### **APRIL ORGANIC MANDARINS**

GOOD NEWS! Late season harvest of California Organic Mandarins are in good shape with plenty of volume and promotable pricing. Quality on the "Murcott" and "Tango" varieties is good with bright orange skin and flesh, deep flavor, and nice sweetness.

**Organic Mandarins** in Cuties, Halos, plus shipper brands are all primed for April displays on bags. Bulk fruit is also in good supply.

**Organic Lemons** remain excellent on large fruit (75 ct and 95 ct) from California, but some shippers are seeing tight supply, particularly on smaller sizes.

-----

**Organic Navel Oranges** are available though winding down with increasing prices and tighter supply at this point in the season.

**Organic Blood** and **Cara Cara Oranges** are still in stock even as harvests start wrapping up for the season as May approaches.



### **OG SPRING VEGETABLES**

New crop **Organic Rhubarb** from Washington is back in season with more volume expected around 4/22.

**Organic Purple Kohlrabi** is in season for the Spring and is a great visual pop and sweet, crisp flavor.

Seasonal **Organic Red** and **White Spring Onions** are here with nice quality - perfect to brighten up your wet veg sets. These tender bulbs with fresh green tops are great for grilling or sautéing!

Jumbo Organic Artichokes are available from coastal California.

Organic Snow Peas and Purple Snow Peas are now available. These tender, vibrant options offer outstanding flavor and visual appeal.



### **OG TOMATOES**

GOOD NEWS! Lady Moon Farms line up of Organic Snacking Tomatoes from Florida remain promotable with robust quality and pricing.

Organic Cluster Tomatoes from Mexico and Canada are in good supply with steady quality.

**NOTE: Organic Beefsteak Tomato** supply dipped sharply in early April but quality remains outstanding despite lighter volume.

**Organic Roma Tomatoes** out of Mexico continue to struggle with low yields and inconsistent quality during April.

Savoura Quebec Greenhouse production of Organic Cherry On-the-Vine and Cocktail Tomatoes is finally improving.



### **OG BERRIES**

**Organic Strawberries** continue from Baja, Mexico and California with excellent quality. Look for a full transition to Santa Maria, CA crops by early May.

**NOTE: Organic Raspberry** production is slowing from Central Mexico. Baja, Mexico and California volumes are just beginning, so tight supply and rising prices expected short-term.

**NOTE: Organic Blackberry** supplies will be short as Mexico struggles with low yields. "**Sweet Karoline**" variety **Organic Blackberries** from Hippie Organics are available at the end of April with excellent quality though.

ALERT! Organic Blueberries remain very limited and expensive as the import season winds down and domestic gets going. The Georgia crop is delayed by 3–4 weeks due to weather. Things will improve around mid-May.



**OG AVOCADOS** 

**NOTE: Organic Hass Avocados** remain in steady supply, but overall pricing remains tight. Plan now for Cinco de Mayo promotions coming out of the Easter holiday, just at higher price points than prior years.



### **OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS**

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Brussels Sprouts** out of Mexico remain in solid promotional volume for late April. Exceptional quality and pricing continue, making this a great time to feature bulk and packaged options.

NOTE: Expect pricing to climb slightly as May starts.



### **OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER**

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Broccoli** from California remain abundant for April. With excellent quality and favorable pricing, this is a strong promotional item throughout the month.

**Organic Cauliflower** volume is good and pricing is reasonable for April.



**OG BELL PEPPERS** 

GOOD NEWS! Organic Color Bell Peppers production is shifting from Israel to Holland and from Mexico to Canada. Canadian greenhouse growers began successfully in mid-April, creating new promotional opportunities.



**OG MELONS** 

**Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons** are still tight as Mexico begins new harvests. Supplies should improve late April. Early fruit has shown excellent quality.

The new crop Mexico **Organic Cantaloupe** harvest is starting. 9 ct fruit will arrive at high pricing around 4/23.



**OG GRAPES** 

**Organic Red Grapes** remain in stock with the first ever **Organic Grapes** from Chile allowed into the USA.

**NOTE: Organic Green** and **Black Grapes** are done until Mexico starts later this Spring.



### **OG BANANAS**

**NOTE: Organic Banana** pricing will rise due to tariffs starting throughout the end of April.

Equal Exchange Fair Trade will begin shipping **Organic Bananas** in polypack bags starting at the end of April to help protect fruit quality during the rainy season in Peru and Ecuador.



### **OG HARD SQUASH**

**Organic Hard Squash** supply remains in growing region transition through April.

- Organic Butternut & Spaghetti Squash: Tight with gaps and pricing pressure
- Organic Acorn Squash: Improved supply
- Organic Delicata Squash: Limited and small-sized
- Organic Kabocha Squash: Back in limited supply

**Organic Honeynut** is in abundant supply and is the best value right now.



### **OG ONIONS & POTATOES**

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Vidalia Onions** will arrive April 20th in 40 lb JBO (41541) and 16/3 (41540) packs.

**Organic Gold A Potatoes** are back in stock with new crop California A size and 16/3 packs (41647 & 41691). High pricing reflects the new season, but the quality is exceptional.

New crop **Organic Red Potatoes** expected to arrive at the end of April.



OG STONE FRUIT OUTLOOK OUTLOOK:

First **Organic California Cherries** will be arriving around the first week of May.

First **Organic California Apricots** are expected in mid-May with promotable volumes to follow.

Organic California Peaches start in mid-May, Nectarines in late May, Plums, and Pluots in early June.



OG CELERY

GOOD NEWS! Organic Celery supply from California and Mexico is strong in April, with excellent quality. Take advantage of steady volume and solid pricing.

**NOTE:** Expect changes heading into May, with tighter supply and higher prices anticipated.



### **OG SUGAR SNAP PEAS**

**Organic Sugar Snap Peas** in 8/12 oz compostable boxes are here for Spring. These are perfect for grab-and-go and sustainability-focused shoppers. (Code 227899)

**Bulk Organic Sugar Snap Peas** are also available from California for the rest of April and into May.



**OG LETTUCES** 

**Organic Iceberg Lettuce** from the West Coast remains excellent in both quality and supply.

**NOTE:** Lady Moon Farms' Florida **Organic Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** program is winding down in Florida.

East Coast **Organic Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** will gap briefly before **LOCAL** farms in NJ and PA, including Lady Moon Farms, restart later in Spring.

California **Organic Lettuce** supply is ready to fill the gap with great quality and fair pricing.

**Organic Romaine Hearts** remain tight with elevated pricing, but signs of improvement are showing into late April.



### **OG APPLES**

Organic Cosmic Crisp, Envy and Pink Lady Apples are the most promotable right now, pile them high for late April ads and in store specials!

**NOTE:** Organic Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, and **Honeycrisp Apple** supplies are tightening, with prices expected to rise in May.

**Organic SugarBee** and **Opal Apple** varieties will finish in early to mid May.



### **OG TROPICALS**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mango supplies are strong and pricing is becoming more promotable for late April and Cinco de Mayo.

**Organic Royal Star Papayas** are in steady supply for mid-April.

Frieda's Aloha **Organic Brown Coconuts** from Mexico are here! New to the lineup, these will be available in a 20 ct case.

### **OTHER STORIES**

**Organic Chard Greens** are shipping from California, North Carolina, and **LOCAL** New Jersey farms for steady supply.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Collards from Lady Moon Farms remain beautiful and consistent through April. GOOD NEWS! Import new crop Organic Red and Green Bartlett Pears remain in strong supply.

**NOTE: Organic Green Beans** are tightening into late April. Expect higher pricing until supply rebounds with new production closer to May.

**NOTE: Organic Ginger** is transitioning to new crop from Peru with thinner skin and higher prices expected through April.

**NOTE: Organic Dill** from California faces quality and yield issues due to cool weather. Expect occasional gaps through late April.

# **CONVENTIONAL** MARKET NEWS

APRIL 18 - APRIL 24, 2025

### **FLORIDA WATERMELONS BEGIN**



**GOOD NEWS! Seedless Watermelon** volume out of Florida is improving, with pricing easing on larger 45 ct bins and 60 ct fruit holding steady. Quality is strong, and Mexican product remains available with increasing volume and lower pricing.

With weather warming in the northeast time to begin promoting whole **Watermelons** and doing more in store cuts.

Mexico's spring harvest on **Mini Seedless Watermelons** is underway. Supplies are improving, and pricing is gradually coming down. Offshore fruit is winding down as the season transitions.

**Cantaloupe** and **Honeydew** supplies are improving after tight prices earlier in April. Volume is increasing, and pricing is returning to normal levels.



### **CV BERRIES**

**Strawberry** supply is improving slightly post-holiday. Cooler California temperatures are delivering excellent quality and size, though harvest pace is slowed.

**Blackberries** are steady with excellent quality and strong availability out of Mexico.

**Raspberries** are tightening as Mexico finishes and California has yet to begin. Pricing is firming, but quality remains strong. Expect tighter prices through April.

ALERT! Blueberries are very limited across all regions. Georgia's harvest has been delayed by weather, keeping supplies tight and pricing elevated into early May.



### **CV SPECIALTY BERRIES**

Driscoll's "**Sweetest Batch**" **Raspberries** are in season with incredible flavor. Modest volumes are arriving frequently and fast sell through is the plan for these high sugar berries.

Popular "**Sweetest Batch**" **Blueberries** from Driscoll's are available for April, though in lighter volumes during the shoulder season between Mexico and USA. **Jumbo Blueberries** are in stock with modest quantities.

Driscoll's "**Sweetest Batch**" **Strawberries** will be available as California ramps up.

Mother's Day is May 11. Talk to your rep about prebooking Long-stem **Strawberries**, **Heartshaped Strawberries** packs, and **Heart-shaped Raspberry** packs.

**NOTE:** Driscoll's **"Sweetest Batch" Blackberries** will experience a gap as Mexico wraps up and California prepares to start.



### **CV STONE FRUIT OUTLOOK**

New crop California **Peaches** from Coachella, CA are expected to start around April 23rd. Early sizing will be small but will increase into May.

South Carolina **Peaches** are set to begin mid-May with an excellent-looking crop. Mid-May is also when the California **White** & **Yellow Peaches** and **Nectarines** supplies start to ship more to fill sets.

**Plums, Pluots, Plumcots,** and **Apriums** will start with early varietals at the beginning of June.

California **Cherries** are projected to start arriving around April 28th, with firm volume building into May. Peak availability will come post-Memorial Day.

Washington **Cherries** will follow in early June with a strong **Red Cherry** crop and good supplies of Rainier yellow colored **Cherries**.

California **Apricots** are expected by the second week of May with a large crop and promotable sizing.



### **CV LETTUCES**

GOOD NEWS! Iceberg Lettuce and Romaine Hearts are showing great quality and consistent availability with promotable pricing.

Leaf Lettuces and Romaine also remain steady, making the entire Lettuce category a reliable item for April promotions.



### **CV PINEAPPLES**

**Pineapples** are improving in volume, although pricing is higher than previous seasons due to tariffs.

**PinkGlow**, Dole **Golden Selection**, and Del Monte **HoneyGlow** varieties are available in limited quantities.



### **CV MANGOS**

GOOD NEWS! Mango volume remains steady with good overall quality.

**Red Round Mangos** are starting to increase in availability just in time for Cinco de Mayo.

**Ataulfo Honey Mangos** remain highly promotable with lower pricing.



### **CV ARTICHOKES**

California **Artichokes** remain elevated in price due to limited April production. Despite tighter volumes, quality has been exceptional and is expected to remain strong through early May.



**CV GRAPES** 

Import **Grape** pricing has increased over the middle of April. Quality and sizing remain excellent across all colors.



### **CV BANANAS**

**NOTE: Banana** pricing will rise due to tariffs starting throughout the end of April.



### **CV VIDALIA SWEET ONIONS**

**GOOD NEWS!** The first shipments of 2025 Genuine Georgia **Vidalia Sweet Onions** are here! Jumbo 40 lb (code 4105) and 16/3 lb (code 4166) bags are expected in by April 20th. Promote through July, with peak ad opportunities in May and June.



### **CV TOMATOES**

Canadian **Cluster** and **Beefsteak Tomatoes** are in excellent supply, with promotable pricing and strong quality.

GOOD NEWS! Florida and Mexican Vine-Ripe Tomatoes have rebounded from earlier supply tightness, and the category is well-positioned for strong promotions in late April.



### **CV COLOR BELL PEPPERS**

GOOD NEWS! Canadian-grown greenhouse Color Bell Peppers are increasing in volume and supporting promotable prices, while Mexican product remains in good supply at favorable pricing.

Look for strong promotional opportunities by late April.



### **CV AVOCADOS**

**NOTE:** Mexican **Hass Avocados** saw slight price drops heading into Easter, as growers released additional fruit ahead of their Holy Week pause. Pricing is expected to trend upward slightly heading into Cinco de Mayo.



### **CV LOCAL VEG**

Early LOCAL Bunched Herbs, Leeks, and Bunch Greens are starting to arrive from New Jersey, marking the beginning of LOCAL season!



### **CV SWEET CORN**

GOOD NEWS! Warmer temperatures are boosting early Florida Sweet Corn supply and pushing prices lower. Availability and deals will improve heading into May.

**CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER** 

**GOOD NEWS! Broccoli** is in great supply from multiple growing regions, with consistent quality and competitive pricing. Promotional opportunities are expected to continue through April and into May.

California **Cauliflower** supplies have been steady, with favorable pricing and reliable quality. Modest pricing increases are being observed, but remain manageable as we move through April.



**CV CITRUS** 

GOOD NEWS! Mandarins, including "Murcotts" and "Tangos" from California, are in peak condition, excellent eating quality and ideal for spring promotions.

**Cara Cara Oranges** are the best value item in California citrus for April.

Lime prices remain stable for now, but some fluctuations are expected heading into early May around Cinco de Mayo. NOTE: Mexican Holy Week will likely influence short-term availability due to harvests stopping for Easter observation.



### **CV APPLES & PEARS**

GOOD NEWS! Stemilt Gala, Fuji, Granny Smith, Pink Lady, and Red Delicious Apples are promotable through Earth Day, with a \$1 per case donation to PASA for each purchase.

GOOD NEWS! Washington-grown Cosmic Crisp and Envy Apples remain in good supply with strong promotional opportunities heading into May.

Eastern **Granny Smith Apples** have finished for the season, but quality fruit is still shipping out of Washington.

**Bosc Pears** have transitioned to imported fruit with firm markets and reliable quality.

NOTE: Asparagus was expensive and in short supply for Easter. With improved production and easing demand, pricing is stabilizing as April continues. LOCAL Asparagus will start in late April and ramp up in May.

**OUTLOOK:** Zespri **SunGold Kiwi** is expected to begin in early May and will be a strong seasonal feature.

### **OTHER STORIES**

**NOTE: Green Kiwi** remains limited out of Europe and Chile. Pricing is firm as supplies tighten. Look for new crop from New Zealand to start in June. Washington **Rhubarb** is expected to arrive around April 21st with good early supplies.




