FEB-BLUE-ARY ORGANICS



GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries are promotable for our FeBLUEary promotion.

Quality has been exceptional, though supplies are expected to slow in mid-February due to reduced Chilean production. This year's promotion began earlier and will conclude by mid-month.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberries from Baja, Mexico will be promotable for early February, supported by ideal growing conditions that are driving increased volume. Supplies are strong, and quality has been excellent overall.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Raspberries will be promotable for the first week of February from Baja as growers enter an early-season flush, delivering strong volume and outstanding quality. Fruit is arriving large, firm, and with excellent eating characteristics.

Organic Blackberry supplies will begin to firm as growers move beyond winter peak production. Pricing is expected to rise into a more typical range, with steady availability and good quality out of Central Mexico.



OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mandarins from California are now in season with strong varieties going forward, supply stabilizing, and quality improving, allowing retailers to confidently bring these back to the shelf for February and March on the "Cuties" and "Halos" brands.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Navel Oranges are seeing abundant supplies of large fruit out of California, supporting promotions on all sizes larger than 56 ct throughout the month of February.

Organic Citrus varieties, including Blood Oranges, Cara Cara Oranges, Minneolas, Pummelos, and Heirloom Navel Oranges, are now available and offer excellent opportunities to build variety-driven displays.

Ask your rep about weekly availability on Buck Brand Organic Specialty Citrus varieties.



OG TOMATOES

NOTE: Organic Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes are beginning to show increased supply pressure, particularly on Organic Cluster Tomato varieties. Availability is tightening as February begins, quality remains strong, and rising costs are limiting promotional activity.

Organic Snacking Tomatoes from Florida remain limited, with supplemental supply from Canada and Mexico also constrained. Overall volume remains tight, despite quality continuing to be exceptional. Costs are elevated, and promotional activity is expected to be limited.

ALERT! Upcoming cold temperatures in Florida will be closely monitored due to potential impacts on production and availability.

Organic Roma Tomatoes continue to show steady availability from Mexico, though volume has dipped slightly. Quality remains strong, and promotional activity is recommended as the "Big Game" approaches.



OG PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Color Bell Peppers are seeing good supply volume from both Israel and Mexico, with quality remaining strong across both regions. As early February begins, Mexico is expected to become the primary source, with promotional opportunities emerging.

Israeli Organic Color Bell Peppers will continue to be available, though at a premium, supporting the higher end of the market.



OG LADY MOON VEG

ALERT! Like many Florida growers, Lady Moon continues to closely monitor the potential for very cold temperatures over the start of February. Recent strong winds may further impact upcoming supplies of warm-weather vegetables such as Organic Eggplant and Green Bell Peppers.

Organic Kales, Collards, Dandelion Greens, Shishito Peppers, and Parsleys are currently in excellent supply for now with strong quality from Lady Moon Farms in Florida.



OG CARROTS

ALERT! Organic Carrot supplies, including cellos/bags and value-added items, remain constrained due to ongoing weather impacts in California and Georgia. Allocations persist, and reliance on multiple labels and Canadian supply will continue until California desert production begins later in February and Georgia recovers from recent cold conditions.



OG ROOT VEG

Organic Yuca Root is available in a 10 lb bulk case from Glaser Farms. Organic Yuca is not waxed like the conventional root. It is very rare to find an Organic Root option like this!

More organic options from Glaser Farms include Organic Cactus Leaves, Water Coconuts, Starfruit, Black Sapote, Sapodilla and more!



OG ARUGULA

ALERT! Salad producers continue to struggle with quality and yields on organic Baby Arugula salad greens. This is causing persistent out-of-stocks or pro-rated fill-rates which are expected to continue through February for Earthbound, Olivia's, and organicgirl.



OG MANGOS

New crop Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos are now available from Mexico! Be sure to get them worked into your Mango displays for the start of February!

Organic Mangos from Peru are winding down and the fruit is very large. We will have 7/8 ct fruit available along with more limited supplies of 10 and 12 ct fruit. The smaller fruit is limited and commanding a higher price to finish the season.



OG ASPARAGUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Asparagus production from Caborca, Mexico is improving, positioning February through late March as a strong promotional window. Current supplies remain reliable, with excellent quality available under the "Hippie Organics" label from Alpine.



OG CAULIFLOWER & ROMANESCO

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cauliflower remains highly promotable, with strong counts and pack quality continuing out of California.

Organic Romanesco remains in steady supply from Lakeside, supported by strong quality and consistent sizing.



OG SOLI BASIL

NOTE: Soli is warning of low production on Organic Basil for early to mid February from low light and cold temps, impacting fill-rates on 3/0.5oz retail packs especially.

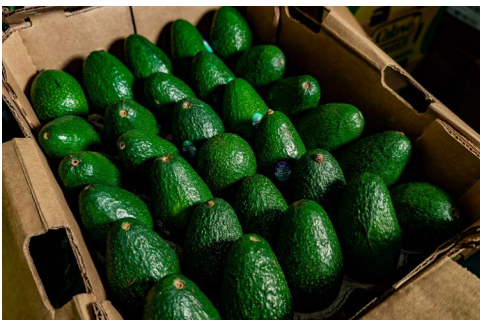


OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Mini and Euro Cucumbers are showing mixed market conditions.

Organic Euro Cucumbers remain steady with average pricing conditions.

ALERT! **Organic Mini Cucumbers** tight in supply and elevated in cost.



OG AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! 48ct and 60ct **Organic Hass Avocados** will be promotable to start February and Four Seasons is ready for your "Big Game" preparation and displays. Bagged **Organic Hass Avocado** options will also be available!

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados** are back in stock, including 8/4ct ready cycle trays.

We are stocked up with some great Point of Sale materials from Avocados from Mexico. Be sure to tap into some of these free resources to increase your "Big Game" sales!

- **Organic Red Turmeric** from Florida is now available in very limited supplies. This **Organic Red Turmeric** is beautiful and grown with pride on a small farm in northern Florida! This will undoubtedly be the nicest **Organic Turmeric** your shelves see all year!

- **NOTE:** **Organic Pomegranate Arils** will see a small gap sometime in early February as the California Pomegranate season is officially over and Peru processing has yet to begin.

- **Organic Grapes** from Peru and South Africa are supplying both **Organic Red** and **Organic Green Grapes**, with prices remaining elevated despite steady quality and availability.

- **Organic Pineapples** from Mexico will be in steady supply for the start of February. **Organic**



OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli, including both **Bunched** and **Crown** packs, is relying primarily on West Coast production, with strong quality.

NOTE: **Organic Broccoli Crown** pricing remains elevated due to size curves, though overall pricing remains workable.

Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli is around, though tightening is expected in the coming weeks.



OG APPLES

The start of February begins the huge Washington **Organic Rockit/SugarBee Apple** Promo and Display Contest, featuring 14 prizes, including two all-expense-paid trips to Washington State to visit Chelan Fresh and tour their Cherry orchards and production facilities.

Organic Wild Twist Apples will become available for the first time ever around the second week of February, offered in both bulk and pouch options. This outstanding cross between Honeycrisp and Pink Lady delivers a crisp, sweet-tart eating experience and is sure to become a customer favorite. Be sure to add this exciting new variety to your mix.

NOTE: In general, **Organic Apple** supplies are packing out shorter than expected across most varieties. Combined with strong demand, this is driving prices higher as we transition into controlled atmosphere rooms in mid-February.

OTHER STORIES

Pineapples from Costa Rica will be available but limited from Costa Rica during this time as well!

- **Organic Red Radishes** and **Bunch Spinach** have both tightened in supply out of California, resulting in elevated market conditions and increased pricing.

- **ALERT!** **Organic Green Squash** has tightened significantly, with pricing jumping notably out of Mexico. **Organic Yellow Squash** remains somewhat more available by comparison to Green.

- **NOTE:** **Organic Cilantro** has tightened out of California, with pricing trending higher. Overall supply remains adequate, though promotable volumes and pricing are currently limited.

- **GOOD NEWS!** **Green** and **Red Cabbages** are abundant and promotable, supported by strong



OG DRAGON FRUIT

10 lb **Organic Dragon Fruit** (red skin/white flesh) will be available from new partner Freshway Produce for the start of February!



OG LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Romaine Hearts** remain flush out west, offering a strong promotional window over the next several weeks.

Organic Leaf Lettuces including **Green Leaf**, **Red Leaf**, and **Romaine** have been excellent from Lady Moon in Florida.

Organic Iceberg Lettuce from California remains steady and clean, though overall conventional market pressure may impact organic availability.

NOTE: Lady Moon and other Florida growers are concerned about cold temperature forecasts for early February.

supply from both Lady Moon Farms in Florida and California growing regions. Quality remains excellent across both sources.

- An **Organic Green Kiwi** clamshell option from Italy and or Greece are now available to replace that spot on your shelves. These will be available in a 16/1lb option. California **Organic Mammoth Kiwi** are done for the season.

- **Organic SunGold Kiwi** from Zespri are still available from Italy but are winding down very soon. Both Clamshell and VF Bulk options will be available.

- **Organic Celery** and **Celery Hearts** continue on a downward price trend. Availability has improved significantly, though minor blight reports could firm the market in the coming weeks, warranting close monitoring of field conditions.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

JANUARY 30 - FEBRUARY 6, 2025

CITRUS RETURNING TO PROMOTABILITY



GOOD NEWS! California **Navel Oranges** are seeing heavy supplies on large to Jumbo fruit ranging from 36ct to 56ct, making this an excellent time to promote large fruit throughout the month of February. 75/8lb bags in bins are also promotable!

Mandarin Oranges out of California have officially transitioned away from the "Clementine" variety, to stronger and more flavorful "Tangos" and "Murcotts" now ready for harvest, supporting improved quality and supply on the Halos brand from February on.

Citrus specialty varieties out of California are in strong supply and offer great promotional opportunities, including **Cara Cara Oranges**, **Blood Oranges**, **Minneolas**, **SUMO Citrus**, **Pummelos**, and **Heirloom Navel Oranges**.



CV TOMATOES

ALERT! **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes** continue to experience limited production, particularly on **Cluster Tomato** varieties as early February begins. Availability remains tight, while quality is strong and costs continue to trend higher, limiting promotional opportunities. Market indicators suggest conditions may improve as we move deeper into February.

Roma and **Round Tomatoes** are experiencing steady movement, though recent weather challenges in Mexico and Florida have reduced overall volume. Quality remains acceptable, while costs are firm and trending higher.

NOTE: **Snacking Tomatoes** remain firm across **Grape**, **Cherry**, and **Medley Snacking Tomato** varieties, driven by tighter supplies from Mexico and Florida. Quality remains good overall, despite elevated costs. Promotional opportunities are expected to remain limited into early February.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! **Raspberries** will be promotable in early February from Central Mexico. Looking ahead, mid to late February volumes are expected to trend lighter as harvests move past peak production and transition toward spring crops in late March.

Blueberries remain steady overall, though pricing is firm and expected to increase slightly as Peruvian and Chilean production remains light. Quality has been exceptional from all regions.

GOOD NEWS! **Driscoll's Sweetest Batch Blueberries** remain available in early February with good supplies from Peru and Mexico, offering outstanding eating quality.

Blackberry production remains steady in Central Mexico, with good availability and consistently nice quality. Pricing is inching higher as growers move beyond the winter "peak" production period.

NOTE: **Strawberries** are expected to remain tight over the next several weeks leading into Valentine's Day, as demand continues to outpace supply. Florida production is being hampered by cold temperatures and potential freezes, limiting harvests, while Central Mexico production is trending down as growers move beyond peak months.



CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! The start of February begins our huge Washington **Rockit/SugarBee Apple** Display Contest, featuring 14 prizes, including two all-expense-paid trips to Washington State to visit Chelan Fresh and tour their **Cherry** orchards and production facilities. Even better, this program highlights two outstanding **Apple** varieties while offering your customers exceptional fruit at promotional pricing.

GOOD NEWS! Eastern **Evercrisp Apples** are becoming promotable. Be sure to stock this excellent cross of Honeycrisp and Fuji, offering a crisp texture and sweet flavor profile.

Washington **Cosmic Crisp Apple** prices are rising as demand continues to exceed supply while we move deeper into controlled atmosphere storage.

Washington **Envy Apple** supplies are returning to more normal pricing levels, though supplies have firmed slightly due to lower-than-expected pack-outs.



CV ASPARAGUS

GOOD NEWS! Asparagus production from Caborca, Mexico is now underway, offering near-term promotional opportunities. Late February through March remains the prime feature window, as volume and quality are expected to peak.

White Asparagus continues to show excellent quality, adding some specialty flair to your veg sets.



CV BROCCOLI

NOTE: Broccoli Crowns and Bunched Broccoli from both the East and West are tightening due to major sizing issues and frost damage in the Southeast, along with supply gaps from several West Coast shippers. Market conditions are expected to trend higher over the next several weeks. Mexican will help bridge coverage until Florida and Western production recover.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

ALERT! Brussels Sprouts 25 lb remain limited from the West, with discoloration and early breakdown still appearing. Sizing remains inconsistent, which continues to keep the prices elevated, with broader relief expected by mid-February.

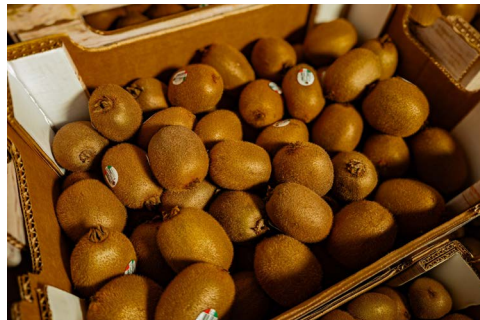
Belgium **Iceless Brussels Sprouts** remains a strong alternative, though port timing can fluctuate, so coordination with your representative is recommended to confirm availability.



CV MANGOS

New crop Ataulfo Honey Mangos from Mexico are beginning to arrive.

Red Round Mangos from Mexico expected just weeks away. In the meantime, Peruvian **Kent Mangos** are available with nice quality, and pricing is easing slightly to kick off the start of February.



CV KIWI

Green Kiwi volumes remain steady from Italy and Greece, with pricing holding consistent across the East Coast.

SunGold Kiwi from Zespri is winding down for the season, with remaining fruit expected to last into the first or second week of February. Demand has been tremendous this season, marking one of the strongest Italian seasons on record.



CV CUCUMBERS

NOTE: Mini and Euro Cucumbers are facing tighter production and limited supply as January concludes. **Euro Cucumbers** are expected to improve in early to mid-February, while **ALERT!** Mini Cucumbers are expected to remain tight throughout the month.



CV COLOR BELL PEPPERS

Color Bell Peppers remain available, though supplies have tightened following recent weather conditions. Quality is decent, while costs continue to trend higher and most promotional pricing has concluded.

Elongated Sweet Red Peppers remain available but are also beginning to see rising costs, with February expected to bring regular availability and more balanced pricing conditions across the category.



CV CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: Cauliflower 12ct supplies are tightening quickly, with increased quality concerns and limited counts from multiple shippers. The market remains inherently volatile, and promotional activity should remain conditional, with Florida product being utilized when quality permits.



CV AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Four Seasons is ready to help make your "Big Game" celebrations amazing with super deals on **Hass Avocados**.

Promotable sizing on 36 ct and 48 ct fruit will be especially strong leading up to the game, making this an ideal time to build impactful displays. Be sure to secure your "Big Game" point-of-sale bins.



CV GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! Grapes should be promoted in February on large and extra-large fruit across all colors, with strong availability supporting aggressive features. Volumes are good from Pery. Chile will come into season too. Quality has been nice.



CV CELERY

Celery and Celery Hearts pricing continues to ease, with steady availability and no near-term supply concerns.



CV MELONS

GOOD NEWS! Melon pricing on both Cantaloupes and Honeydews are coming down as additional supply becomes available and more growing regions come into play.



CV STONE FRUIT

South American bulk and clamshell Plums are now in stock with good availability. Additional specialty varieties including Cherry Plums, Watermelon Plums, Lemon Plums, and Sugar Plums are expected to arrive over the next couple of weeks.

Import Yellow Peaches are now available in tray packs and volume-filled options, with clamshell packaging expected to join the mix in early February.

Import Yellow and Donut Nectarines are now available in both bulk and clamshell formats, with firm supply expected to carry through the month of February.

NOTE: Chilean Cherry prices are rising as most shippers conclude their seasons. Limited availability is expected for the next several weeks, extending through the end of February.



CV LETTUCES

ALERT! Iceberg Lettuce is facing future supply challenges as abnormally warm temperatures in Yuma accelerated growth, forcing early harvests and acreage pass-overs. An industry-wide shortfall is expected from mid to late February through early to mid-April, and promotional activity should be avoided during this window, as availability is unlikely to support increased demand.

Leaf Lettuces including Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and Romaine continue to loosen in supply from desert production. Fill rates remain clean, and pricing supports light to moderate promotional activity, though conditions will be monitored closely due to concerns surrounding the upcoming Iceberg Lettuce shortfall.

GOOD NEWS! Romaine Hearts are benefiting from lower trims and improved weights, translating into easing costs as acreage scales and production strengthens.



CV PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Pineapple volumes are declining lower to begin February and are expected to remain limited heading into the Valentine's Day holiday.

A small volume of PinkGlow Pineapples will be available leading up to Valentine's Day to support specialty promotions.

Honeybear is now offering Topless Pineapple, with tops being replanted in Costa Rica to support regenerative efforts. Shipping without tops allows for more Pineapples per case and improved shipping efficiency. Ask your rep for more info.

OTHER STORIES

- **ALERT!** Carrot supplies, including cello bags and value-added items, remain tight due to unprecedented rain and cold in California combined with cold and rain in Georgia, which are limiting yields and sizing. Allocations persist, and several value-added items continue to be impacted.

- **NOTE:** Green Beans are currently tight out of Florida, with pricing reflecting the limited availability.

- **NOTE:** Incoming cold weather forecasted in Florida for early February could further impact Green Beans, along with other warm-weather vegetables such as Eggplant, Cucumbers, and Green and Yellow Squash.

- Cucumbers are seeing a slight increase in pricing, though overall supplies remain adequate to meet demand. Quality continues to be steady across available lots.

- **NOTE:** Jalapeño Peppers are experiencing a price increase as supplies tighten out of Florida. This item remains vulnerable to potential disruptions from the upcoming cold weather, which could further limit availability and elevate market conditions.

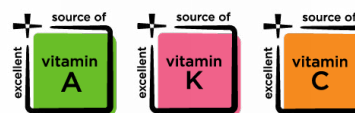

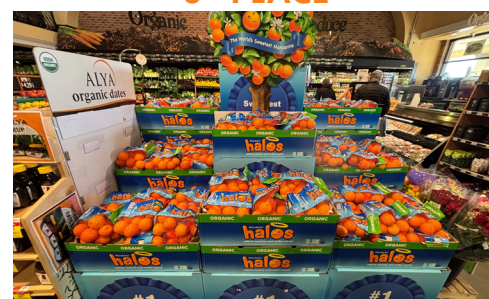

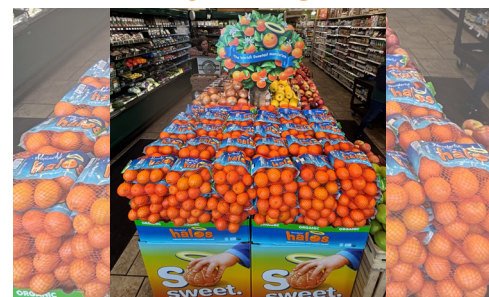
