PROMOTABLE ORGANIC ASPARAGUS FOR MARCH



GOOD NEWS! Organic Asparagus will be very promotable for the entire month of March with the Hippie Organics brand. Quality is outstanding, and availability will be steady.

The organic market is still crossing plenty of product which is different than conventional asparagus, so ads and in-store specials should catch consumer attention.

Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico will be promotable throughout March and into April! As many other vegetable commodities face supply issues, **Organic Brussels Sprouts** will add a great value for consumers with outstanding quality.

Look to add high graphic pre-packaged 1 lb **Organic Brussels Sprouts** bags from Hippie Organics to displays as an excellent "grab and go" option.



OG LETTUCES & GREENS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Greens, Lettuces, and Parsleys from Lady Moon Farms in Punta Gorda, FL are in peak volume and quality during March.

Promotional opportunities will be available across these commodities, like **Organic Kale**, **Collards**, **Romaine**, and more, to encourage strong additional sales.

Lady Moon's Florida **Organic Romaine Heart** program is going well and allowing East Coast retailers access to product that is fresher by days!

ALERT! Organic Dill quality issues will create a shortage of product throughout March. Anticipate a complete gap in availability for much of March.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberry prices will be promotable out of Baja, Mexico. Harvests are flushing, leading to the deal buy opportunities. Florida fruit remains available as well, but their flush has slowed down to a steadier pace for the most part. Quality has been exceptional from both regions.

Organic Raspberry prices continue to ease off as supplies get better out of Baja and Central Mexico. Quality has been very nice and they're eating very well. Look for more promotable opportunities towards the end of March.

Organic Blackberry prices are going up slightly as supplies naturally slow down. Quality has been good and the fruit is eating very well.

NOTE: Organic Blueberry prices are increasing as supplies remain tight. Low harvests out of Mexico and Peru this time of year keep supplies tight. Quality has been exceptional from Peru and Mexico.



OG CITRUS

Another round of snow and rains hit the California growing regions, and with all the wetness, it kept many growers from harvesting. That said, the overall crop continues to be in good shape and there will be **Organic Citrus** to promote for March and early April.

Organic Grapefruit, Lemons, Mandarins, Cara Cara Oranges, Blood Oranges, Pummelos, Minneola Tangelos, and Navel Oranges are in excellent supply. Now is the time to promote!

On the specialty side, Buck Brand **Organic TDE Mandarins** are in peak season for early to midMarch. This triple cross variety has Temple Tangor,
Dancy Mandarin, and Encore Mandarin parentage.

Organic TDE Mandarins are known for their rich sweet taste and juicy flesh - messy in the best way!

ALERT! Mexican **Organic Limes** continue to be challenging with very high prices.





OG ONIONS

Organic "Ever-Mild" Sweet Onions from Peri & Sons on both the bulk and bags will continue until mid-March, at which poiwnt we will transition over to new crop Mexican Organic Sweet Onions.

Organic Cippolinis from Peri & Sons will be available for early March but will then be done for the season until the fall growing season.



OG MANGOS

Larger sized 12-14ct **Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos** from Mexico will be steady. Smaller 16
and 18ct sizes have been limited but should soon rebound.

The beginning of March will mark the transition from **Kent Organic Mangos** from Peru and the start of the Mexican season. New crop **Organic Tommy Atkins Mangos** fruit from Mexico will be arriving the week of 3/6.



OG WARM VEG

Organic Cucumbers, Zucchini, and Yellow Squash costs from Mexico have begun to ease in early March. Steady availability, good quality, and improving prices should be expected.

Florida grown **Organic Green Bell Peppers** and **Eggplant** from Lady Moon Farms are in steady supply in early March. Anticipate stable costs and top-notch quality. Supply from Mexico will remain available on both commodities in March as a supplemental option.



OG POTATOES

Organic Red and **Gold Potatoes** from Manitoba, Canada have pushed up on price due to increased demand.

ALERT! Organic Russet Potatoes continue to be extremely tight nationwide while we prepare for supply gap shortage on Organic Russet Potatoes in mid-late March and early April until new growing regions begin their new crop.



OG PREMIUM VARIETY APPLES

Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples are sizing very large right now, and there are plenty of them. Make sure to take advantage of promotional opportunities now available in 27lb 2-layer Euro boxes.

Organic Opal and **SugarBee Apples** will finish for the season by mid-March. **Organic Pinata Apples** have finished for the season.



OG CABBAGE

Organic Green Cabbage is limited as St. Patrick's Day approaches. Although supply volume remains limited, there will be no shortages for the holiday favorite. Due to conditions, costs will not be at a promotional price point.



OG CELERY

NOTE: Organic Celery supply volume will begin to weaken in early March from the Imperial Valley of California. Costs will begin to increase with less production. Expect all of March and into April, potentially longer, to be difficult conditions for all commodities as growing regions conclude and transitions occur.



OG PEARS

New crop **Organic Red** and **Green Bartlett Pears** imports are now available in good supply.

Storage crop **Organic Pears** continue to wind down out of Washington and most varieties will be finished by the end of March with a smooth transition into imports.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes are still being imported for Peru, but the market is slowly correcting itself. We are seeing promotable pricing on Organic Greens, but Organic Reds will be tight for early March.

Organic Black Grapes from South Africa will be available in a limited way!





OG SWEET POTATOES

NEW! We received our first arrival of the Organic "Ben Yagi" Purple Sweet Potatoes in code 234694. Now is a great time to check out this new sweet potato variety with light purple flesh that has good moisture content.




OG TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Grape Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms will be a promotable through Easter. Quality has been great and there is plenty of product to grab.

Organic Darkloom and Heirloom Tomatoes out of Mexico will be steady and promotable into mid-March.

Organic Roma Tomato prices have fallen, and demand has dropped, which is keeping this a promotable item. Quality is outstanding, and availability will be steady. This is expected to hold until at least the middle of March.



- Organic Hass Avocado field prices continued to rise as we start March. Volume on fruit is down slightly especially on 48 size fruit and larger. Overall volume is still promotable and fruit quality and oil content has been excellent.
- Beautiful Organic Pitahaya/Yellow Dragon Fruit will continue to be promotable into March with small gaps in availability in between



OG GREENHOUSE CUCUMBERS

Organic Euro and Mini Seedless Cucumber prices have dropped and will be promotable in mid-March! Quality is great and new crop Canadian product has started.



OG PEPPERS

Organic Mini Mix Sweet Peppers in clamshells from Lady Moon Farms in Florida are in good supply with promotional pricing. Quality is outstanding and will be the perfect addition to any display to add a pop of color. 12/1lb pouch bag supply from Mexico will remain available in March as a supplemental option.

Organic Red, Yellow, and Orange Peppers from Mexico and Israel are in ok supply in March. Mexican volume has slowed in late February causing increased costs as March begins, while Israeli production remains steady in volume and costs. Quality from both regions remain strong.



OG PINEAPPLES

Organic Pineapple supplies from Costa Rica have been strong. Quality has been excellent. Organic Pineapples will be promotable for the start of March.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Organic Broccoli and Cauliflower supplies from the Imperial Valley of California will wind down throughout March as the desert season concludes and growers begin to transition North.

NOTE: Organic Broccoli costs will begin to increase in early March and will continue to rise as supply volume begins to dwindle.

ALERT! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli will remain limited in early to mid-March. Expect elevated costs and gaps in supply availability.

ALERT! Organic Cauliflower will remain limited as it has since mid-February. Costs will continue to increase as supply volume diminishes in early March.

OTHER STORIES

container shipments from Ecuador. This yellow skinned, white-fleshed fruit is commonly thought to be the sweetest of the dragon fruit varieties.

- · Organic Green Beans for Mexico remain in steady availability in early March, but volumes are plentiful. Anticipate strong quality and consistent product at an elevated cost for most of March.
- Supplies are steady on Organic Royal Star Papayas from Mexico. These Fair-Trade Papayas will be available to start the month of March. Quality has been excellent.
- NOTE: Organic Drink & Eat Coconuts and Young Thai Coconuts from Thailand will gap for the start of March. There should be steady supply of Young Thai Coconuts after the 2nd week of March.
- Organic Turmeric from our Hawaii growing partner Secret Beach Organics is back for the start of March.
- · Organic Pomegranate Arils in cups are now back in stock with some imported fruit.

- Cut halves and overwrap to show off the flesh of the fruit. Be sure to sticker on the back with "sample only" so consumers know that it is not for sale.
- Sampling is a super simple way to get fruit into a cart, so if you are in an area where sampling is allowed, it is a great use of time to gain sales.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

MARCH 3 - MARCH 10, 2023

MARCH IS FOR SUNKIST CITRUS



Navel Oranges are peaking on smaller fruit, but the current rain will change that trend for late March and April. This remains an excellent time to promote 10/4lb bagged Sunkist **Navel Oranges** and 88sz Fancy.

Blood Oranges have peak supply with quality is top notch. It's a great time to promote for the month of March!

Cara Cara Oranges are showing prime quality and peaking on smaller fruit, so this is a great time to promote bagged fruit.

Golden Nuggets (10/3lb) are in stock and peaking on Large/ Jumbo fruit. Look for **Pixie Tangerines** to start in mid-March.

Minneola Tangelos remain in solid supply with smaller fruit from the California Central Valley peaking, so it's a great time to promote bags. Large fruit remains on the sparse side, but we will remain covered for our Sunkist Contest!

Lemons continue to show marvelous quality out of the California Central Valley and California Coast Regions with prices remaining promotable and sizes peaking on 115s/140s and mainly choice fruit. Great time to promote!



CV CITRUS

Rain, Snow, and Wind in late February in California has caused some sizes to become tight as harvests are limited due to grove conditions. The weather should not hurt the crop as the rain will help with some growth.

Vintage Sweets Heirloom Navel Oranges continue with great flavor and quality. Jumbo 36sz Vintage Sweets will return in mid-March.

Halos Mandarins from CA are showing nice quality as we are pushing the Tango variety (24-28ct peaking). **Stem & Leaf Mandarins** are promotable through mid-March.

There are excellent deal prices on 10/3lb and 15/2lb "Nadorcott" variety **Mandarins** from Morocco through mid-March!

SUMO Citrus are peaking on 25ct. Quality has been outstanding with praiseworthy flavor!

Grapefruit is peaking heavy on smaller fruit as large fruit is getting tight out of both FL and TX. **Pummelos** will remain in-stock for early March, but in 18ct size as most shipper/growers are on the last picks of the season.

Honey Bells from FL are back in-stock in 80ct and 12/3 options.



CV GRAPES

Grapes are abundant and promotable with volumes from both Chile and Peru fighting for best price and quality. Chile is coming on to more proprietary varieties with a mix of traditional as Peru is strictly proprietary and on the later deal of this import season.

Red Grapes will be highly promotable through March going forward. We will continue to carry MD/LG, XL, and Jumbo sizes in both **Red** and **Green**.

Movement continues to be the name of the game, get super aggressive ads rolling for March, especially on MD/LG and LG sizing.

Additional offerings remain Cotton Candy (Imports), clamshells and bagged, Black Grapes and Red Globes!



CV BERRIES

Strawberry prices are expected to remain promotable for early March, just not as cheap and plentiful as we have seen the past few weeks. Quality out of Florida continues to be excellent. Rain/Snow weather events have all but stopped any California harvests that were starting. Florida and Mexico are beginning to move product to supply West Coast markets cleaning up their flush of fruit.

Raspberry prices are continuing to ease off as supplies continue to get better week after week. Quality has been excellent and eating very well. Supplies are expected to get better as the month continues out of Mexico.

Blackberry prices will be rising some as natural growing cycles begin to limit supplies. Quality has been excellent but expect supplies to tighten up.

NOTE: Blueberry prices continue to be high with very tight supplies. Mexico is expecting a gap on some farms continuing to limit availability. Quality however has been excellent and eating very well. Chilean imports are very light but still hanging around. Quality has been hit or miss all season.





CV CABBAGE

Cabbage prices are expected in stay steady shortterm but will increase as we head to St. Patrick's Day. Pricing is higher than last year. It is anticipated that there is 25% less acreage planted and some of the deep freezes that growers have had this year will cause some crop damage for the holiday.

Four Seasons is locked in and ready for the holiday with volume at this time out of Florida and there will also be product in Georgia and Carolinas starting up mid-March.



CV MANGOS

14ct "Champagne" brand Ataulfo Honey Mangos are beginning their season and will be in stock starting 3/6.

The **Mango** season will finish with the great eating Kent variety in 9 and 10ct sizing. Mexico will also be starting and we will transition right into some Tommy Atkins fruit from there.



CV ASPARAGUS

NOTE: Asparagus prices continue to be elevated. There are still two cold snaps expected to hit Mexico which could hold this pricing into mid-March before the volumes ramp back up.

Shippers will not be packing 28lb during this time and will only be packing 11lb for what small amount does cross. This will switch back to 28lb cases once volume picks back up. We are expecting volume and 28lb cases to be back by end of March and in time for Easter. Quality is outstanding for what is crossing.



CV MELONS

Melon supplies remain limited, but we are approaching real volume to bring this market to more profitable prices. Same story as well in both 5's and 6's! New plantings from Guatemala, Honduras, and Costa Rica are showing excellent yields for spring selling in the US.

We will continue to carry **Dino Melons**, **MAGS**, and **Galia Melons** while available.



CV BROCCOLI

Broccoli Crowns prices bumped higher. Expect reasonable but slightly increased pricing the first half of March.

ALERT! Sweet Baby Broccoli is extremely limited and quality has been a struggle. Expect gaps with inventory.



CV PEARS

Washington storage **Bartlett Pears** are winding down fast and will finish for the season by the end of March. Supplies will transition into new crop **Bartlett Pears** from South America in the spring.

Comice Pears are expected to finish for the season by mid-March.



CV GREEN BEANS

GOOD NEWS! Green Bean prices really fell off and are very promotable. The warmer weather that has hit Florida brought on a lot of beans very fast. Quality has been excellent out of Florida and availability is steady at this time.



CV CAULIFLOWER

ALERT! Limited supplies and higher pricing continue for **Cauliflower** as we kick of the month of March. This will be a tough commodity for the next few weeks.



CV PREMIUM BULK POTATOES

Supplies have made the transition over to new crop Florida grown Red, Gold, and White Potatoes. White Potatoes continue to be limited while Gold and Red Potatoes have been more plentiful this week.





CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Brussels Sprouts remain one of the few wet veg items that is staying consistent in pricing and promotable.



CV FUJI APPLES

Washington **Fuji Apples** are in excellent supply. Look for promotional opportunities for the month of March!



CV ARTICHOKES

GOOD NEWS! 12ct Jumbo Artichokes remain promotable through St. Patrick's Day!



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Roma Tomato prices are at the minimum out of Mexico. This is usually a sign that Rounds/Vine Ripes will follow this trend. There is product out of Mexico and Florida, and quality is fantastic.

GOOD NEWS! Vine Ripe Tomato prices have dropped and will be promotable into the middle of March. Smaller size tomatoes are still pricing at a premium since there is not a lot of smaller size around.

Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomato** prices will remain steady. Quality has been excellent, and supplies are steady.

Heirloom Tomatoes out of Mexico will remain steady and promotable as we head into the end of March.



CV IMPORT STONE FRUIT

Peaches, and especially **Nectarines**, continue in excellent promotional supply and great quality, and are expected to continue this way for the whole month of March. **Donut Peaches** are now available.

Black Plums, while tighter in supply, are currently available and except for a small gap here and there between arrivals should remain this way for the month of March.

Dapple Pluots will be in and out of supply for March.

Lemon Plums have come and gone for the import season.

Cherries will finish for the season in early March. Then, we will gap until California begins around the first week of May. Early predictions are pointing mid-May to mid-June being in excellent supply to promote, of course this is barring any major weather events between now and then.



CV PEPPERS

11lb Hothouse Red, Orange, and Yellow Bell Pepper prices have increased across the board. Mexico is in a gap on all three colors and Canada will not start until mid-March. Canada and Mexico will start to ramp up again about the same time causing some very promotable pricing. We continue to carry XL /jumbo size Peppers.
