ORGANIC CALIFORNIA GRAPE SEASON



August through early October will be prime time for peak season **Organic Grapes** from California's San Joaquin Valley.

California **Organic Black**, **Green**, and **Red Grapes** are now in excellent supply. Quality is very nice on the Sugarone greens, Summer Royal black, and Flame reds.

Specialty Organic Grapes are also in season!

California **Organic Champagne Grapes** will be available in sporadic supply during August.

Seedless Thomcord Grapes with grape-jelly flavor will be promotable from August 10 through mid-September.



OG FIGS

California **Organic Figs** are coming into peak season.

Available for early August are the Calimyrna (Green) and Brown Turkey varieties. Both have a gooey red flesh that has a sweet taste.

Headed into mid-August, the ever popular **Or**ganic Black Mission Figs will be promotable.

Fresh figs sell well when merchandised in refrigeration by the berry and grape displays.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes are available in steady numbers this week from Lady Moon Farms' PA fields. Quality looks fantastic on the early harvests. Promote locally grown!

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms in PA will be available in promotable numbers this week. Quality is very nice on this new local crop.

Organic Roma Tomatoes from King Family Farms in Lancaster County, PA are available this week. Quality has been very nice on this local tomato. Lady Moon will also start harvesting from PA farms this week.

Organic Round Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms PA crop will be available in limited numbers to start the week. Volume should start to ramp up quickly as the summer heat continues. Quality should be excellent on this new crop.



OG STONE FRUIT

California **Organic Black** and **Red Plums** are in good, steady supply. These are some of the best eating plum varieties of the season.

California Organic Pluots are still cycling through varieties, including Dapple Dandy, and remain promotable.

California **Organic White** and **Yellow Peaches** are in excellent supply. Washington is just getting started and anticipates a great crop.

California **Organic Yellow** and **White Nectarines** are in <u>extremely</u> limited supply. The first Washington **Organic Nectarines** are available but not in as much volume as the peach crop.

Washington **Organic Dark Sweet Cherries** have continued slightly longer than expected but will finish for the season by mid-August. **Organic Rainier Cherries** are finished.

Organic Apricots are starting to wind down out of the Pacific Northwest.



OG MELONS

Organic Cantaloupes from the San Joaquin Valley of California are in peak season. Fruit is mostly large, so 9ct will be the predominant promotable size.

Some **Organic Tuscan Cantaloupes** are also coming into season from California.

Organic Honeydew are in light supply and will have a sporadic fill-rate for August. Growers over-planted last year and have cut back on their 2019 acreage.



OG SWEET CORN

Organic Sweet Corn grown in South Carolina is in peak season and promotable.

PA & NY are also in season, but day-to-day with their yield expectations. Overall, mid-August is a good time to promote **Certified Organic Sweet Corn**.



OG POTATOES

NOTE: New crop **Organic Russet Potatoes** will get started this week. Price will jump up significantly because of the transition over to new crop.

Organic Red and **Yellow Potatoes** continue to come out of California with very nice quality and steady pricing.



OG WATERMELONS

Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons remain very promotable. Fruit has been sizing very big, leading to more availability on 6ct minis. Quality has been excellent.

Organic Seedless Watermelon Bins will be very tight this week. Supplies are slowing up quickly as harvests are slowing down rapidly. Expect some shortages as we go through the week.



OG HASS AVOCADOS

Prices are beginning to ease down slightly on **Organic Hass Avocados** as volumes increase in Mexico. California also remains in season.

Equal Exchange **Fair-Trade Organic Hass Avocados** are back in season for mid-August out of Mexico.



OG APPLES

Organic Braeburn, Fuji, Gala, Granny and Pink Lady Apples from New Zealand are in decent supply for August.

On the unique variety side, **Organic NZ Queen** and **Diva Apples** are available to complement mid-August displays.

On the US new crop outlook, some **Organic Rave Apples** from Stemilt will come into season for late August and CA **Organic Gala Apples** will start to be harvested during the middle of the month.



OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Cauliflower from California will begin to tighten in supply. Many shippers are experiencing low quantities due to weather conditions over a month ago while the crop was growing.

We should see reliable product coming out of Nevada while California struggles. With tighter supplies in California, pricing has been on the rise. Expect to see some supply out of Canada with better pricing.



OG CELERY

Organic Celery from California has continued to be in steady supply as we head into August. Expect aggressive pricing, qualities, and supplies to continue. With pricing being extremely high for so long, this is a great opportunity to promote and move some extra volume.



OG PEARS

New crop California **Organic Bartlett Pears** are now in season. Promotability will increase as Washington growers being their new crop harvests in mid to late August.

New crop **Organic Starkrimson Red Pears** are likely to be in season at the end of August.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico are back in supply. As we head into late July and early August, expect to see steady supplies from Mexico and California with excellent quality.



OG HARD SQUASH

We will have a limited amount of a new butternut variety called an **Organic Bellevue Butternut Squash** arriving this week. It's a cross between a Butternut and a Seminole Pumpkin resulting in a very nutty flavor profile.

PA local **Organic Butternut** and **Spaghetti Squash** are now in season.



OG ONIONS

PA local **Organic Red** and **Candy Sweet Onions** continue to be in very promotable supply this week. Quality is outstanding!



OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli from California will start slowing down in supply as we head into late July. Expect to see pricing to begin to rise and some suppliers to have limited supplies. There's some availability out of Washington as well.

The Quebec season has started with limited supplies, and product will ramp up here in early August. As the season continues, expect to see steady volumes and competitive pricing compared to California product.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blueberries continue in decent supply out of California and the Pacific Northwest. Expect prices to rise in mid-August as harvests wind down.

Driscoll's **Organic Blackberries** out of California continue to be limited with high prices. Other brands continue to gap until new crop begins in the fall.

Driscoll's Organic Raspberries out of California continue in steady supply for mid-August.

Organic Strawberries seem to be in a little better supply this week, but this short-term increase is expected to tighten up again in mid-August when prices will rise. Quality has improved.



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumbers from local regions are beginning to come on strong. The heat is causing many growers to see high yields as we conclude July.

Organic European Seedless Cucumber supplies are steady, and quality has been outstanding. Expect to see promotional opportunities heading into August.

Organic Mini Cucumbers from Canada are in consistent supply with steady pricing.

OTHER STORIES

• ALERT! Organic Asparagus prices remain very high. Quality has been very nice from Mexico but expect short term gaps and limited supplies again this week.

• Zespri New Zealand Organic Green and Sun-Gold Kiwifruit are now in steady supply.

• Organic Beets from California will be back in supply as July concludes. Continue to expect to see inconsistent pricing and less than ideal quality. Weather conditions in many growing regions are causing breakdown and discoloration of the leaves. • New crop **Organic Satsuma Mandarins** are available out of Peru in both bulk and pouch bags. Expect sporadic supplies.

• California Organic Valencia Orange supplies are excellent with steady markets. Expect some green skin color on the Organic Valencia's this time of year.

• ALERT! Organic Lemons out of California and Mexico remain extremely limited with skyrocketing prices continue. Mostly choice fruit is available. • Organic Kent Mangos will be the primary variety for early to mid-August. Supplies and quality are excellent. Organic Keitt Mangos are anticipated for mid to late August and will peak on jumbo sizes (7-9ct).

On **Eastern Apples**, we will have old crop Red and Fuji Apples until mid-August. At that time, we will start a new season with fresh **Gala**, **Ginger Gold**, and **Paula Red Apples**. To the right are the start dates of other varieties of **Eastern Apples** from Virginia and Pennsylvania. New York-grown will follow in September.

Washington will follow along the same lines with some growers packing **Gala Apples** and **Ginger Golds** in early August. Expect higher prices as we move into new crop.

La Rouge Red Peppers will be gapping this week from California. Expect shortages and limited supplies.



CV LOCAL TOMATOES

Local Heirloom Tomatoes from Cedar Meadow Farms are available in good numbers this week. Quality and sizing are fantastic.

Local Grape Tomatoes packaged in our "Native Grown" brand will also be very promotable this week. Harvests really picked up this week, bringing on strong numbers. Quality has been excellent. "Native Grown" Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes from Cedar Meadow Farms in Lancaster County, PA are promotable. Quality is fantastic.

Vine Ripe Tomatoes from Lancaster County are promotable this week. Quality is excellent on these as the recent hot weather brought on the flush. Promote local!

Roma Tomato prices will be a bit stronger this week. Quality and pricing however will still remain promotable. Quality coming from Alabama and Tennessee has been very nice.



CV STONE FRUIT

New Jersey and Pennsylvania **Yellow Peach**es are in peak season for August promotion. NJ growers are hinting that their volumes may not be as big as they originally projected. Stay tuned.

Red and **Black Plums** are eating good right now. This is a great time of the year to promote this fruit. Also for even bigger flavor, **Pluots** from California are outstanding for August with varieties like red "Summer Punch", yellow "Golden Treat", yellow/green "Flavor Grenade", and the mottled "Dapple Dandy".

The last of the season Northwest **Dark Sweet Cherries** are arriving to the East Coast and will sell out by mid-August. **Rainier Cherries** are done for the season.



CV PEARS

We are into new crop California Bartlett, Bosc, and Starkrimson Red Pears.

Washington will start their **Bartlett Pears** here in the beginning of August.

There are some imports still available, mostly **Pack-ham Pears**, but you will see some blow out deals from vendors looking to close out their season.



CV HASS AVOCADOS

The **Hass Avocado** market has been steady with less movement over the past two weeks.

Prices on Mexican fruit has been creeping down. Fruit is peaking on 48 counts and smaller.



CV CITRUS

Supplies exceeds demand on **Navel Oranges** coming in from Chile, Peru, and South Africa. Prices are soft as growers look to move the excess inventories.

Minneola Tangelos are plentiful, and prices are down on these as well. The **Clementine Manda**rin movement is steady with many growers having program business. There are spot deals on the smaller sizes, 36's and 40's.



CV SWEET CORN

White, Yellow, and Bi-Color Sweet Corn prices remain at a historic high for this time of year due to yield damage in the Midwest. With some new regions to start new harvests sometime in early August, prices may ease off a bit. Quality from PA and DE continue to be excellent.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus prices continue to be strong. Demand continues to be stronger than supply on both Peruvian and Mexican product, setting high prices. Quality has been very nice from both regions.



CV WATERMELONS

Watermelon quality has been excellent with great color and great sugar. Prices are not as low as late July since production from Delaware and Maryland remain somewhat tight and overall demand is strong.

Lancaster County, PA product is also available in less than load volume with outstanding quality.



CV HOTHOUSE TOMATOES

Hothouse Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes will be promotable again this week. Despite lower harvests, less demand is keeping prices steady. Quality looks great.

Campari Tomatoes will be very promotable this week. Quality has been very nice.



CV POTATOES

10/5lb New Jersey Fresh White Potatoes are in promotable supply. The 10/5lb New Jersey Fresh Red Potatoes be available for a few weeks before supplies finish up.

Russet Potato supplies are winding down across the country. There may be a few gaps between storage crop ending and new crop availability. Pricing appears to be rising on all sizes.
