PEAK SEASON ORGANIC APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Mid-October marks the peak season for most varieties of **Organic Apples!** Growers in Washington State are picking, packing, and also putting some product into storage.

Organic Gala, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, and Swee-Tango Apples are promotable and great quality. Organic Fuji Apples are struggling with size and color as we transition from early fruit to Aztec. In the next couple of weeks, things should drastically improve.

Four Seasons Produce and Stemilt are partnered together to offer a display contest and promotion on **Organic Apples** and **Pears** for mid-October through mid-November. **Organic Lil Snapper Apple** pouch bags are available to promote too!



New crop Washington **Organic Envy Apples** are set to arrive here in mid-October. A great crop is expected. We will welcome new crop **Organic Lady Alice Apples** back into the mix out of Washington too.

Fan-favorite, sweet and crisp Organic SugarBee Apples have arrived out of Washington, and quality is outstanding.

Mini snack-sized Organic Rockit Apples are in season and available in 3lb "Shuttle" containers made from 80% recycled plastic.



OG TROPICALS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocado supplies are still promotable despite heavy rain that has prevented harvests for most early October in Mexico. Equal Exchange Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados are promotable too!

GOOD NEWS! Organic Pineapples supplies remain steady and fruit has been sweet!

Organic Dragon Fruit from California will be steady for the rest of October. Fruit quality has been nice. **Organic Kiwano Melons** and **Organic Passion Fruit** from California will be available in limited quantities for October.

NOTE: California grown Organic Keitt Mangos are lightly available. Pricing is higher, but fruit quality has been good. Four Seasons has been carrying a 12ct box, but harvests were much bigger, so 7ct fruit will also be offered.

NOTE: Organic Papayas from Mexico will be more limited for the next few weeks and as we close out October due to a tropical storm and heavy rains associated with it.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Raspberries will remain promotable for mid-October before extra supplies are expected to clean up and start steadying out. Quality has been excellent, so promote now while supplies are plentiful!

NOTE: Organic Blackberry pricing is increasing as supplies are limited out of California/Mexico. Mexico has had some rains, and growers are struggling with any kind of volume. There is a pending storm expected to hit the region as well and could really slow down supplies very quickly.

ALERT! Organic Blueberry supplies remain limited with very high pricing! Peru is expected to see better fill rates heading into Thanksgiving, but for now, expect limits and shortages. Quality has been nice on what is available.

NOTE: Organic Strawberry pricing will increase next week as California production slows down quickly. Expect pricing to continue to increase over the next few weeks as supplies wind down quickly.



OG LETTUCE

October is LOCAL Organic Lettuce season! Growers in New York, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey are being utilized to supply the steady production of Organic Romaine, Green Leaf, and Red Leaf Lettuce.

Additionally, New Jersey is being relied on for purchasing **LOCAL Organic Butter Lettuce** since Pennsylvania producers are not ready to harvest later in October.

Harvests of LOCAL Organic Iceberg Lettuce in New Jersey is currently underway, and it is anticipated that there will be a plentiful supply until the end of October.

Organic Romaine Hearts remain marketable in October with high quality and excellent volume out of California.





OG CARROTS

There will be less to no prorates on **Organic Cello Carrots**. While pro-rates from Cal-O continue, another grower is filling the gap for us until recovery week of 11/6.

With new crop from alternative suppliers flowing in, customers can expect consistent fill rates on **Organic Carrots** across the board.



OG MICROGREENS

Organic Microgreens are now in stock and available from Four Seasons Produce from "Gilberties" in Connecticut.

The four varieties are Asian, French, Mediterranean, and Tex-Mex.



OG CELERY

Throughout October, California-grown **Organic Celery** has remained very marketable. With excellent quality and competitive cost.

Things are likely to change as November draws near. Demand for this Thanksgiving staple always rises in November. Volume is not anticipated to be a problem, but rising demand and shifting market dynamics will result in higher prices as the Thanksgiving holiday draws near.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus will be coming in from Mexico, Argentina, and Ecuador with fantastic quality. Mexico will be crossing more and more as we get into the end of October. Argentina is having a struggle with yields and will lead us to lean on Mexican production into the end of October.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes are available with great pricing and availability out of Mexico.

Organic Roma Tomatoes are finishing up locally and should fizzle out by the end of October. We are starting to mix in Mexico production.



OG PEPPERS

Organic Stoplight (8/3ct), Rainbow (8/3ct), and 2 color (12/2ct) Pepper packs are available.

11lb Organic Red, Orange, and Yellow Pepper prices are coming down on product out of Mexico heading into the end of October.



OG POMEGRANATES

Organic Pomegranates from California are now available! Fruit will have nice quality in LG and MD sized 2-layer fruit for the season.



OG KIWI BERRIES

Organic Kiwi Berries will be winding down by the end of October. Keep promoting this unique fruit until the end of this short season.





OG SWEET CORN

Organic Bi-color Sweet Corn in eco boxes and $12/2 \, \text{pks}$ are available out of Georgia.





OG MELONS

Organic Mini Watermelons remain available as we transition to Mexico. Quality should be excellent, and supplies are steady.

NOTE: Organic Cantaloupes and Honeydew are ending for the California season.



OG PEARS

GOOD NEWS! The first Organic Anjou Pears out of Washington have arrived, and excellent quality should be expected the whole season.

Organic Green Bartlett, Starkrimson Red, Bosc, Comice, and Asian Pears all continue in peak season.





OG POTATOES

We will make the switch to new crop Manitoba, Canada grown **Organic Red** and **Gold Potatoes** in mid-October. These will be in the Poplar Grove label and will be much nicer quality than what we have been seeing out of Wisconsin.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Organic Broccoli prices are expected to come down out of California in mid-October. Promotional possibilities will be made accessible over the duration of October with both price and availability improvements. Take advantage of these possibilities as promotional circumstances will not last long before prices start to rise again in early November.

As conditions gradually become healthier in the middle of October, **Organic Broccoli Rabe** and **Sweet Baby Broccoli** are beginning to show signs of progress. As October continues, pricing is anticipated to improve along with both commodities' volume.

NOTE: Due to decreasing harvest yields, **Organic Cauliflower** prices are rising rapidly. Through November, these circumstances are anticipated to persist.



OG GREENS

GOOD NEWS! There are still plenty of LOCAL Organic Greens farmed locally out of Pennsylvania and New Jersey, as well as lighter supplies from New York. Although local volume for these products is still high, the local season will come to an end as October goes on and the temperatures decrease.

After the local season, production will travel down the East Coast to Georgia and Florida from Lady Moon Farms. Pricing is anticipated to remain consistent.



OG WARM VEG

Organic Cucumbers and Zucchini grown in Florida continue to be available from Lady Moon Farms. As always, the quality is superb. In late October, Organic Green Peppers, Jalapenos, and Eggplant will be added.

Currently, these products, along with **Organic Yellow Squash**, are sourced from North Carolina, where they are consistently available with excellent quality.

As an addition to the domestic supply, **Organic Yellow Squash**, **Cucumbers**, and **Zucchini** are produced in Mexico.



OG JOSIE'S CHOP SALADS

NOTE: It has been several weeks (9/14) now that we haven't had the **Josie's Organic Vegan Avocado Goddess Chop Salad** due to packaging delays.

Braga has now pushed the timeline back on when this product will be available due the master packs being on hold.

The other Josie's Organic Chop Salads are available and selling well.

CALIFORNIA GRAPE QUALITY





California has had a challenging **Grape** season due to damage from rain and humidity from Hurricane Hilary. But for the rest of October, there's a little positive news.



It's a great time to push **Grapes** with superior size, quality, and crunch, even though prices are still not promotable.

"Sweet Celebration" **Red Grapes** are in prime-time in the Jumbo and XL lines. "Scarlett Royal" are in the LG line.

Green Grapes are sizing big in all size lines with "Autumn Crisp" and "Green Envy."

The Grapery Specialty Grapes continue with Cotton Candy, Gum Drops, and Moon Drops. Import Cotton Candy Grapes from Brazil are also available with fantastic quality.







CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Raspberries continue to be promotable out of Mexico. Quality has been very nice, and as harvests remain plentiful. It's safe to promote for the next few weeks.

Strawberries continue to be a split market from older Northern California fruit and new crop Southern California/Central Mexico fruit. We're in mostly new crop fruit, and quality has looked great with nice big berries.

NOTE: Blackberry volume is limited out of Central Mexico. Rains really slowed down crops. Prices are increasing, and volume will be limited. There is a Hurricane forecasted to hit the region, which could cause significant damage as well.

ALERT! Blueberry volume remains limited. Arrivals continue to be sporadic and oversold before they arrive. Shippers aren't sure what is coming in on containers as growers just send what they can. Mexico is expected to start lightly, but expect supplies to remain tight and pricing high until closer to Thanksgiving.



CV FALL FRUIT

California **Pomegranates** are steady. More growers have fruit, and pricing is dropping.

POM Wonderful brand **Pomegranates** will be in stock for the season around 10/24.

POM-POM Pomegranate Arils from POM Wonderful will arrive from California around 10/20.

Fuyu Persimmons have started in California, and some single layer fruit available now! Fruit should steady now that the season is up and going. Hachiya Persimmons will be about a week later. Fuyu can be eaten when firm or soft, while Hachiya must ripen to soft before cutting.

Fresh **Cranberries** are in season! Four Seasons will offer both Ocean Spray brand and **LOCAL** Jersey Fruit brand.



CV APPLES

Apples are in peak season from PA and NY, plus Washington!

Pouch bag "Lil Snapper" kid-sized Apples are in stock from Stemilt with several varieties.

"Club/Premium varieties that are in stock include: Lady Glo, Lucy Rose, Rave, Rockit, Snap Dragon, SugarBee, and SweeTango. Plus..

Envy Apples will transition from imports to new crop Washington in October. Good supplies are expected.

New **Kissabel Apple** out of Washington will be available for mid-October. Check out this cool apple that comes with yellow or red skin, and red flesh. These will only be around for a few weeks get them while you can! For more info: KISSABEL®

Eastern **Macoun Apples** are in season. A good crop is expected.





CV POTATOES

Premium Bulk-for-Retail A, B, and C **Gold**, **Red**, and **White Potatoes** will make the transition up to Washington state grown product this week and the quality is just fantastic.

North Dakota Dole bag **Red** and **Gold Potatoes** are steady on price and a great value priced option. This product looks very nice pricing is locked in through the end of the year.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus prices will be increasing due to poor quality and low yields out of Mexico. We are having to rely on the Peruvian market, and everything is leading this direction for Thanksgiving as well.

Senora, Mexico is expected to start by early to mid-November, which may be too late for Thanksgiving.



CV CAULIFLOWER

Quebec **Cauliflower** has finished for the season. California was already expecting lighter supplies. Pricing jumped a good bit.

LOCAL New York and Pennsylvania Cauliflower harvests are feeling the impact of cooler temps, but are expecting beautiful product as the outcome later in October. Stay tuned!



CV LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL New Jersey has as slow start due to the cool temps, but anticipate to finish out October with Red Leaf, Green Leaf, Boston, and Romaine Lettuce.

The Quebec **Lettuce** season is coming to an end. Due to lower demand, California growers have a push of product.



CV SQUASH

GOOD NEWS! Zucchini and Yellow Squash will be promotable into at least the middle of October. Product is still going strong locally, Mexico, and starting out of the Carolinas and Georgia.

This is a HOT deal for stores looking for ad or just to promote on a spot buy.



CV PINEAPPLES

GOOD NEWS! Pineapples remain very promotable for the rest of October. Look to push and promote fruit.

Premium HoneyGlow and Golden Selection Pineapples will also be promotable.



CV CELERY

Better **Celery** supplies are available across all growers! Pricing will start to come down. It is still a little too early to tell availability and how the prices will be impacted for Thanksgiving.



CV CUCUMBERS

Cucumbers are rolling in from Georgia and North Carolina, but we will be transitioning to product out of Mexico by the end of October.



CV GUATEMALA VEG

ALERT! Civil unrest and protests in Guatemala are impacting in-country logistics are port operations. Expect out-of-stocks and pro-rates on **French Beans** and some other specialty import veg.





CV HASS AVOCADOS

Rain from Hurricane Lidia affected **Hass Avocado** harvests in Mexico, but supplies should still be steady. Expect a very small correction in price up after delayed harvests, but this should be back to normal soon.



CV ONIONS

Supplies are steady across the board on **Red**, **Yellow**, **and White Onions**. Good supplies are coming from Idaho, Washington, Nevada, and a couple other smaller growing regions. Quality is outstanding Across the board. Some premium Peri & Sons **Color Onions** will be available for mid-October out of Nevada. Product is expected to be nice.

The **Sweet Onion** market remains relatively unchanged with Peru being tight on Jumbo product, but readily available from other regions. There seems to be a split in the market as domestic growers try to figure out what their product is worth with the tighter Peruvian product.

We will see some 40lb Jumbo "Sweetie Sweets" hit the end of this week that will be a really great option for customers as this **Sweet Onion** is regarded as one of the best domestic sweet onion varieties grown in the US. Expect this market to creep up as we head closer to the holiday where demand will be very strong.



CV MANGOS

ALERT! Pricing on **Tommy Atkins Mangos** from Brazil will spike even further for the East Coast for the last two weeks of October. Overall, quality has been good.

Mango supplies are expected to be extremely short for the 4th quarter of the year.



CV MELONS

NOTE: Cantaloupes and Honeydews continue in predominantly large sizes, causing a shortage in smaller fruit. Cantaloupe supplies have tightened.

Expected timeline for transitions:

- California will be available until October 15.
- Mexico/Arizona from October 15 November 6
- Import fruit will be available for the rest of the year.

NOTE: Watermelons continue to be tight right now. Florida is forecasted to have rain in mid-October, slowing down and limiting production of their fall harvest. Mexico does have some volume coming in. Sizing is bigger as it's new fruit, and pricing is much higher due to freight.



CV TOMATOES

Vine Ripe and Roma Tomatoes are tightening up. We are pulling product from Mexico moving forward, looking for the best quality and price.



CV CITRUS

Star Ruby Grapefruit from Florida has started peaking on smaller fruit. Texas Rio's are expected to get started in mid-October, with real volume at the end of October. Big sized fruit will ramp up later.

Juice Oranges, Tangerines, and **Pummelos** are currently available from Florida.

Valencia Oranges will be available through October larger fruit.

NOTE: Import **Mandarins** will remain firmly priced for the month of October as supply has tightened. "Halos" continue to show top-notch quality during this import season.

Oranges have transitioned to "Midnights" from South Africa and Chile. California is expected to start new crop **Navel Oranges** on October 30th.

Lemons have now transitioned to District 3 in California, where crop is peaking rather small and Choice-grade to kick off D3.

Lime prices will remain elevated for the month of October. Stay away from promoting, and keep inventory fresh and turning.



APPLE CIDER

There will be good availability on Zeigler's Honeycrisp Apple Cider through December.

OTHER STORIES

- NOTE: Tomatillos and other Mexican crops have been affected by heavy rains in Mexico for the middle of October. Expect pricing to jump for the next few weeks as a result.
- Green Beans out of Georgia are expected to start by the middle of October, and should offer a bit of relief in the pricing. There will be a little Green Beans out of New Jersey, along with Georgia and Mexico.
- Green Peppers are rolling in from Georgia, but we will be transitioning to product out of Mexico by the end of October.
