# ORGANIC MARKETNEWS







GOOD NEWS! Promote Organic Blueberries while you can in late July and early August.

**Organic Blueberry** pricing is slightly increasing due to reduced production but remains favorable for good price points. Volume is slowing from the Pacific Northwest due to heat and weather, with Michigan also harvesting limited numbers. Quality has been very good from both regions. 6 oz pint, and 18 oz packs are available.

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberries** are promotable from California, with excellent quality and taste. Pricing remains aggressive with some expected flushes into early August.

**Organic Raspberries** remain steady from California with no changes in production or price. Quality continues to be very good.

**Organic Blackberries** are steady from California with no changes in production or price. Quality remains high with good-tasting fruit.



#### **OG EGGPLANT & CHILI PEPPERS**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Eggplant remains promotable, with product from New Jersey and Pennsylvania from Lady Moon Farms and Flaim Farm. Other varieties available now include:

#### **OG TOMATOES**

Pennsylvania Lady Moon LOCAL Organic Gold Grape Tomatoes and Organic SunGold Cherry Tomatoes will become available by early August.

LOCAL Organic Snacking Tomatoes are in good supply and promotable into early August.

LOCAL Pennsylvania Organic Heirloom Tomatoes are in season from Lady Moon Farms.

NOTE: Organic Cluster Tomatoes and Cherry on the Vine Tomatoes from Savoura in Quebec are done for the season. Once sold out, other suppliers will be used to fill these lines. Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes will continue from Savoura, with other suppliers taking over once the Savoura label is exhausted.



#### **OG STONE FRUIT**

**Organic Stone Fruit** has been affected by the heat, with California facing one of the longest and highest heat waves in it's history. Expect tighter fruit supplies and stronger markets on some items.

Washington **Organic Peaches and Nectarines** have started and should continue until the end of September, providing some relief for California supplies.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Red and Black Plums remain promotable with excellent flavors and good supplies. Organic Pluots are in season too!

**Organic Cherries** are also nearing the end of their season, as many high elevation orchards suffered frost damage this spring, with small sizing prevailing in the supply pipeline.

**NOTE: Organic Apricots** will finish for the season at the end of July.





#### **OG POTATOES**

Organic Russet Potatoes will begin to start harvesting from Washington state in August. Expect smaller "count" Organic Russet Potatoes initially, with larger counts shipping around mid-August. Wisconsin will begin with Organic Russet and Organic Red and Yellow Potatoes around the same time, with pricing relief expected around mid-August.

For now, we have one more batch of "A-size" **Organic Russet Potatoes** from California in code 41618.



#### **OG MANGOS**

Organic Nam Doc Mai and Mallika Specialty Mangoes will be available in to late-July in a small flush! Promote these unique varieties that are only available during this time of year!

Through July, the availability of **Organic Mangos** will shift from 10ct to peaking on 8ct due to its larger size. **NOTE:** 12ct are virtually done. **Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangoes** are also quickly coming to an end.



OG PEARS

Import **Organic Pears** will continue to be available, with the first new crop California **Organic Bartlett Pears** arriving to the East Coast around August 4th.

Washington **Organic Pears** are expected to arrive in the first week of September. Pricing is anticipated to be high due to a crop half the size of last year's.



#### **OG BABY SPINACH**

NOTE: Excessive heat is causing bruising and quality issues which are impacting yields on **Organic Baby Spinach**. All brands will be limited on supply and Taylor/Earthbound will likely have pro-rated shipping volumes for late July and early August.



#### **OG ONIONS**

LOCALLY Pennsylvania Organic Red and Sweet Onions are now fully in season. Pricing has decreased significantly as we move away from western product with expensive freight, and the quality is very good.



#### OG AVOCADOS

**Organic Hass Avocado** supplies remain snug with fluctuating market prices. Pricing will be slightly down, with high-quality fruit showing very high oil content.

Smaller 60ct fruit is particularly tight, with most fruit being 48ct size or larger.



#### **OG LETTUCE**

**Organic Romaine Hearts** continue to have excellent availability, cost, and quality. Promotional opportunities will continue early in the month.

**Organic Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** from New York and Quebec are thriving as August approaches.

**Organic Iceberg Lettuce** from California remains available, with costs improving but still slightly elevated.



#### **OG GREEN BEANS**

**Organic Green Beans** from a **LOCAL** small family farm are now available, showcasing excellent quality. Supplies are expected to remain steady throughout the season.



#### **OG BUNCHED VEG**

Ample supplies of Organic Red and Gold Beets, along with Organic Orange and Rainbow Carrots, are in house from California. 25 lb sack Organic Beets are all LOCAL.

**Organic Chards** have mostly transitioned back to California, with **LOCAL** returning in the fall. Expect consistent quality from the California harvests.





**OG FIGS** 

Organic Brown Turkey Figs are now in season, with Black Mission Figs following shortly. Both varieties are expected to last throughout the summer, barring any weather events.



OG ARTICHOKES Organic Artichokes are in great availability, with promotional opportunities. Expand displays and highlight promotions to boost sales.



#### **OG BROCCOLI**

**Organic Broccoli** availability is steady as August begins. Although volumes are consistent, promotional pricing and opportunities are limited. Expect steady supplies and fair pricing with great quality.



#### OG APPLES

**Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples** remain promotable with excellent quality, which some say flavor sets better as they store. Supplies are expected to last until the new crop arrives in December.

**Organic Honeycrisp** and **Granny Smith Apples** from Washington show no gap between crops in August and September.

A slight gap may occur with **Gala**, **Fuji**, and **Pink Lady Apples**, but it is expected to last only a week or two, helping to clear the pipeline for the new crop to arrive.

OUTLOOK: New crop Organic SweeTango and Rockit Apples are expected to arrive in early September, with Organic Opal and SugarBee Apples following in early October, and Organic Pinata in mid-November.

**Organic Cantaloupe** and **Honeydew** have shown improved sizing, with the Central Valley crop providing a nice mix of sizes. Expect prices to continue decreasing as a result, leading to more favorable prices.

ALERT! Organic Valencia Oranges are very tight across all sizes. Avoid ads and promotions for now.

**ALERT! Organic Lemons** continue to face supply challenges from all regions, especially California. Argentinian fruit currently shows the best quality.

Lady Moon Farms **Organic Mini Peppers** have started to arrive in limited quantities.



#### **OG GRAPES**

New crop **Organic Grapes** from California's Central Valley are currently in season but struggling with **Red and Black Grape** volumes to start in the high heat, but **Organic Green Grapes** are still in good supply.

10/2 lb packs of **Organic Red** and **Green Grapes** will be available in biodegradable packages arriving 7/30.

**Organic Champagne Grapes** (mini Red Seedless with tender stems) will be in season for a short time through early August.



#### **OG WATERMELONS**

**Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons** continue to be promotable from South Carolina and California, with excellent quality.

**Organic Seedless Watermelons** from California are of excellent quality and taste. Pennsylvania **LOCAL** is expected to start harvests around early August.

#### **OTHER STORIES**

**Organic Asparagus** pricing is fairly promotable, with volume picking up from Mexico and excellent quality.

**Organic Brussels Sprouts** from Mexico are back in stock but at a premium. With expanded growing regions, stable supplies should carry us through the coming months, though promotional opportunities are limited.

**Organic Cauliflower** from California continues to show varying availability in late July. Increased costs and unstable supply volumes are expected to persist into early August, though quality remains outstanding. **Organic Royal Star Papayas** are improving in availability for mid to late July.

**ALERT! Organic Pineapples** will be extremely limited for the remainder of July, with high pricing and expected prorates.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green and SunGold Kiwi are in excellent supply for July. Ensure both bulk and clamshell options are included in your produce sets.

Promotional opportunities on **Organic Celery** are still available with good quality, though costs are less aggressive than earlier in July.

# CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

### LOCAL PEAK SEASON PEACHES





**GOOD NEWS!** There are good supplies of **LOCAL Peaches** from New Jersey in 12/2-lb tote bags and 25 lb cases with 2-1/2" and 2-3/4" + sizing. Promote!

Pennsylvania **LOCAL Peaches** are tight in late July as growers wait for the next varietals to be more promotable in early August.

A two-week heatwave in California is causing trouble in the **Stone Fruit** market, with rising prices and some struggling varieties expected in August. California **Yel-Iow Peaches** and **Nectarines** are somewhat limited.



#### **CV BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! Strawberries will be promotable out of California. Quality remains very nice, despite smaller berries. Continue to push fruit.

GOOD NEWS! Blueberries are promotable out of the Pacific Northwest. Quality is very nice overall, supplies are plentiful, and pricing is aggressive. Jumbo Blueberries out of Peru have started to be available, with more expected in early August.

**GOOD NEWS! Raspberries** have flipped to promotable volume as a slug of fruit from Mexico starts. California is also harvesting, with good quality. The fruit is eating excellently, and pricing has eased off to move the excess supply.

**Blackberries** remain steady out of California. Demand remains strong as availability tightens. Quality is nice, and the fruit eats like candy.



#### **CV STONE FRUIT**

Dark Sweet Cherries are experiencing a bumpy patch in supply, with quality peaking on large fruit. Due to the heat, short-term deals are available for late July, but NOTE we expect prices to climb and double at the start of August, with the crop finishing by mid-August. **Rainier Cherries** will finish in late July.

Red and Black Plums are steady. There are some outstanding varietals of Pluots/Plumcots in season on Reds, Blacks, Mottled, and Green!

**NOTE:** California **Apricots** are winding down and will transition to a small **Apricot** crop from Washington to finish at the end of July to early August.

Consider filling **Apricot** holes on the shelf with **Crimson** and **Midnight Rose Apriums**, which will only be around through mid-August. If you haven't tried these, they are one of the season's best specialties.

Verry Cherry Plums are done for the season. Family Tree Farms will have a similar variety of Cherry Plum in August.



#### **CV APPLES**

Washington **Cosmic Crisp Apple** flavor has improves later in the season with the storage crop. Now is the time to promote. New crop is not expected until December, but there is plenty of delicious **Cosmic Crisp Apples** with promotable pricing continuing until then.

Washington **Envy Apples** have transitioned to new crop New Zealand imports, offering a great value to shoppers. Stock this great apple.

Washington **Braeburn Apples** are winding down for the season, possibly the last season ever for commercial production as shippers replace them with newer varieties.

Washington Gala, Honeycrisp, Granny Smith, Golden Delicious, Fuji, Red Delicious, and Pink Lady Apples are expected to ship right through to new crop without a gap, beginning in the fall.

Washington new crop **Rave Apples** and **Swee**tango Apples are expected to start mid-August, followed by Koru, Lucy Glo, and Lucy Rose Apples in October.

Eastern storage crop **Apples** are winding down for the season. Only **Fuji**, **Gala**, and **Golden Apples** are expected to go right through to "new crop", which starts with **LOCAL Ginger Gold** and **Honeycrisp Apples** in August.





#### **CV HASS AVOCADOS**

Hass Avocados supplies from Mexico have rebounded, and fruit prices have been dropping since mid-July. Overall supplies are weighted more heavily to the larger size curve as the main season ends. This will shift dramatically next month when the Flor Loca season starts, with fruit starting off very small.



#### **CV SWEET CORN**

LOCAL Sweet Corn remains promotable! Rain and storms slowed production slightly but caused no significant damage. Quality is great.



#### **CV KIWI**

**Kiwi** in both **Green** and **SunGold** varieties from New Zealand remain strong in supply for mid-July. Look to promote **Green Kiwi** especially over this time.



#### **CV MELONS**

**Cantaloupe** supplies are strong on 9 ct fruit, with smaller fruit gaining strength as July comes to an end. **Heirloom Cantaloupes**, **Tuscan Style Cantaloupes**, and **LOCAL Athena Style Cantaloupes** are in season for late July!

**Honeydew** supply is currently peaking on small fruit but will quickly shift to larger fruit in August. Eating quality is has been great.



#### **CV EGGPLANT**

LOCAL Eggplant from New Jersey is rolling in from Flaim Farm and is promotable right now. Available now:

- 236485 CV Eggplant Fairytale 5 lb Mini Graffiti
- 1260 CV Eggplant PREM 24 lb
- 1275 CV Eggplant Graffiti NJ 12 lb
- 1273 CV Eggplant Sicilian NJ 20 lb
- 1290 CV Eggplant Japanese 5 lb - 1285 CV Eggplant Italian NJ 10 lb



#### **CV WATERMELONS**

GOOD NEWS! Watermelons are promotable from multiple states right now including Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Maryland. Quality is excellent and eating outstanding. Pricing remains aggressive. Seeded and "Sugar Baby" are in season too!

Mini Watermelons are promotable out of California. Quality looks good, and the fruit is eating great.



#### CV LETTUCE

The **Lettuce** category remains favorable as August approaches, with **Iceberg**, **Romaine Hearts**, **Romaine**, and **Leaf** items continuously harvested from both Quebec and California.

GOOD NEWS! Romaine Hearts continue to be promotable with great availability and deal opportunities into August.



#### **CV PEARS**

**Bartlett and Bosc Pears** are transitioning from imports to new crop California and then to Washington.

California and Washington crops are significantly lower in volume, expect strong pricing and sporadic availability this upcoming Fall and Winter, especially on **Bosc** and **Anjou**.



#### **CV ARTICHOKES**

Jumbo Artichokes from California continue to have steady availability, but the cost varies depending on the grower. Take advantage of deal opportunities and increase sales by expanding displays.





#### **CV PEPPERS**

**NOTE:** California has started with some **Red Bell Peppers**, but the heat affected their crop, making the product unable to make the ride to the east coast.

By August, the market may fall a bit, but for now, the field and greenhouse **Red Belled Pepper** market is in a tough spot, and **Yellow** and **Orange Bell Peppers** are slightly elevated.



#### **CV CITRUS**

**GOOD NEWS! Mandarins** from Chile, Peru, Uruguay, and South Africa is keeping the supply chain in great shape! Look for promotable prices as we enter August.

Import Cara Cara Oranges are available, and in the start of August we will have import Minneola Tangelos.

Import **Navel Oranges** are available, but large fruit is very tight. California **Valencia Oranges** are suffering from the heat, causing major crop loss throughout the state.

**Broccoli Crown** production is readily available with most volume coming from Maine, with additional supply from California. Costs normalized in mid-July and are expected to hold steady into early August. Quality remains strong from both regions.

**Brussels Sprout** conditions remain unchanged in late July, with limited volumes and elevated costs. Expect similar conditions to persist into August. Quality remains favorable despite the cost and availability limitations.

**Cauliflower** from California continues to have steady availability at a reasonable price in July,



#### CV GRAPES

New crop California Central Valley **Grapes** are experiencing harvest delays due to extreme heat in the San Joaquin Valley, with crews working half days. This is causing limited supply, mainly on **Red Grapes**. Weather is expected to normalize in late-July, helping supply.

California Specialty Grapes in stock for late July and early August include Thomcord, Champagne (mini seedless with tender stem), Gum Drops, plus Cotton Candy Grapes from Mexico.



#### **CV FIGS**

Fresh Figs have made their return from California! Brown Turkey figs will be the first available, followed by Black Mission Figs. 12/8 oz clamshell packs will be available. There may be some limited Green Fig varieties as well!



#### **CV POTATOES**

New Jersey Fresh bagged LOCAL White Potatoes are starting with the first arrival at the end of July under code 4404. New Jersey LOCAL Red Potatoes should start at the end of August, and New Jersey Gold Potatoes around the second week of August.

We've switched to Stockton, CA "A, B, C" size premium bulk **Gold**, **Red**, **and White Potatoes** in late July. Pricing is up due to strong demand for these premium **Potatoes**. Bakersfield is struggling with quality, increasing volume pressure on Stockton shippers' nice stuff.

#### **OTHER STORIES**

with costs rising slightly as we enter August. Quality has remained strong, and production will remain steady.

**Mangos** are past the flush experienced in May, June, and into July. Fruit in general is sizing bigger, making 10ct and 12ct sizes harder to find.

NOTE: Ataulfo Honey Mango volumes are way down as the season approaches it's end.

Yellow Pitahaya and White Flesh Dragon Fruit will be in good supply for mid-July, marking a return to the marketplace for Yellow Pitahaya after a brief gap. Pricing should be promotable.



#### **CV TOMATOES**

**Snacking Tomatoes** are in good supply and promotable through the first week of August with product from **LOCAL** New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

LOCAL Vine Ripe Tomatoes are also flushing and promotable into the first week of August with product from NJ, DE, and PA. Expect the category to tighten up around mid-August due to heat and bloom drop from the early part of the local season.

**Cluster** and **Beefsteak Tomatoes** continue rolling in from Savoura and others. This product is high in price due to disease pressure and the heat affecting yields.

LOCAL Beets, Bunching Greens, Kohlrabi, Leeks, and Radishes are managing some heat-related challenges, but they continue to be available.

**Celery** harvests from California are producing strong volume in July and will continue into August. **Celery** promotions will be available in late July and early August, with aggressive pricing and top-notch quality.
