# ORGANIC GRAPES FROM MEXICO







In the overall market, Organic Grapes remain in short supply for June due to rain-related harvest delays in Mexico. The good news is that Four Seasons is well supplied and are in better shape than much of the industry.

Specialty varieties such as Organic Gummy Berries, Jelly Berries, and Cotton Candy Grapes from Mexico will be in stock starting 6/17.

**OUTLOOK:** Peak season for California Organic Grapes will ramp up in July with mid-August through early October being the best time to promote.



#### **OG STONE FRUIT**

Organic Dark Sweet Cherries from California, and Washington are now in season and arriving in 18 lb bulk and 16/1 lb clamshells. Sizing varies, and markets are easing week to week. Expect strong momentum going into the July 4th holiday and the Northwest Cherry Display Contest and Promo. Four Seasons has planned for next month.

Washington Organic Rainier Cherries have started in limited supply and are expected to increase in volume soon.

**GOOD NEWS!** The Homegrown Organic Stone Fruit Promo and Display Contest starts Monday, June 16. Featuring EFI and Regenerative Organic Certified **Organic White & Yellow Peaches, Nectarines, Red** & Black Plums, and Pluots through July 13th.

South Carolina Organic Yellow Peaches remain in excellent supply. Organic Red and Sugar Plums are also plentiful and high in quality.

**OUTLOOK: Organic Verry Cherry Plums** are expected to arrive during the week of June 30th.



#### **OG MANGOS**

GOOD NEWS! It's time to build displays and push Organic Mangos! Crespo Organics and Four Seasons Produce are ready to support with promotions on 8 ct and 10 ct fruit.

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Ataulfo Honey Mangos** in 16/18 ct sizing are trending smaller, creating opportunities for great deals.

Specialty varieties like Organic Nam Doc Mai and Mallika Mangos will be available for July displays. A limited quantity of stunning Point-of-Sale materials is available.

#### **OG BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! "Little Buck" LOCAL Organic Blueberries are beginning to harvest in New Jersey with excellent quality expected. California supply from Driscoll's remains promotable, and Southeastern regions continue harvest. The transition to New Jersey-grown Driscoll's Organic Blueberries will begin in the coming weeks.

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberries** from Driscoll's remain promotable out of Watsonville and Salinas, CA. Quality is excellent and pricing is ideal for strong retail sales. Continue building large displays while fruit remains promotable.

Organic Raspberries are steady as growing regions transition from Mexico and Baja to California. Quality has been excellent and supply consistent.

Organic Blackberry supplies are tightening now that Mexico's season is complete. California is beginning with light volume, and LOCAL New Jersey will help with availability starting in early July.

**DG ASPARAGUS** 

ALERT! Organic Asparagus is currently in a gap as Michigan and New Jersey seasons have concluded. Mexico has not yet begun harvest. Expect out of stocks in June!



#### OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico continue to be plentiful and high in quality. Pricing has gradually declined due to better supply, and these favorable conditions are expected to continue through June.



#### OG MELONS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cantaloupes and Honeydew are in full supply, this is the time to build displays and promote.

Organic Gaya and Galia Melons are also available and offer a great extension to the melon category. And by June 21, Organic Golden Dews and Orange Flesh Honeydew will arrive.



#### **OG AVOCADOS**

Pre-conditioned Equal Exchange Fair Trade **Organic Hass Avocados** 48ct (219815) and 60ct (207631) are in stock and available from Peru for a trail program.

**Organic Hass Avocado** supply from Mexico has slowed slightly. California fruit is being added to supplement availability. The California crop is producing excellent quality this year.



**OG BELL PEPPERS** 

Organic Hothouse Yellow and Red Color Bell

Peppers are the most promotable at this time

Organic Orange Color Bell Peppers remains

limited. Quality is excellent across the board.

#### **OG APPLES**

**Organic Envy** and **Pink Lady** Apples are promotable for June!

NOTE: Washington Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples are winding down, and sporadic supply gaps are likely to continue. LONG TERM OUT-LOOK: A large new crop is expected in the fall, with production 2-3 times larger than this season.

**NOTE: Organic Granny Smith** and **Honeycrisp Apples** from Washington are nearly finished. These varieties are expected to wrap up by early to mid-July. Limited imports will help bridge the gap before the fall crop.



**OG CITRUS** 

Organic Mandarin Oranges from Sun Pacific (Cuties

We are now fully transitioned into new crop Cal-

ifornia Organic Valencia Oranges, available in

56/72/88 ct Fancy and 10/4 lb bag formats.

label) continue to be strong in supply and quality.

#### **OG WATERMELONS**

**Organic Seedless Watermelons** from California fields are in transition, with new production coming online near Bakersfield, CA.

**Organic Yumi Watermelon** bins are promotable in 45 ct and more limited on 55-60 ct.

**Organic Seeded Watermelons** remain in limited supply as California enters the early stages of transition. Expect volumes to improve by the end of June.

**Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons** are transitioning out of Southern California and Mexico. North Carolina is expected to start harvesting in the third week of June.



#### **OG SPECIALTY**

**Organic Lychee** and **Organic Eggfruit** (Canistel) are currently available from Homestead, Florida as part of our tropical offering.

**Organic Rhubarb** is nearing the end of its season and may wrap up at any time.

LOCAL PA Organic Snow Peas, Green Kohlrabi and Fava Beans are now in season.

Back in season from California for the week of June 16 are: Organic Chioggia Beets, Purple Snow Peas, Treviso, and Burdock Root.

#### **OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER**

GOOD NEWS! Organic Bunch Broccoli production in California remains abundant with excellent quality throughout June. Strong availability continues to open up promotional pricing opportunities.

Organic Broccoli Crowns are priced higher.

LOCAL PA Organic Stem Broccoli is in season for the rest of June. (CODE: 40577)

**Organic Cauliflower** from California remains available, although supply remains tight and pricing elevated. Quality is holding steady at average levels, and these trends are expected through late June.



OG CELERY

**Organic Celery** supplies have stabilized with volume increasing week by week. Pricing is improving and quality from Mexico remains strong. These favorable conditions should persist throughout June.



#### **OG KIWI**

**Organic Green Kiwi** from Zespri in New Zealand has arrived and will be in season through the summer.

Both Volume Filled and Clamshell options are available in **Organic Green** and **SunGold Kiwi** varieties.



#### **OG LOCAL VEG**

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Organic Green Cabbage from Pennsylvania is now available, from Lancaster County Amish growers Josh Weaver and Christ King. They expect to begin harvesting Organic Red Cabbage near the start of July.

LOCAL Organic Bunch Carrots, Bok Choy, Greens, and Bunch Leeks continue in strong supply from Flaim Farms in New Jersey.

**LOCAL** 25 lb **Organic Red Beets** from Eagle Shadow Farms in Pennsylvania have started with the first deliveries are expected in late June.

LOCAL Organic Kale, Collards, and Dandelions are in steady supply from Lady Moon Farms in Chambersburg, PA. Quality is excellent and Organic Green Kale remains a promotable item through the foreseeable future.



#### **OG LETTUCE**

LOCAL Organic Lettuce from Lady Moon Farms in Pennsylvania continues to be available but will soon conclude due to warmer temperatures. Additional supply from New Jersey remains, though this season will also wrap by the end of June.

Quebec and other northern regions will pick up the slack as local seasons wind down. Expect steady **Organic Lettuce** supply through summer until production resumes in PA and NJ.

**NOTE: Organic Iceberg Lettuce** from New Jersey is nearly finished, and California supply is tightening, leading to expected price increases.

NOTE: Organic Romaine Hearts from California remain available with elevated pricing and fair quality.



#### **OG TOMATOES**

**GOOD NEWS! Organic Cluster Tomatoes** remain promotable out of Canada. Pricing is aggressive and quality continues to be top-tier.

**Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes** quality continues to be excellent with consistent availability and pricing from Canada greenhouses.

**Organic Grape Tomatoes** are available from fields in North Carolina, showing nice quality. **OUTLOOK:** Lady Moon Farms' Pennsylvania **LOCAL** production of **Organic Snacking Tomatoes** is expected to start in early July.

Organic Snacking Tomatoes from Savoura in Quebec remain available. Their Organic Cocktail (Apero), Cerizo (Cherry), and Mini Apero (Cherry on the Vine) varieties continue to show exceptional flavor and quality.

**Organic Roma** and **Round Tomatoes** from North Carolina are in steady supply with strong quality.

## **Organic Pineapple** supply remains steady into mid-June.

**ALERT! Organic Peeled Garlic** remains tight but is expected to improve in late-June.

Organic Royal Star Papayas remain steady for mid-June.

**OTHER STORIES** 

**Organic Grapefruit** from California continues to show excellent quality and strong pricing.

NOTE: Earthbound is experiencing field quality issues due to bug pressure on Organic Baby Red Butter and Red Arugula during mid-June. Expect some out-of-stocks and lower fill-rates on those items.

# **NORTHWEST CHERRY SEASON BEGINS**







#### **CV BERRIES**

GOOD NEWS! New Jersey LOCAL Blueberries are now in season! Quality should be excellent and farms are reporting strong healthy plants and expected to have a great season through much of July. California and Southeastern growers will continue to harvest as well but we will move primarily to the New Jersey crops.

GOOD NEWS! Strawberries remain promotable out of California. Volumes remain strong out of Watsonville and Salinas, CA areas. Quality has been excellent.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries are promotable as domestic crops continue. Mexico harvests are finished for the season and will return in the fall. California fruit is expected to be excellent and Georgia fruit is starting as well. LOCAL New Jersey fruit will begin closer to July.

**Raspberries** are steady out of California. California crops are coming in and quality is expected to be strong. Mexico fruit is finished for the season.



#### **CV STONE FRUIT**

GOOD NEWS! Eastern Peaches out of South Carolina continue in excellent supply quality and size with some value small fruit available. These are expected to continue right up until the LOCAL New Jersey and Pennsylvania crops start during July.

GOOD NEWS! California White and Yellow Peaches and Nectarines are in promotable supplies with easing prices.

New California **Summeripe Yellow Peaches** and **Nectarines** pre conditioned fruit are now available. Make sure to give this premium fruit a try for the best customer experience.

California White Donut Peaches are now available in good supply in clamshells, loose, and punnet baskets.

Excellent supplies of California **Red** and **Black Plums** as well as **Red** and **Black Pluots/Plumcots** are now in excellent supply. Make sure to give all the different **Pluot/Plumcot** varieties a try to offer your customer a unique color and flavor experience.

GOOD NEWS! The 2025 Northwest Cherry season is here!

Growers in Washington have hit gas pedal with harvest volume as they're experiencing some hot temperatures in mid-June. This urgency to harvest, cool, and pack will help fill up the retail and wholesale **Cherry** supply chain more quickly during mid-to-late June. The new Washington fruit will also lead to more affordable pricing than seen during the now finished California **Cherry** season which fell short way short of volume projections due to weather.

The first Northwest **Dark Sweet Cherries** have arrived to the East Coast and showing nice quality! Prices are starting to come down and are expected to become promotable for July.

Four Seasons is offering **Dark Sweet Cherry** SKU options that include 18lb case random weight bagged Jumbo (8.5-8row), XXL (9.5-9row), XL/ LG (10.5-10row), and LG/MD (11.5-11row), plus 16/11b UPC'd Clamshells filled with 10.5row & larger fruit. New crop Washington **Rainier Cherries** will be available in 15lb cases of random weight bags and 16/11b UPC'd Clamshells starting 6/16.

A big Northwest **Cherry** promo and display contest is planned for July available to Four Seasons Produce independent retailer customers. Stay tuned and get ready to sell quality on the top sales-driving seasonal impulse item: Northwest **Cherries**!



**CV MELONS** 

Lots of specialty options are also available including Eastern 120 ct Athena Cantaloupe bins, 9ct Athena Cantaloupes cartons, 9 ct Tuscan Cantaloupes, 6 ct Golden Dews, 5 ct Gaya Melons, 6-8 ct Honey Kiss, and 4-12 ct Summer Kiss Melons.

Manageable volume and excellent quality are expected currently on **Cantaloupes** and **Honey-dews** coming from multiple southwest regions.

Eastern Vine-Ripe Jumbo **Honeydew** are available by request in 120 ct bins.

GOOD NEWS! Seedless and Seeded Watermelons are steady out of the southeast. North Florida crop is winding down as Georgia is starting up. An abundance of 45 ct fruit is available with 60s still a promotable option!

GOOD NEWS! Mini Seedless Watermelons are highly promotable in mid-June with a competitive deal on season ending Mexican fruit. Fruit is arriving perfectly ripe and ready for store display.



**CV SWEET CORN** 

GOOD NEWS! Sweet Corn remains promotable out of Georgia. Pricing will hold for a week or so but is expected to slowly increase as the peak harvests are winding down.

Time to get excited for LOCAL Sweet Corn. LOCAL Delaware grown Sweet Corn from Ray Vincent Farms is expected to begin around June 27th.



**CV HONEYCRISP APPLES** 

**NOTE:** Washington **Honeycrisp Apple** supplies continue to tighten. Expect very strong pricing and sporadic gaps in supply for the remainder of the season until new crop in the fall.

Import **Honeycrisp Apples** from Canada and Chile will also be sporadically available with strong pricing to compensate for some of the domestic gaps. So far the import fruit has been beautiful.



**CV RED ENDIVE** 

NEW: California grown Belgian-style **Red Endive** is now available in 8lb cases (code 230508) to compliment the California Belgian-style **White Endive** 10lb already offered (code 2890).



#### **CV GRAPES**

**Grapes** from Mexico continue to remain limited compared to last year due to heavy rain damage. **Green Grapes** are tight. **Red** and **Black Grape** supplies are affected by the rains. Prices are very unstable and high now regardless of Coachella, CA or Mexico supplies.

NOTE: Red Globe Seedless Grapes are in a gap.

The **Grape** category will improve in July when the San Joaquin Valley of California Comes into season.



#### **CV ASPARAGUS**

**NOTE: Asparagus** harvests out of New Jersey will end this week. It was a good **LOCAL** season but crops are finishing up and weeds are taking over.

Michigan harvests are expected to continue for through June and then we will transition back to Mexico and Peru. **Asparagus** quality has been excellent from all regions.



#### **CV PEPPERS**

Hothouse Peppers remain steady overall.

**GOOD NEWS! Red Bell Peppers** continues to be the most promotable color with spot buy opportunities.

Yellow and Orange Peppers remain available with good supply and quality out of Canada.

GOOD NEWS! Eastern Jumbo/XL Green Bell Peppers are in excellent supply with promo pricing for bigger displays during the rest of June. LOCAL will be starting by July.



#### **CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS**

**GOOD NEWS!** There was a gradual improvement in the conditions of **Brussels Sprouts** throughout early June. Decreased prices and enhanced quality are now yielding advantageous conditions for promotion. Similar conditions can be expected for the remainder of June.

Ocean Mist's "Roastables" Brussels Sprouts, Broccoli, and Cauliflower Kits are back in stock and selling well.



#### **CV LOCAL VEG**

LOCAL New Jersey Cabbage is looking very nice right now and supplies are great!

LOCAL Bunched Herbs, Scallions, and most Greens are still in good supply from New Jersey.

However, **Bunch Spinach** is experiencing some supply issues with some growers gapping and pricing increasing. **Dill** has slowly been coming back after a brief gap.



**CV FIGS** 

California has started their early **Fresh Fig** season with **Black Mission Figs** in a 12/8 oz clamshell. This season will only last a few weeks so be sure to get them as soon as possible on your shelves.



**CV AVOCADOS** 

Overall the **Hass Avocado** market is flush with fruit. The industry's main supply is still coming from Mexico but Colombia and Peru also have fruit. Mexico's pricing has been firm due to lower volumes of Negra crop fruit and that season's end looming. Expect dark colored fruit with higher oil content and some of the best eating **Hass Avocados** of the year from Mexico.

For a value option import 48 ct **Hass Avocados** from Colombia or Peru are in stock. These are being pre-conditioned for better eating experience.



#### **CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI**

GOOD NEWS! In California, **Cauliflower** growth continues to generate elevated yields and exceptional quality. With enhanced production conditions and the absence of quality issues, pricing has become competitive. Anticipate promotional opportunities in mid to late June.

**Broccoli Crown** production from North Carolina remains constrained as mid June approaches, resulting in elevated costs and restricted availability. The supplemental supply volume from California is priced higher. Pricing is expected to be just a little higher through June, yet still reasonable.

New Zealand **Green Kiwi** from Zespri has finally started. Volume filled **Green Kiwi** along with a clamshell option are in stock. **SunGold Kiwi** are steady from New Zealand.

**Pineapples** supplies are steady for the start of June. Look for deals on 6 ct fruit from Four Seasons for the middle of June. **HoneyGlow** and **PinkGlow Pineapples** are steady from Del Monte.



#### **CV CITRUS**

New item for summer: 18/2 lb Lemon-Lime Combo Bags will be offered from code 231841.

**Lemon** prices are ticking up a bit out of California. **NOTE: Seedless Lemons** from "Wonderful" have finished for the season.

**Mandarins Oranges** will transition fully into imports through the end of June as California starts to dry up with supply.

Import **Navel Oranges** are now available at a value compared to California. We have 56 ct and 9/3 lb bagged options available.



#### **CV LETTUCE**

GOOD NEWS! California grown Iceberg Lettuce is still readily accessible and of exceptional quality with excellent pricing and promotional opportunities. Moreover **Romaine** and **Leaf Lettuce** from California are competitively priced while providing outstanding quantity and superior quality.

**NOTE:** In recent weeks growers on the West Coast have seen a decline in **Romaine Heart** production which has led to a dramatic spike in price.

The harvest of LOCAL Leaf Lettuce and Romaine in New Jersey remains, however, due to rising summer temperatures the season is anticipated to conclude by the last week of June.

With the conclusion of the New Jersey season, supplies with transition to the summer Quebec **Lettuce** crop which will provide short transit times and good value. This production will encompass bulk **Leaf** and **Romaine** in addition to **Iceberg** and **Romaine Hearts**.

#### **OTHER STORIES**

**NOTE:** Imported **Pomegranates** from Chile and Peru will be winding down by mid June. This will be it for the summer until the California season starts.

ALERT! Pomegranate Arils are available in the Sun Belle label. The 4.4 oz cups will be winding down around mid-June.



#### **CV ARTICHOKES**

**GOOD NEWS! Artichoke** volumes from California remains strong as promotional opportunities continue into mid-June with outstanding quality and favorable costs. Build eye catching displays to generate consumer interest and boost sales.



#### **CV TOMATOES**

GOOD NEWS! Roma Tomatoes remain promotable overall with good production. Quality has been excellent out of Georgia and Florida.

GOOD NEWS! Beefsteak Tomatoes will be promotable out of Canada. With the added sunshine harvests are expected to increase leading to promotable volume and pricing. Quality has been excellent.

**Cluster Tomato** production remains steady. Demand is picking up but Canada production remains strong. Quality has been excellent.

GOOD NEWS! Snacking Tomatoes remain steady overall with Grape Tomatoes out of Florida and Georgia remaining the most promotable. Cherries, Medleys, and Cocktail Snacking Tomatoes all remain available out of Canada and Mexico greenhouses with steady supplies and nice quality.

**Green Beans** have inched up in price from North Carolina where quality has been excellent.

6/12oz Rambutan is now in season (code 17782)!


