# ORGANIC CHERRIES IN SEASON!

Few items can impact the sales of your produce department like fresh cherries!

Organic Dark Sweet and Rainier Cherries are now in peak season from Washington. An excellent crop is expected during June and July.

Prices will continue to ease as we head towards July 4th. Sizing will be heavy to 10.5 row (XL) to 9.5 row (XXL).





# **OG CA STONE FRUIT**

Organic Peaches are now in excellent supply. Expect a 25%+ price decrease this coming week.

Organic White Peaches are gapping between varieties. We should see the next variety in mid June.

Organic White Donut Peaches are expected back in here in late June with the new larger Galaxy variety.

Organic Apricots, plus Organic Yellow and White Nectarines are now in steady supply with firm pricing.

Organic Black Plums are gapping this week, but better supplies are expected in late June. Organic Red Plums are in firm, but steady supply.

Organic Pluots are available and supplies are now steady with prices easing slightly.



# **OG BERRIES**

Local New Jersey Organic Blueberries are expected to start during the week of June 18th. Supplies are expected to be steady.

Driscoll's Organic Blueberries are now in very good supply in 6 oz packs. Pints are more limited. Other brands of California Organic Blueberries are in excellent supply this week.

California Organic Strawberry supplies are excellent with promotional opportunities expected to continue until at least the end of June.

Driscoll's Organic Raspberry supplies are ramping up. Good supplies are now available.

Driscoll's Organic Blackberries remain tighter this week as California has not ramped up, while Mexico is slowing down. Supplies are expected to improve in late June.



# **OG GRAPES**

Mexican Organic Green, Red, and Black Grape supplies are limited due to high demand, varietal gaps, growing region changes, and weather. Expect higher than normal prices. This crop is expected to end early - before the July 4th holiday.

California Organic Red, Green, and Black Grapes are now available out of the desert arowing region in Coachella, CA. Prices are slightly higher, and a small gap is expected towards the end of June and the first week of July as Bakersfield gets started.

Mexican Organic Cotton Candy Grapes are available, but more limited than last year due to crop size. Prices are firming. The first Organic Sweet Sapphire (Witch Fingers) are available! The long, black grapes are nice and firm - delicious too!



#### **OG PEPPERS**

Holland **Organic Red, Yellow,** and **Orange Peppers** are all in good supply. Prices are moving up.

A few **Organic Red Peppers** are available from Mexico, but quality may be questionable.

Desert production has begun on **Organic Green Peppers**, though supply is limited. GA reports limited supplies of **Organic Green Peppers**, mostly jumbo sized.



# **OG CUCUMBERS**

**Organic Cucumbers** are in good supply out of GA and Mexico. The price out of Mexico is up a little bit this week.

Organic Hothouse Cucumbers from Mexico are more limited. Organic Seedless Mini Cucumbers are steady. A limited crop of Organic Pickle Cucumbers is now available from CA.



# **OG CELERY**

**Organic Celery** quality is better and prices are lower this week and will continue to go down in increments. No major quality or bug issues have been noted.

Organic Celery Hearts are in good supply.



#### **OG MELONS**

California **Organic Cantaloupes** have started. Expect better supplies each week as supplies ramp up. Larger sizes are more prevalent.

California **Organic Galia Melons** are now in firm but steady supply.

Mexican **Organic Honeydew** should finish up for the season and transition to California.



# **OG MANGOS**

Organic Tommy Atkins and Honey (Ataulfo) Mangos supplies should be great for the rest of June and provide some good promotional opportunities. Stay tuned for some exciting promotions coming up in the month of July!

Organic Fair-Trade Francis Mangos from Haiti will finally be making their way to the marketplace in very limited quantities. This season is now projecting to see its heaviest quantities in late June and early July, but small amounts will be available soon!



# **OG EGGPLANT**

**Organic Eggplant** from GA is in adequate supply, but nothing is available from Mexico.

There may be some product available from northern CA in late June.



#### OG WATERMELONS

**Organic Watermelons** and **Mini Watermelon** supplies will ramp up this week from the west coast. Freight costs will keep prices more elevated than normal out of California.

Lady Moon Farms **Organic Watermelons** from Georgia will start in late June.



# **OG APPLES**

New Zealand **Organic Jazz, Queen,** and **Pacific Rose Apples** are now in season. These premium varieties can add some fresh flavor to your summer apple selection.

**Organic Gala, Granny Smith,** and **Fuji Apples** are now in good supply out of Argentina, Chile, and New Zealand. Expect higher and rising prices.



# **OG KALE**

This is an excellent time to promote **Organic Kale! Organic Green Kale** is in good supply out of PA, OH, GA, TN, NC, and CA. Prices are coming down as there will be plenty of product for a few weeks. **Organic Kale** has also begun out of New York.

**Organic Lacinato** and **Red Kale** will also be available out of GA, NJ, and CA.



#### OG KIWIFRUIT

**Organic SunGold Kiwifruit** out of New Zealand is available. Expect larger sizing in late June.

New Zealand **Organic Green Kiwifruit** is expected to arrive the week of June 18th.



# **OG LETTUCE**

Local Organic Romaine, Red Leaf, Green Leaf, and Red Butter Lettuce is available from Pennsylvania in limited supply.

CA growers have good supply of all **Organic Lettuce**, with the exception of **Organic Iceberg Lettuce**, where pink ribs make the quality unattractive.

**Organic Romaine Heart** prices moved up a few dollars, but quality and supply are still good.



#### **OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER**

**Organic Broccoli** is in adequate supply out of CA and pricing is soft. Local Pennsylvania **Organic Stem Broccoli** will begin the week of June 18th.

**Organic Cauliflower** is in good supply. Quality is nice and prices are steady.



#### **OG TOMATOES**

**15lb Organic Hothouse Tomatoes** from Mexico and Canada are in decent supply. **Organic 2-Layer Tomatoes** are available this week, but price has moved up.

**Organic Cherry** and **Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes** out of GA are in decent supply. Mexico shippers have adequate supply of **Organic Cherry Tomatoes**.

**Organic Grape Tomatoes** are in steady supply out of GA and Mexico.

**Organic Roma Tomatoes** are in decent supply. Quality was better this week, with better color out of Mexico.

The **Organic Cluster Tomato** market is up this week. Quality is very good out of Mexico and Canada.



#### **OG ASPARAGUS**

**Organic Asparagus** out of Michigan, California, and Canada is in adequate supply. Quality has been very good. The CA product will be available through June.

The New York **Organic Asparagus** season ends this week.



# **OG HASS AVOCADOS**

**Organic Hass Avocados** from Mexico remain steady, but look for expected heavy rain to slow harvesting in the coming week. Mexican fruit is very high in oil content, making it some of the best eating fruit of the season. Fruit is ripening quickly. Look to hold fruit back by keeping it colder than normal.

CA fruit is slightly more expensive and is available in the 48ct size.

OKE's Equal Exchange Peruvian **Organic Fair Trade** program has had a good beginning and pre-conditioning fruit seems to be helping end users get a favorable eating experience. Look to continue to promote 60ct fruit as that is where the volume is falling.

- Organic Baby Butter Lettuce remains out of stock from the Olivia's brand.
- Organic Sweet Potatoes are a great item to throw on the grill. Quality right now looks outstanding!
- CA growers have adequate supply of Organic Green Cabbage. Demand and pricing are high.
   Organic Red Cabbage is reported to be in tight

supply from FL and GA. The east coast growers had a lot of quality issues with burst, but CA has just been limited in supply. **Organic Napa Cabbage** is limited out of CA as well.

- Organic Spinach is in adequate supply out of CA. New York growers have started their crop of Organic Semi-Savoy Spinach that should go until early July.
- Georgia growers report decent supplies of Organic Zucchini, but are more limited on Organic Yellow Squash. The market has loosened on Mexican Organic Squash, as prices have dropped.

It's time to make your scheduling, ordering and merchandising plans for the Independence Day holiday sales period!

# **Deliveries and Planning**

Four Seasons Produce will be delivering on a standard schedule for the week before and of the 4th of July. Don't wait until the last minute to fill your cooler and back rooms or you might be caught with empty shelves and be waiting on a delivery to satisfy your customers.

#### **WEDNESDAY 6/27:**

Order your hard goods such as croutons, dips, dressings, snacks, juices, etc) to arrive this day. Get 'em in and pack 'em out early so you're not messing around with these areas of your department during the busiest times of the selling period.

#### **THURSDAY 6/28 - FRIDAY 6/29:**

Order your hard fruits and vegetables. Have your evening associates pack out your semi-perishables and non-perishables & hard fruits and vegetables. Have your back rooms and storage areas organized and straightened in preparation for large deliveries. Be organized and the holiday will go smoothly.



#### FRIDAY 6/29 - SATURDAY 6/30:

Get your tonnage items in early. Start taking delivery of your sweet corn, summer fruits, watermelon and cantaloupe needs. If you wait until Saturday 7/1 to bring in our heaviest orders, you'll be waiting on your delivery for product that you need to sell that day. The heavy surge of customers will begin on Thursday and pick up momentum as you get further into the holiday weekend.

#### **SUNDAY 7/1 - TUESDAY 7/3:**

Bring in your refill of ad items, highly perishables and product to cover your weekend and Monday sales.



# LOCAL NEW JERSEY BLUEBERRY SEASON



In the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast, consumers really look forward to the Jersey **Blueberry** season - the wait is almost over!

New Jersey **Blueberries** will begin to ship in limited volume starting around June 19/20.

Supplies will ramp up quickly in the end of June and early July - ideal for promotion.





# **CV EGGPLANT**

There are abundant supplies of **Eggplant** in Florida and Georgia. Quality is very good. Now is the time to promote!

Check out our two newest **Eggplant** SKUs – **Baby Purple Eggplant** (code 1269) and **Baby Graffiti Eggplant** (code 208527), both from Del Fresco Produce in Canada.



# **CV CHERRIES**

It's Northwest **Cherry** season! California **Cherries** are done, and Washington **Dark Sweet Cherries** have ramped up.

The supply is ample on all ranges of sizes with heavy commits on 10.5 row. Growers are looking for movement on the 11 rows and smaller and 10 rows and larger.

Prices have dramatically dropped over the past two days. It's been a great start and quality and color has been very nice.

Rainier (gold varieties) Cherries are also now in peak season!



# **CV SQUASH**

Local **Zucchini** and **Yellow Squash** growers in PA and NJ expect to start harvesting this week. Initial quantities will be limited.

We will continue to augment with NC **Squash** until the local deal really kicks into gear in early July.



#### CV STRAWBERRIES

Keep promoting **Strawberries** from California for June! Volumes and prices will be steady again this week.



# **CV BLACKBERRIES**

**Blackberry** quality out of the Southeast has been fair at best due to all of the rain over the past weeks.

California volume will begin to come on this week. Prices will be high this week and supplies will remain limited until the pipeline gets refilled.



#### CV LETTUCE

Most Iceberg Lettuce shippers hit a field transition last week which will cause a slight supply interruption and bump prices up slightly.

This won't last very long as they will be opening new fields quickly.



# CV BROCCOLI

**Broccoli** volumes are expected to improve this week and that should help to ease markets down slightly.



# **CV WATERMELONS**

**Watermelon** growers have opened up fields in Georgia and South Carolina. Prices will be steady this week until the pipeline gets refilled in late June.

Prices won't come off significantly as demand for July 4th is right around the corner.



# **CV CABBAGE**

Local **Green** and **Red Cabbage** are starting in PA and NJ this week. Shippers are reporting very good quality, but more limited quantities for the first few weeks.

**Savoy Cabbage** will start in PA and NJ the week of June 18th.



# **CV PEPPERS**

**Green Peppers** are promotable for mid-June. Prices will go back up a little for late June during the transition into locally grown product.

**Hothouse Bell Peppers** from Canada continue to be tight, with Orange Peppers the most limited. Pricing has come down slightly. Availability and pricing should improve significantly in late June.



# **CV PEACHES**

South Carolina **Peaches** were plentiful last week, but going into the weekend many growers hit a gap between varieties and now they are short, causing prices to firm up. Supplies should be back to plenty around June 20th.

The crop is mostly running in the 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 3" sizes with very little to no smaller sizes.



# **CV KALE**

Quality and volume on **Green Kale** are excellent. Look for **NJ-grown Kale** from Flaim Farms (code 1315) and eastern from Holthouse Farms in Ohio (code 1320).



# **CV ONIONS**

Growers from New Mexico have begun shipping their new crop Yellow, Red, and White Onions, which will be the primary source for the summer. Growers from Texas, Georgia, and California are still shipping Onions.

There are plenty of supplies available around the country and the market is steady.

Transportation issues have created problems for **Onion** shippers once again. Freight out of the west is very high and trucks are scarce. FOB pricing will be held in check due to this issue as we move into summer.




#### **CV TOMATOES**

Hothouse Beef and Cluster Tomatoes are in excellent supply this week out of Canada, as well as from greenhouses in Ohio and Virginia. Look for excellent quality, and promotable pricing all week. We have good supplies on both Yellow and Orange Cluster Tomatoes as well.

Campari Tomatoes are starting to tighten up, and pricing is beginning to rise. This will mostly likely be the last week to promote until supplies improve. Quality has been very nice on all Cocktail Tomatoes.

**Roma Tomatoes** at this time are hothouse grown from Ohio. Quality has been very nice and the color is perfect on these Vine Ripened Tomatoes.



#### **CV POTATOES**

Demand in the **Russet Potato** market appears to be steady. Pricing remains relatively stable with fluctuation on the larger-sized **Russet Potatoes**. Those prices are continuing to rise.

We will see Green Giant pricing on **Red, Yellow**, and **White Potatoes** increase this week as we head into the later part of June and we see all of these items transition into high quality new crop regions — **Reds** and **Yellows** will be from Arizona and Whites will be from California.



#### CV HASS AVOCADOS

Heavy rains are pounding **Hass Avocado** fields in Mexico. Wet weather is expected to continue throughout the week. Growers are not harvesting to help prevent black spots on the fruit. They cannot get their equipment on the field to harvest due to the fields saturated grounds.

The smaller fruit will begin to increase with price because supply is lower with small fruit. The shortages will begin to trend towards the larger fruit and we will see the market increase.



#### CV LIMES

Rain is affecting the East Coast of Mexico. Lime growers are not getting hit with the Tropical Storm as the West Coast, but we could see four to five days of light supplies and prices firming up.
