ORGANIC APPLES WINTER UPDATE

Organic Apples show varied conditions across the category. Some varieties will inch up in price for the storage season while others are primed for promotion.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Envy Apples will be in excellent supply in January as they are featured in a major promotion and display contest here at Four Seasons!

One of the best-tasting **Organic Apples** available with premier texture is **Organic Sugar-Bee**. They're in steady supply and are a must-have for flavor-forward retailers.

Organic Lady Alice Apples are back in stock and provide a seasonal favorite for displays. **Organic Kanzie, Pazazz,** and **Opal Apples** are also in season with great flavor and texture.

Organic Honeycrisp Apples continue to pack out below estimates, creating a demand-exceeds-supply situation with firm markets. XL and Jumbo or lower-grade **Organic Honeycrips Apples** may pop up for promotional opportunities.



Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples are limited with firm markets, a trend expected to continue as much of the fruit moves into Controlled Atmosphere storage to make them last all year.

Organic EverCrisp Apples remain sporadic in supply during their first season, with continued intermittent availability expected until the season wraps.

Organic McIntosh Apples are expected to finish for the season by the new year.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries remain promotable out of Mexico with strong volume, excellent quality, and promotable pricing.

Organic Blueberries will remain stable out of Peru on shipper brands. Pricing will stay on the stronger side as supply decreases through the next few weeks heading into the new year, though quality continues to be excellent.

Organic Raspberries remain steady out of Mexico with consistent volume and good overall quality. **NOTE:** Driscoll's brand **Organic Raspberries** are limited and expensive.

NOTE: Organic Strawberry supplies are beginning to increase out of Baja, Mexico, and pricing will ease as volume builds. ALERT! Driscoll's remains very limited with short supplies.



OG GREENS & LETTUCES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Baby Bok Choy, Kales, and Collards abundant and promotable from Florida at Lady Moon Farms, where quality has been excellent.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Fennel is abundant from Lady Moon, offering clean bulbs and reliable sizing.

East Coast Organic Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and Romaine Lettuces are flush with beautiful quality and strong color from Lady Moon Farms in Florida.

Organic Romaine Hearts are steady overall, with limited quantities available from Lady Moon.

Organic Iceberg Lettuce weights and volume show major improvement as more desert fields open; pricing is easing into mid-month.

Organic Green, Red, and Rainbow Chards are abundant from out West, supported by strong new-crop desert region production.



OG TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Snacking Tomatoes continue to perform well with solid availability across Organic Grape, Cherry, and Medley programs from Florida at Lady Moon Farms. Quality is strong, and pricing sits in an average range with room for ads or displays.

Organic Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** are holding steady with consistent Canadian greenhouse volume and excellent color. Mexican supply is increasing as mid-December approaches, creating additional promotional opportunities. Overall conditions are expected to remain favorable with steady pricing.

Organic Roma Tomatoes are seeing improving supply volume with consistent sizing and strong quality out of Mexico. Costs remain slightly elevated, but movement is healthy and demand is steady, with price relief anticipated later in December.





OG MANGOS & PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Organic Pineapples are beginning to open up slightly for mid-December, with limited fruit available from Costa Rica and Mexico.

NOTE: Organic Mangos from Ecuador have been somewhat limited. Peru's season is beginning and fruit will be available in mid-December in limited volume. 7ct and 8ct are where mot of the volume is.



OG CELERY

ALERT! Organic Celery and **Celery Hearts** are extremely limited and <u>not</u> promotable as "blight" continues to spread quickly in California. Tight plantings and smaller, more frequent cuts offer limited relief, and blight can present even after the first harvest.

Pricing is very high and likely to remain that way until early January when desert volume is expected to improve availability. Fewer shippers are producing, and allocations are increasing.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cucumbers are in good supply and strong quality out of Mexico and are expected to remain promotable through mid-December.

Organic Mini Cucumbers and Euro Cucumbers are showing excellent quality from Canadian production, with Mexican supply increasing into mid-December. Prices remain within normal ranges, though costs on Organic Mini Cucumbers are expected to rise later in December as supply decreases.



OG KIWIFRUIT

Organic "Mammoth" Kiwifruit in clamshells from California will be available throughout December, and bulk **Green Kiwifruit** from Italy is also available.

Italian-grown **Organic SunGold Kiwifruit** from Zespri will be available in both clamshell and bulk formats starting in mid-December.



OG FALL FRUIT

Organic Pomegranates from California will be finished around mid-December.

Organic Pomegranate Arils remain in steady supply in a 4oz container under the I Love Pomegranate label.

Organic Hachiya Persimmons are winding down and are expected to finish their California season in early to mid-December. Organic Fuyu Persimmons will last a bit longer but will likely wrap up just before Christmas.



OG SPECIALTY FRUIT

Organic Feijoa, Passion Fruit, and Kiwano Horned Melons from California will be available through December.

Organic Starfruit, Eggfruit (Canistel), and Black Sapote from Florida will return to the marketplace for mid-December as well.

Green Skin Avocados from Florida will also be available for mid-December.



OG BABY ARUGULA

ALERT! Organic Baby Arugula Salad continue to suffer poor fill-rates and out-of-stocks due to field quality and yield problems into mid-December.



OG ASPARAGUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Asparagus is in good shape with lighter post-holiday demand and clean fields, making it promotable with reliable coverage and attractive costs compared to recent weeks.



OG GRAPES

New crop import **Organic Grapes** continue to show solid performance, despite high prices. **Organic Green Grapes** from Peru are arriving with strong quality, and **Organic Red Grapes** are expected to arrive to the East Coast 12/17.





OG PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Northwest Organic Pears are in good supply and quality, and will take center stage in January with a large display contest featuring Organic Anjou, Bosc, and Red Pears, accompanied by exciting gifts and prizes.



OG CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

Organic Cauliflower is in improving volume out of winter growing region out of California with more consistent pack outs.

NOTE: Organic Romanesco remains tight on quality concerns.

NOTE: Organic Broccoli, both bunched and crowns, is tightening as East Coast availability declines. Prices are rising as reliance increases on West-side desert supply beginning to open up.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Broccoli Rabe and Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli continue to show improving availability with droping prices.



OG CABBAGE

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green and Red Cabbages are abundant and promotable from Florida at Lady Moon Farms, where quality has been excellent.



OG ARTICHOKES

Organic Artichokes are back in good supply from Lakeside with dependable arrivals and represent a timely buy.



OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mandarins show excellent quality and strong supply out of California and are highly promotable.

Organic Navel Oranges continue to keep pace with demand as markets gradually ease, supported by excellent quality.

Organic Grapefruit supplies remain unstable with higher-than-normal markets, though conditions are expected to shift as more shippers enter new crop production heading into the holidays.

OG AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocados will be promotable for the month of December. Retailers are encouraged to capitalize on Four Seasons' 1st Annual Avocados from Mexico and Calavo Display Contest running throughout the month. All sizing will be in good supply.

OKE and Equal Exchange Fair Trade Organic fruit will be available in 48ct and 60ct for mid-December. The 48ct will be more limited, while the 60ct shows the majority of volume. 8/4ct Ready-Cycle Trays from Equal Exchange will also be available, offering promotional opportunities.

- GOOD NEWS! Organic Green Squash continues to ease in cost and is promotable out of Mexico.
- NOTE: Organic Bunch Carrots have tightened as some California shippers note issues with tops.
- NOTE: Organic Carrots, including Bags, Baby Peeled, and value-added have been tight but are improving. Allocations should continue to ease with stronger sizing and improved quality during December.

OTHER STORIES

- NOTE: Organic Scallions are showing a slight increase in cost, though well below the escalation seen in the conventional market.
- NOTE: Organic Bicolor Sweet Corn is finishing harvest in Florida and will conclude for the season in mid-December.
- NOTE: Organic French Beans 10/1 lb from Guatemala remain limited due to excessive rain and container delays. Orders should be kept conservative with expectations for intermittent shorts.
- NOTE: Organic Brown Turkey Figs from California are now finished for the season. While a small amount of fruit remains, the long transit to the East Coast results in inconsistent quality, so the program is effectively done.
- NOTE: Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons remain limited out of Mexico due to strong demand and cooler temperatures slowing harvest. As December progresses, new Mexican fields are expected to begin producing, improving supply consistency.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

DECEMBER 12 - DECEMBER 19, 2025

SUMO CITRUS SEASON BEGINS

One of the most exciting varietals to hit produce departments in recent years is **SUMO Citrus** (Dekopons). This jumbo seedless mandarin hybrid was originally cultivated in Japan and is known for it's exceptionally sweet taste, bump rind with a knob at the top that is easy to peel, and big flavor. Citrus fans look forward to this delectable variety more each year!

GOOD NEWS! The first SUMO Citrus of the new California season will be in stock on the East Coast around 12/16, with peak season running January through early April. Growers are reporting that this year's crop is looking good and has a large size profile. All 28ct and smaller fruit will be packed into bags. The larger fruit will be sold bulk. Four Seasons will be promoting 25ct in 18lb tray cases as well as 9/3lb high graphic bags.

A big **SUMO Citrus** promotion and display contest is being planned for Four Seasons Produce customers for early January stay tuned for more details!





CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Clementine Mandarins show topnotch quality out of California with even stronger supply. This is an excellent time to promote Mandarins.

GOOD NEWS! Import Mandarins are tradingin at deep discounts, especially on 36ct medium fruit.

Most shippers are up and running in limited volume on **Cara Cara Oranges** and markets are expected to ease slightly as the holiday approaches.

GOOD NEWS! "Vintage Sweets" Heirloom Navel Oranges back in eason on 10/3lb bags.

Recent rainfall is contributing to an increased supply of larger sized **Navel Oranges**. This is a strong opportunity to promote **Jumbo Navels** in bins, 8lb bags, and cartons.

Florida Citrus continues to show outstanding quality across Grapefruit, Juice Oranges, and Pummelos. These items offer excellent seasonal appeal and are worth featuring.

GOOD NEWS! Noble's premium, super-sweet, easy-to-peel, low-seed Autumn Honey Tanger-ine variety from Florida is in peak season for December. Quality and flavor are outstanding! Bulk and bags are available in high graphic boxes.





CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Strawberry supplies have increased rapidly out of Florida and Mexico, prompting sharp price reductions. Weather in Florida may temporarily slow production, but Mexico remains strong. Spot deals will appear before pricing stabilizes heading into Christmas.

Driscoll's Sweetest Batch Strawberries are available with exceptional quality and flavor.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries are promotable out of Mexico with strong volume, excellent quality, and continued high demand.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** are available again with exceptional flavor.

Blueberry supplies remain steady. Peruvian volume is declining while Mexican supply is increasing, supporting stable pricing and excellent quality.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** are tasting fantastic and selling well!

NOTE: Raspberries are tightening as production becomes sporadic, resulting in higher pricing and potential shortages.



CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Envy Apples from New York are available for the first time in bulk and pouch bags, supporting regional interest. Envy Apples from WAshington are promotable and in peak season!

GOOD NEWS! Eastern Ludacrisp Apples, a Honeycrisp offspring, is performing well with intense sweetness and juicy flesh.

Washington **Gala Apples** are packing under estimates with rising markets and potential packing gaps, creating pressure on eastern fruit as well.

Washington **Honeycrisp Apples** is also underpacking, resulting in firmer markets and occasional gaps.

Washington **Cosmic Crisp Apples** are in peak season. Markets are expected to remain stronger than anticipated with the new crop having more of the less desirable sizes and high demand.

Lucy Rose and **Lucy Glo Apples** will be in season through December and remain popular for their reddish flesh and sweet-tart flavor.

Eastern **Pink Lady Apples** are arriving with high color.





CV GRAPES

California **Red Grapes** continue to show strong supply on late season varieties, like "Scarlotta" and "Allisons," and more favorable pricing compared to the limited imported fruit. Import prices for December will remain stable but elevated across all colors and sizes.

Green Grapes are fully transitioned to new crop Peru with firm prices. XL will be "Sweet Globe" variety. Some "Atumn Crisp" Jumbos will be available approaching the holidays.



CV SPECIALTY GRAPES

Specialty Grapes are coming into season from South America. Here are some packs in stock for the rest of December:

CV CELERY

ALERT! Celery and Celery Hearts are limited as blight continues to impact California production. Availability is <u>not</u> promotable and pricing remains very high until early January when desert production is expected to offer relief. Fills remain week to week.



CV LETTUCE

Romaine Hearts show improved weights and consistent trims with declining costs.

Iceberg Lettuce volume and weights are strengthening as more desert fields open, and pricing is easing into mid-month.

Green, Red, and **Romaine Lettuces** are easing quickly in cost as desert acreage expands. Fills are clean and quality concerns are down.



CV VEG

GOOD NEWS! Eggplant, Green Peppers, Green Squash, and Yellow Squash are all trending down in price with good availability, with Green Squash particularly promotable.

Green Beans are in good supply, and market pricing continues to ease. Quality has been solid out of the Southeast.

NOTE: French Beans from Guatemala continue uneven arrivals due to weather and transportation variability.



CV KIWIFRUIT

Green Kiwifruit is available from Italy and Greece, and **Red Kiwifruit** in clamshells is available from California.

SunGold Kiwifruit from Zespri has returned with the Italian season underway in both clamshell and volume-filled options.



CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! Cauliflower is abundant out of California with a strong, uniform appearance and promotional potential.

GOOD NEWS! Broccoli Crowns and Bunched Broccoli are plentiful and competing with heavy Mexico volume, pushing East Coast pricing lower. Quality is excellent as Georgia winds down and Florida begins harvesting.

Broccoli Rabe availability continues to improve and prices easing with steady conditions expected.



CV PEPPERS

New **Hot Pepper** retail packs from Ark Foods include bagged **Jalapeños**, **Hot Pepper Medley**, and **Poblanos**.

Color Bell Peppers remain stable with strong color, wall thickness, and consistent pack outs from Mexico and remaining Canadian programs. Markets are steady with elevated but predictable costs and reliable availability. Choice Peppers remain limited.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

ALERT! Brussels Sprouts remain challenging despite slight quality improvements, and markets stay high until demand eases and new cuts improve grading consistency.

A Belgium grower has been added with excellent quality in 2/12.5-pound bags per case to supplement availability for the holidays.





CV PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Washington Pears are in excellent supply with most varieties packing above estimates. This is an ideal time to promote Anjou, Asian, Bartlett, Bosc, Comice, Forelle, Prism Tri-Color bags, Red Anjou, and Seckel for the holidays and into the New Year.



CV FALL FRUIT

California **Pomegranates** are finishing a shorter season, with POM Wonderful supply possibly falling slightly short for Christmas. Limited display bins are available.

POM Pomegranate Arils remain steady through December, including the new Twin Pack of two 8-ounce cups.

Black Mission Figs from Mexico are available in 12/8-ounce clamshells.

NOTE: Hachiya Persimmons will be increasingly limited as the California season winds down.

Fuyu Persimmons remain available a bit longer and should be merchandised with clear customer guidance: Fuyu can be eaten firm like an apple; Hachiya must be eaten extremely soft like jelly.

- NOTE: English Peas remain choppy and firm until field and container timing stabilizes. Snow Peas and Sugar Snap Peas remain tight from Guatemala and Peru, holding firm pricing as Peru winds down.
- NOTE: Carrots, including Bags, Baby Peeled, and value-added packs, have been limited but are improving as loading begins from Lake Park, Georgia to support Grimmway's programs, leading to stronger sizing, improved quality, and easing allocations.
- Boston and Artisan Lettuces are stabilizing with increased desert acreage, improving handling performance, and declining costs.



CV HASS AVOCADOS

Hass Avocados remain promotable for mid-December. The Happy Hass-i-days Display Contest with Avocados from Mexico and Calavo features strong pricing and attractive display materials.



CV MELONS

Mini Seedless Watermelons remain in good supply out of Guatemala with reasonable pricing and strong quality, supported by Mexico and Florida.

Seedless Watermelon prices are easing as Mexico and offshore supply improve, with Florida aligning at lower price levels.

NOTE: Offshore **Cantaloupe** and **Honeydew** continue to struggle with consistent supply due to earlier weather events and current vessel delays, keeping December markets elevated.



CV CHESTNUTS

Italian **Fresh Chestnuts** from Bella Vita are available in bulk 25-pound cases and premium 20/1lb jute bags with strong seasonal appeal and high-quality presentation.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Snacking Tomatoes, including Grape, Cherry, Medley, and Specialty packs remain well supplied from both field and greenhouse programs, supported by strong quality and favorable pricing for promotions.

Roma and Round Tomatoes are stabilizing after earlier volatility, with Mexico and Florida providing consistent volume. Quality remains strong, and pricing is holding at average levels with relief expected in the near future.

Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes pricing remains steady with solid quality. Canadian hothouse markets are currently average, with slightly firmer markets possible as the holiday approaches.

OTHER STORIES

- Fennel from California continues to build in volume with strong flavor and gently easing markets as desert production expands.
- ALERT! Scallion prices have moved significantly higher as supplies tighten out of Mexico, and iceless and bagged packs remain especially challenged.
- **Bicolor Corn** continues out of Florida with steady volume and may see minor price increases due to holiday freight conditions.
- Cherries from Chile are arriving by vessel with easing markets and steady supplies expected heading into the New Year. Peaches and Nectarines are expected to begin soon with limited and sporadic arrivals.

- NOTE: Lime prices are expected to gradually increase for the remainder of December.
- Mango arrivals remain sporadic on the East Coast due to container delays from Ecuador and Peru, though overall supply remains strong.
- GOOD NEWS! Artichokes are flush and highly promotable with consistent sizing and clean packs.
- Mini and Euro Seedless Cucumbers continue steady production and excellent quality from Canadian and Mexican greenhouses. Pricing is moderate and supply is meeting current demand, though costs are expected to rise in the coming weeks.

- Have key Christmas displays set by Dec 16 to maximize sales and labor efficiency.
- Bring in tonnage/items on Dec 16-20 deliveries.
- Stay ahead on potatoes, onions, dips—low shrink, but don't miss sales by running out.
- Keep bananas with good yellow color for fruit salads.
- From Wed. before Christmas, expect busy days—capture every sale.
- Use off-hour fills for hard goods (nuts, dried fruit, potatoes, onions) and longer shelf-life items (dressings, dips, salsa, hummus, juices, snacks).
- Daytime labor should focus on fresh displays and customer engagement.
- Expect large orders 12/21 and 12/23—plan ahead to avoid delays.
