PEAK SEASON ORGANIC APPLES



GOOD NEWS! Organic Apples are abundant in peak season and promotable!

Make sure to take advantage of the great supply, quality, and pricing on Washington Organic Ambrosia, Cosmic Crisp, Envy, Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Honeycrisp, Kanzi, Pink Lady, and Sweetango for our Stemilt Organic Apple promotion 10/13 to 11/19.

GOOD NEWS! Spot-buy deals will be available on **Organic Honeycrisp Apples** especially on XL sizes like 48-56 ct in 40 lb cases, plus LG in 27 lb cases.

Organic McIntosh Apples are done packing and are expected to sell out for the season before the end of October. Get them on your shelves now.

New crop **Organic Washington Rockit Apples** have arrived with excellent supplies expected in 6/3 lb "shuttles".

New crop **Organic SugarBee Apples** are due in stock around 10/16, and excellent supplies are expected to continue for peak season of late Fall and Winter.

Other special varieties available include; Organic Ambrosia, Cosmic Crisp (still old crop), Envy, and Kanzi Apples. Organic Lady Alice Apples will arrive in late October.



OG AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico are in excellent supply, with 48 ct fruit highly promotable.

60 ct fruit is slightly more limited though affordable, and a 70 ct option from Calavo is available at a value.

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados** will be available in 48 and 60 ct sizes, and the popular 8/4 ct Ready-Cycle Trays are back in stock (Code: 231906).

Organic Green Skin Avocados from Florida remain steady and available.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blackberries remain steady overall out of California. Quality has been nice, and volume and pricing are steady. Production is expected to slow down by November, and Central Mexico has not been able to harvest due to severe weather conditions.

NOTE: Organic Blueberries will remain on the tighter side next week as supply continues to be light and port delays cause minor hold-ups in loading. Quality is excellent out of Peru, and similar market conditions are expected through the end of October.

ALERT! Organic Raspberries will be extremely tight starting 10/11 as California production declines faster than anticipated. Central Mexico's volume is not strong yet, creating a gap in supply, so pro-rates and limits should be expected in mid to late October.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries will also remain extremely tight. Production continues to decline out of California, and more rain is expected early next week. Quality has improved, though is not perfect. Limits and pro-rates should be anticipated, with pricing continuing to rise.



OG LOCAL VEG

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green Kale, Lacinato Kale, and Red Kale are all in promotable supply with excellent quality from LOCAL Lady Moon Farms in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania. Quality is excellent!

LOCAL Organic Eggplant from Lady Moon Farms in Pennsylvania is wrapping up for the season, but new production is set to begin in Florida in late-October. Supplies from the Southeast and New Jersey will help bridge the transition.

LOCAL Organic Green Beans are winding down from local Pennsylvania grower Marc Reed, with supply expected through mid-October. After that, look for 30lb Organic Green Beans from Mexico or California to fill the gap.



OG KIWIBERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Kiwiberries from

Oregon are in full production, with abundant availability and competitive pricing. A few more weeks of harvest are expected and big promos are available on this seasonal snack.



OG PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Peak season for Organic Pears is rocking! Bags and Bulk (US #1 and Fancy) are available.

New crop **Organic Anjou** and **Comice Pears** are expected to join the mix of **Asian, Bartlett, Bosc,** and **Starkrimson Pears** already in house for mid-October.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Euro and Organic Mini Cucumbers have become increasingly promotable in October due to higher volumes, good quality and aggressive pricing, encouraging early-month promotions.



OG FENNEL

GOOD NEWS! Organic Fennel from LOCAL Lady Moon Farms in PA is very promotable with excellent quality!

As the weather cools, this becomes a great item to promote and highlight.



OG GRAPES

Organic Grapes are at peak quality, with heavy supply and excellent flavor across all colors.

October is a prime time to promote these standout varieties like "Adora" Black Seedless, "Autumn Crisp" Green Seedless, and "Timco" and "Scarlotta" Red Seedless.



OG CABBAGE

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green Cabbage is abundant and promotable, with excellent quality from LOCAL Pennsylvania growers Lady Moon Farms, Christ King, and Joshua Weaver.



OG MANGOS

ALERT! California **Organic Green Keitt Mangos** are limited in supply and expected to remain scarce through October.

Ecuador **Organic Mangos** are anticipated to begin by the end of October, with meaningful volume likely in November.



OG CAULIFLOWER

LOCAL Organic Jacket Cauliflower (12 ct & 9 ct) is available from Lancaster County, PA.

NOTE: West Coast **Organic Cauliflower** yields are light, and some arrivals are showing slight discoloration.

NOTE: Organic Romanesco is currently in a temporary gap but is expected to return shortly as new fields open and this week's harvest restores availability. There is also potential for a LOCAL Organic Romanesco opportunity as alternate growers begin trial production late this month.



OG MELONS

Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons continue out of California. New fields in the southern region of the state are providing excellent late-season product.

NOTE: Organic Honeydews have finished for the season, while Organic Cantaloupes will remain available till around mid to late October.



OG FALL FRUIT

Organic Fuyu Persimmons are now available in single layer packs, with Organic Hachiya Persimmons expected shortly.

Organic Pomegranates and **Pomegranate Arils** are available at higher pricing, which should ease as more growers come online.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus supply has improved significantly, with pricing beginning to ease.



OG PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Color Bell Peppers remain promotable in volume and cost during early October, though availability is expected to tighten later in the month. Canadian-grown Organic Peppers continue to offer outstanding quality.

Florida production of **Organic Green Peppers** will begin in the next few weeks, and **Organic Jalapeño Peppers** have already started harvesting there.



OG TOMATOES

Organic Cluster Tomatoes are plentiful in early October.

LOCAL Organic Snacking Tomato varieties and Organic Heirloom Tomatoes from Lady Moon Farms in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania are experiencing a decrease in volume as cooler temperatures arrive. Supplemental product will be needed through mid-October. Lady Moon's Florida production is expected to begin in late October.



OG LETTUCE

Organic Lettuce production in Quebec is winding down while maintaining strong quality.

New Jersey is beginning to harvest, creating a smooth transition between late-season Quebec product and the new fall crop **LOCAL Organic Lettuce** from New Jersey through mid-October.

Organic Romaine remains promotable from both Canada and California, with steady availability and strong quality.

ALERT! As the growing season gets ready to transition from Salinas, CA to southern CA and then AZ this fall, Organic Salad grower-shippers are reporting quality issues on some tender leaf items that are causing some occasional pro-rates and out-of-stocks from brands like Organicgirl on Baby Arugula and Butter.



OG BROCCOLI

LOCAL Organic Stalk Broccoli (14 ct) and LOCAL Organic Purple Stalk Broccoli (14 ct) from Spring Willow Farm are available and producing well for the Fall in modest supply from Lancaster County, PA.

ALERT! Organic Broccoli remains tight on the West Coast due to recent heat and quality concerns, including pin rot. Supply from Canada and East Coast growers is helping ease cost pressure.

NOTE: The Organic Brown Turkey and Black Mission Fig season is winding down, resulting in limited availability and higher pricing.

Organic Bunch Spinach supplies are improving out of California, though pricing has not eased significantly yet.

NOTE: Organic Grapefruit supplies are very limited this week with inconsistent sizing. Better availability is anticipated toward the end of October.

OTHER STORIES

NOTE: Organic Valencia Oranges are nearing the end of their season, with most shippers now finished. Expect limited supply and elevated prices through the rest of October. OUTLOOK: California Organic Navels are set to begin in early November.

Organic Corn is in its final harvest out of Lamont, California. Sizing is slightly smaller compared to previous arrivals, but pricing remains very attractive.

Organic Brussels Sprouts have good supply from Mexico, with some minor weather-related quality concerns.

NOTE: Organic Celery is tightening up due to California weather and yield pressure, and Organic Celery Hearts face similar challenges.

NOTE: Organic Artichokes continue to face supply challenges following brief gaps caused by insect and mildew pressure, along with inconsistent weather creating sizing issues.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

OCTOBER 10 - OCTOBER 17, 2025

PROMOTABLE AVOCADOS FROM MEXICO



GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocados from Mexico continue to have strong supply and value pricing, providing excellent opportunities for promotion through October. Point-of-Sale Bins to help drive sales are available, so ask your rep for more info.

36 ct, 48 ct, 60 ct, and bags are all abundant!

Four Seasons also offers pre-conditioned fruit in all available sizes, which ripens more quickly for consumers and provides a great way to increase incremental sales.





CV FALL FRUIT

Fuyu and Hachiya Persimmons are now in season and available in 16/18 ct single layer packs. It is important to educate customers on how to best enjoy Persimmons: Fuyu can be eaten when firm, like an apple, while Hachiya must be eaten very soft, like a soft mango.

Chocolate Fuyu Persimmons in pouch bags are finished for the season.

GOOD NEWS! California Pomegranates continue to be in strong supply with excellent quality! POM POM Arils in 4 oz and 8 oz options will be available by mid-October, with POM Wonderful Whole Pomegranates arriving around 10/20 in 22 ct and 30 ct cartons plus display bins.

California-grown **Quince** is now available in single layer packs and will be offered throughout the fall.

First of the season Ocean Spray fresh **Cranber- ries** are in stock now.



CV CITRUS

Import **Navel Orange** supplies from offshore regions are tightening as the season winds down, and prices are trending upward.

The first new crop California **Navel Oranges** of the season are expected to arrive around 10/20.

Sunkist Meyer Lemon 18/1 lb bags are back in season.

Specialty Citrus offerings remain abundant with excellent inventory on Blood Oranges (both bulk and bagged), Cara Cara Oranges, Minneolas, and Heirloom Navels. This is a great time to feature Import Specialty Citrus and capture additional sales.

New crop Florida Citrus season is underway with "Hamlin" Juice Oranges and "Starburst" Pummelos now available, and Fall Glo Tangerines arriving by 10/12. New crop Florida Grapefruit will start in the second half of October.

Import **Dekopons** are finished for the season. **OUTLOOK:** California **Sumo Citrus Dekopons** come into season in mid-December.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Raspberries will remain promotable in mid-October, with plentiful supplies, value pricing and good quality.

NOTE: Blackberries will be very tight as California harvests begin to slow down and Mexico has experienced hurricane-force winds and rain. Volume is limited, and pricing is expected to increase.

NOTE: Blueberry demand remains strong as port delays continue to affect the light volume arriving in the market. Volumes are expected to increase in early November, but availability is likely to remain light until then. Quality has been excellent.

ALERT! Strawberries will continue to be very tight. Pricing is expected to increase slightly as growers continue to fall short of estimated production. Quality is improving with cooler temperatures, but fruit is not ripening as fast as expected and some bruising is still seen. Rain early next week could make supplies even shorter, and demand will continue to exceed supply.



CV KIWIBERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Kiwiberries are in a strong flush out of Oregon. Plenty of product is available at competitive pricing, and production is expected to continue for a through October.



CV ASPARAGUS

Asparagus production continues to improve with Mexico producing strong volume. Peru remains in full swing from both northern and southern regions. Prices fell sharply but are beginning to rise slightly; as new fields open and demand increases, pricing should return to average levels.



CV PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Color Bell Peppers from Canada remain available with favorable volume and quality, creating promotable pricing. Conditions are expected to ease back to average by late October. Slight increases in cost may occur then, but availability and quality remain consistent. Mexican production will be available as a supplemental option.



CV CORN

LOCAL Corn from New Jersey has extended its season due to favorable weather. Prices are steady, with Bi-Color Corn leading movement. White and Yellow Corn are concluding for the season.



CV GREEN BEANS

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Green Beans are coming into stronger supply with promotable pricing as southeastern growing regions ramp up production. Pennsylvania is finishing its LOCAL season, while LOCAL New Jersey continues to provide decent volume.



CV CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Cucumbers remain abundant and promotable, with steady supplies coming out of Georgia and North Carolina. Additional product is also crossing through Nogales from Mexico, adding to availability.

GOOD NEWS! Euro and Mini Cucumbers from Canada continue to have big volumes and nice quality throughout October. These favorable conditions provide promotional opportunities for both varieties during the middle of the month.



CV CAULIFLOWER

ALERT! California Cauliflower growers are really struggling with quality concerns in mid-October. Maine growers are seeing the yields they expected either. Pricing is spiking up as supplies suddenly dwindle.

ALERT! Color Cauliflower varieties, especially **Purple Cauliflower**, experienced a temporary crop failure but are now back in supply.



CV GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! Grapes remain in excellent condition across all varieties and sizes. Supply is strong, quality is outstanding, and markets are holding steady. October is an ideal time to promote California Grapes, as eating quality is exceptional.



CV LETTUCE

ALERT! Iceberg Lettuce and Romaine Hearts are going up in price as California quality is weak with Salinas, CA fields ending and cold weather winds down the Quebec season. The growing season transition is here for October and early November and it could be a little bumpy.



CV CELERY

Celery remains in good supply for now, though tightening is expected as California faces lower yields and stronger demand. The same conditions apply to **Celery Hearts**.





CV SQUASH

COCAL Lancaster County, PA Regeneratively
Grown Hard Squash from Cedar Meadow
Farms continues in full swing, with excellent quality being reported by grower Steve Groff. Strong supplies of Acorn, Butternut, and Spaghetti
Squash are expected to last through Christmas, offering great opportunities for promotion.

Green and **Yellow Squash** prices are beginning to firm as **LOCAL** supplies decline from Pennsylvania and slow down from New Jersey. Georgia and North Carolina remain in good supply, though pricing is trending slightly higher, though still affordable.

ALERT! Brussels Sprouts remain very limited as high temperatures have negatively impacted yields and sizing, keeping markets above average. Improvement is being seen as New Jersey availability opens up.

NOTE: Mangos from Brazil are currently in a demand-exceeding-supply situation for mid-October. Container delays have caused pricing to spike, particularly on larger 9 ct fruit. There are a few **Keitt Mangos** available from Puerto Rico, which are eating well.

Seedless Watermelons are finishing up for the season in Delaware and North Carolina, with new crop Florida set to begin shortly after. Increased freight costs are expected to strengthen markets.





CV SALADS

ALERT! As the Salad growing season gets ready to transition from Salinas, CA to southern CA and then AZ and Mexico this fall, Salad grower-shippers are reporting quality issues on some lceberg and Romaine items for October that are causing some occasional pro-rates and out-of-stocks on Garden and America salads. Foodservice packs of Chopped Iceberg and Romaine bulk salads are going up in price during this time too.



CV BROCCOLI CROWNS

NOTE: Broccoli supply remains tight due to West Coast heat, high precipitation, and heavy demand, resulting in higher prices.

OTHER STORIES

Mini Seedless Watermelons continue out of California, with supplies expected to ramp up again once the Florida season begins. Mexico fruit should become available toward the end of the month. Prices are steady and expected to remain consistent.

Melon production continues with large sizing on both **Cantaloupes** and **Honeydews**. The transition from California to Arizona and Mexico later this Fall is expected to be seamless, with prices remaining consistent through the change.

North Carolina #1 Sweet Potato prices are easing in mid-October as some shippers begin packing new crop, increasing overall supply.





CV LOCAL BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

LOCAL Broccoli in 110 ct bins from Stauffer Huling Farms is showing excellent quality.

LOCAL Cauliflower in 60 ct bins from Stauffer Huling Farms is showing excellent quality and strong supply, and both 12 ct and 9 ct LOCAL Naked Cauliflower are also available.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes continue to produce consistently high-quality fruit at value pricing. Early in October, conditions remain stable, though as the month progresses, higher pricing is expected.

GOOD NEWS! Roma and Round Tomatoes maintain stable availability, quality, and pricing during early to mid-October. Both varieties remain excellent for promotion, with opportunities for spot deals throughout the month.

GOOD NEWS! Eggplants continue to be promotable, with steady supply from both New Jersey and southeastern growers.

NOTE: Artichokes are limited supply due to insect damage and ongoing quality issues. Cooler weather is expected to help improve yields. The popular 12 ct Jumbo size remains the hardest to secure, as only one or two buds per plant typically reach that size.

HACHIYA PERSIMMONS

APPEARANCE:

Cone-shaped with bright-orange skin

WHEN'S IT READY?

Must ripen at room temperature to a soft, gooey state before eating, baking, or cooking

HOW TO EAT:

When soft, rinse, slice the top off, spoon out the pudding like flesh for a sweet snack or to use as an ingredient in baking

HEADS UP!

Hard, unripe Hachiyas, are full of tannins and are so astringent that they'll draw your cheeks and lips to a pucker
