# PEAK SEASON ORGANIC SWEETS & POTATOES



With true fall weather beginning to set into the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast, consumers will begin shifting their mindset towards baking and roasting recipes. At the same time, peak season is here for **Organic Sweet Potatoes** and **Organic Potatoes**. Time to expand those displays and prepare for the holidays!

California growers have only a few more weeks left to finish digging this year's **Organic Sweet Potato** crop. There is still a lot of product yet to come out of the ground but from what growers have seen going into storage during September and October, the quality has been outstanding, and we can expect a fantastic crop to promote.

All varieties of **Organic Sweet Potatoes** are now in peak supply and offer excellent promotional opportunities through January. With peak availability and holiday promotional pricing established, talk to your Four Seasons rep about planning opportunities.

Organic Red and Orange-skin, White, Japanese, and Stokes Purple Sweet Potato varieties are all in season, along with bags, microwaveable options, and mixed baby packs.

We will see the first arrival of Manitoba grown **Organic Red** and **Gold Potatoes** arrive later in October. Quality will be much improved from this new region, specifically on **Organic Red Potatoes** over what we have seen earlier in October. Pricing will also start to ease off with the start of Manitoba **Organic Color Potatoes**.

**Organic Russet Potatoes** are in steady supply from Wisconsin and Colorado. **Organic Baby Potatoes** (1-Bite Red, Gold, and Medley) are in peak season from California and selling very well!



# **OG FALL FRUIT**

**Organic Cranberries** are here with excellent supplies and quality. This is expected to continue right through the holidays.

**Organic Pomegranates** from California continue to be promotable for the end of October – available in 24-28ct size and 30-36ct.

**Organic Pomegranate Arils** from I LOVE POME-GRANATES will be available now through the winter season.

Organic Hachiya and Fuyu Persimmons are both in season and available! Both of these fall favorites will be available in limited quantities for late October.



# **OG APPLES**

The first of the season new crop Organic Envy Apples 27lb euro cases out of Washington have arrived. Steady supplies with excellent quality are expected. This adds to our specialty apple assortment that now includes Organic Lady Alice, Opal, Rockit, SugarBee, and SweeTango.

The first of the season new crop Washington **Organic Pink Lady Apples** have arrived with excellent quality and steady supplies are expected.

These fresh crop Organic Heirloom Apple varieties from Oregon are now available for the last week of October: Organic Arkansas Black, Golden Russett, and Northern Spy.



# OG BERRIES

**Organic Blueberry** supplies have ramped up out of Peru, Chile, and Argentina. Quality has been excellent with large tasty fruit and nice bloom.

NOTE: Organic Blackberries out of California have become extremely limited, and Mexico hasn't quite ramped up due to multiple rainstorms. Expect high prices, less than ideal quality, and sporadic gaps.

**NOTE:** Organic Raspberries are in firm supply with high prices. This is expected to continue right into the new year.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries are going into "off season" status. Expect high and rising prices, so-so quality, and sporadic gaps. California fruit is very light in the southern growing regions and Mexico volume will be very limited at the start of their season.



# **OG LETTUCE**

Organic Leaf and Romaine Lettuce supplies remain limited from California in late October with now no relief expected until transitioning South. Supplies from Québec will continue to have availability for early November, but the season will begin to winded down in early to mid-November.

Local Pennsylvania and New Jersey supplies are available in limited quantities to supplement California supplies.

NOTE: Organic Romaine Hearts and Organic Iceberg Lettuce also remain limited heading into November. Expect increased pricing because of limited California product, with limited local availability to supplement supplies.



# **OG LADY MOON WARM VEG**

Organic Eggplant and Organic Green Bell Pepper harvests have begun from Lady Moon Farms in Punta Gorda, Florida. Strong yields are expected as the season begins and will continue to grow in November. Stable supplies and pricing with top-notch quality is to be expected throughout the season.

**Organic Jalapeños** from Lady Moon Farms in Florida have also begun harvesting. Steady supplies are expected.



# **OG CELERY**

**Organic Celery** quality has remained outstanding. Supplies are expected to be even better in early to mid-November as Thanksgiving approaches.



# **OG CAULIFLOWER**

**Organic Cauliflower** volumes have remained steady from California, but late October will become challenging with supplies becoming limited and elevated pricing. Conditions will stay this way until the Yuma, AZ and El Centro, CA growing regions begin in mid-November.

Strong supply of Pennsylvania grown **Organic Cauliflower** is available for late October, including limited supply of unwrapped local **Organic Cauliflower** and **Colored Cauliflower**. Quality is outstanding.



## **OG PEPPERS**

**Organic Colored Bell Peppers** are in a transition period as most Canadian shippers prepare to finish their crop in early to mid-November. Both the Israel and Mexico seasons will begin to build supplies in late October as main volumes will shift to these growing regions.

**Organic Mini Mix Peppers** from Ohio and Pennsylvania are finished for the season. Supplies from Mexico will be available, but pricing will increase.



## **OG GREEN BEANS**

ALERT! Organic Green Beans are in limited supply for late October. Production for California is available but limited, and production from Mexico is only due to begin during the final week of October. Expect product from California, Mexico, and Florida in late October into early November. Pricing will be elevated.



# **OG CITRUS**

**Organic Lemons** markets are split with some cheap Mexican fruit pulling markets down and good supplies of excellent quality California fruit with good sizes out of both regions.

**Organic Grapefruit** is ramping up out of California, but smaller sizes are more prevalent. Mexico and additional California growing areas are expected to ramp up in November, and we will see prices come down with excellent quality.

OUTLOOK: We are expecting the first Mexican and California **Organic Navel Oranges** sometime the first two weeks of November, as well as some Mexican **Organic Juice Oranges**.



# **OG MELONS**

**Organic Cantaloupes** are now back in steady supply with new crop fruit from Mexico. Mostly 9ct will be available as we head into November, but sizing will then drop back to mostly 12ct. Quality has been very nice on our first arrival from Mexico.

**Organic Honeydews** are off to a slower start from Mexico. Expect better supplies heading into the last week of October.



#### OG ASPARAGUS

**Organic Asparagus** prices continue to ease off as harvest numbers increase. Quality from Argentina and Mexico has been excellent.

UPC packaged **Organic Asparagus** (code 228139) is back in stock for fall and winter.



#### OG BROCCOL

NOTE: Organic Broccoli supplies are back to reduced yields from California in late October. Price increases and less than ideal quality is to be expected as November beings. Supplemental volumes from Virginia and the Carolinas will be available beginning in late October, while limited Pennsylvania product continues to be available. Expect market conditions to remain unchanged until the Yuma, AZ and El Centro, CA season begin in mid-November.



# **OG SNACKING TOMATOES**

Organic Snacking Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms return here at the end of October, including Organic Grape and Cherry Tomatoes. Harvests have started on new Florida production and quality will be excellent.

Organic Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes will start harvests the last week of October. There will be limited amounts of Sungold Cherries and Golden Grape Tomatoes available as well.

**Organic Grape Tomato** prices will begin to ease off for late October as Florida production has started from other growers as well. Quality will look excellent.

- Local **Organic Sweet Onions** will continue to wind down in late October, marking the last arrival of the season. We will transition over to Nevada grown **Organic Sweet Onions** by early November and should have a seamless transition with no supply gaps.
- NOTE: Organic Kiwifruit from New Zealand will be in stock through the middle of November. Supplies are dwindling and delays at the ports has compounded the supply chain issues.



# **OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS**

**Organic Purple Brussels Sprouts** from Mexico are back in stock in October.

**Organic Brussels Sprouts** supplies from Mexico are expected to remain strong into November. Quality has been excellent on both 10lb and 25lb cases, however pricing is likely to elevated headed towards Thanksgiving. New York product will be available to supplement supplies.



# **OG TOMATOES**

NOTE: Organic Beefsteak Tomato prices are extremely short for late October. Mexico and Canada continue to struggle with supplies as new harvests are still not ready to come off the vines. Demand is extremely strong. New harvests are expected to start in early November.

**Organic Cluster Tomatoes** will be available from Mexico. Demand is strong but supplies are keeping up for now. Quality out has been nice. Canadian harvests are expected to begin in early November.

**Organic Heirloom Tomatoes** will be in a brief gap for the end of October. Demand is strong and supplies are very limited.

**NOTE: Organic Roma Tomatoes** are available, and prices are extremely high. Mexico is not producing strong numbers and demand continues to increase.

# **OTHER STORIES**

- Organic Cucumbers from Lady Moon Farms in Florida continue with steady availability in October, and supplies from the Carolinas, Georgia, and Florida are also available. Pricing remains stable and quality has been excellent for all growing regions. Mexican Organic Cucumbers will be available starting in early November.
- Organic Euro Seedless Cucumber prices will ease off as new harvests from Canada are starting in the end of October. Quality is expected to be excellent on new crop!



# **OG SQUASH**

**Organic Zucchini** production from Lady Moon Farms in Florida remains plentiful in late October. Strong volumes, promotable pricing, and excellent quality are expected to continue into November. Mexican supplies will become available in early November.

**Organic Yellow Squash** has decreased yields from the Carolinas in late October. With harvests from Mexico increasing, expect supplies to shift to this growing region with disruption of price.



# **OG TROPICALS**

**Organic Hass Avocado** supplies continue to be steady. Some growers were trying to bump pricing just a bit from early October when pricing fell very quickly. Overall costs should be steady for the end of October and allow for more reasonable price points.

Equal Exchange Fair-Trade Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico are in great supply! Pricing should continue to drop.

**Organic Royal Star Papayas** from Mexico will be promotable for the end of October. This flavorful papaya is quickly becoming a favorite as it is gaining popularity.

Organic Red/Magenta Dragon Fruit will be in limited supply from California. Yellow Organic Pitahaya Dragon Fruit will be available for a very short season for the end of October.

- Organic Mini Seedless Cucumber supplies are steady out of Canada and Mexico. Quality has been nice.
- Organic Keitt Mangos from California continue in season and should last into November. We will be offering a 12ct piece of fruit. Organic Ecuador fruit will be available in early November.
- Price increases are expected to be levied by Organic Mushroom growers headed into November due to the rise in costs.



# PA LOCAL BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER









**Stem Broccoli Bins** from Lancaster County, PA are available and looking really nice!

**Jacket Cauliflower** bins and cases are also being harvested through a co-op in Lancaster County and Howard, PA.

Now is the best time of the year to promote these products grown by Amish and Mennonite farmers. Both of these items are expected to be harvested through Thanksgiving, depending on weather.

California is back to being tight on **Broccoli Crown** supplies. Growers expect ups and downs in availability until transitioning to winter growing regions in mid-November.

Prices are holding steady since Mexico, PA, and GA growers are harvesting **Broccoli Crowns** with NC a few weeks out.

CA **Cello Cauliflower** demand is strong. Pricing holds on the higher end. Supplies look to be tighter until transition mid November.



## **CV BERRIES**

**Blueberries** are in excellent supply from Peru, Argentina, and Mexico heading into the last week of October. There could be outstanding promotional opportunities on all 12/1 pints and 12/6 oz clamshells beginning now and throughout the entire month of November. Quality has been excellent on all fruit.

ALERT! Strawberries will be in tighter supply as we head into November. Rain and cooler weather in the Santa Maria, CA area is causing supplies to drop, and Oxnard, CA does not have the additional supplies to cover the demand. Expect pricing to climb into the last week of October. Quality has been very nice as we've moved south into Oxnard, CA.

Raspberries and Blackberries have been sputtering in volume. Growers report out of Mexico that quality and volume is improving. Both berries could become more promotable in November.



# **CV CITRUS**

**Grapefruit** will be in good supply from California, and now Florida is ramping up for the season. Sizing is beginning to improve with more larger fruit, and the quality is excellent. Get ready to promote Florida Red Grapefruit!

Lemons are still in steady supply from District 3 in California, but there is still lots of import fruit around from Argentina and Chile. There will definitely be a spread in the market between domestic and import fruit, but right now we're mainly carrying all California fruit. Quality has been nice on all fancy and choice fruit.

**Limes** are in steady supply from Mexico as we head into November. We will have good supplies on all place pack 42's and 54's as well as bulk 175's and 200's. Quality has been very nice!

**Mandarins** continue to be in high demand with light volumes from Chile. California will begin harvesting during November with "Halos" start date around mid-November.



## **CV GRAPES**

**Grapes** are in steady supply from California, and the quality continues to be very nice. We will see pricing remain steady as we head into November, but we may start to see some pressure on the market depending on the number of imports at that time.

**Hobgoblin brand XL Grapes** will be available through the end of October for seasonal promotion!

New crop Peruvian imports will overlap the California crop, but we'll try to stay in domestic fruit as long as possible.

**Cotton Candy Grapes** are done out of California and will now transition to 10/1lb clamshells out of Brazil headed into November.



# **CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS**

**Brussels Sprouts** are in better availability and pricing is poised to drop.

**Stalk Brussels Sprouts** are now available for weekly pre-book through the holidays.

Now is the time to expand on the Ocean Mist "Steam & Serve" Brussels Sprouts line and net bag Brussels Sprouts.



# **CV LETTUCE**

**ALERT! Iceberg Lettuce** has become very limited in volume and prices have skyrocketed. Quality is poor even on the light yields being harvested. Cut back displays and keep your turns quick.

Some Lettuce growers from CA will transition to Huron at the end of October and the rest with transition to Yuma, AZ in early to mid-November. CA is starting to see cooler temps. Expect to see end of season quality out of CA across labels.

On a positive note, local New Jersey growers have started to harvest their fall crop of **Red Leaf**, **Green Leaf**, and **Romaine Lettuce** and expect strong numbers out of the fields to kick off the season.



# **CV SQUASH**

Green and Yellow Squash will be promotable out Mexico. Harvests came on strong for mid-October and quality is excellent. East coast production is much more limited, but it has to match pricing to stay competitive with flushing West Coast markets.



## **CV MELONS**

**Cantaloupes** and **Honeydews** have now started for the season out of Mexico, and we'll have good supplies rolling our way for the week of 10/25. As growers get into these new fields, sizing will be on the larger side with mostly 9ct on **Cantaloupes** and 4/5ct on **Honeydew**.

Looking forward, offshore **Cantaloupes** and **Honeydew** will begin mid-November from Guatemala.



# **CV CUCUMBERS**

**NOTE:** Super Select Cucumber prices are rising for late October. East coast production has been slowed down by cooler temps and rain. We will be switching to product from Mexico for the most part as quality is excellent and supplies are steady.

**Euro Seedless Cucumber** prices will ease off as new crops kick in from Canada and Mexico. Quality has been excellent.

Mini Seedless Cucumber prices will hold for late October. Prices are then expected to start easing off as new harvests start up from Mexico and Canada. Quality has been excellent.



# **CV HASS AVOCADOS**

Hass Avocados markets were stable in late October, with pricing seeming like it was trending up just a bit for the end of October. 48 and 60sz continue to be promotable. 40sz+ fruit remains very limited as we approach the end of October.



# **CV MANGOS**

**Ataulfo Honey Mangos** from Ecuador and Brazil will be available for the last week of October in 18ct. Fruit has been very nice in quality!

Mangos will be steady from Brazil. Fruit from Puerto Rico will be available into November in 6, 10, and 12ct sizing. The very first Ecuador fruit is also starting to make its way into the marketplace.



# **CV PEPPERS**

11lb **Red, Orange**, and **Yellow Pepper** prices will stay high for late October. Picks are very low from Mexico and Canada, keeping supplies very tight. Mexico is coming into better volume expect to see markets more promotable mid-November.

NOTE: Green Pepper prices are up for late October after the southern growing regions experienced some unfavorable weather. California production did start, and quality will be excellent. Sizing will be closer to XL to start.

**Asparagus** will be very promotable for late October as Mexico has come on strong. Quality has been excellent.



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# **CV KIWIFRUIT**

**Red Kiwifruit** will be available for the month of October in an 8/1lb clamshell.

NOTE: Kiwifruit from New Zealand has slowed down considerably. Port delays and extended amount of time on containers have caused some quality issues and some product to be lost. Zespri is expecting to have fruit until about the beginning or middle of November.

# **CV APPLES**

The first of the season new crop **Envy Apples** in 27lb euro cases out of Washington are now in season! Steady supplies with excellent quality are expected. This adds to our specialty selection of **Jazz, Rockit, Snap Dragon, SugarBee,** and **Swee-Tango Apples.** 

New crop PA **Stayman Apples** are expected the last week of October.

## **CV GREEN BEANS**

**Green Beans** jumped up for late October as East Coast harvests are slowing down due to cool temps and rainy weather. Most production is coming out of Georgia as Florida has not yet begun. Quality has been nice.



# **CV FALL FRUIT**

Fuyu and Hachiya Persimmons have started and will be available for the last week of October and should remain steady.

**Brown Turkey Figs** will be available in limited quantities for the last week of October.

**Quince** will be available once again from California in a 32-36ct single layer pack!

**Pomegranates** from California are in full swing! Quality has been excellent on the 36ct and 24ct 2-layer sizing!

Four Seasons will begin offering POM Wonderful label fruit in display bins and cartons beginning 10/22. Pricing will be steady through the season, with promotions built in along the way.

Pomegranate Arils will also be offered by POM Wonderful and will start a bit earlier than the whole pomegranates! These will be available for the entire season in a 4oz and 8oz cup!

• **Pineapples** started to see a slight rise from the rock bottom pricing we were experiencing in the beginning of October. They will still be very promotable through the end of the month.



# **CV FIELD TOMATOES**

**Grape Tomato** prices are easing off from Florida. Production is beginning to ramp up with better supplies and quality is excellent.

**ALERT! Roma Tomatoes** remain extremely short for late October from Mexico. There was a hurricane that hit the growing regions, but overall demand is stronger than supplies right now. Florida is expected to begin new harvests in early November.

NOTE: Vine Ripe Round Tomato prices continue to be strong for late October as well. Florida production did start in a limited capacity for late October on their Vine and Mature Greens. Mexico volume is still very light.



# CV HOTHOUSE TOMATOES

NOTE: Beefsteak Tomato supplies are extremely short, and demand is very strong. Demand is surpassing supplies as many greenhouses are still waiting for new crops to start up from USA and Canada. Prices are expected to stay strong heading into November as less acreage has been planted.

**Cluster Tomato** prices continue to increase for late October. New greenhouses are expected to harvest and be available for the last week of October. Quality has been excellent.

**Campari Tomatoes** will be available for late October from Mexico, but prices are rising as demand begins to pick up. Quality has been excellent.

# **OTHER STORIES**

•Green Cabbage remains promotable for late October from local PA, NY, and NJ farms. Quality has been excellent. Bok Choy, Baby Bok Choy, Red Cabbage, and Savoy Cabbage are also available from New Jersey with excellent quality.
• ALERT! Peeled Garlic has continued to be very tight due to container delays.

• Artichoke supplies are tightening, and prices are firming.
