PROMOTABLE ORGANIC HASS AVOCADOS



Organic Hass Avocado supplies are up for the middle of October out of Mexico. This steady volume with nice quality at reasonable pricing is allowing for October promotions!

The Mexican crop is transitioning from "Flora Loca" crop to the "Aventajada" crop during this time.

Equal Exchange brand **Organic Fair Trade Avocados** continue with good availability on 48ct and 60ct. Small size fruit in 4ct ReadyCycle packages with brand story are also available from Equal Exchange.





OG BERRIES

Organic Raspberries are in excellent supply from Mexico, and now is a great time to promote. Pricing will go back up to more typical levels in November, but sharp price points should be available until then!

Organic Blueberry supplies from Mexico are excellent, and quality has been beautiful. Get ready to promote Blueberry pints the week of October 17th - Now is the perfect time!

NOTE: Organic Blackberries will be in very tight supply as we close out the month of October, and pricing is not expected to drop. Quality has been solid.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries are extremely tight, and pricing just continues to rise. Overall supplies are down, and it will create a tough market moving forward. Expect more price increases each week as we head into November.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: Organic Cauliflower from California remains a difficult market during October. Although some growers are reporting increased volume in mid to late October, others are struggling with low yields and quality issues. There's a range of prices and this will be a volatile market.

Local PA growers are expected to begin harvesting their fall crop of **Organic Cauliflower** in late October, which will run into November with nice quality expected.

ALERT! Organic Broccoli pricing remains extremely elevated in mid-October. California continues to be the main source of supplies but they're struggling with quality and yields. Quebec is winding down. North Carolina growers will start later in October, and generally improved quality and availability is expected then.

Local PA **Organic Stem/Stalk Broccoli** will become available in mid-October.

NOTE: Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli from California is going up in price and volumes are expected to drop closer to November. Some product from North Carolina will become available to supplement.



OG TROPICALS

Organic Pineapple supplies have been excellent and promotable for both óct and 8ct sizing. Quality has been very good.

Both Organic Eat & Drink Coconuts and Organic Young Thai Coconuts will be in stock for most of October!

Organic Keitt Mangos from California will be available in limited supplies. Pricing is high for this domestic fruit.

Organic Passion Fruit and **Jujube** are available for mid-October.

NOTE: Organic Dragon Fruit supplies suffered from severe weather in Mexico. Supplies will be very limited and likely out of stock for the time being.

NOTE: Organic Royal Star Papayas are in tight supply due to rain and gaps in crop supplies for the middle to end of October.

OG CITRUS

Organic Valencia Oranges continue to be in steady supply and are expected to transition to Organic Navel Oranges in the first half of November. A good size crop of good quality fruit should be expected.

Organic Grapefruit continue to be very limited out of California. We expect supplies to begin improving the first or second week of November.

Organic Lemons and **Limes** are finally in good supply with easing prices.



OG PEPPERS

NOTE: Organic Color Bell Peppers from Canada and Holland remain limited during the later stages of their season. Mexican grown product is now available in mid to late October, although volumes remain light. Expect limited supplies and product from various growing regions to fulfill supplies during October and early November.

Organic Mini Sweet Peppers from Mexico will become available in light volumes in late October.



OG SQUASH

Organic Zucchini and **Yellow Squash** remain in consistent supply during mid-October as NC and FL production continues. Colder temperatures in NC have drastically slowed, however Lady Moon Farms has resumed harvests of **Organic Zucchini** after the impacts of Hurricane lan subsided. Mexican supplies of both commodities are becoming available, and volumes are increasing in late October.

Expect supplies from Mexico to supplement any shortages due to colder temperatures or aftermath effects of Hurricane Ian.



OG CARROTS

NOTE: Grimmway (Cal-O and Bunny-Luv brands) have put prorates in place for **Organic Cello, Table, Jumbo,** and **Juice Carrots** in order to stretch out their light inventory during October. Limited supplies are expected until they can harvest the next block of fields in late November.

Organic Rainbow Cello Carrots will be fully unavailable until the next lot of fields.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes are in good supply due a switch to stronger varieties. **Organic Green Grapes** have transitioned into "Autumn Crisp," which is a topnotch variety.

Organic Black Grapes, Thomcords, and Red & Green Grapes in biodegradable packs are all available for mid-October.



OG CELERY

Organic Celery production from CA remains strong in mid-October. As November approaches and Thanksgiving begins to increase demand, **Organic Celery** is expected to increase in price. Quality remains good from California and is expected to remain so through the Thanksgiving holiday.



OG GREEN PEPPERS & EGGPLANT

Organic Green Bell Peppers and **Eggplant** continue to be sourced from NC with strong volume and excellent quality, but as November approaches, colder temperatures will begin to slow production.

Mexican grown product will be the main source of supply following the conclusion of the NC season as the FL season was delayed due to Hurricane Ian. Lady Moon will gap until later this winter on these items.



OG APPLES

Make sure to enter the Stemilt **Organic Apple** Display Contest to drive lots of volume inflation-busting market opportunities.

Organic Opal and **SugarBee Apples** will be available towards the end of October.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus prices are expected to remain steady at current levels out of Argentina until the Mexico season starts in November.



OG FALL FRUIT

Organic Fresh Figs will be available through October in limited supplies. Organic Pomegranates and Organic Pomegranate Arils are now in peak season. Organic Fuyu Persimmons are now available with Hachiya variety starting by 10/19.



OG CABBAGE

Locally grown **Organic Green Cabbage** continues to be in full swing during October from NY and PA. **Organic Red Cabbage** has full transitioned to PA grown, while **Organic Napa** and **Savoy Cabbage** continue to be sourced from NJ and VT respectively.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico resumed harvests in a limited way during mid-October. Supply volume will gradually increase, while pricing decreases in late October. The 16/11b microwavable pack is selling well too.



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumbers are in strong supply despite the impacts of Hurricane Ian in Florida. In the initial aftermath of the storm, North Carolina and Mexican growing regions were light in supplies. In mid-October, the Mexican season began to ramp up while North Carolina production began increasing. Expect strong supplies, quality, and promotable pricing during late October on **Organic Cucumbers**. Limited amounts of Lady Moon Farms **Organic Cucumbers** will be available in late October as they continue to recover from the effects of the storm.

12ct **Organic Euro Seedless Cucumber** prices are decreasing as we head into the end of October. Availability is increasing and quality is okay, but will be improving.

ALERT! Organic Mini Seedless Cucumber prices will remain high as many shippers are in crop transition. Additionally, some growers have reduced their greenhouse plantings on this commodity.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes are now new crop from Quebec. Quality is nice so far.

Organic Cluster Tomatoes out of Canada are starting in a small way with some additional volume to supplement the end of the Mexico crop. New crop Canada will provide the very best quality around as we head into the end of the year.

Cocktail Tomatoes are in peak season from Quebec in the Savoura brand. **Organic Campari Cocktail Tomatoes** are also available.

NOTE: Organic Grape and Cherry Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms are finished in PA and would have been starting in mid-October with their new crop out of Florida. Unfortunately, with the weather that Florida has had, this will cause them to clean up and replant. This means that there will be no Lady Moon **Tomatoes** out of Florida until at least mid-December.

We will have other Organic Grape and Cherry Tomato brands available while Lady Moon gaps.



OG LETTUCE

ALERT! Organic Leaf and **Romaine Lettuce** remain limited in October as California suppliers struggle with "INSV" field disease and light harvest yields. These conditions are expected to continue into November when growers transition to southern growing regions.

Quebec supplies have rebounded during mid-October after cold temperatures slowed production, but their season is in the final stages as it is expected to conclude by November.

Local New Jersey productions is beginning in late October and will last a few weeks.

ALERT! Organic Romaine Hearts and Iceberg Lettuce from California remain limited due to growers not consistently harvesting daily. With inconsistent harvests and yields, pricing is expected to remain elevated into November when new growing regions finally begin.

OTHER STORIES

• Organic Cantaloupes and Honeydew seem to have finished from California with minimal inventory remaining. Arizona will start Honeydew in mid-October. • Organic SunGold Kiwifruit will be finishing up for the season by the middle of October. Organic Green Kiwifruit from Zespri will be in good supply through at least October. • Locally grown **Organic Green Beans** from PA are ending in mid-October. After a strong local season, we will source from NC, FL, and Mexico to supplement supplies during the fall months.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

FALL CITRUS OUTLOOK





SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE:

Import **Mandarins** are in ample supply for October with some reasonable pricing available. "Halos" brand **Mandarins** from Chile, with good size and quality, are available at a premium.

Navel Oranges continue with remarkable quality on imported fruit. All sizes are currently in good supply during October.

Import Cara Cara Oranges and Minneola Tangelos are now done for the season.



CV BERRIES

Blueberries are in excellent supply from Mexico and Peru. North America continues to receive plenty of volume from Peru, and this has kept market prices are very promotable levels. This market should remain unchanged heading into November. Quality has been excellent on fruit from all regions, so now is a great time promote **Blueberries**.

Raspberries will be promotable for the remainder of October. Supplies are excellent from California and Mexico.

Blackberries will be in shorter supply heading into the week of 10/17. California is winding down for the season, and volumes from Mexico are just beginning to ramp up. Look for pricing to slide down as we head into November.

ALERT! Strawberries are in very short supply, and the market price has continued to climb. Beginning the week of 10/17, we'll be making a switch from California fruit to Mexican fruit. While pricing is not expected to change, we should see a nice quality improvement on this new crop fruit.



FLORIDA & TEXAS:

Florida **Juice Oranges** are now in season. For stores that do in-store juicing, we'll be bringing in a 100ct bulk. 12/3lb bags will be available for retailers selling to at-home juicers.

Fall Glo Tangerines are in season. 80ct and 12/3lb bags will be available for the week of 10/17. This variety has plenty of seeds, but there are still some stores that want to offer this to their shoppers.

Florida and Texas **Grapefruit** will be ready to go by mid to late October. Stay tuned for more details.



CV APPLES

It's peak **Apple** season! We are now seeing better supplies available to load from all eastern and western **Apple** shippers across more varieties, despite what may be a smaller crop volume than usual.

The third week of October brings a few more varieties in stock. Out west, we will see new crop **Braeburn** and the anticipated return of **SugarBee Apples** on 10/20. Tart-sweet **Lucy Glo Apples**, with yellow skin and reddish flesh, are now available.

Back east, **Cortlan Apples** are now in stock, and **Rome** and **Stayman** will be arriving in late October.

18/2lb pouch bags out of New York will be available in **Empire, Gala, McIntosh,** and **Red Delicious** "Lil Apples."

Eastern and western **Ginger Gold Apples** are done for the season, and we have fully transitioned into new crop **Gold Delicious Apples**.

CALIFORNIA:

Look for California "Clementine" variety **Mandarins** to start at the beginning of November. "Halos" will be our primary brand and they will have some new point of sail material and display bins available for mid-November and December promotion.

New crop California **Navel Oranges** are set to begin at the end of October or beginning of November – weather and quality pending! Growers do expect a good volume **Navel Orange** crop later this fall and winter. Small fruit and bags will be prominent during November and December.

We are winding down California Valencia Oranges at this point in the season and will offer Florida Juice Oranges and new crop Navel Oranges as alternatives.

Grapefruit is winding down out of their peak season in California.

With a new growing region coming on, **Lemon** quality is improving noticeably. Pricing is expected to moderate.



CV GRAPES

Red Grapes remain plentiful as quality-dependability has been outstanding. We will remain in some of the strongest varieties of "Scarlett Royal," "Jack Salute," "Alison," and "Timco."

Green Grapes have rebounded with excellent arrivals of late varieties, such as "Autumn Crisp" and "Autumn Kings."

We will continue to offer **Jumbo Grape** lines, currently "Jack Salute" on **Red** and "Autumn Crisp" on **Green** from Illume.

Additional offerings will be **Bi-Color** clamshells, **Cotton Candy** bags/clamshells, **Stella Bella Greens, Moon Drops** (ending), **Black Seedless**, **Globes**, and **Jam** clamshells.



CV BROCCOLI

Broccoli Crowns from Maine are done for the season. Virginia is currently harvesting, with North Carolina ready to start by the end of October. Supplies on the east coast are limited due to current demand to supply ratio.

California remains on the limited side. Mexico and Quebec are available.

Local PA Stem Broccoli bins are readily available!



CV CAULIFLOWER

Cauliflower prices are coming off with better availability from California. Maine is done for the season, but Quebec has a small program on **Bikini-cut Cauliflower**.

Local PA **Bin Jacket-cut Cauliflower** has been gapping due to cooler temps. There are hopes of getting back to a regular harvest schedule to close out October.



CV LETTUCE

ALERT! California growers have given notice to smaller and lighter heads of Iceberg, Romaine, and Romaine Hearts due to poor growing conditions. These Lettuces are extremely limited and becoming very expensive. Growers are not protecting on quality defects - it is a "take it or leave it" market.

Little relief is expected until growers transition to their winter growing regions in November.

Local New Jersey growers have availability on Boston, Red Leaf, Green Leaf, and Romaine Lettuces. It is pricier than usual, but it does provide some relief to the California situation.



CV AVOCADOS

Mexican **Hass Avocado** harvests volumes have increased in Mexico and prices have remained steady despite volumes from Peru winding down for their season.

As we shift away from the Peru fruit due the focus will be on 32ct, 48ct, 60ct, and 15/4ct bags from Mexico. Mexican harvests are transitioning from "Flora Loca" crop to "Aventajada" crop during this time. This should improve fruit quality and oil content of fruit!



CV GREEN BEANS

NOTE: Green Bean prices are expected to increase as we head into the end of October with crops damaged in Florida. Currently, we are offering Georgia product and will be filling needs most likely with product from Mexico for this Thanksgiving, but that could change once we see what type of volume Georgia will have.

Tennessee **Green Beans** have also been damaged from a recent frost, causing even less beans in the market and causing the price to jump.



CV CARROTS

NOTE: Grimmway (including Dole brand) has implemented prorates for **Cello, Table, Jumbo**, and **Juice Carrots** due to low harvest yields during October. Limited supplies are expected until they can harvest the next block of fields in late November.



CV STEAM IT! POTATOES

We received in the POS bins for the **Steam It! Microwave 1.5lb Potatoes.** Look to promote these **Steam It!** items for the month of November.



CV CUCUMBERS

Super Select Cucumber prices are expected to decrease slightly into the end of October with Mexico ramping up in volume. Quality is great but it is about time to move into the solid Mexican dark Green Cucumbers that everyone loves!

Euro and **Mini Seedless Cucumber** prices are starting to ease as we enter the end of October. We are not expected to see floor pricing with less cucumbers planted and disease pressure. Quality has been good.

óct **King O' The West Honeydews** are promotable due to CA fruit still available as well as fruit in Arizona. Look for *new* **Solara Melons** (greenhouse Galia) to be available to start in mid-October. **Cantaloupes** remain tight as the southern regions have not ramped up yet.

CV PEPPERS

Green Pepper prices will start to increase as we transition to Mexico product. Quality has been excellent!

111b Hothouse Yellow and Orange Pepper prices will stay steady. Red Peppers will still be tighter than Yellow and Orange moving forward. There are cheaper Red Peppers available, but it is smaller sizing and not jumbo. We continue to source most of our product from Canada.

15lb **Sweet Red Pepper** prices will remain steady out of California.

Mini Mix Sweet Pepper prices will remain steady into the end of October with Mexico still not having an abundance of product and Canada lagging behind in their production. Quality has been excellent.



CV TOMATOES

Snacking Specialty Tomatoes from Nature-Sweet continue to be promotable through October with promotions of different varieties. Availability is excellent and quality has been superb on all inbounds.

NOTE: Grape and **Cherry Tomato** prices are still on the rise as we will most likely not be seeing any product out of Florida until mid to late December due to the Hurricane.

Cluster Tomatoes will continue to increase as we head into the end of October due to rugose and other disease pressures impacting many greenhouse growers. Another reason for upward market pressure is the lack of Florida **Tomatoes**.

Beefsteak Tomato prices will stay somewhat elevated, if not go up due to high demand with less Florida field grown fruit. 12/3ct packaged **Beefsteak Tomatoes** from Integrow in New York will be back in stock starting the last week of October.

NOTE: Vine Ripe, Round, and **Roma Tomato** prices are poised to go up towards the end of October. Local production is finishing in many parts of the east coast, Florida production will be disrupted by Hurricane Ian damage, and Mexico is not ramped up fully for the season.



CV FALL FRUIT

Fuyu and Hachiya Persimmons are now available in single layer tray pack options! Fruit has started to color up and both crops are looking to have good supplies through December once things get rolling! Be sure to promote this increasingly popular fruit.

Pomegranates continue to be available in good supplies.

The POM Wonderful **Pomegranates** program will begin in late October. At that time, will be offering **POM Wonderful Pomegranates Arils** in 4oz and 8oz pack sizes as well.

Brown Turkey Figs will be available in a 12/8oz through October. Pricing is up.

Quince are now available in a 32-36ct pack. This fruit should be available through most of the fall season.

Ocean Spray and Jersey Fresh **Cranberries** are in stock!



CV BAGGED SALADS

ALERT! Due to raw product supply shortages caused by poor California growing conditions and "INSV" disease, **Iceberg Lettuce** based salads will be in lighter supply for October.

Fresh Express will be heavily prorating their **Shredded Lettuce** line during October. Dole has announced they will temporarily discontinue their Garden Salad items for at least a week during mid-October.

OTHER STORIES

• **Gold** and **Red Potatoes** are available from MN in mid-October, and White Potatoes will still be available out of NJ.

• Local 10/51b PA **White Potatoes** will get started from Bender Potato towards the first or second week of November as their harvest has been delayed due to all the rain earlier this month.

Eggplant prices will increase with local ending quickly. We will be transitioning out to the Carolinas and Mexico as well when available.

• Green and Yellow Squash is increasing, and we will be transitioning to the Carolinas and Mexican product as we move toward the end of October.

• Asparagus prices are expected to remain steady as Mexico is not producing as quickly as expected. This is causing more pulls from the Peruvian Asparagus and causing the hold in the market price. We can expect this to be a steady decline into end October. Quality has been good, and Mexico will start to come on with more and more volume.

• Limes out of Mexico continue to present better quality with the market continuing to slowly decrease more so on 150's and 230's. They are currently peaking on smaller fruit. The Tropical Storm could cause some issues in Mexico this weekend.
