PROMOTABLE ORGANIC BLUEBERRIES



GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries are highly promotable for the first week of March as Chilean imports wind down with great deals to sell all the volume. Expect prices to rise towards mid-March as the transition shifts to Peru and new crop Mexico.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberries are being promoted from Baja, Mexico with significantly lowered prices to match the increasing volume. The quality from Baja has been excellent.

Organic Blackberry supplies and pricing remain stable from Mexico, with good quality.

NOTE: Organic Raspberries remain tight from Mexico due to weather constraints, but growers anticipate more availability in March as crops recover from a challenging winter. The quality is good for the available fruit.



OG ASPARAGUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Asparagus pricing is dropping lower and lower creating wonderful opportunities in early to mid-March!

There will be a surge in lower priced product for the first full week of March. Pricing is expected to go up after but still stay promotable for the remainder of March.

The middle of March will also kick off our "Hippie brand" Organic Asparagus display contest and promo. Time to rock some Organic Asparagus!



ORGANIC CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! On promotion at Four Seasons for March in partnership with Sunkist are bulk and bag Organic Lemons, and Organic XL Navel and Cara Cara Oranges plus bags.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mandarins, including "Tangos" and "Murcotts", are in excellent supply. We have both Organic Cuties and Organic Halos brands available.

Delicious Organic Gold Nugget Mandarins are also currently in stock and look great.

Juicy Organic Minneola Tangelo quality is superb and highly promotable through the first week of March.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

In Yuma, AZ and El Centro, CA, Organic Broccoli harvests continue to yield excellent quality. Expect promotional opportunities due to the affordability and quality. North Carolina's new crop Organic Broccoli season is expected to start in April.

ALERT! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli is in very limited supply with high pricing due to low yields for early March.

Minor quality issues have been reported with Organic Cauliflower, but overall availability remains consistent for the desert-growing regions on the west coast. Prices and availability will shift in March.

OG AVOCADOS

Organic Avocados from Mexico supplies are steady for the beginning of March. The Negra crop has a higher oil content and a darker color.

Fair Trade Equal Exchange **Organic Avocados**, available in ReadyCycle 8/4-ct tray packs, offer a sustainable option as reasonable pricing for **Avocados**, perfect for single-serving.



OG DRAGON FRUIT

Limited supplies of **Organic Dragon Fruit** will be available in March.



OG POMEGRANATES

Organic Pomegranate Arils are back in stock, along with imported **Organic Pomegranate Arils** from Peru.

NOTE: However, whole **Organic Pomegranates** cannot be imported due to irradiation requirements.



OG PEARS

We've begun importing new crop **Organic Bartlett Pears** from Argentina, but large-sized fruit is expected to be challenging throughout the season.

Organic Bosc and **Anjou Pears** from the Pacific Northwest will finish completely in March.



OG APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Continue to promote Organic Apples; most varieties are in excellent supply with competitive pricing.

Organic Cosmic Crisp will be promotable through April.

New **Organic Pazazz Apples** are available for early March.

Organic Sweetango Apples will conclude the season this week.



OG CELERY

NOTE: The poor quality of Organic Celery (blight causing discoloration and sunken areas) in late February is expected to improve as new growing regions in Mexico start producing. Prices might stay high in the first part of March until better product arrives.



OG CABBAGE

Organic Cabbage volume for St. Patrick's Day will boast outstanding quality, with Lady Moon and Organic Treat brands available for the holiday.



OG CUCUMBERS

NOTE: Organic Cucumbers will be limited and pricey until the end of March due to field plantings transitions in Mexico.



OG GRAPES

NOTE: Organic Grape pricing remains expensive with limited supply in the category unfortunately. Peru is the primary supply, South Africa's product has been hit or miss on volume and flavor.



OG MANGOS

Crespo has started the season on Organic "Tommy Atkins" Round Mangos and Ataulfo Honey Mangos. Prices are expected to lower during March with increased supplies.



OG PINEAPPLES

Organic Pineapples will be more limited in supply as we enter March.



ORGANIC BOK CHOY & NAPA

Organic Bok Choy from California will arrive to start March with steady availability.

Organic Napa Cabbage from California is expected by mid-March, but the current color is light and unappealing.



OG GREEN BEANS

Organic Green Beans out of Mexico continue to struggle with rain, pushing off harvests and limiting supplies. Growers need a good two weeks without rain to get back on track and are hopeful, weather pending, to have better supplies by Easter.

Florida continues to have steady supplies with steady pricing, and do not foresee any supply gaps or disruptions to impact the upcoming weeks leading to Easter.



OG LETTUCES

GOOD NEWS! March will see a steady supply of East Coast Organic Romaine and Leaf Lettuce from Lady Moon Farms in Florida, with exceptional quality and increasing volumes.

NOTE: Organic Iceberg Lettuce from California is more expensive and has smaller, denser heads.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! In March, Mexico's Organic Brussels Sprouts are at their peak production. High volume is anticipated, providing ample opportunities for promotions.

OTHER STORIES

Organic Sungold Kiwi from Italy is finished for the season.

Overall, Organic Green Kiwi supplies are fair, with a slight increase in pricing.

Organic Mini-Mix Sweet Peppers 12/8 oz are now available from Pero Family Farms!

NOTE: Organic Baby Arugula salad production is improving, but is not back to normal yet. Organicgirl is still substituting Organic Mizuna until quality improves, while some other brands are starting to fill higher portions of Organic Baby Arugula.

ABUNDANT MEXICO ASPARAGUS



GOOD NEWS! Early March will likely be the best time of the year to promote Asparagus at the value pricing!

Asparagus supply continues to exceed demand. Weather in Caborca, Mexico has been ideal for growing and producing high yields. 28lb standard and jumbo are the most prevalent pack sizes at outstanding deal prices! 11lb has been more of a pack to order size.

Easter (3/31) is a bit earlier this year creating a great opportunity to promote **Asparagus** for the holiday. It is expected for the Caborca season to finish shortly after Easter.





CV STONE FRUIT

Chilean **White** and **Yellow Nectarines** continue to be in good supply as March begins.

Lemon Plums are back in stock for their last appearance of the season, running out just in time for the arrival of **K-Plum Yellow Plums** in early March.

Red and Black Plums from Chile are in firm and steady supply for March. There is a very limited supply of **Dapple Pluots** now available.

NOTE: Chilean **Peaches** remain extremely limited this week with strong markets; they could gap or end at any moment.

Chilean **Cherry** supplies are dwindling, and prices are up. Expect these **Cherries** to conclude for the season in early March.



CV APPLES & PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Continue promoting Eastern and Western **Apples**; most varieties have ample supply with favorable pricing, providing good value in the produce department.

Cosmic Crisp Apples will become a go-to promo variety for Spring.

GOOD NEWS! Eastern Ruby Frost Apples in 12/2lb pouches, and Gold Delicious, McIntosh, and Red Delicious 12/3 lb bags are highly promotable at the start of March.

Eastern **Stayman Apples** will finish for the season as we enter March.

Pacific Northwest **Bartlett Pears** are winding down for the season, and we will transition to new crop imports **Bartlett Pears** in Mid-March.

Bosc and **Red & Green Anjou Pears** are still available in good supply and quality for March.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Blueberry pricing has been low to push extra fruit but will begin to firm up a bit as Chilean imports slow down. Expect a shift to Peruvian imports and Mexican fruit of good quality. **Blueberries** wills till be a promotable item.

GOOD NEWS! Strawberry prices are easing off as Florida, Baja, and Central Mexico come back into decent volume. With more availability, pricing should ease to more promotable levels at the start of March. The quality has been excellent.

Blackberry pricing and availability remain steady out of Mexico, with some slight issues due to cooler temperatures, but overall quality is good.

NOTE: Raspberries continue to be tight out of Mexico, waiting for new fruit to be harvested, but fruit remains limited. Quality has been good despite some soft fruit due to cooler temperatures.

NEW: Red Currants are available in 12/6oz packs to add variety to your berry sets in March.

CV LETTUCES

NOTE: In late February, conditions for **Iceberg Lettuce**, **Romaine Hearts**, and other **Lettuces** from the west coast's desert regions drastically changed due to weather-related issues.

Limited availability and inconsistent quality are expected to persist into the first part of March.

While prices for **Leaf Lettuce** from the same region have risen, the situation is not as severe.



CV CORN

There is a good supply of South Florida **Bi-color** and **Yellow Sweet Corn** for early March. With better supplies, pricing will come down just enough to encourage better demand. A potential gap between plantings is expected as we approach St Patrick's Day and into Easter as they transition to fields further north into Belle Glade, Florida.

White Corn will remain unavailable until the beginning of April when Belle Glade crops begin.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! "Vintage Sweet" Heirloom Navel Oranges will be a great item to promote for the month of March. 36 ct Jumbo loose will have promo pricing and 12/13 lb high-graphic bags are selling well.

GOOD NEWS! Navel Orange supply is abundant with large fruit. Continue to promote large Navels through March.

Sunkist Blood and Cara Cara Oranges, Minneola Tangelos, and Lemons will be on promo for March.

Mandarins are in great supply from both California and Moroccan fruit. The quality is tremendous for both regions.



CV POMEGRANATES

Pomegranate Arils will be back in stock for the start of March in a 4 oz cup option from Sun Belle.

NOTE: Pomegranates will gap for the beginning of March. Peruvian whole **Pomegranates** will be available in the middle of the month.



CV MELONS

GOOD NEWS! MAG Cantaloupes from Del Monte are showing excellent quality internally and externally with affordable price, making them exceedingly promotable at this time.

Galia Melons will be available to add variety to your **Melon** sets in March.



CV PREMIUM BERRIES

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** and **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** from Mexico are in season.

Sweetest Batch Strawberries will be limited for early March.



CV CUCUMBERS

Hothouse Euro Cucumbers will be starting with a crop out of Canada, bringing promotable pricing.

ALERT! Cucumbers will remain tight through the month of March due to field transitions in Mexico.



CV BROCCOLI CROWNS

GOOD NEWS! Excellent Broccoli Crowns will still be regularly available on the east and west coasts. Mexican products provide a great extra option at comparable prices.



CV SWEET PEPPERS

NEW! Mini-Mix Sweet Pepper Rings 6/8 oz are in stock and available from Pero Family Farms!

CODE: 238528

Pricing and availability will shift in later March.



CV CAULIFLOWER

As March approaches, the supply of **Cauliflower** from Arizona and the Californian desert regions is still scarce and expensive. Prices are expected to normalize in early March.



CV AVOCADOS

Hass Avocados from Mexico remain steady in pricing as we begin March. The size curve is heavy on 48s with the larger 32/36 size being the tightest.



CV GRAPES

NOTE: Grape demand continues to exceed supply, while Chile remains the main player. Expect pricing to remain high and limited volume until late March, especially on **Red Seedless Grapes** and large sizing.

CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! Brussels Sprouts are expected

throughout March. The bulk of the volume comes

to be a great item for Easter promotions and

from Mexico, with excellent quality.



CV ARTICHOKES

GOOD NEWS! California **Jumbo Artichokes** from Coachella, CA are still producing at their highest level, with promotional opportunities continuing into March.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Cluster Tomatoes will be promotable as we enter March, with Mexico going strong on volume and driving pricing down from all regions.

Grape and Cherry Tomatoes are in better supply with prices returning to more normal levels.

Campari Tomatoes should improve by mid-March with better growing conditions and more volume.

NOTE: Field Round and **Vine Ripe Tomatoes** are expensive with light volume.



CV DRAGON FRUIT

Red Skin Dragon Fruit will be in good supply from Ecuador for the start of March. Look to promote over the next month or so.

Yellow-skinned Pitahaya will also be in good supply throughout the month of March.



CV GREEN BEANS

Green Beans are in better supply out of Florida. Prices have dropped.

It is expected to be an unstable market through to Easter until the next transition further north. Post Easter should kick off steady supplies and better opportunities for promotions.



CV MANGOS

Ciruli Brothers' popular 14 ct "**Champagne brand**" **Ataulfo Mangos** are going to be available at the beginning of March.

18 ct Ataulfo Honey Mango supplies are increasing, and pricing is becoming more affordable.

Mangos will be increasing in volume after a challenging middle of February. March brings more fruit, driving prices down.
