ORGANIC ZUCCHINI IN SEASON



Organic Zucchini continues to be in abundant supply out of Mexico as multiple shippers have strong volume being harvested in the fields.

The rest of February and early March are shaping up to be an excellent time to promote **Organic Zucchini.**

Quality has been very good. Expect prices to remain low throughout the next week.



OG CA MANDARINS

Organic Murcott Mandarins continue in both bald and pouch bags. The fruit is easy to peel and delicious.

Organic Petite Murcott Mandarin Gift Boxes will be available for March promotions.

Organic Tango Mandarins are now available in 12/2lb. mesh bags.

Organic Satsuma Mandarin supplies are winding down for the season.

Organic Gold Nuggets have just come into season and will become sweeter towards mid-March.

Organic Royal Mandarin Tangerines are in excellent supply this week but will finish soon. This variety is tangy and juicy.



OG TOMATOES

OG Round Tomatoes are in good supply out of FL & Mexico. Mexican shippers still holding firm to a higher price. Quality out of both regions is very nice.

OG Grape Tomatoes remain in steady supply out of FL and Mexico. Virginia may have some **Hothouse Organic Grape Tomatoes** next week

OG Cherry Tomatoes are in adequate supplies out of FL. Mexico is still on the limited side. **Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes** are in adequate supply out of FL.

OG Cluster Tomatoes are in good supply out of Mexico. Virginia may have some **Organic Clusters** next week.

OG Roma Tomatoes — from Mexico are abundantly supplied. This is a good time to promote.

OG Heirloom Tomatoes – steady supplies out of Mexico



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Supply continues to out-pace demand, leaving **Organic Broccoli** growers with little choice but to continue to discount to get movement. Product quality has been very good.

Organic Cauliflower supplies are steady, but later this week there may be an increase in volume. Quality has been good.

Organic Orange and **Purple Cauliflower** is in very tight supply.



OG GREEN BEANS

ALERT! Organic Green Beans are in tighter supply this week. Out of FL, shippers are expecting very light supplies, even for bagged operations (like Pero Organic).

CA and Mexico report very light supplies and high demand. Quality is described as good to very good.



OG CELERY

Organic Celery is in better supply now for the rest of February. Prices have come down and the quality is very good. Expect good supplies on all sizes, and on **Organic Celery Hearts** as well.



OG APPLES

All Washington **Organic Apples** remain extremely tight, with limited supplies and high prices. This is expected to continue until imports begin in the spring. Expect to see sporadic gaps in some varieties.

Import Organic Gala Apples are the first variety to arrive around the 3-4th week of March from South America.



OG LEMONS

Organic Meyer Lemons are beginning to firm as well with prices expected to rise over the next couple of weeks. Pouch bags are also back in.

California **Organic Lemon** supplies began shifting to tighter markets. Prices began rising and a trend to smaller fruit should be expected as growers move into their spring growing region.



OG GRAPEFRUIT

California **Organic Grapefruit** prices have shifted up with the end of the main winter growing region. Fruit will remain in season, but harvests will be less abundant.

Florida Organic Grapefruit supplies are gapping. We do expect to see more in a couple of weeks, but supplies will be very sporadic until the end of the season.



OG PEARS

The first Import Organic Bartlett Pears are expected to arrive next week from South America, pending port delays. Then the first Import Organic Red Bartlett Pears are expected to begin a week after that.

Washington **Organic Anjou** and **Bosc Pears** will finish for the season by early March.



OG GRAPES

South African **Organic Black Seeded Grapes** are expected to begin by the weekend. Expect excellent quality.

South African **Organic Green Grapes** are available but limited this week.



OG ROMANESCO

Organic Romanesco is in abundant supply out of CA. This is a good week to promote this specialty vegetable!



OG BERRIES

Organic Blueberries out of Chile are in promotable supply in both 4.4oz and 6oz packs.

Mexican **Organic Blackberry s**upplies continue to firm with prices on the rise.

Organic Strawberry and **Raspberry** prices are starting to improve in supply. Markets remain quite firm, but expect lower pricing as the pipeline fills up with product during March.



OG ONIONS

CA and NV growers are reporting better yields on **Organic Onions** than in weeks past, which will mean their **Organic Yellow**, **Red**, and **White Onion** crop will last longer than anticipated, at least through March.

Organic Yellow Onions are anticipated to wind down in about three weeks at which time we will transition to Washington and Canadian storage product.

OG ASPARAGUS

At this time it appears there is adequate **Organic Asparagus** supply out of CA and Mexico. Quality has been very good to excellent.

Some **Organic Asparagus Tips** are available. Expect supply to continue to be decent through March.



OG SWEET POTATOES

North Carolina **Organic Sweet Potatoes** are a lower cost alternative to **CA Organic Sweet Potatoes**. They are packed in 40lb bulk and 10/3lb bags (NEW ITEM 48721).

AV Thomas (Natural Beauty) California grown beautiful **Organic Sweet Potatoes** are in great supply and would be a good items to promote.

OG MANGOS

Peruvian Organic Mangos are in great supply. Expect fruit to be slightly less hard than their Tommy Atkins counterparts. Do not let this deter you from this fruit. The excellent flavor and creaminess more than make up for it.

Early season **Organic Ataulfo Mangos** from Mexico are in stock now! These should be in steady supply for the next few weeks. Round type **Organic Mangos** from Mexico are projected a few weeks earlier than normal this year and might overlap the Peruvian season a bit towards the end.



OG CA ORANGES

Organic Blood Oranges are in peak season quality and volume!

Full box **Organic Cara Cara Oranges** continue to have good flavor, a nice exterior, and a deep pink flesh. Supplies are steady.

Organic Navel Oranges are steady this week with some promotional opportunities available on larger fruit.

Organic Valencia Oranges have begun in a very limited way. Better supplies are expected over the next few weeks.



OG KALE

Organic Kale is in good supply out of CA and FL. Quality has been very good out of both regions, with darker color leaves coming out of CA from growers in Oxnard.

Organic Lacinato Kale is in good supply out of CA, while FL is more limited.

Organic Red Kale is in adequate supply out of CA but is limited from FL.

OTHER STORIES:

- Prices are taking some pretty big increases and smaller sizing will prevail.
- Organic Bunched Spinach is in good supply at this time. Quality is better this week over the last few weeks, with larger bunches now seen out of CA.
- Organic Butternut and Spaghetti Squash are dwindling in supply out of Mexico and CA. Organic Spaghetti Squash has more scarring than usual. Prices are steady. Organic Delicata and Green Acorn Squash

- ALERT! The Organic Lime supply has tightened. supplies are expected later this week.

- ALERT! Organic Baby Arugula and Baby Spinach will continue to be a struggle as mildew has been causing some quality and supply issues.
- **Organic Formosa Papayas** are projected to be in stock consistently over the next few months due to a strong partnership with the grower. Condition has been great!
- ALERT! Organic Ginger will be in tighter supply

for the next few weeks.

- Organic Brussels Sprouts continue in good supply out of Mexico and CA as multiple growers are reporting large harvests. Organic Microwaveable Brussels Sprouts are in good supply out of CA.

Organic Pineapples will be in better supply for next week. Quality has been excellent. Prices are trending lower.



STRAWBERRY SUPPLIES IMPROVE



Time to promote Florida Strawberries!

Volumes will be much better for the remainder of February and through mid-March out of Florida.

Pricing could vary substantially day-to-day based on quality and which grower has extra fruit to move, but throughout, **Strawberries** should continue to be promotable.

Premium Driscoll's brand **Strawberries** from Mexico and Oxnard, CA are coming down in price, but will not be nearly as cheap as shipper labels from Florida.



CV PINEAPPLES

Pineapple supplies continue to be light, but will slowly start to ramp up in early March and volumes will keep going up through the Easter ad period. Prices should remain where it is and possibly going up on the spot market the week before Easter.

The supply after Easter will drop off for the next two weeks as growers would have picked all the fruit that was ready to take care of the demand prior to the holiday. Price again will stay firm.



CV AVOCADOS

Mexican Hass Avocados are in excellent supply.

Large fruit (32/36/40ct) continues to be available and there are no shortages on any specific size. Affordable price points have kept **Hass Avocados** selling great even after the "Big Game."

Avocados from Mexico have a terrific taste profile. This satisfying flavor will increase over the next few months. Look for more information in coming weeks on "Avocados from Mexico" promotional programs like Fanwich and Fiesta del Fuego.



CV TOMATOES

Cluster Tomatoes will be lower in price this week as Mexican greenhouses hit peak volume.

Beef Tomatoes are leveling out in price as last week's abundance winds down. Quality is nice from Mexico.

Vine Ripe Two-layer and **25 lb. Tomatoes** are in good supply from Mexico.

Grape Tomato pricing is lower with better supply from Mexico and Florida.

Cherry Tomatoes remain limited due to virtually no field production in Florida. We're offering greenhouse grown product again this week.



CV ASPARAGUS

Promote **Asparagus** this week! Good supplies will continue from Mexico.



CV CAULIFLOWER

There seems to be a glut of supply in **Cauliflower** once again. Pricing is down this week with nice quality, allowing for more promotions.



CV ICEBERG LETTUCE

Supplies of **Iceberg Lettuce** are steady with steady pricing and nice quality.

CV SQUASH

Zucchini is abundant with nice quality and promotable supplies and pricing.

Yellow Squash supplies are more available with lower pricing this week.

Hard Squash is steady.



CV BROCCOLI

There continues to be good supply of bunched **Broccoli** and **Broccoli Crowns.** These are two items to promote again this week.



CV LETTUCE

Romaine Hearts, Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and Romaine Lettuces are in great supply with promotable volumes and aggressive pricing. Quality is nice from Yuma, AZ.



CV CUCUMBERS

The **Cucumber** market seems to be coming off the bottom, and pricing may be higher the second half of the week. Quality is nice from Mexico.

Cello Wrapped Cucumbers are limited from Mexico and Canada with higher pricing this week and nice quality.



CV PEPPERS

ALERT! Green Peppers are extremely tight with higher pricing this week. Supplies are short from Mexico.

15lb Red Peppers are limited with nice quality. 11lb Red, Yellow, and Orange Peppers are steady. Don't forget to try the new 9/4pk Red Peppers!

Mini Mixed Sweet Peppers are steady.



CV ONIONS

Onions, in all colors and sizes, have leveled off this week, but still remain in high demand and price.

Peruvian Sweet Onions will begin to wind down. We will see the first arrival of Mexican Sweet Onions this week. Availability on Mexican Onions has improved drastically this week causing pricing to become more advantageous than where the Peru Onions had been.



CV BERRIES

Keep promoting Blueberries for the rest of this month! Chilean volumes won't be winding down for another few weeks. We're now stocking both 6 oz. and 1 pint packs. Florida Blueberries will start towards the end of March.

Raspberry and Blackberry supplies will remain limited this week. Prices are also high.

CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

There is ample supply of promotable Brussels Sprouts from California. Quality is nice and pricing is down.

Please be sure to ask your sales rep for details on the new recipe clamshell pack!



CV MELONS

Cantaloupes from Central America will be promotable for late February and early March. We will be sourcing the extra dense and sweet Del Monte MAG variety for much of our supply.

Honeydews from Central America remain steady this week. Mexico will be bringing Honeydews in this week, helping ease the markets slightly.

CV IMPORT PEARS

Outlook for fresh crop Pears from South America:

Argentina & Chilean Bartlett Pears:

Available now in a light way, peak volume arriving mid to late March. Crop will be smaller.

Chilean Packham Pears:

Arriving in late March to supplement Bartlett demand, especially on bigger sizes.

Chilean Bosc Pears:

Arriving in mid-March. Storage crop Washington will be available too.

Chilean Forelle Pears:

Arriving in April.



CV IMPORT APPLES

Outlook for fresh crop Apples from South America:

Chilean Gala Apples:

Expected in mid-March. Crop sizing looks smaller than last year.

Chilean Granny Smith Apples:

Arrivals to US expected in late April or early May.

Chilean Cripps Pink Apples:

First arrivals expected in June.

Chilean Braeburn Apples:

First arrivals by late June to July.

Chilean Fuji Apples:

First arrivals by late June to July.



CV MANGOS

Mangos coming in from Peru are winding down, likely to finish in two weeks. Peak sizes on these are still 6-8 counts. Mexico is already underway with their new season with the Tommy Atkin variety along with Ataulfos. Both available in a full range of sizes.

Markets should remain firm for the next three to four weeks at which time the volume from Mexico hits full stride.
