LADY MOON ORGANIC FLORIDA GREENS



Organic Green, Red, and **Lacinato Kale** will be in excellent supply from Lady Moon Farms this week out of Florida. Weather has been ideal, and there's been really good size to the bunches arriving each week. Look for supplies to remain steady and promotable. Quality has been outstanding.

Organic Green Dandelion is in excellent supply right now, and Lady Moon is promoting. Growing conditions have been absolutely perfect, and this crop is beautiful.

Organic Romaine Lettuce will be in excellent supply this week as Lady Moon Farms will be promoting all 24 ct. The Florida **Organic Romaine Lettuce** has been beautiful all season.





OG BROCCOLI

14ct **Organic Broccoli** and **Organic Broccoli Crowns** has been in excellent supply so far for February. Growers from California, Arizona, and Mexico are all in full swing, causing market pricing to be at promotable levels. Quality has been beautiful on all **Organic Broccoli**.

But cold weather in the desert growing regions will slow harvests enough to push prices up a bit for mid-February.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Grape Tomatoes continue be promotable from Lady Moon Farms in Florida! Pricing from Mexico is lower, but quality is not as good. Organic On-the-Vine Cherry Tomatoes from Wholesum Organics are promotable!

Florida 2-Layer **Organic Round Tomatoes** are available in steady supply from Lady Moon Farms. Quality is excellent and will look for move volume this week.

Organic Roma Tomato Markets remain steady from Florida and Mexico. Quality is excellent from both areas right now. Continue to promote.

Quality is excellent on both **Organic Cluster** and **15lb Beefsteak Tomatoes** with steady pricing.

Organic Heirloom Tomato prices will begin to rise this week as the harvest flush from Covilli slows down. Product will remain available with excellent quality, just look for prices to move up.



OG BERRIES

Chilean Organic Blueberries are in excellent supply!

Driscoll's Organic Blueberries from Mexico are steady this week in 6 oz packs, with some great flavor and big size.

Organic Blackberries out of Mexico are in better supply this week. Expect Prices to start easing going into late February as weather improves.

Organic Strawberry supply continues to be firm but better supplies and quality are expected in late February. Stay tuned!

ALERT! Driscoll's **Organic Raspberry** supplies are expected to tighten up significantly before the flush comes a week or two after Valentine's Day.



OG GRAPES

South African **Organic Green Grapes** are available and will be very limited until the second week of March, when we will also see some **Organic Black Seeded** and **Seedless Grapes**.

Peruvian Organic Red Globe and Green Seedless Grapes are finished for the season.



OG MANGOS

Organic Kent Mangos have been in excellent quality. The fruit is bright and super clean, mostly green skin that's sweet and smooth. Fruit continues to be large! 8ct will be available next week, with 10 and 12ct sizing being more limited out of Peru.

Mexico has started with our first fruit coming in the way of **Organic Honey (Ataulfo) Mangos.** Supplies will "trickle in" over the course of the next few weeks before becoming more readily available.



OG HASS AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocados are in excellent supply for mid-February promotion. Supplies are good and pricing is advantageous due to shippers trying to move excess inventory from ramped up inventory for one of the biggest avocado weeks of the year!

Look to keep your displays stocked with great pricing available next week as well!



OG CHERIMOYA

Organic Cherimoya is available in very limited supplies. This is the first time we have been able to source **Organic Cherimoyas** in a long time! Be sure to grab a case if you can! The taste has been described as a mix of banana and pineapple, and has been a delicious tropical treat loaded with important vitamins!



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts will be in peak supply this week from Mexico. Look for excellent opportunities to promote 10 lb. Organic Brussels Sprouts. Quality has been nice.



OG LEMONS

Organic Lemons out of California continue in excellent supplies and quality with some promotional opportunities on 75 and 140ct fruit.

Organic Meyer Lemons continue in steady supply.



OG ZUCCHINI

Organic Zucchini is now in peak season from Mexico. Pricing has dropped significantly and now is the time to promote. We will have plenty of medium and fancy available all week.

Florida supplies are now finished until early March.



OG BROCCOLI RABE

Organic Broccoli Rabe from D'Arrigo will remain in good supply this week. There has been one small change on the bunched **Organic Broccoli Rabe** - it's now being packed as a 26ct / 12oz. bunch vs. the previous 20ct / 11b.



OG CAULIFLOWER

After promotable volumes in early February, **Organic Cauliflower** pricing is going up and volumes will decrease temporarily following some cold weather in the desert growing regions, especially in Arizona.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus markets are coming down, leading to promotable pricing. Quality is excellent coming from Mexico. Continue to promote!



OG SALADS

ALERT! Organic Salads took yet another setback in supplies with colder weather and rain causing more problems with the Organic Arugula crops. Expect pro-rates to continue for the next few weeks in all major organic lines.



OG ROMANESCO

Organic Romanesco is in excellent supply this week as multiple growers are all harvesting at the same time. We will have plenty of 12ct and 16ct, and the quality is excellent. Everything we have rolling is naked and not cello wrapped.



OG CITRUS

Beautiful **Organic Blood Oranges** continue to be in good supply - make sure to get this specialty citrus on your shelves!

California fresh crop **Organic Tango Mandarins** are available in both bulk and pouch bags. Product is expected to remain steady for the rest of February and into March.

California Organic Cara Cara Oranges, Navel Oranges, Pummelos, and Minneola Tangelos are all in good supply.

California **Organic Grapefruit** continues in excellent supply with promotional opportunities available.



OG CUCUMBERS

Supplies on **Organic Cucumbers** are finally improving after many weeks of short supply and high pricing. Look for pricing to drop quite a bit over the next couple weeks as we move back to promotable levels. Quality has been very nice on all Mexican **Organic Cucumbers**.

Organic Euro Seedless Cucumbers have started from our Canadian hothouse growers. Look for a switch into Canadian grown instead of Mexico as we try to source more locally.



OG APPLES

Washington Organic Autumn Glory, Braeburn, Envy, Fuji, Gala, Gold Delicious, Granny Smith, Jazz, Kanzi, Kiku, Lady Alice, Opal, Pacific Rose, Piñata, Pink Lady, and Red Delicious Apples are in steady supply with much higher prices as we continue in CA storage. Prices will continue to rise. Imports won't start until late spring.

Washington **Organic Honeycrisp Apples** are winding down for the season with some shippers completely finished. Expect to transition to euro 27lb. boxes in late February. Prices will rise until everyone finishes for the season.

OTHER STORIES

• Organic Celery supplies will continue to improve each week as we head forward. We now have much better supplies on all sleeve 24's and 30's, with plenty of Organic Celery Hearts. Look for pricing to slide slightly again this upcoming week.

• ALERT! Organic Lime supplies are going to have a short gap sometime this week. Hopefully we will have minimal disruption due to the Mexican Constitution Day and weather. Lighter color and smaller fruit should now be expected. • **Organic Pineapple** quality is excellent. Supplies have been steady, and we will continue to offer 6 and 8ct sizes.

• Supplies are steady **Organic** and **All-Natural Young Thai Coconuts.** Pricing has inched back up a bit due to the increased interest around the Lunar New Year.

• New crop **Organic Red Plums** out of New Zealand are available and eat great! Supplies will be very limited. • Organic Mini Watermelons continue to be available. Quality is excellent. Offer your customers a little taste of summer in these cold days, reminding them better weather is right around the corner!

• Washington Organic Red Anjou, Green Anjou, Bosc, and Comice Pears are in firmer supply as the end of the domestic season nears. Expect higher prices until imports begin in late February or early March.



WHY IS THERE A SHORTAGE OF EQUAL EXCHANGE BANANAS THIS WEEK?

Equal Exchange wants to provide our customers with relevant updates to make sure you are aware of any and all disruptions that may impact the small farmer supply chain that you support.

Last week, a <u>fire broke out</u> in the engine room of the ship carrying Equal Exchange bananas from Ecuador to Philadelphia. Fortunately, the fire was contained quickly; no one was hurt, nor was any cargo lost. Unfortunately, the arrival of EE bananas will be delayed as a new ship is rerouted to pick up the cargo currently positioned in Panama.

Delays like this one can disrupt the carefully planned delivery and ripening schedule that is an essential part of steady store delivery. We estimate that this delay will impact the timing and availability of Equal Exchange bananas for 1-2 weeks.

<u>What this means for Stores</u>: Stores will see shortages in Equal Exchange bananas through the first weeks of February, 2019. Please ask your Four Seasons representative for more details.

MARKET NEWS CONVENTIONAL OUTLOOK

JUMBO ARTICHOKE PROMOS

Now is the time to promote Artichokes!

Look for great deals on Ocean Mist Farms label Jumbo 12ct Artichokes through early March. Quality is outstanding.

Most will be free from frost discoloration, but the flavor on any "frost-kissed" artichokes is even better.

The crop is profiling large in the February and March growing region of the Coachella, CA area.

Big displays will drive big sales!





CV STRAWBERRIES

ALERT! Strawberries will be extremely tight this week as all growers from all growing areas have been prorating all orders due to weather. This shortage isn't coming at the best time, but cool weather and rain has really had an impact on yields and quality. Look for pricing to be higher through mid-February.

Late February should bring improved volumes and more affordable prices.



CV TOMATOES

Roma Tomato markets are rising up a bit as harvests begin to slow down. Look for a slight increase in pricing, however still very promotable. Quality remains excellent. 1 Ib pouch bags are available!

Grape Tomatoes remain very promotable. Growers continue to flush, leading to excellent pricing and great quality. Expect prices to remain weak. **Cherry Tomatoes** are also very promotable coming from Florida.

Round Tomato markets are holding steady from Mexico and Florida. Quality and pricing remain very promotable on 2-layers and 25lb bulk boxes.



CV HOTHOUSE TOMATOES

New crop **Cluster Tomatoes** will be available from Ohio greenhouses. Quality is excellent and price has come down, leading to very promotable quality.

Hothouse Beefsteak Tomatoes are also very promotable this week. Quality is outstanding and we will have both XL and XXL available. We will have a mix of both Canadian and Mexican product.

Campari Cocktail Tomatoes remain steady in pricing and volume.

The Premium NatureSweet line is fully available as well.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus prices are becoming promotable from Mexico. Quality has been excellent, and volumes are increasing. Look for 28lb cases to available here in mid to late-February.



CV LETTUCE

ALERT! Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and **Romaine Lettuces** are poised to go up in price in Yuma, AZ. On 2/7 there was a heavy frost. Issues with fringe burn, wind burn, and epidermal peeling persist with **Romaine Lettuce**.

Western **Cello Iceberg Lettuce** will also be impacted by heavy frost in Yuma, which will not benefit quality or availability.



CV MELONS

Demand has been light on **Cantaloupes**, and despite a light supply, prices have dropped to move some inventory.

The **Honeydew** market remains strong because of a very light supply.

CV BROCCOLI

Broccoli prices in Yuma and Mexico continue to strengthen. Quality remains excellent across the board.

Eastern **Broccoli Crowns** are not available, and bunched is extremely limited.



CV HASS AVOCADOS

After the Big Game, **Hass Avocado** pulls are predictably slow. Mexico has slowed production for this week in order to match demand and firm up prices.



CV POTATOES

The **Potato** market remains steady this week with promotions going on currently for Idaho Potato Lover's Month.

Red Potatoes continue to be in good supply and pricing remains steady on that item.

Locally grown King **White Potatoes** from PA will wind down and finish for the season this week. We will continue to see good supply on bagged **White Potatoes** out of NY at least into march.



CV PEPPERS

Colored Bell Pepper prices are a little stronger this week, but is still at promotable levels.

Green Pepper pricing is coming down some, but will remain relatively steady. Shippers in Nogales and Florida report outstanding quality.



CV GRAPES

The supply of Chilean **Grapes** is much better this week. Vendors are getting more fruit released from the ports and filling the pipeline. Prices are still very strong with most fruit being the high end extra-large and jumbo fruit. There is very little large sizes available for customers looking for a value box.



CV MANGOS

Red Mangos are very tight due to light volumes from Peru and take a late start to the Mexico crop.

Honey (Ataulfo) Mangos from Mexico have started harvesting in Mexico. The quality is adequate, as there is some staining and scarring. Color is nice and the fruit is maturing well.



CV CUCUMBERS

Super Select Cucumbers from Sonora and Sinaloa, Mexico are in decent supply.

Mini Seedless Cucumbers remain in lighter supply but new crop harvests are on their way soon. 12/6ct are expensive, but 12/11b pouches are a bit more affordable for February.



CV CELERY

The Oxnard **Celery** deal continues to be challenged by rain and cold weather. There are widespread issues with pitting and blight.

Yuma and Brawley, AZ have started but have minimal volume. Shippers report significantly better quality in the desert but supplies remain lighter than normal.



CV SWEET POTATOES

North Carolina **Sweet Potatoes** continue to see strong demand in the marketplace. Lower yields and pack outs cause the price to continue to rise here this week. Expect this price to continue to increase slowly headed into March.



CV CITRUS

A rainy late January has caused some occasional post-harvest quality issues on some recent arrivals of California **Navel Oranges.** Quality and volume is set to improve again for mid February. **"Vintage Sweet" Heirloom Navels** continue to sell very well - expect a slightly more intense flavor, good sweetness and juiciness.

SUMO Citrus Mandarins continue in peak season along with Cara Cara Oranges, Blood Oranges and Minneola Tangelos from California.



CV CAULIFLOWER

Cauliflower will go back up in price. Lighter supplies are expected in Yuma, AZ this week following their cold weather issues.



CV BLUEBERRIES

Blueberries will continue to be in a harvest flush for the rest of the month as Chilean growers continue to send lots of volume packed in pints. **Blueberries** will be a great item to promote for all of February.

Driscoll's **Blueberries** are in season from Mexico in 6 oz and pint packs. Excellent flavor!



CV ONIONS

Shippers out of Mexico will begin shipping their Yellow Onions this week. Pricing on this new crop Yellow Onion will be at a premium in comparison to storage Onions from the Pacific Northwest and other regions like Idaho.

White Onions out of Mexico are not expected to start to ship for another two weeks. Limited supply on White Onions and really caused this market to jump in recent weeks and that trend is expected to continue.



CV MANDARINS

"Halos" Mandarins are back! New crop California Mandarins are back in season with excellent quality and bigger flavor now that the Tango variety mandarins is being packed.

Beautiful **Stem & Leaf Tango Mandarins** are also in peak season.



CV RASPBERRIES & BLACKBERRIES

Raspberries and **Blackberries** are in steady supply from Mexico, and quality has been very nice.
