ORGANIC AVOCADO VOLUMES REBOUNDING



Price relief has finally arrived!

Organic Hass Avocado supplies from Mexico have come on strong and prices are beginning to fall as well. Lower case costs are expected to level off by the middle to end of October, and volumes will continue to be promotable during the fourth quarter of 2021.

Four Seasons has started the Mexican season with our Fair Trade Partner Equal Exchange. **FT Organic Hass Avocados** will be in good supply for the week of 10/11! Each week should see a small drop in price throughout October.

Quality is expected to be in nice shape.

Organic Green Skin Avocados from Florida are in peak season for early October. This variety is preferred in Caribbean cuisine.



OG FALL FRUIT

Organic Pomegranates from California will be promotable for the week of 10/11! Four Seasons will offer a 24-28ct and 30-36ct sizes throughout the season.

Organic Pomegranate Arils from I LOVE POME-GRANATES will be back in season starting at the beginning of October though the rest of 2021. This convenience product is best merchandised in refrigeration beside your berry or grape assortment.

Organic Fuyu Persimmons will be in season and available starting 10/13. Fuyu are the flat variety that can be eaten when firm or soft. Later in mid-October the cone shaped **Organic Hachiya Persimmons** will come into season. Hachiya must be ripened to water balloon soft.

The first of the season **Organic Cranberries** are in stock for Fall selling.

Organic Kiwi Berries continue in peak season in the front half of October.



OG CITRUS

Organic Citrus' outlook is looking up with **Organic Lemons** out of both Mexico and California in good supply and prices continuing to come down.

California **Organic Grapefruit** is just starting in a small way. Expect these to remain limited in volume until November.

New crop Mexican **Organic Valencia Oranges** should get started by the end of October, and then these will quickly be followed by new crop California **Organic Navel Oranges.**

Organic Satsuma Mandarins are expected to arrive by November.

Steady supplies of Mexican **Organic Limes** are expected for October.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blackberries continue to transition from old crop California to new crop Mexico with firm supplies out of both regions, but better volumes are expected towards the end October. Prices should come down at that time.

Organic Blueberry supplies are firm out of California, Argentina, and Peru, with some of the best bloom, size, and taste that we have seen in a while on the new crop import fruit. Supplies should ramp up as we move through October and prices should ease alongside.

NOTE: Organic Raspberries continue in very firm supply with high prices. This is expected to continue through December when we move into the new Baja crop.

Organic Strawberries are experiencing a very small peak and then (**NOTE**) expected to tighten significantly, causing prices to take steep increases as we move into the end of October or early November.



OG APPLES & PEARS

Our amazing October Stemilt **Organic Apple** and **Pear** promotion continues! Quality has been outstanding so far!

Organic Premium Apples in stock now: Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, and Swee-Tango Apples as well as, Organic Bartlett, Bosc, and Starkrimson Red Pears. Out of California Organic Asian Pears and Seckel Pears are in peak season.

During mid-October, we will welcome the long-awaited new crop Organic Gold Delicious, Opal, Sugar Bee and Rocklt Apples, as well as Washington Organic Anjou, Concorde, and Seckel Pears.



OG PEPPERS

Organic Red, Orange, and **Yellow Bell Peppers** from Canada continue to see strong supplies, but as we approach the end of the month supplies will begin to dwindle as we switch to Mexican supplies.

Organic Mini Mix Peppers bags from Green Field Farms in Ohio will continue to have availability in early October. Supplies from Ohio are expected to be steady in the early part of the month and quality will be strong.



OG LETTUCES

Organic Leaf, Iceberg, and **Romaine Lettuces** are experiencing slightly stronger yields in mid-October, but overall remain low. Both pricing and availability from California are expected to improve as October continues, while quality will remain strong. Mid to late-November is the expected start of Lady Moon's Florida Lettuce season!



OG CABBAGE

Organic Cabbage from Lancaster County, PA and upstate New York will have strong volumes in October. Both growing regions forecast stable supplies and pricing throughout October.



OG SOFT SQUASH

Organic Zucchini yields are strong from Lady Moon Farms Florida in mid-October. Promotional opportunities will be available in mid-October with increased volumes and improved pricing, while continuing top-notch quality.

Organic Yellow Squash volumes have improved and promotional opportunities to pair with Zucchini will be available. Quality from South Carolina has been stellar in October!



OG GRAPES

Organic Seedless Grapes from California continue in peak season with nice quality. For October, **Black** are "Autumn Royal", **Green** are "Autumn Crisp" and "Autumn King", **Red** are "Timco", "Krissy", and "Scarlotta" - All nice textured large sized premium grapes.



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumbers from Lady Moon Farms in Florida is experiencing a small lull in supplies from growing conditions. Volume from the Carolinas, Georgia, and Florida will be available to supplement supplies. Mid to late-October is when supplies are expected to improve. Quality from all regions have been excellent!

NOTE: Organic Mini Seedless Cucumbers continue to be very limited, and prices are high. Quality has been nice.

Organic Euro Seedless Cucumbers will be promotable for mid-October. Canadian growers are in a small flush and have some extra product available. Quality has been excellent.



OG HARD SQUASH

Organic Hard Squash is in full swing from Pennsylvania and Wisconsin farms!

The exciting **Organic Honeynut Squash** variety is in very promotable supply for the next couple weeks – if you have not yet tried this variety, it is a fantastic eating hard squash! It's extremely sweet, with a nutty flavor and a buttery texture.

NOTE: Organic Spaghetti Squash is more limited this year.



OG GREENS

Organic Greens from Lady Moon Farms in PA finished harvesting in early October. We will see a gap in Lady Moon Farms **Organic Greens** production until they begin in Florida in mid to late November. In the meanwhile, expect to see product for California to supplement our other local growers.



OG ONIONS

October-November will be peak season for Peri and Sons premium bagged **Organic Onions** from Nevada.

Organic Red and Yellow Onions are in stock now in 16/3 lb bags, followed by Organic Sweet Onions by mid-month.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes will be available from Mexico and Canada. Canadian greenhouse production is down, so expect more supplies from Mexico. Canada is expected to have steadier supplies later this Fall. UPC packaged Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes are back in stock!

Organic Cluster Tomatoes will be available mainly out of Mexico. Canadian production had an unexpected delay in harvests. UPC packaged Organic Cluster Tomatoes are back in stock!

Organic Grape Tomato prices are high this week. Local production has finished up and Florida is not expected to start until early November. Mexico is harvesting but supply chain issues keep availability sporadic. South Carolina will have availability and quality is excellent.

Organic Campari Tomatoes out of Mexico are available with steady supplies. Bagged Organic Roma Tomatoes are back in stock!

Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes from King Family Farms in PA continue to be available. These high tunnel, locally grown tomatoes are excellent quality and flavor, as backyard gardens finish up for the season.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico will have stable volumes, with improved pricing. Promotional opportunities on Organic Brussels Sprouts will be available in October and quality will be excellent.

NEW: Organic Purple Brussels Sprouts will be available beginning in mid-October.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

ALERT! Organic Broccoli from California remains a struggle with volume. Elevated pricing will continue throughout October with light volumes and subpar quality.

ALERT! Organic Broccoli Crowns and Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli also continue to experience limited supplies in October. Pricing will remain elevated for most of October.

NOTE: Organic Cauliflower volumes are becoming lighter and will be reflected in pricing during mid-October. California product will begin to suffer from lighter harvest numbers and subpar quality, while Quebec has experienced colder weather slowing product at the end of their season. Prepare to see price increases in mid-October and continue for the remainder of the month.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus continues to be available from Argentina. Supplies will slow down out of Argentina as flight space is very limited. However, Mexico is now starting new harvests as well. After a delayed start, supplies are expected to be available through October.



OG TROPICALS

California grown Organic Magenta Dragon Fruit will be available at times during mid-October. Ecuador grown Organic Yellow Pitahaya Dragon Fruit will also have some in-and-out availability throughout October. Keep an eye out for these!

NOTE: Organic Mangos from Mexico are now done for the season and the only thing available will be some limited volumes of higher priced Organic California Keitt Mangos. Expect occasional out of stocks until new crop Ecuador product arrives to the US later in October.

Organic Pineapples will be steady through September. We will offer both 6ct and 8ct during this time.

ALERT! Organic Drink & Eat Coconuts and Coconut Chunks will be out of stock for the month of October due to container delays.

Organic Kiwano Melons and Organic Passion Fruit will be available for early October.

OTHER STORIES

• Organic Eggplant and Green Pepper from the Carolinas will continue to have steady supplies in mid-October. Quality is excellent for both commodities and pricing will remain unchanged in mid-October. Lady Moon Farms is expected to begin by late October. • New crop **Organic Mini Watermelons** are available Mexico. Quality has been excellent on the first arrivals. Supplies are expected to remain steady through October and into November.

• Organic Celery supplies are abundant, quality is strong, and pricing is promotable to increase sales.

 ALERT! Poor yields on Organic Carrots in California are causing problems for October. Expect occasional prorates on Organic Baby Peeled Carrots and other items.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

OCTOBER 8 - OCTOBER 15, 2021

IMPORT BLUEBERRY OUTLOOK



The import **Blueberry** season got off to a slow start in 2021, including a lot of problems due to delays coming into and getting out of US ports. It appears volumes are finally catching up some.

Blueberry supplies have increased significantly over the past week from Peru coming into Philadelphia area ports, and we will see more promotable pricing as we head into mid-October. Quality has been excellent, and the sizing has been very large.

Most growers are sending Pints to North America with less 6 oz. clamshells available. There are also some 9.8 oz **Jumbo Blueberry** packs available.

Mid to late October is an improved time to promote more pint **Blueberries**, and it's looking like November will be a great time to run ads (So long as things don't get worse at the ports). More volume is on the way from Peru.



CV BERRIES

Strawberries are in steady supply from multiple growing regions in California. We will transition away from the Salinas and Watsonville, CA old crops, and move south into Santa Maria now, and then to Oxnard. **NOTE:** Quality has been declining from the northern growing areas, and now is the time to get into better fruit. Sizing will still be on the smaller side, but you will begin to see quality improve later in October. Pricing will begin to climb slightly over the next couple weeks.

Raspberries and **Blackberries** will transition to new crop Mexico. Heading into the week of 10/11, we will be loading all Mexican grown fruit and should see a significant improvement in quality. **NOTE: Blackberries** have had very poor shelf life from California.

Raspberry supplies look to be more plentiful than **Blackberries**, and pricing will reflect that accordingly. Get ready to promote Mexican Berries!



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Local PA **Jacket Cauliflower** bins are a slow go to start the season with limited availability. Quality has looked very nice.

Some of these same local PA growers have smaller volumes of **Purple** and **Orange Cheddar Jack-et Cauliflower** available to prebook.

12ct **Cello Cauliflower** from Quebec is done for the season, and California is seeing a stronger demand. Pricing is slowly bumping up.

NOTE: California **Broccoli Crowns** remain limited, and Maine growers are finishing up for the season. Georgia harvests have started with North Carolina following soon after. Prices will remain higher until volumes ramp up.

Local PA **Stem Broccoli Bins** are in peak season and looking really nice!



CV APPLES

Eastern Apples (PA, NY) continue build momentum into the fall. We will introduce the Stayman, Rome, and Granny Smith Apples to the mix by mid-October from our local PA growers. We will have options in trays, bags, and totes on all three varieties.

The NY **Snap Dragon Apples** continue to sell well, and the quality is outstanding. We have trays in a euro pack as well as 12/2 lb pouch bags.

SugarBee Apples out of Washington are right around the corner. We will get our first load of SugarBee Apples around 10/16. Get ready to promote this great eating apple!

Rockit Apples will begin towards the end of October. These will be part of the display contest for November, and we will have two options to carry. Get ready to promote this unique, small sized apple.



CV GRAPES

Cotton Candy Grapes will continue from California until the last week of October. Quality has been absolutely perfect on these **Grapes**, and it looks like it'll be a smooth transition into imports from Brazil. Containers will begin to arrive the week of 10/11 in mostly a 10/1 lb, with 16 lb bag options arriving in November.

Green and Red Seedless Grapes continue to be in excellent supply. Now is the time to promote the Hobgoblin Grapes as we head into Halloween. The quality has been excellent, and the pricing will improve as we head into mid-October, providing some promotional opportunities.



CV PUMPKINS & ORNAMENTALS

Pumpkins and **Ornamentals** remain available from local growers. Specialty varieties are beginning to finish up for the season as growers plan to finish these up in early October. Face Pumpkins are expected to remain steady through Halloween.



CV PEPPERS

111b Red, Orange, and **Yellow Peppers** remain promotable. Quality out of Canada and Mexico has been excellent. Supplies are very plentiful.

Green Pepper prices will remain steady. GA production continues and quality is nice. Local production is more sporadic but remains available. Florida is expected to begin late October. Quality has been nice from all regions.



CV MELONS

Cantaloupes and **Honeydew** will slowly come to an end in California and begin to shift into Mexican growing regions for late Fall.

In California, the **Cantaloupe** sizing has dropped from 9ct to mostly 12ct at the end of the season. Look for 12ct to be the primary pack as we head into mid-October.

King of the West **Honeydews** will finish for the season the week of 10/11, but Mexico has begun. It looks like it'll be a smooth transition this season.



CV PEARS

Pears are in plentiful supply across the board. We will have beautiful Asian Pears from California and premium 90sz in Bartlett, Bosc, and Anjou Pears from Washington all month. Get ready to promote Pears for the month of November with our upcoming promotion and display contest!



CV WATERMELON

NOTE: Watermelon volumes are getting tight. Supplies are coming from the Carolinas, and New Mexico are limited. Florida's new Fall crop isn't expected to start harvests until the end of October. Mexico is expected to start in November.

In the meantime **Watermelons** will be in and out of stock with some 8 ct **Mini Watermelons** to supplement.



CV CUCUMBERS

Super Select Cucumbers will be promotable from GA and NC. Quality has been excellent. Mexico is beginning to harvest as well but supplies are still limited.

Euro Seedless Cucumber supplies remain very tight. Crop rotation continues to keep supplies very snug and prices high. Supplies are expected to increase in the end of October.

Mini Seedless Cucumbers will remain tight as well. Mexico harvests are expected to start midlate October, leading to better supplies. Quality has been nice.



CV RED KIWI FRUIT

Red Kiwifruit will be available for the month of October in an 8/11b clamshell. Be sure to try this premium fruit this fall!



CV IDAHO POTATOES

NOTE: Bagged Idaho Russet Potatoes will be limited during mid-October as the size profile is much larger than we have been seeing over the last month. **Bagged Idaho Potatoes** could potentially gap in supply so we'll fill in from Wisconsin and Prince Edward Island during that time.

On the other hand, large **Count Russet Potatoes** are in very good supply and pricing has started to come down significantly since late September.



CV CITRUS

Import Navel Oranges from the southern hemisphere have seen high demand to start the month of October. Valencia Oranges from California will come to a close by the end of the month, and we'll make a smooth transition into Navel Oranges. The California crop is looking to be in good supply, but it will take some time for the crop to show larger sizing.

Grapefruit will begin harvesting the week of 10/11 from Florida. The overall Florida crop is looking to be off slightly compared to last year, but due to the significant damage in Texas, we're expecting much higher pricing across the board this season. Sizing is expected to start off between 36sz and 56sz, and overall quality will be great. Get ready for another outstanding **Grapefruit** season from Florida!

Mandarins from California are right around the corner! We will have our first Halo's the second week of November. Until then, we will have steady supplies of import **Mandarins** from Peru and Chile. **NOTE**: Pricing has been higher than usual lately, mostly due to the port issues with product being released on time. Quality has been very nice on all imports.

Lemons from California are in much better supply heading into mid-October, and the quality has improved greatly now that we're in district 3. Mexican Lemons have really picked up, and we're beginning to see a split market between import and domestic. Quality has been excellent from both growing regions.

• Mangos will tighten a bit as container delays from Brazil, but there's product from Puerto Rico. We will offer 6, 10, and 12ct sizing. The first Ataulfo Honey Mangos from Ecuador will be available for the week of 10/11 in an 18ct offering.

• **Pineapples** will be super promotable through October! Sizing will be especially promotable in 7 and 8ct sizes for the next few weeks. The popular premium **HoneyGlow Pineapples** from Del Monte will also be available in 5 and 7ct sizing. The taste and quality of this fruit is outstanding.

• Hass Avocado prices are dropping very quickly. A major flush of product after weeks of very short supplies has seen prices become promotable overnight. Volume in the popular 48 and 60ct sizing is very good while larger fruit, such as 32ct, is still commanding higher prices.



CV TOMATOES

Beefsteak Tomatoes remain steady this week. Demand has been strong, keeping prices elevated. Mexico has the most volume available. There is light USA and Canadian production available as well. Quality has been excellent.

Cluster Tomato prices are easing off as more production becomes available from Mexico. USA greenhouses are a few weeks away from new fall crops. Quality has been excellent.

NOTE: Grape Tomato prices are very high this week. Demand is extremely strong, and Florida production has just begun. Quality has been excellent.

Campari Tomatoes supplies from Mexico are steady and quality has been excellent.

NOTE: Local **Heirloom Tomato** production is slowing down very rapidly with the cool temperatures overnight. Supplies will be very limited as we approach the end of the season very fast.

NOTE: Vine Ripe Tomato prices remain very high. Production down south has been very limited, and local production is finishing up very quickly. Quality has been nice.

Roma Tomato prices continue to be strong Production down south is in transition as Tennessee finishes production and Florida has not yet begun. Mexico has limited production as well keeping supplies tight.

OTHER STORIES

• Zucchini prices are steady from the East Coast. Quality has been nice. Mexico is expected to start with good volume this week as well, and quality should be excellent. Freight rates continue to be strong as well keeping costs elevated. Yellow Squash prices, supplies, and demand continue to be steady. Quality has been excellent.
