ABUNDANT ORGANIC BLUEBERRIES





GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberry prices remain promotable on 12/1 pints and 12/18oz clamshells. We'll see fruit coming in from the Pacific Northwest, and volume is plentiful. Quality has been solid offering great deals for consumers at sharp price points into the second week of August! New Jersey fruit is now finished for the season.

Organic Blackberry prices remain steady as production continues from California and **LOCAL** New Jersey. NJ growers are expected to last until the end of July, pending weather conditions. CA growers will be steady and production is expected increase as we get into early August, leading to more promotable pricing and availability.

NOTE: Organic Strawberry prices have jumped up very quickly. California farms are seeing lower yields as the season starts coming to an end. Quality has been very nice, but expect higher pricing and lighter supplies headed into late summer.

ALERT! Organic Raspberries will be extremely limited as quality issues continue to cut orders short. Expected shortages and limits as growers work through this challenging season.



OG MELONS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cantaloupes and Honeydews are in full swing from the San Joaquin Valley of California. Promotional opportunities will be available now through August, and quality is the best of the season.

Organic Galia and **Hami Melons** are in season from California and full of flavor!

Organic Watermelons continue to be available out of California. Quality has been very nice but pricing is much higher due to freight and overall higher production costs.

Organic Black Rind Seedless Watermelons are available by request out of North Carolina.

Organic Mini Watermelons remain available from California and Arizona. Quality has been excellent overall, and fruit is eating excellent.



OG GREENS & LETTUCES

LOCAL Organic Kales and **Collards** remain in steady supply from Lady Moon Farms in Pennsylvania.

Other LOCAL growers in PA and NJ will begin to slow down with their Organic Greens in late July, but then they will return in September. LOCAL New York production begins to increase.

LOCAL Organic Leaf and **Romaine Lettuce** in Pennsylvania has fully finished. **LOCAL** Product in New York, Vermont, and Quebec are all in season. Expect consistent supplies and strong quality in late July.

Organic Romaine Hearts and Iceberg Lettuce from California have strong volumes and excellent quality. Look for promotional opportunities in late July. Quebec production will supplement California supplies at a comparable cost, unless the heavy rains from 7/20-21 hurt the crop of delay harvest.



OG MANGOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Round Mangos continue to be promotable.

Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos will be more limited through the end of the month, with larger sizes being tighter.

Crespo Organics is also beginning to offer 3 new varieties of **Specialty Organic Mangos** in the US marketplace:

- Yellow "Nam Doc Mai" variety
- Yellow skinned "Malikka" variety
- Green Thai Mango known as the "Kiew Savoy".
 The green "Kiew Savoy" is eaten when the flesh is hard to firm and resembles a crunchy apple when eaten.

All 3 varieties will be very limited to start.





OG HASS AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocado volumes rebounded just a bit from Mexico as growers began to harvest "Flora Loca" season fruit.

California fruit is available to help keep up with demand.

Small amounts of Peruvian **Organic Hass Avocados** are available in the marketplace.



OG TOMATOES

LOCAL Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms have started out of Pennsylvania.

LOCAL Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes are delayed in starting, and now are not expected to ramp up until the end of July into early August.

LOCAL Organic Heirloom Tomatoes have just begun out of Amish grower crops in Ohio and Pennsylvania! Peak season will be August.

Organic Roma Tomato prices are firming with an unexpected gap until local PA crops get started.



OG KIWIFRUIT

Now is the time to promote Zespri Organic Green and SunGold Kiwifruit from New Zealand while availability and quality are at peak through August.

Four Seasons will be kicking off the annual Zespri Kiwifruit Display Contest during the month of August! A full complement of volume filled and clamshell options will be available.



OG CABBAGE

LOCAL Organic Cabbage remains in steady volume from Pennsylvania. As August approaches, production in PA will slow and New York and Vermont will begin. Volumes should remain steady throughout the summer.



OG LOCAL SWEET ONIONS

Lancaster County, PA **Organic PA Candy Sweet Onions** are in full swing from our **LOCAL** grower,
Christ King and Sam Zook! This is a great item to
promote with good availability



OG CELERY

Organic Celery from California has begun to improve in both volume and quality. Expect steady availability throughout the remainder of July. Pricing will still not be promotable in July, but it will gradually improve as volumes increase in August.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes from California are kicking off for the season with mostly Reds to start. We'll see "Flames" on the Reds initially, and the Greens will begin to load the final week of July.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cotton Candy Grapes from Mexico will be abundant and promotable for the rest of July!



OG HOTHOUSE CUCUMBERS

Organic Euro Seedless Cucumbers will be promotable into the end of July out of Canada and Mexico. Quality is outstanding.

NOTE: Organic Mini Seedless Cucumbers in the tray and bags have tightened, and there is a spike in pricing out of Canada.



OG LOCAL WARM VEG

LOCAL Organic Warm Vegetables are coming into full season in Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

Expect steady supply volume on Organic Cucumbers, Eggplant, Green Peppers, Summer Squashes, and Specialty Peppers. Promotional opportunities will be available in late July and August.



OG HARD SQUASH

We will start the transition over to LOCAL Pennsylvania grown Organic Hard Squash in late July from Central PA Produce.

By August, Organic Delicata, Spaghetti, and Acorn Squash will have started, and then, Organic Butternut and Kabocha Squash will follow. Organic Squash will have promotable pricing across the board.



OG GREEN BEANS

The LOCAL Pennsylvania Organic Green Bean season is beginning with strong volume in only its second week of harvest.

Late July will bring high volumes and promotional opportunities.



OG CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cauliflower from California is yielding strong volumes and excellent quality. Promotional opportunities will be available in late July.



OG CITRUS

California **Organic Valencia Orange** prices are starting to increase due to a smaller crop. Expect some sporadic out of stocks.

Organic Grapefruit remain very sporadic with seasonal quality.

NOTE: Organic Lemon supplies remain very tight out of Argentina with sporadic arrivals. Mexico has not started yet, but they expect to in August, and California is expected to begin again in September.

NOTE: Organic Limes continue to be challenging with lighter color and blanching to be expected. Prices continue to rise.



OG STONE FRUIT

Organic Yellow & White Peaches and Nectarines, continue in peak season from California with excellent quality. Stemilt is starting their Artisan Organic Peach and Nectarine program at the end of July from Washington as well.

California growers are running into abundant harvests on **Organic Red** and **Black Plums** for late July. Pricing will become more affordable for late July and early August.

Organic Verry Cherry Plums and **Pluots** remain in steady supply.

LAST CALL! Washington Organic Rainier Cherries have finished for the season, and Organic Dark Sweet Cherries will finish by the end of July.

LAST CALL! California and Washington Organic Apricots will finish for the season here in late July.



OG BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli and Broccoli Rabe have strong volume and promotional opportunities.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Broccoli from California continues to improve in availability and pricing. Expect both bunches and crowns to have consistent availability in late July. With improved volume, pricing is becoming promotable to increase demand.

Canadian grown **Organic Broccoli** from Quebec will supplement California supplies.

- NOTE: Organic Black Mission Figs from California will gap for the end of the July, and will return sometime in early August for the fall.
- NOTE: Code 40397 Organic Rainbow Carrots 24/2lb bags are gapping but expected back in stock in mid-August.
- Organic Red, Orange, and Yellow Bell Peppers remain in steady supply for July. Quality is strong, while pricing and availability remain consistent.



Watermelons remain steady overall. Fruit is coming in from North Carolina and LOCAL Maryland right now. LOCAL Delaware growers are slowly scratching their fields but expect better production to start in late July. LOCAL Pennsylvania growers are also expected to start by the beginning of August for their short season. Quality has been very nice on new fields.

GOOD NEWS! We are in peak season for premium Cantaloupes and Honeydew from Firebaugh, California. Pricing will be promotable for late July and much of August. Quality is top notch! Much of our supply will be with the famous "Peacock" and "King



CV GRAPES

GOOD NEWS!

New crop California **Grapes** from the Delano, CA region are off and running for the season, and our first arrivals are coming in with excellent quality.

"Ruby Rush" and "Passion Fire" will be the Red Grape varieties on premium California fruit, while "Sugar Drops" and "Honey Pops" will be the Green Grapes for late July. Get ready for some awesome, large size, sweet, new crop California Grapes!

There are still price-value opportunities on Mexican Grapes in the marketplace. The Mexican crop started late and will end late, causing an overlap with the California season. Great promotable opportunities are available on large Mexican Green and Red Grapes!

Cotton Candy Grapes from Mexico will be priced at the lowest levels of the season to help move the abundant (and late) crop before the California harvests begin. Late July and early August will be a great time for ads and in-store specials.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Blueberries are very promotable for the rest of July and early August on pints and 18oz packs. British Columbia and Michigan production remains strong, and volume continues to increase. Quality has been very nice. There are some great deals available to pass on to consumers to really move some volume!

Driscoll's **Blackberries** have been eating like candy, offering a great eating experience for consumers. Production is expected to ramp up in early August, leading to more promotable availability and pricing.

NOTE: Strawberry prices spiked very quickly as growers yields have fallen short. Cold temps last month really affected yields creating a gap. Quality has been nice but expect higher markets and production to steady out. Expect possible pro-rates and shortages.

ALERT! Raspberries are extremely tight and limited. Quality has been an ongoing issue, hampering availability. California production has been impacted from the weird weather patterns this season. Mexico production really isn't expected to start with any kind of volume until late August or early September.



CV TOMATOES

LOCAL Heirloom Tomatoes are starting to roll in, and quality is expected to be outstanding! Our Lancaster County, PA grower, Cedar Meadow Farms, has just achieved Regenerative Certification for their farming operations.

Greenhouse Heirloom Tomatoes have been steady out of Canada.

Vine Ripe Tomato availability has been a struggle with the East Coast having limited yields. LOCAL Jumbo 25lb has been our main supply out of Delaware. North Carolina has been struggling to keep up with any demand, and LOCAL New Jersey is slow to start. LOCAL Pennsylvania is starting in a very small way and will increase in volume by August.

LOCAL Lancaster County, PA **Grape Tomatoes** have begun and will make up most of our supply headed into August.

Roma Tomatoes are unexpectedly gapping. NC is struggling due to rain. LOCAL Roma Tomatoes have started in a small way. There is still product out of Mexico but not enough to soften demand.

Cluster Tomatoes stayed promotable but we are expecting a shift in the market by August.





CV LOCAL SWEET ONIONS

We will switch over from Vidalia Onions to LOCAL PA Simply Sweet Onions here in late July.

14/3lb bags and 40lb jumbos will begin the week of 7/24.



CV EGGPLANT

LOCAL Eggplant is struggling to get started out of New Jersey. Growers are experiencing lower yields than expected. South of NJ has better availability but feels the demand and is more expensive. The market is firming, but this should be short lived until local season kicks in stronger.



CV SWEET CORN

LOCAL Sweet Corn prices continue to fall now that production is ramping up.

Bins and crates will be readily available and promotable out of New Jersey, Delaware, and Pennsylvania for the rest of July and into August.



CV MANGOS

Round Mangos have passed the mid-way point of the season for Mexico as the crop is beginning to size larger and shifting away from 10 and 12ct smaller sizing. We will see that shift continue through the end of the season.

The **"Pango Mango"** label from Puerto Rico continues in season.

NOTE: Ataulfo Honey Mangos are tightening considerably as growers are beginning to wind down production. Pricing has begun to go up.



CV KIWIFRUIT

Premium Zespri **Green** and **SunGold Kiwifruit** from New Zealand will be in peak supply and quality during August.

Fruit volume is ample in all sizes and varieties, and it will be a great time to promote with big displays as part of the Four Seasons Display Contest.

Ask your rep about point of sale materials and display bins!



CV PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Pineapple supplies remain tight. Expect prices to remain high for the rest of July and into August.

NOTE: Del Monte's **HoneyGlow Pineapples** and Dole's **Golden Selection Pineapples** will be extremely limited through August.



CV PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS!

LOCAL Jumbo Green Bell Peppers are now primarily out of New Jersey. Pricing is promotable and is expected to remain that way.

11lb Hothouse Red, Orange, and Yellow Bell Pepper prices continue to flow in steadily and will remain promotable from Nature Sweet into August.



CV LOCAL VEG

LOCAL Baby Bok Choy, Bok Choy, Napa Cabbage, Squash, Cabbages, and Cucumbers are available out of New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

Availability fluctuates as PA and NJ experience hot weather accompanied with little to no rain, or nonstop rain!



CV LETTUCES

NOTE: Iceberg and **Leaf Lettuces** pricing will be on the rise since the Quebec growing region got slammed with heavy rains on 7/20-7/21. Many growers in California have cut back production to account for the Quebec deal.

Romaine Hearts will be a little slower to jump up, while Iceberg Lettuce is quicker to rise in price.





CV "SWEETEST BATCH" BERRIES

Driscoll's "Sweetest Batch" Blueberries are in season with LOCAL product from New Jersey on a special variety with great size, quality, and flavor.

"Sweetest Batch" Blackberries are gapping but there will be some "Sweetest Batch" Raspberries and Strawberries from California.



CV HASS AVOCADOS

Hass Avocado supplies are ample for 60ct and smaller fruit, while 48s and larger continue to be tighter. "Flora Loca" crop fruit out of Mexico is just starting, and that fruit is on the smaller side and are projected to remain so for a few weeks. This will cause demand for larger fruit to be great, and drive prices upward.

Peru and Columbia continue to offer a cheaper alternative to the Mexican fruit. That said, there is much less product coming from Peru this year than last, which is keeping the overall pricing higher.



· Asparagus prices are dropping slightly and is expected to do so into August. Peru continues to be challenged with low yields, and Mexico starts with some new fields.



CV GREEN BEANS

Green Bean prices have dropped as we kick off LOCAL season with beautiful quality out of Central Pennsylvania. Time to promote!



CV RAMBUTAN

Rambutan will be available from Guatemala in the "Ramboos" label clamshells from Goldenberry Farms starting at the end of July.



CV STONE FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! Washington Dark Sweet Cherries remain plentiful with promotional opportunities on large sizing through the end of July. Supplies will continue well into August with higher elevation fruit.

Rainier Cherries, on the other hand, will end earlier than expected by the beginning of August.

California Yellow & White Nectarines and Peaches, as well as LOCAL Pennsylvania and New Jersey Peaches, remain in steady peak season supply.

Apriums, Plumcots, and Pluots continue in season with varieties changing often. Varieties for late July will include "Midnight Rose", "Crimson Rose", "Plumogranate", "Amber Jewel", "King Midas Yellow", and "Dapple Jack"/"Dapple Fire".

Red and Black Plums, along with "Verry Cherry" Plums remain in good supply. "Nectapie" Flat Nectarines and Donut Peaches are in peak season.

NOTE: Apricots are winding down for the season.

OTHER STORIES

- 12ct and 24ct Artichokes are readily available.
- Brussels Sprouts pricing has started to go back up as demand pulled stronger than availability.
- Celery has better pricing and availability now across the growing regions. There is a long way to fall on price but it is slowly getting there!



CV CITRUS

Mandarins are very promotable, and this will continue into the end of July. Now is the time to promote all 15/2 lb and 10/3 lb bags. Quality on Chilean fruit has been very nice.

California Navel Oranges are finally winding down for the season, but they still have decent supply on 56's. Small sizes are very tight, so we've had to make the move to import Chilean fruit. Quality has been very nice.

NOTE: Cara Cara Oranges, in bulk and bags, will be very limited over the next few weeks. The vessel arriving to North America from South Africa won't arrive at dock until the week of the 24th, so expect tighter availability and higher prices heading into August.

Lemons are in good supply from California and able to cover all demand across the board with all sizing. Imports are also available, and we'll have great value deals on small sizes, specifically fancy 165's and 200's.
