian fruit. These will be available after Labor Day.



### CV SPECIALTY

**Quince** will be available once again from California in a 32-36ct single layer pack!

**Pomegranate** pricing fell a few dollars as more fruit hit the market. The season has started with the Granada variety which has been looking very nice, with great color.

**Dragon Fruit** from Florida dried up very quickly and supplies are very tight in all varieties. We should begin to see some fruit coming from Ecuador, but that season has been slow to come on.



### CV AVOCADOS

**ALERT!** Rain has caused all kinds of trouble the past few weeks for **Hass Avocados** from Mexico.

Large fruit continues to be very tight. 60ct fruit remains more available, so some retailers are switching to this size to stay in stock.

Mexico's Aventajada crop will not start until at least the middle of September, so the next few weeks will be very tight.

### OTHER STORIES

- NOTE: Green Bean** prices will jump rapidly for the beginning of September. The rains from Ida have finished some fields prematurely and gaps are expected on local product. Quality has been good.

- Brussels Sprouts** are expected to have better volume and pricing after Labor Day.

- Artichoke** availability is limited and prices likely to remain high for early September.

- California and Quebec **Iceberg, Romaine, and Romaine Hearts** are starting to inch up in price due to quality and packing yields.

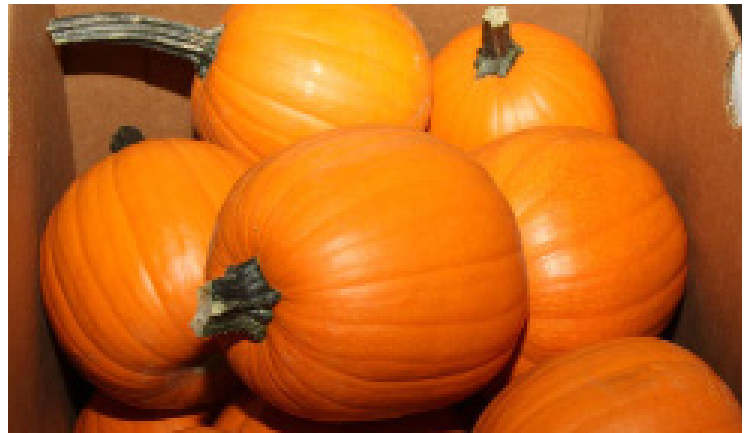
