


# PROMOTABLE ORGANIC GRAPES





GOOD NEWS! July is presenting exciting promotional opportunities on Organic Grapes while both Mexico and Southern California are in season!






Central California Organic Grapes will come into peak season at the end of July and run through the fall. Organic Thomcord Grapes and Champagne Grapes are expected to arrive by the end of July.









GOOD NEWS! 9ct and 12ct Organic Cantaloupes are coming into peak season from Central California, with promotable pricing on the 9ct

Organic Honeydews are also in season from USA. Expect Organic Specialty Melons are expected to harvest the week of 7/10.

Organic Watermelons are available out of California. Prices are a higher due to growing costs and freight across the country but quality is excellent.



GOOD NEWS! California Organic Yellow & White Peaches and Nectarines and Red & Black Plums continue in peak season supply and excellent quality.

Organic Apricots have transitioned smoothly from California into new crop Washington fruit. Mid-July will feature the high color "Robada" variety with red blush. Expect steady supplies in the month of July.

Organic Verry Cherry Plums are now in season. Try this delicious little plum/cherry hybrid packed in 1lb clamshells

Organic Pluots continue to be sporadic in supply.



OG BERRIES GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberry prices are becom-

ing very promotable. LOCAL New Jersey growers will

continue through mid-July depending on weather. The

heat is stressing some of the fruit. Pacific Northwest fruit is starting and coming on strong out of Oregon to start, so promotability will continue. GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries remain promotable overall. California continues to see strong

GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberry markets remain promotable out of CA. Harvests remain steady out of Watsonville/Salinas regions and quality has been arriving very nice.

## OG MANGOS

GOOD NEWS! Continue to promote Organic Round and Ataulfo Honey Mangos while peak season is at its height in Mexico. Fruit is ripening quickly, so plan on fast turns.

Crespo is also beginning to offer 3 new varieties of Specialty Organic Mangos in the US marketplace: the yellow "Nam Doc Mai" variety, the yellow skinned "Malikka" variety, and a Green Thai Mango known as the "Kiew Savoy". The "Kiew Savoy" is eaten when the flesh is hard to firm and resembles a crunchy apple when eaten. All 3 varieties will be very limited to start.



## OG BROCCOL

Organic Broccoli market conditions continue to improve. Supply volume from California has continued to increase, and as a result, prices have begun to decrease. Expect steady supply, strong quality, and improved costs in mid to late July.

LOCAL Pennsylvania Organic Broccoli will come to a close in early July and return in the fall.

Québec Organic Broccoli production is beginning in mid-July, providing a supplemental opportunity if any short or quality issues arise in California.



# **OG BEANS**

LOCAL Organic Green Beans from Pennsylvania are beginning harvest in mid-July. Supplies will be limited to start the season, but volumes will quickly increase as July continues. LOCAL availability should remain consistent until mid-October.

LOCAL Organic Fava or Romano Beans from Pennsylvania are also in season.



# **OG ASPARAGUS**

Organic Asparagus fields in Mexico are new crop. Quality is great on all inbounds. Markets are expected to rise into the middle of July until Mexico really starts to ramp up again and have the volume to drop the market.



## OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Cauliflower volume from California will remain consistent in early to mid-July. After strong volume in late June, yields have normalized and pricing has begun to increase slightly. Mid to late July will bring the beginning of the Canadian season. Product grown in Québec traditionally has strong quality and volume throughout the summer months, with a price advantage.



# **OG ONIONS**

All Organic Onions have transitioned up to Firebaugh, and should have a bit better skin set and slightly darker appearance.

**LOCAL Organic Candy Sweet Onions** are running ahead of schedule and will get started the week of 7/10.



# **OG FIGS**

Organic Black Mission Figs from California are in season! These will be available in 12/8oz clamshell for a short season, and then gap again until later this summer.



## **OG GREENHOUSE TOMATOES**

NOTE: Our Quebec greenhouse grower of Organic Cocktail and Cherry-on-the-Vine Tomatoes, Savoura Bio, will be going through a seasonal gap on these items as they replant. We'll source some other brands on these items.



## OG HASS AVOCADOS

NOTE: Organic Hass Avocado volumes rebounded just a bit from Mexico as growers began to harvest "Flora Loca" season fruit, but overall pricing is up. California 48ct Organic Hass Avocados are available to help fulfill demand as the seasons wind down.





**OG CUCUMBERS** 

GOOD NEWS! Organic Euro and Mini Seedless Cucumbers will be promotable into the middle of July. Quality is outstanding.



# OG PEPPERS

**Organic Color Bell Peppers** from Canada are consistently available, but supply volume does remain limited in mid-July. Pricing is average and is expected to remain consistent throughout most of July. Quality has remained strong.



## OG KIWIFRUIT

Both **Organic Green** and **SunGold Kiwifruit** from New Zealand with be available in good supplies through the summer.



# **OG LETTUCE**

LOCAL Organic Leaf and Romaine Lettuce from Pennsylvania and New Jersey have all but concluded for the spring/early Summer season. New York and Vermont will begin to have supplies in mid-July.

The Québec season on **Organic Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Lettuce** is also beginning in mid-July. Expect steady supplies from these growing regions for the remainder of the summer.

**Organic Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Lettuce** remain in steady supply from California.



# **OG WARM VEG**

LOCAL Organic Cucumbers, Eggplant, Green Bell Peppers, Jalapeños, Zucchini, and Yellow Squash are all in season or becoming available in the coming weeks from PA and NJ.

Lady Moon Farms has begun harvesting Organic Zucchini with strong numbers in early July. In mid-July, Organic Cucumbers, Green Bell Peppers, and Jalapeño Peppers from Lady Moon will start in Pennsylvania.

**LOCAL Organic Eggplant** from New Jersey will begin in mid-July. Expect strong local supply throughout the summer months.



# **OG TOMATOES**

LOCAL Organic Round Tomatoes in 2-layer packs are expected to start by the middle of July with product out New Jersey, Delaware, and Pennsylvania.

**Organic Roma Tomato** prices will be promotable with domestic product. Quality is great on our inbounds. **LOCAL** is expected to start by the middle of July in a small way with product from Delaware, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

Lady Moon Farms' **Organic Grape**, **Cherry**, and **Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes** from Georgia will be ending and will transition by the 3rd week of July into their new crop **LOCAL** Pennsylvania product.

**NOTE: Organic Tomatoes** from Savoura will be ending by middle of July and will be in a gap until mid-September when they will start back up.

• NOTE: Organic Navel Oranges and Mandarins have finished for the season.

## OTHER STORIES

- ALERT! Organic Celery availability from California remains a struggle. Conditions are expected to remain unfavorable through the month of July.



- · Stone fruit is best stored and merchandised outside of your refrigerated cases. It allows the fruit to ripen properly and avoids it from being in the flavor kill zone!
- · Place small brown paper bags on your displays to suggest ripening at home.
- · Variety offerings are key in successful stone fruit sales. Be sure to carry a full array of fruit to offer to your customers. It might also expose them to varieties that they might have tried before.



- · Cull stone fruit often during each day to insure freshness. Remove any bruised or overripe fruit.
- Stone fruit bruises very easily, so handle with care, both in the backroom and on your display.

# LOCAL SWEET CORN IS BACK!





GOOD NEWS! Sweet Corn prices fell dramatically after the 4th of July as new fields are coming into season throughout the Mid-Atlantic region.

**LOCAL Sweet Corn** has started from New Jersey, Delaware, and Pennsylvania, bringing relief to the market from the Georgia weather issues.

50 dozen bins and 48ct crates are available.

**LOCAL Sweet Corn** will continue to be promotable for July, and likely much of August!



## **CV BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! Blueberry prices remain promotable as fruit is plentiful. New Jersey, California, and Pacific Northwest harvests are all available. LOCAL New Jersey Blueberries are expected to continue through mid-July depending on weather as extreme heat hits the region.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberry prices hit rock bottom during early July to move extra fruit. More normal prices will return later in the month as the California flush cleans up. Supplies will continue to be steady, and quality has been very nice. There are pockets of LOCAL production around out of New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

GOOD NEWS! Strawberry prices will ease off as the Salinas, CA crops are beginning to flush. Look of spot buys and overall lower prices for the week of 7/10. Quality has been looking sharp and improving on every arrival.

ALERT! Raspberries continue to be extremely tight with limited availability. Expect this to continue into August. Quality has been improving on every arrival. Organic Raspberries will be more available and pricing will be similar during July.



## **CV MELONS**

GOOD NEWS! Seedless Watermelons are easing off to promotable levels with good volumes. Georgia fruit is finishing up, South Carolina is going with good volume, North Carolina is expected to start any day, and Maryland is starting as well. Plenty of regions are harvesting right now, leading to plentiful supplies. Quality has been very nice from all regions. LOCAL Delaware Watermelons are expected to begin the week of 7/17.

Cantaloupes and Honeydew are now from California with Turlock Fruit (Peacock, King O' the West) harvesting here in mid-July, along with some other quality shippers. We will continue to have good supplies.

1 20ct **Bin Cantaloupes** from Docia are available from Tifton, GA but finishing up as we transition into North Carolina, with excellent taste, smell, and quality.

**Tuscan-style Cantaloupes, Sugar Kiss**, and **Summer Kiss Melons** are also available. Look for 6ct **Orange Flesh Honeydews** to arrive the week of 7/10 at a promotable price.



# CV STONE FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! Washington Dark Sweet Cherries continue to be in excellent supply. Growers have an abundance of high-quality fruit coming and will be relying on retailers to promote all the volume. Keep an eye out for spot buys, and in-store specials and ads are encouraged.

"Peach Pie" Peaches and Donut Peaches from Family Tree Farm are now in season. "Midnight Rose" and "Crimson Rose" Apriums, in both bulk and clamshells, will be available in mid-July.

California Peaches, Nectarines, Red & Black Plumcots, and Red & Black Plums are in good supply.

Eastern **Peaches** will transition from South Carolina to **LOCAL** New Jersey and Pennsylvania. Excellent supplies are expected with large fruit prevailing.

**Verry Cherry Plums** are now in season! Supplies are expected to be steady through mid-August.

**Apricots** have transitioned from California to Washington with good supplies for July.





# **CV GRAPES**

GOOD NEWS! Grapes continue to show plentiful supplies from both Mexico and Southern California. There are a number of varieties available, creating nice spreads in price on different sizes and varieties. Headed towards mid-July, the proprietary varieties are trending bigger towards XL.

**Cotton Candy Grapes** are in peak season from Mexico with more affordable pricing.



# **CV PEPPERS**

GOOD NEWS! Green Bell Peppers are becoming promotable with LOCAL volumes coming on in New Jersey, and the Pennsylvania crop peaking soon too.

111b Hothouse **Red, Orange**, and **Yellow Bell Pepper** prices are steady, and there will be promotable opportunities in August.



# **DEL MONTE JAR FRUIT**

**NOTE:** Del Monte Foods will be prorating and cutting orders on their **Jarred Grapefruit** and **Citrus Salad** products through at least the fall.

All promotions have been suspended on these SKUs due to lower yields and increased consumption in the US on these products until supplies recover for Del Monte later in 2023.



# CV HASS AVOCADOS

**NOTE:** On **Hass Avocados**, Mexico's "Negra" crop is finishing, so overall supplies are limited. There will be some "Flora Loca" crop fruit this summer, but prices are up.

Peru and Columbia also have lower yields than expected. Pricing for this fruit will be a value over the Mexican fruit.



# CV LETTUCES

GOOD NEWS! Quebec Leaf, Romaine, Romaine Hearts, and Iceberg Lettuces are readily available with great quality. They're expected to be priced as a value against the California product.

California Lettuce prices are rising for mid-July.

New Jersey **Lettuce** crops have wrapped up for the spring season.



## CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

East Coast **Broccoli Crowns** are still gapping, so the primary supply is from California. Lighter availability and pricier markets are expected to continue into mid-July.

**Cauliflower** supplies are tightening and prices are rising out West. Quebec **Naked Cauliflower** is coming into peak season and should be priced at a value vs the Western product.



# **CV KIWIFRUIT**

Zespri **Green** and **SunGold Kiwifruit** supplies are in full swing from New Zealand.

The 16/1lb **Green Kiwifruit** from California in the "Mighties" label will be transitioned to Zespri 12/1lb clamshells from New Zealand for the middle of July.



# **CV PINEAPPLES**

**Pineapple** supplies are tightening, so expect to see pricing creep up a bit through July.

**ALERT!** Del Monte's **HoneyGlow Pineapples** and Dole's **Golden Selection Pineapples** will be entering a time of low production for the summer. Availability will be sparse.



# **CV LOCAL VEG**

LOCAL Baby Bok Choy, Bok Choy, Cabbages, Cucumbers, Pickle Cucumbers, and Green Peppers are in peak season out of New Jersey and Pennsylvania.





# CV CUCUMBERS

**Super Select Cucumber** prices will increase slightly with **LOCAL** product bringing a premium.

GOOD NEWS! Euro Seedless Cucumbers are expected to remain steady and promotable heading into the middle of July. Quality is outstanding.



# **CV TOMATOES**

LOCAL Vine Ripe Round Tomatoes are in season. We will transition all 2-layer boxes and 25lb volume fill boxes from Mexico to Delaware, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania product. Quality will be excellent.

**Roma Tomato** prices are steady heading into the middle of July out of Mexico and the Carolinas. Quality is fantastic. **LOCAL Roma Tomatoes** will start by the middle of July.

Greenhouse Heirloom Tomatoes will remain steady with outstanding quality. LOCAL field-grown Heirloom Tomatoes are expected to start by the third week of July in a small way. This is being pushed back from our original start date.

Greenhouse **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomato** prices are promotable and are dropping with product flushing out of Mexico. Quality has been excellent and there is still product out of Mexico, Canada, and US.

- 12ct **Jumbo Artichokes** are readily available and promotable through the month of July.
- Black Mission Figs from California will continue through mid-July. These will be available in a 12/8oz clamshell for a short season and then gap again until later this summer. Get in on this early season while you can!



# CV GREEN BEANS

GOOD NEWS! Green Bean prices come down for the middle of July. LOCAL Pennsylvania new crop Green Beans have arrived with fantastic quality.



# **CV MANGOS**

Mangos are in great supply as we head into July. Mexico has plenty of fruit, mainly Tommy Atkins. Some Kent variety Mangos are also available. Pricing continues to be promotable in the 10 and 12ct sizing, while larger sizing has been more expensive.

"Pango Mango" Mangos from Puerto Rico will be available in a 9ct carton through most of July.

"Champagne" Ataulfo Mangos will be winding down by the middle to end of July at higher pricing.



# **CV SQUASH & EGGPLANT**

**LOCAL Green** and **Yellow Squash** from New Jersey, Delaware, and Pennsylvania will be steady. Quality is outstanding.

**LOCAL Eggplant** is expected to be available by mid-July.



# **CV CITRUS**

Import Mandarins remain in high demand from Peru/Chile/South Africa/Uruguay as the California crop is finished. This market will remain firm though as the end of July could get tricky due to weather in these regions.

**Grapefruit** crop remains strong with great quality and excellent promotable pricing. Look for "Star Rubies" from CA to be around through end of July. 5lb bag options available as well.

**Lemons** are increasing in price slightly as this market may become crowded with Mexico and Argentina in the mix. **Lime** prices continue to increase while quality has remained solid.

**Navel Orange** prices are firm with large and fancy fruit remaining tight. We are offering import fruit at promotable pricing with outstanding quality on 56ct and 9/3lb options.

Cara Cara Oranges are available.

## **OTHER STORIES**

- ALERT! Celery demand continues to exceed supply, which is holding prices high. Relief isn't expected until end of July.
- Both **Red** and **Gold Potatoes** in the Green Giant label continue to be from California with nice quality and high pricing. **LOCAL** New Jersey **Red** and **White Potatoes** are ahead of schedule and expected to get started by the 3rd week of July. There should have a plentiful crop, specifically on the **White Potatoes**.
- Vidalia Sweet Onions are still rolling along and are expected to bridge the gap all the way to new crop LOCAL PA Simply Sweet Onions. This market has bumped up by a couple dollars as supplies are winding down in Georgia. Jumbos are expected to continue to increase in price over the next couple weeks.
