ORGANIC GINGER, TURMERIC, & GARLIC OUTLOOK



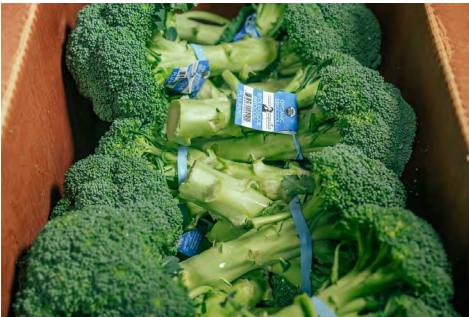
Organic Ginger from our primary grower/packer La Grama (and their Ipoki brand) is currently in steady supply thanks to a great partnership. La Grama goes beyond Organic and supports growers and farmers with Fair Trade and more.

2023 has been a challenging year for La Grama and their growers starting with some political and social protests which affected exportation of many different produce commodities, including **Organic Ginger**. Another challenge this season in Peru has been weather. The rainy season has been stronger than usual, and cyclone Yaku is passing through the coast of Peru. The scope of damage that this storm has yet to be realized.

Overall **Organic Ginger** supply has been tight over the past month. Peru, Honduras and China are all harvesting below "normal" levels right now. Peru **Organic Ginger** is short as their season is coming to an end (by the end of April Peru will be finished until new crop arrivals in June). Honduras has another month to go on shipping and it is now in their end of season phase.

Organic Turmeric from our growing partner Secret Beach Organics in Hawaii is back for the start of March. Four Seasons will offer full 30lb cases and 5lb smaller cases for added convenience.

Fresh **Organic Garlic** supplies are good from Argentina, and the quality is excellent. It is a good time to promote Easter/Passover ads for loose **Garlic**. There is adequate supply of Argentina **Organic Garlic** to cover until the new crop Mexico is ready in late May.



OG VEG IMPACTS

GOOD NEWS (SHORT TERM): The conclusion of the desert season is approaching in the Imperial Valley on the West Coast. Supply volume has steadily declined, while cost have increased throughout March. During the final weeks of the season suppliers will try to harvest as much product as possible while weather permits.

As a result of all that rushed picking to end the season, a glut of product will enter the marketplace and drive decreased costs on commodities such as **Organic Broccoli, Cauliflower, and Celery for late March and the first week of April**. Promotions are encouraged during this time as transition North to the Salinas will prove to be difficult.

ALERT! (LONG TERM): As a result of continual rain events in the Central and Northern veg growing regions of California product availability will be scarce, and cost will be significantly increased potentially starting around Easter and all the way into June.



OG MANGOS

The 2023 new crop Mexican **Organic Mango** season is off and running. Fruit supply is still not quite in full swing and high demand has also kept pricing higher. That said, don't shy away from promotion.

Organic Altaulfo Mangos will be in good and steady supply for the end of March! Look to promote this creamy sweet tart fruit!

An 8/6ct "Club Pack" will be available from Crespo Organic. The 6ct (9 sz) Club Box is meant to sell as a whole "mini case" on **Organic Round Mangos** to the end consumer. This will give customers the opportunity to buy in bulk and drive more volume in sales!



OG CITRUS

Wet weather in California continues to be the problem on the citrus front, with record breaking rains and flooding picking, packing and shipping **Organic Citrus** is extremely challenging.

But despite the rain, we are in good supply on **Organic Grapefruit, Lemons, Mandarins, Blood Oranges, Cara Caras and Navels** through the end of March. The start of April could be a little more challenging until we break through the rain and get back into regular supplies through the summer.

Organic Minneolas will wrap up for the season through the end of March.

Organic Buck Brand TDE will also wrap up for the season over the start of April.



OG LETTUCE

NOTE: **Organic Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** supply volumes will be limited in late March. Lady Moon Farms Florida crop is beginning to wind down as they prepare to transition to Georgia. On the West Coast, the transition out of the Southern desert growing regions has begun. Expect increased prices in April and May from the rains.

NOTE: **Organic Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Lettuce** from California is expected to have limited supplies in late March and early April due to transition. East Coast production on **Organic Romaine Hearts** from Lady Moon have been outstanding, unfortunately they will be gapping in late March and early April.



OG BOK CHOY

ALERT! **Organic Bok Choy** and **Baby Bok Choy** will remain limited to conclude March. Transitional period on both the East Coast and the West Coast is the reason for the shortages. As Lady Moon Farms begins to transition from Florida to Georgia availability should increase in early April. Meanwhile the desert season concludes in the Imperial Valley out West, and shippers will begin to transition North in California. Expect supply volume to stabilize by mid-April.



OG EGGPLANT

Organic Eggplant grown by Lady Moon Farms in Florida continue to yield strong volumes as March concludes. Nice quality and promotional opportunities will be available into early April.



OG GREEN BEANS & BRUSSELS

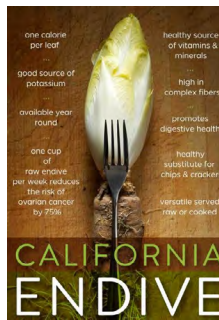
GOOD NEWS! **Organic Brussels Sprouts** from Mexico continue to experience a flush of production during March. Expect excellent quality and promotable pricing through the Easter holiday. Include high-graphic 1lb pre-packaged bags to displays for a "grab and go" option that is sure to catch consumers attention.

Organic Green Beans from Mexico are beginning to yield consistently stronger volumes in late March. Expect steady availability and excellent quality to conclude March and begin April as



OG PEARS

New crop import **Organic Abate, Bartlett** and **Red Bartlett Pears** are in excellent supply. Washington is still supplying us with good storage crop supplies of **Organic Green** and **Red Anjou**, and **Bosc Pears**.



OG ENDIVE

NOTE: There is a product gap on the tray packs of **Organic Endive** as the sizing is too big to fit the packs right now.

In the meantime we are switching to the 10lb bulk **Organic Endive** from California Endive Farms.



OG SQUASH & CUCUMBERS

Florida grown **Organic Zucchini** from Lady Moon Farms has resumed harvest for their Spring season. Quality has been outstanding so far and volumes will quickly grow as April approaches.

NOTE: **Organic Yellow Squash** has remained limited as April is approaching. Expect pricing conditions of limited supply and elevated costs to continue.

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Euro Cucumbers** and **Mini Cucumbers** have fallen off and will be promotable right into April. Quality is great and new



OG WATERMELONS

Organic Seedless Watermelons are scheduled to start in Mexico Mid-April. There may be limited supplies early April, but they will be very light until mid to late April.

There are some limited amounts of **Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons** available.



OG GRAPES

NOTE: Import **Organic Grapes** have gotten very tight with the pricing surging back to beginning of season prices. We will remain in stock on **Organic Green Grapes** while **Organic Red Grapes** will be limited for the end of March. Look for **Organic Red Grapes** to open up more starting in April.



OG GREEN PEPPERS

Organic Green Bell Peppers grown by Lady Moon Farms in Florida will conclude for the season during the final week of March.

Supply will be limited in early to mid-April but will be available from Mexico and Canada. Expect prices to increase.



OG PURPLE BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Purple Brussels Sprouts are back in season from Covilli Fair-Trade Organic out of Mexico.



OG AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocado pricing was steady for the second week in a row and should remain steady through the end of March. Some fruit harvested right now may exhibit some darker black color, while remaining hard to firm. This fruit especially, should have the excellent oil content that make Mexico avocados so creamy and taste so good!

Equal Exchange Fair Trade **Organic Avocados** will be in fair to good supply. 60 ct fruit Equal Exchange fruit has been tight.



OG TOMATOES

East Coast **Organic Grape Tomatoes** from Lady Moon Farms will be a promotable through Easter. Quality has been great and there is plenty of product to grab.

Organic Heirloom Tomatoes out of Mexico will be steady and promotable into April.

We also have **Organic Darklooms** from Covilli available, but we are seeing some concerns with product coloring up due to weather in Mexico so **Darklooms** have been hit or miss depending on when they can pick.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus will be promotable right through Easter from our partners with Alpine and the Hippiie Organics label.

Quality is outstanding, and availability will be steady.

NOTE: After Easter this pricing will increase as fields will be finishing up out of Caborca, Mexico.



OG BERRIES

Organic Raspberry pricing continues to ease off as supplies are forecasted to ramp up. Quality has looked excellent and as more supplies come on this looks to be a "Safe Berry" to promote for the Easter Holiday.

NOTE: **Organic Blackberry** prices are higher as crops continue to transition. Old fields are closing as new fields are not quite ready to harvest strong numbers. Followed by a few rainy days limiting harvests.

ALERT! **Organic Blueberries** are very tight overall from all regions. Domestic production should start mid to late April, but it will remain very limited until then. Mexico has very little supplies coming in as does California. Supplies are extremely limited so expect possible pro-rates and limits throughout April.

NOTE: **Organic Strawberry** prices are going to rise as Baja and California growers are now a bit delayed due to the recent weather patterns. Quality has been nice overall, and supplies remain steady out of Baja, California. The transition won't fully happen until mid to late April. At that time we'll see how the recent California rains and floods have affected the crops.

OTHER STORIES

ALERT! **Organic Red Bunched Beets** remain limited in availability during March. Availability constraints are expected to remain an issue until at least mid-April.

Organic Greens and **Kale** will begin transitioning from Florida to Georgia in late March for Lady Moon Farms. Expect a smooth transition with little to no drop in volume and continued excellent quality.

Planning Tips

- **Plan out your ordering and delivery timelines with your rep.** See next page for the Four Seasons Easter schedule.
- **If you are not waiting on trucks and have the product on hand, your department operations will run as smoothly and efficiently as possible.** Your time will be more productive working on the sales floor, engaging with your customers.
- **If you bring in your holiday tonnage items early,** it will take enough pressure off of our warehouse selectors and loaders and trucks to help minimize late deliveries on those crucial last few days before the holiday weekend. This will help your department's efficiency and organization.
- **Order holiday semi-perishable and hard tonnage items early.** Plan on getting your tonnage items into your stores by the Tuesday before Easter.
- **Develop an off-hour or evening fill schedule for your hard goods.**
- **Stay ahead with tomato and banana color on hand** in order to have ready-to-eat, mature fruit on display. Consumers will want to consume this product immediately.
- **Easter business can come late. Historically, Friday and Saturday are busy days.**

PASSOVER WILL BEGIN AT SUNDOWN ON APRIL 5TH AND CONTINUE THROUGH APRIL 13TH.

*****Foods consumed during this period should be Kosher.***

IMPORTANT PASSOVER HOLIDAY ITEMS:

Bitter Herbs are very important for the **Seder Plate** - Horseradish, Dill, Endive, Escarole, Romaine Lettuce, Leeks, Onions, Ginger, and Soup Mix.

Book orders now for 50lb Horseradish, 25 lb Turnips, Beets & Parsnips, Full Case Dill, Root Parsley & Leeks.

PROMOTABLE TOMATOES FOR SPRING

Rainbow Medley Snacking Tomatoes are abundant and promotable for late March and early April! Ask your rep about spot buy deals on various pack options! These colorful **Mini Mix Tomatoes** can add a pop of Spring color to your department and to shoppers' salads and pastas!

"Naturesweet" premium branded **Tomatoes** are in great supply across their assortment. Spring will be a good time to get behind this great selling line.

Heirloom Tomatoes out of Mexico will remain steady and promotable along with new crop Hothouse Canadian flushing again. This will be promotable as we head into April.

Hothouse Tomato On-the-Vine and **Beefsteak Tomato** pricing is easing off. New crop greenhouse fruit is starting out of New York and Canada. This market will be promotable into April. Quality has been excellent and there is still product out of Mexico, Canada, and US (Ohio and New York).

Round Tomato prices will remain steady into April and be promotable. We will continue with 2-layer 4x4 and 4x5 **Vine Ripe Tomatoes** out of Mexico but will start transitioning our 25 lb **Jumbo Vine Ripe** packs to new crop product out of Florida for the beginning of April. Quality will be excellent from both regions.

Roma Tomato pricing has been steady with product out of Mexico. There is product out of Mexico and Florida and quality is fantastic.



CV BERRIES

Raspberry pricing remains promotable out of Mexico. Crops continue to come in and quality has been excellent. This is probably the safest berry to promote heading into Easter.

Blackberry pricing remains steady out of Mexico.

ALERT! Blueberries are extremely tight and priced very high. Supplies are super short from all regions. In early April domestic production should start to help supplies.

ALERT! Strawberry prices have been very active. Florida fruit is still coming in; however, the plants are tired, and it's been hot leading to bruising. Our last Florida load has arrived and sold out and then we will move into all California products.

California **Strawberries** are short, and pricing is much higher! Quality has looked decent, and sizing is big. Total damage from all the California rains is yet to be determined, but just keep in mind there will be challenges possibly all spring and summer this year due to flooding out there.



CV ASPARAGUS

GOOD NEWS! Asparagus will be very promotable for the end of March and the first few days of April. The best price points will be on the **Small/Pencil gauge Asparagus**.

Then with increasing demand for Easter and fields finishing in Caborca, Mexico, we can expect prices to go right back up before Easter.

11 lb and 28 lb cases of **Asparagus** are available and there are opportunities on Small/Pencil, Standard, and Large gauged-sizings. Quality is outstanding for what is crossing.

Local **Asparagus** out of Delaware or New Jersey is expected to start around April 15th with peak season arriving through the month of May.



CV GRAPES

Grapes continue to flush the market with promotable pricing on both Chile and Peru fruit. The bulk of Chile has landed on the East Coast allowing spot buys.

Red and Green Seedless Grapes will be highly promotable through March. This pricing will firm up quickly as we head deeper into April with Greens leading the way up.

Additional offerings remain with **Cotton Candy, Bi-Color Packs, Black Grapes, Red Candy Snap and Globes!**

It is highly encouraged to promote **Red Grapes**, especially for the remainder of March and take advantage of this pricing while it's HOT!



CV CANTALoupES

Cantaloupe supply from Central America is in great shape and quality has been outstanding on the newer plantings.

12ct **Cantaloupes** are very promotable for April, including on Del Monte MAGnificent Melons. Mexico and Texas will start beginning of May.

Florida "Athenas" style and Bin **Cantaloupes** are said to start beginning of April just in time for Easter on 120-150ct!



CV MANGOS

GOOD NEWS! Ciruli Brothers "Champagne" **Altaulfos Mangos** will be steady for March and promotable for April on 14cts. 18ct shipper brand **Altaulfos Honey Mangos** will be in stock for a value-play.

Round Mangos continued to demand a premium price. Import volume plus the new crop Mexico "Tommy Atkins" just cannot keep up with high demand in the marketplace. Expect pricing to be higher through March and expect 10/12 ct size fruit to be very tight.



CV VIDALIA ONIONS

The official start date of **Vidalia Sweet Onions** has been announced with an April 17th pack/ship date by the Georgia Department of Agriculture.

We will see the first arrivals of **Vidalias** be in stock around 4/19 or 4/20. There should be a smooth transition into the Vidalia Sweet Onion season with ample supplies available out of Peru/Mexico/Texas leading up to Georgia harvest.



CV POMEGRANATES

Import **Pomegranate** supplies will be very tight until the end of March until the Chilean season begins for April selling.

Imported **Pomegranate Arils** will be available in the popular "I Love Pomegranates" label for March and April.



CV KIWI

We are approaching the later stage of **Green Kiwi** supplies from Italy and Greece. Pricing is up just a bit as volume is down. Chile will be starting soon. Growers are reporting about 20% less fruit for the Chilean season compared to last year.

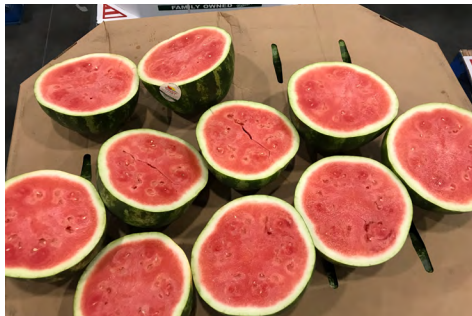
California grown "Mighties" label **Green Kiwi** Clamshells will be available in good supply. These will be offered in a 16/11lb clamshell.



CV PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Pineapple supply has been low on the east coast and some unexpected price spikes followed. Easter volume will likely be very tight, and pricing will be higher than previously expected.

ALERT! Del Monte "PinkGlow" Pineapples will be out of stock until at least April. There will be a few Dole "Golden Selection" Pineapples to substitute for Del Monte "HoneyGlow" which will be in short supply for Easter.



CV WATERMELON

Florida Grown seedless **Watermelons** will be in for the end of March! Quality looks great and Brix are 10+. This is early crop and prices are bit higher, most Florida shippers won't begin until Mid-April to where pricing starts to ease off.



CV ARTICHOKEs

12ct **Jumbo Artichokes** remain promotable as we finish the month of March.

Clamshell **Baby Artichokes** are available for a limited amount of time. **Long Stem Artichokes** are expected to be available for Easter in sporadic supply from Ocean Mist Farms.



CV DRAGON FRUIT

Dragon Fruit remains promotable from Ecuador; however, pricing is rising again as many growers have past the flush of fruit that they had at the beginning of the month. Four Seasons will offer yellow-skin/white flesh and red-skin/white flesh options.



CV AVOCADOS

Hass Avocado supplies and good and pricing leveled off after several weeks of price increases. 60ct fruit remains a little snug but 48ct fruit and larger showed signs of pricing coming off a bit due to good supply for the end of March.



CV MASHER POTATOES

Green Giant **Minute Mashers** are now here – talk to your sales rep to get some of this new convenient item!



CV PEPPERS

11 lb Hot House **Color Bell Peppers** prices will start to ease down in prices with new crop Canadian **Peppers** starting through the end of March along with Mexican product through the month of April.

15 lb **Red Sweet Peppers** will increase in volume as we head into April out of Mexico. Quality has been excellent, and this could be a great alternative to an 11 lb **Red Pepper**.

Jumbo **Green Peppers** pricing is steady. There is low volume crossing from Mexico, but Florida has more product available which is where we are pulling from now to keep our customers right with pricing and quality. We can expect this pricing to ease down again after Easter. Quality is good both out of Mexico and Florida.



CV STONE FRUIT

Import **Nectarines** and **Peaches** are expected to wrap up in early April and then gap until new crop California gets started in May. **Plums** should continue out of South Africa and end sometime late April.



CV PEARS

Washington **Bosc Pears** should wrap up for the season in early April. Decent supplies of import South American new crop **Bosc Pears** should be expected to transition smoothly.



CV HARD SQUASH

Spaghetti and **Acorn Squash** are both steady out of Mexico with decent supply coming in across the board.

NOTE: Butternut Squash out of Mexico is extremely tight. We will see some nice quality **Butternut Squash** from Panama hits at the end of March which will help to keep cost and supply steady through. More **Mexican Butternut Squash** is expected to get started again towards the beginning of April.



CV GREEN BEANS

NOTE: Green Bean prices have tightened up heavily with larger pulls. This price is expected to increase into the April and will not be as promotable as originally thought. Quality has been excellent out of Florida and availability is steady currently.



CV COSMIC CRISP

Washington **Cosmic Crisp Apples** are in excellent supply with promotional opportunities available.



CV CITRUS

Navel Oranges are peaking on 72's/88's with good supply on smaller fruit and choice options while large fruit remains rigorously tight. This market will firm up on pricing as we enter April due to rain delaying harvests. This crop looks to go through early July at this point.

Blood Oranges have not been affected by the rains, continue to promote. Fruit is showing excellent deep red color and eating great! This crop will go through July.

Cara Caras are peaking on 72's-113's with larger fruit tight due to the rain. This crop will go through Mid- June and will become promotable again once harvest becomes more regular and the rain dries up.

We will remain in **Sumo Citrus** 25ct and 12/2's through Mid- April. **Golden Nuggets** (10/3) are in stock so promote away here. **Mandarosa** will be in-stock in 15/2's for the end of March before we finish that season.

Grapefruit is finishing up end of March in Florida, early-April for Texas while the California Desert crop (Star Rubies) are up and running with real volumes coming within the end of April. California crop is coming on very strong.

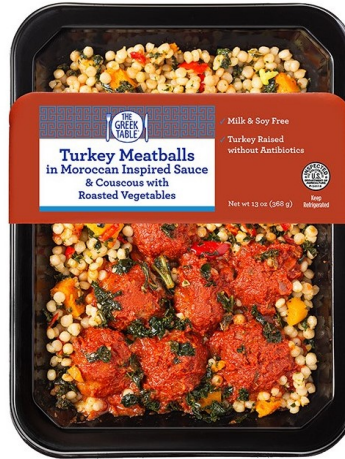
