EXCELLENT 2025 CROP OF ORGANIC PEARS





Organic Pears are in peak season from Oregon and Washington orchards! This year's crop is considerable and quality so far is very nice.



GOOD NEWS! Organic Bartlett, Bosc, and Starkrimson Red Pears are now in strong promotional supply.



New crop Organic Anjou Pears are expected to join the mix by mid-October.



"Shinko" variety Organic Asian Pears continue in peak season. Juicy, crunchy, and sweet!



OG BERRIES

OG HARD SQUASH

There is a full complement of LOCAL Organic Hard Squash in season and in stock at the moment from Central Pennsylvania Produce Co-op, with the exception of Organic Spaghetti, which is currently coming from Organic Valley's member farms in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.

Starting later in September, supply will transition to Wisconsin grown Organic Valley Organic Spaghetti Squash as the LOCAL season comes to an end.

One new addition to the category is LOCAL Organic Koginut Squash (code 221790). This variety is a cross between a Kabocha and Butternut, meant to be roasted whole and enjoyed. The flavor is sweet, creamy, and nutty with a smooth texture.

Organic Blackberries and Raspberries remain steady out of California with sharp quality and great flavor. Volume and pricing continue to hold steady.

Organic Strawberries continue to hold steady out of Santa Maria with consistent volume and pricing. NOTE: However, supplies are expected to decrease in early October with pricing likely to rise. Quality has been good overall, but warm overnight temperatures have caused more bruising than usual.

Organic Blueberry availability is set to improve as more fruit begins arriving at ports. Pricing has been expensive but is expected to ease slightly, with supplies improving week over week. Quality has remained excellent.



OG TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Heirloom Tomatoes from LOCAL PA Lady Moon Farms continue to produce abundant volumes with aggressive pricing and outstanding quality in September. As the month progresses and temperatures cool heading into October, volumes will soon begin to decline. Take advantage of promotional opportunities while they last.

LOCAL Organic Snacking Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms in Pennsylvania also remain available, though volumes are beginning to drop. Supply should remain steady, but pricing is expected to increase as September continues.

GOOD NEWS! Canadian greenhouse grown new crop Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes have become regularly available in September, with volumes quickly increasing to plentiful levels. As supply has grown, pricing has become more promotable and can be featured on ads to generate additional sales in late September and early October.



OG SWEET ONIONS

The last arrivals of **LOCAL** PA grown **Organic Sweet Onions** will wind down during late September.

Supply will transition to Nevada grown **Organic Sweet Onions** headed into October. This will include both bulk 40 lb JBO and 16/3 lb **Organic Sweet Onions**.



OG CELERY

Organic Celery is expected to tighten over the end of September due to low yields and high demand from California.

Organic Celery Hearts are expected to face the same challenges as growers monitor conditions.



OG ARTICHOKES

Organic Jumbo Artichokes will be in steadier supply starting the week of 9/21. New fields have opened producing good quality, and availability should continue with no foreseeable concerns as weather conditions remain favorable.



OG FENNEL

Organic Fennel is in good supply with excellent quality. Lady Moon Farms is starting up their Fall **Organic Fennel LOCAL** PA program and is expected to maintain outstanding quality.



OG GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Grapes are in good supply with great-tasting varieties and advantageous pricing, creating an excellent promotion period for the remainder of September.

Specialty offerings in clamshells include **Organic Autumn Crisp Greens, Organic Candy Snap Reds, and Organic Thomcord Grapes.**



OG KIWI BERRIES

Organic Kiwiberries are now in season! This tiny kiwi variety is eaten whole and features sweet tangy flavor when ripened to soft at room temp. Merchandise **Organic Kiwiberries** with your berries and grapes.

The Lil' Pranksters **Organic Kiwiberry** brand will be in stock around 9/24.



OG AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico are in great supply. Push and promote 48ct fruit! This popular size is expected to have an even lower price per case than other organic sizes.

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados** will experience a gap until October. Calavo Fair Trade will be stocked in the meantime.

Organic Green Skin Avocados from Florida remain steady in supply.



OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Cauliflower availability varies by region; the West Coast reports lower yields, while Canada and Maine remain flush with promotable product and outstanding quality.

NOTE: Organic Romanesco continues to face supply challenges with potential gaps due to limited availability, but improvements are expected as new fields open during the first week of October.



OG MANGOS

Late season **Organic Mangos** from Mexico are still available in limited quantities. This supply is expected to be exhausted by late September.

NOTE: California has begun shipping their **Organic Keitt Mango** variety for the season. Expect pricing to double.



OG PINEAPPLES

ALERT! A small amount of **Organic Pineapple** supply will provide some relief to empty retailer shelves for mid-September, but prices remain historically high. This is expected to continue for the remainder of the month.



OG ASPARAGUS

ALERT! Organic Asparagus production is very limited and prices are high. Growing areas in Mexico will provide some volume later this Fall.



OG SWEET PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Greenhouse **Organic Color Bell Peppers** are in favorable condition with excellent volume and aggressive costs in late September.

With consistent supply and promotable pricing, large displays should be built, and **Organic Color Bell Peppers** can be highlighted throughout the remainder of the month to drive sales.



OG APPLES

GOOD NEWS! New crop Washington Organic Gala and Sweetango Apples are in strong promotional supply across all sizes and packs.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Honeycrisp Apple prices have taken a sharp dip with plenty of fruit now available. It is an excellent time to begin promoting. Prices are expected to soften slightly in the coming weeks and months.

NOTE: Washington storage Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples will be in tight supply until new crop. The good news is that the release date has been moved up, and fruit is now expected to arrive in mid to late November instead of December as originally planned.

NOTE: Organic Pink Lady Apples have become very tight. Expect sporadic packing.



OG LETTUCE

Regeneratively grown Organic Romaine Hearts are available from Braga under the Josie's Organic label.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Lettuce production in Canada continues under ideal conditions and is very promotable across the category.

Organic Romaine remains promotable from Canada, while **Organic Romaine Hearts** from California follow similar trends.



OG BROCCOLI

Organic Broccoli prices jumped up significantly on the West Coast due to heat and weather patterns, combined with very high demand, while Mexico faces similar challenges and Canada continues to recover from higher temperatures and low yields over the past few weeks.

Organic Broccoli Crowns are very limited and costs have risen significantly.

OUTLOOK: Canadian suppliers are expected to ease the market as organic availability begins on the East Coast, helping reduce the impact of higher West Coast costs.

14 ct LOCAL Organic Stem Broccoli is available from Spring Willow Farm, just a few miles from Four Seasons in Lancaster County, PA.

OTHER STORIES

Several key new **Organic Tropical Fruits** arrivals for fall include **Kiwano Horned Melons**, **Passion Fruit**, and **Magenta Flesh Dragon Fruit** from California.

Organic Pomegranates are expected to begin sometime in early October from California.

Both **Organic Brown Turkey** and **Black Mission Figs** remain steady, but pricing has increased over the start of September.

Organic SunGold and **Green Kiwi** from Zespri are expected to see a price increase due to tariffs heading into late September. Supplies should remain steady.

ALERT! Organic Papayas continue to be only tighter for September. Quality has been fair to good.

Organic Greenhouse Seedless and Mini Cucumbers remain in consistent supply in late September.

While overall production remains average, some growers do have additional volumes of both commodities, creating spot promotional opportunities. Capitalize on these opportunities while they are available, as they will not last long.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Brussels Sprouts continue to be available with excellent quality and strong supply from Covilli and product coming out of Mexico.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Carrots are in good supply with strong quality and availability. Demand is beginning to increase as seasonal consumer habits shift toward root vegetable preparation.

NOTE: Organic French Beans are experiencing limited availability due to container delays, but this is expected to be short term. Demand is increasing with new fields opening, and markets are gradually dropping as we approach peak season.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

FALL FRUIT SEASON BEGINS



California Pomegranates are in season and volume continues to increase each week.

Four Seasons Fruit quality has been excellent. Four Seasons will again support the POM Wonderful Whole Pomegranate and **POM POM Arils** program this year starting in mid-October, with additional details to come.

Early season **Persimmons** have started in California. Four Seasons will carry a 10/2 lb pouch Bag with the **Chocolate Fuyu** variety to start. This variety features a chocolate-colored center with regular Persimmon flavor. The pouch includes a UPC for grab-and-go displays.

California grown **Quince** are now available and will continue to ship throughout the fall in a single-layer pack.

California fresh **Figs** have passed the peak of the season. **Black Mission** 12/8 oz clamshells are still available, but expect pricing to rise slightly in the coming weeks.



CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Eastern LOCAL Cortland, Empire, Red Delicious, and Snap Dragon Apples from PA and NY will be added at the end of September to the current mix of Eastern LOCAL Fuji, Gala, Ginger Gold, Honeycrisp, and McIntosh Apples.

GOOD NEWS! Washington Gala Apples are in excellent supply with promotional opportunities available. Honeycrisp Apples are also becoming promotable.

Washington **Granny Smith Apples** are expected to transition from old crop to new crop by early October. Quality is expected to remain excellent.

Washington Rave, Rockit, SugarBee, and Sweetango Apples are now in promotable supply.

NOTE: Pink Lady Apple supplies have tightened significantly, and a small gap may occur before new crop begins toward the end of October.



CV PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Washington Bartlett, Bosc, Comice, Happi, and Starkrimson Pears are in excellent promotional supply.

GOOD NEWS! Washington US#1 Anjou Pears are in excellent supply. Lower Fancy grade will also be added near the end of September to provide a strong value option with simply some occasional limb rub and scarring.

California and LOCAL Pennsylvania Asian Pears continue to deliver excellent quality and eating experience. Be sure to include these in your pear mix to drive sales.





CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries continue to be very promotable out of California. Harvests remain in flush with strong volumes, excellent quality, and outstanding flavor.

GOOD NEWS! Raspberries are promotable out of California and New Crop Mexico. California harvests remain strong, and new ranches in Central Mexico are now harvesting, creating a strong flush of product.

Blueberry volumes are beginning to increase slightly this week, with light volume coming from Peru. Pricing is easing. **OUTLOOK**: Quality remains outstanding. Promotable supplies are expected by mid-to-late October.

Strawberries remain steady overall. Northern California fields are winding down, Santa Maria harvests remain steady, and Oxnard is set to begin in the coming weeks. **NOTE**: Quality has been decent, though warm overnight temperatures are leading to more bruising than usual.



CV CABBAGE

LOCAL Pennsylvania Green Cabbage is starting up at the end of September in smaller volumes. Supply is expected to increase in the coming weeks.

Stay tuned for updates on **LOCAL** Pennsylvania **Bin Cabbage**.



CV MANGOS

Mangos from Brazil are in full swing. With the exit of Mexican fruit, demand now falls fully on Brazil, causing pricing to increase slightly for mid-September.

A small amount of "Pango Mango" **Keitt Mangos** are available from Puerto Rico. This fruit looks very nice!



CV PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Hothouse Color Bell Peppers continue with great volumes and low cost to entice larger displays and drive additional sales. Promo activity is expected to remain throughout the remainder of September and into October.

GOOD NEWS! Green Peppers remain promotable, with excellent supply and pricing from LOCAL New Jersey and Pennsylvania farms, along with supply from Canada as well.



CV OKINAWA SWEET POTATO

NEW ITEM: A new sweet potato variety with be available here at Four Seasons during the week of 9/21: **Okinawa Sweet Potatoes** grown in Hawaii. The **Okinawa Sweet Potato** originated on its island namesake in Japan, a region known for its long-living population. It has a pale white skin color with a lavender flesh, and is revered for it's high levels of anthocyanins that may offer health benefits. (FSP code 246272).



CV AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocados from Mexico remain promotable for mid-September.

Four Seasons Produce offers pre-conditioned fruit in all the sizes that we carry. This fruit will ripen more quickly for the consumer. Ripe fruit is a great way to drive incremental sales!



CV MELONS

Expect strong quality though more limited availability through October.

Cantaloupe and Honeydew supply is tightening as California slows down toward the end of the season.

Specialty Melon offerings include **Tuscans** and **Orange Honeydews**.



CV CAULIFLOWER

Cauliflower availability is mixed; the West Coast reports lower yields, while Canada and Maine are flush with promotable product and excellent quality.

NOTE: Varieties of colored **Cauliflower**, particularly **Purple**, experienced shortages but are back in good supply at the end of September.



CV GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! Grapes in California are peaking in supply across all colors, highlighting premium and preferred varieties, especially on the Jumbo and XL lines. There are prize deals available on LG size.

Specialty Grape offerings include Autumn Crisp Greens, Cotton Candy, Moon Drops, Gum Drops, Tear Drops, and Thomcord Grape.



CV LETTUCE

Artisan Lettuce, including **Sweet Gem** and **Artisan Romaine**, is an excellent addition to standard **Romaine** and **Iceberg** offerings.

Lettuce production in Canada has returned to steady levels, competing well with California prices.

Iceberg Lettuce from both Canada and California is promotable and expected to continue.



CV CELERY

Celery has good availability, though prices are expected to tighten over the next few weeks due to low yields and high demand out of California.

Celery Hearts are facing the same challenges as growers continue to monitor growing conditions.



CV PEAS

Snow, Snap, and **English Peas** are in good supply arriving from Peru and Guatemala, presenting deal opportunities.

Shelled English Peas in 10/12 oz Bags are back after a long-term absence from Southern Specialties, with steady supply and improved pricing expected as we approach peak season.



CV LOCAL BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Pennsylvania **LOCAL** 60 ct **Bin Jacket Cauliflower** is now in season with outstanding quality.

Pennsylvania **LOCAL** 110 ct **Bin Stalk Broccoli** is readily available with nice quality and market appeal.



CV STONE FRUIT

LOCAL New Jersey Peaches are expected to wrap up at the end of September. California and Washington Peaches will continue into early October, but supplies could end at any time.

Nectarines are winding down for the season and are expected to finish by the end of September, though some fruit may linger into early October.

Now is the time to highlight the best-of-season **Green/Yellow, Mottled,** and **Red** varieties before they are gone. California **Plumcots** in both bulk and punnets are expected to begin wrapping up over the month of October.



CV BROCCOLI CROWNS

NOTE: Broccoli prices tightened significantly on the West Coast due to heat and weather patterns, combined with very high demand while Mexico endures similar challenges and Canada continues to recover from higher temperatures and low yields over the past few weeks.

Despite price increases, **Broccoli Crowns** remain competitive as we rely on Maine, Virginia, and Canadian production to moderate market averages. West Coast prices are expected to improve in October, with some growers in a better position than others.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Conditions of greenhouse Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes continue to be consistent with strong quality and favorable costs as late September approaches. Continue promotions and highlight on large displays to drive additional sales during the remainder of the month.

Snacking Tomato varieties remain in stable conditions during late September. Strong quality and regular availability make for excellent promotional conditions during the latter parts of September.

OTHER STORIES

Eggplant remains steady, and Southern states will begin producing soon to help ensure consistent supply.

Scallions are beginning to show some strength in the prices out of Mexico. Supplies are good, but a potential increase in pricing may occur.

Green and **Yellow Squash** are in good supply. Both **LOCAL** Northeastern growers and Southeastern growers are in solid condition, with pricing steady to decreasing on **Green Squash** and decreasing on **Yellow Squash**.

ALERT! Pineapples remain in tight supply, though volumes are trending in the right direction. Pricing is expected to decrease several dollars per case over the next few weeks but will not reach promotable levels.

Super Select Cucumbers remain fairly steady in price, with supplies looking good. Georgia and the Carolinas are starting production, which should bolster supply and keep prices steady, if not slightly improving.

NOTE: Seedless Cello Cucumbers volumes are slightly improving as late September begins though pricing is high.

GOOD NEWS! Mini Cucumbers continue to experience consistent volume and great quality. Favorable production continues to drive consistent pricing.
