ORGANIC PEPPER UPDATE



Locally grown **Organic Green Peppers** are in steady supply headed into the end of July.

Expect to see increased volumes from Lady Moon Farms in Chambersburg, PA and other local farms in PA and NJ. These good quality peppers will have promotional opportunities in late July.

We will also begin to have limited supplies of local field grown 11 lb **Organic Red Bell Peppers** from King Family Farm in New Holland, PA in late July.

Organic Colored Bell Peppers from Holland are tightening in supply. Prepare to experience some mixed sizing and inconsistent volumes. Expect to see increased supplies from Canada in late July to supplement the inconsistent volumes in Holland.

Organic Mini Sweet Peppers from Mexico will continue to have excellent quality and increased volumes.

Organic Specialty Peppers are available at Four Seasons! Varieties include Organic Anaheim, Banana, Cayenne, Cubanelle, Hungarian, and Serrano Peppers. Also expect to see Organic Shishito Peppers in clamshells and "Cabo Diablo" variety bags to return in late July.



OG CELERY

YAY! Organic Celery from California has continued to be in excellent supply as we head to the later part of July.

Expect promotable pricing, good quality, and supply to continue into late July. With pricing being extremely high for so long, this is a great opportunity to promote and move some extra volume.



OG WATERMELONS

Organic Watermelons will be promotable again for late July. California quality remains very strong. New fields are being harvested so look for more availability on bigger sized fruit.

New crop California **Organic Mini Watermelons** are available again for week 30 in promotable numbers. Quality is excellent.



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumbers from local regions are beginning to come on strong. The heat is causing many growers to see high yields as we finish July.

Organic European Seedless Cucumber supplies are steady, and quality has been outstanding. Expect to see promotional opportunities in mid to late-July.

Organic Mini Cucumbers from Canada are in consistent supply with steady pricing.

OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli from California remains in steady supply as we head into late July. Expect to see continued promotable pricing and excellent quality.

The PA crop has ended, but the Quebec season has started and will have steady volumes and competitive pricing compared to California products.



OG ONIONS

First of the season Lancaster County, PA grown Organic Red and Candy Sweet Onions are now available. Quality is fantastic! We will see steady pricing and availability on these items for the next couple weeks.



OG GREENS

Local PA & NJ Organic Dandelions, Chards, Kales, and Collard Greens will begin to see decreased yields in mid to late July due to heat stunting the growth of the plants. While California is also experiencing issues caused by heat, expect to see more Organic Valley product from Wisconsin to keep reliable supplied during California's weather conditions.



OG CABBAGE

Organic Green and **Red Cabbage** continue to be in steady supply. Local PA Cabbage has continued to have excellent quality and pricing.

Organic Savoy and **Napa Cabbage** is steady in availability and quality is good. Some local product is available.



OG GREEN BEANS

Locally grown **Organic Green Beans** are in full swing! This is a great item to add to your local summer sets as we will be receiving a lot of product from Elizabethtown, PA.

As we head into mid to late July, expect to see improving prices and stellar quality.

Organic Yellow Beans will also be available in late-July from PA.

As July progresses, expect to see sporadic product from California and New York.



OG SQUASH & EGGPLANT

Organic Green and **Yellow Squash** from Lady Moon Farms in PA are beginning to increase harvesting volumes. The hot days have been helping the plants grow and produce increased volumes as we head into late July.

Expect to see promotable opportunities on this beautiful local product in late July and early August!

Organic Eggplant from New Jersey is in steady supply for mid-July. Product from Lady Moon Farms in PA will begin in late July but expect to see good volume and steady supplies in late July and early August.



OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Cauliflower from California will begin to tighten in supply in late July. Many shippers are experiencing low quantities due to weather conditions over a month ago while the crop was growing. We should see reliable product coming out of organic fields in Nevada while California struggles.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grape supplies out of Mexico will wrap up for the season this week. New crop California fruit is steady with pricing that is affordable but higher than where Mexico finished.

Organic Cotton Candy Grapes are done for the season. Organic Sweet Sapphire Grapes will end in late July.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blueberries continue in excellent supply out of California and the Pacific Northwest with aggressive prices. Time to promote!

Driscoll's **Organic Blackberries** out of California continue to be limited with firming prices. Other brands continue to gap until new crop begins in the fall.

Driscoll's **Organic Raspberry** supplies are firming. Expect prices to elevate

Organic Strawberry supplies have tightened up significantly with prices following. It's expected to stay this way for much of the summer.



OG SWEET CORN

Organic Sweet Corn from PA and NJ has begun! Expect to see availability from NY in late July. Supplies will likely be sporadic with subpar quality.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Grape Tomato prices should be steady this week. Hothouses are beginning to flush and more locally grown grape tomato harvests are starting to pick up as well. Quality should be excellent. Lady Moon Farms' premium PA-grown **Organic Grape Tomatoes** should start in limited quantities, and with the hot weather harvests will come on strong.

Organic Cherry Tomato markets will be steady this week. PA growers, including Lady Moon Farms, are coming into better picks. Quality should be very promotable.

Organic Roma Tomato prices are increasing this week as less product is coming in from Mexico and local supplies have just begun. Locally grown PA Organic Roma Tomatoes will be available in very limited numbers, but we should start seeing better numbers in late July! Support local - quality has looked very nice!

Organic Hothouse Beefsteak Tomatoes are very promotable once again this week. Quality has been very strong. Organic Cluster Tomato prices are on rise a little bit this week, but quality has been very strong.

• New crop Mexican **Organic Asparagus** prices will be steady this week. Quality is nice. All domestic product now finished for the season.

• ALERT! Organic Beets from California will be gapping as we head into late July. Expect to see inconsistent pricing and various growing regions. Weather conditions in many growing regions are causing breakdown and discoloration of the leaves.

• ALERT! Organic Bok Choy and Baby Bok Choy from multiple growing regions have been experi-



OG CHERRIES

Washington **Organic Red Cherries** are much more limited this week and end the of the season is expected by the end July. Washington **Organic Rainier Cherries** were damaged by high winds and rain. The crop is very tight and seasonal quality should be expected. The season will wrap up in late July.



OG LETTUCE

Organic Leaf Lettuces from Quebec are in steady volumes and excellent quality. Supplies on Organic Green and Red Leaf Lettuces will be in promotable volumes as July comes to an end. Product from CA and NY are available; however, the Canadian product offers the best price point.

Organic Iceberg Lettuce from Quebec is in excellent supplies, look for promotable opportunities in late July and early August. Quality on the iceberg has been outstanding with well-sized, firm, and good colored heads.

Organic Romaine Hearts from Quebec are experiencing less yield than initial expected. California is offering a great second option, however pricing is more expensive due to weather conditions that caused yields to decrease. Expect pricing to remain elevated into early August.



OG ARTICHOKES

Organic Artichokes from California are back in steady supply. Expect to see competitive price points and excellent quality as we head into late July. This is a great item to add to complement any vegetable displays.



OG STONE FRUIT

Organic Apricots are starting to wind down out of the Pacific Northwest. Some California fruit may pop back up.

California Organic White and Yellow Peaches continue in good supply. Washington is just around the corner in a few weeks. South Carolina Organic Yellow Peaches are back in limited supply. California Organic Donut Peaches are done for the season.

NOTE! California **Organic Nectarines** are in extremely limited supply, but Organic White Nectarines are a great tasting option. We will see the first Washington Organic Nectarines begin in late July.

California Organic Pluots continue cycling through varieties. Organic "Dapple Dandy" Pluots are interesting expected to start in late July. California Organic Black and Red Plums are in good steady supply.

• Organic Broccoli Rabe from California will be in steady supply in mid to late-July. Except to see improved pricing and promotional opportunities in late-July. This is a great time to expand this section of product on your shelves to promote.

• New crop **Organic Acorn**, **Butternut**, and **Spaghetti Squash** are available this week out of PA from Clarion River Organics.

• Organic Navel Oranges out of California are finally done for the season. Organic Valencia Orange supplies are excellent with prices on the way up due to the end of Navels and Mexican Valencias.



EGGPLANT VARIETIES



- PREMIUM EGGPLANT -

Regular Eggplant, sometimes called "Black Beauty" or "Black Bell" Eggplant, are large in size and dark purple in skin color.



ITALIAN EGGPLANT

Italian Eggplant, also called "Baby Eggplant", looks like Regular Eggplant only smaller and more slender. This variety is ideal for roasting and can be used in ways similar to regular eggplant.



GRAFFITI EGGPLANT

Graffiti Eggplant is beautiful! It features a lavender skin streaked with white stripes. Use Graffiti Eggplant the same as regular eggplant.



SICILIAN EGGPLANT

Sicilian Eggplant is a round Eggplant with lavender skin color that varies dark to light. Careful, there can be some gnarly spikes on the calyx. This variety is the very best type for making classic Eggplant Parmesan thanks to its firm texture and round shape for cutting.


LOCAL EGGPLANT & SUMMER SQUASH

PA-grown Green and Yellow Squash are very promotable right now and quality is excellent.

CV TOMATOES

Nice quality Grape Tomatoes from VA and PA are available again this week. Prices remain high with limited availability around the country. PA is starting to come in with better volume. Look to promote them in our "Native Grown" label!

Vine Ripe Round Tomatoes from Delaware are available. Quality has been amazing. New Jersey Vine Ripe Tomatoes are starting as well in limited numbers this week. PA Tomatoes will be available in promotable quantities and quality is very nice.

Local Lancaster County, PA Heirloom Tomatoes from Cedar Meadow Farms are available! Harvests are just beginning but coming in with solid picks with this hot weather coming on. Quality is beautiful. Cedar Meadow Farms also offers Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes packed in a clamshell. Both varieties are high tunnel grown.

New crop Roma Tomatoes from Tennessee and Alabama will be promotable this week. Quality has been very nice. Local Romas are expected for late July or early August.



CV BERRIES

Blueberries are in excellent supply this week. Growers from the Pacific Northwest are in peak the end of July while Michigan is also in full swing. Quality on all new crop has been very good. New Jersey will be finished in late July.

Strawberries are in much better supply this week out of California. Weather has been much more cooperative, and the berry quality is certainly improving. Look for a much better opportunities to promote!

Blackberries are in tighter supply this week from both East and West Coasts. Our supply will continue to be sourced from the East Coast this upcoming week. Berry size has been really good, and the quality is excellent.

Raspberries are also in tighter supply this week from California. Look for pricing to remain higher over the next couple weeks. Quality has been good on all California fruit.



CV PEPPERS

15lb Red and Yellow Elongated Peppers will be very promotable this week. Harvests have been very strong, leading to more promotable volume out of California. Quality has been excellent with beautiful sizing.

111b Orange, Red, and Yellow Bell Pepper markets will be steady this week. Harvests and demand have led to more promotable pricing. Quality has been very nice.

Green Peppers from PA and NJ continue in peak season. Quality has been very nice.

Varietal Chili Peppers are also coming into peak season for promotion from local farms. Available for week 30: Banana, Cubanelle, Jalapeño, and Long Hot Peppers are the most promotable.

CV CUCUMBERS

Super Cucumber markets remain steady this week. PA and NJ local product is coming in very nice. Continue to support local!

Seedless Cucumbers will be promotable once again this week as Canadian hothouses continue to flush. Quality has been very nice.



CV SWEET CORN

Sweet Corn markets were very active for mid-July. PA crops have been delayed due to weather related challenges.

The Midwest and Northeast continue to pull large volumes from DE. PA harvests should be available this week in better volume, taking the pricing back down some.



CV GRAPES

It was an ugly finish with Mexican **Grapes**. With fruit still available on **Green**, **Black**, and **Red Globe Grapes**, growers are blowing them out at cheap prices in order to finish.

New crop California is ramping up fairly quickly in the Bakersfield and Fresno area on **Green**, **Red**, and **Black Grapes**, and prices are reasonable.

Pretty Lady brand **Premium Green**, **Red**, and **Black Grapes** are expecting to start harvests for availability in late July.



CV HASS AVOCADOS

There are better supplies of Mexican **Hass Avo**cados this week, mostly on 48 counts and smaller. Prices did drop on the 48's but firmed back up and leveled off.

With plenty of Peruvian fruit keeping pressure on the market, they're running ten dollars less than the Mexican fruit. On the Peruvian fruit, there are very few 48ct available because contract business takes most of that size.



CV PINEAPPLES

ALERT! For the end of July and heading into August, there will be a significant shortage of **Pineapples** from Central America. Prices are going to jump up as demand will far exceed supplies.



CV EASTERN PEACHES

We will wind down with **Peaches** from South Carolina and transition to local New Jersey for late July.

Pennsylvania **Peaches** will also start. Most PA growers just pack a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and up box with all the ups, not a 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ ".



CV WATERMELONS

Watermelon markets continue to strengthen. With crown fruit from DE and MD starting, sizing remains on the very large size, creating gaps on 45ct and 60ct melons, keeping the market very active. Quality however is great with all this new crop fruit.

Mini Watermelons will be available this week. Prices remain steady and quality is excellent.



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Broccoli Crowns are in good supply from California, and eastern crowns will kick into full gear this week. Look for good opportunities to product eastern grown broccoli this week.

Cauliflower is steady from California, and the quality has been very nice.

Growers in Quebec are in an absolute flush for the next 7-10 days so we'll have really good supplies on all bikini-cut **Cauliflower**. Quality is excellent, and now is the time to promote **Cauliflower**.



CV HOTHOUSE TOMATOES

Hothouse Beefsteak Tomatoes are starting to strengthen a little bit. Lower picks out of Canada is leaving less product available.

Cluster Tomatoes are very promotable this week. Hothouses are flushing and quality is very nice. Look to promote.

Brussels Sprouts continue to be in excellent supply from California and Mexico. We continue to source all California grown sprouts.



CV CELERY

Celery is in steady supply from both California and Michigan. Look for solid supplies and good quality on all sizes as well as naked and sleeve all week. **Celery Hearts** are finally in much better supply.



CV LETTUCES

Lettuces continue to be in excellent supply from Canada and the quality is spectacular.

We will continue to be stocked up on all Leaf Lettuces as well as Cello Iceberg and Romaine Hearts all week.

Local PA **Green Beans** are promotable this week. Harvests are strong and quality has been excellent.

CV SWEET POTATOES

ALERT! We see the market on North Carolina **Sweet Potatoes** continue to be tight this week and pricing has continued to creep up. A gap in supply is likely imminent for this growing region.



CV CITRUS

There are good supplies of **Navel Oranges** from South Africa, Chile, and Peru with prices coming down with the increase of supply.

Better supplies of Peruvian **Minneola Tangelos** are now available with prices surely coming off as more vendors get inventory in. Bag **Clementine Mandarins** are in good supply from several countries as well and vendors have been easing off the price to generate some extra business.
