ORGANIC POTATO PRIME QUALITY









GOOD NEWS! Organic Potatoes are in peak season from the 2025 late summer harvests in various growing regions throughout the US and Canada. Quality is good and prices are affordable for promotions headed into the holidays. Now is the time to enhance your organic potato sets and assortment to drive fall cooking and holiday sales!

Organic Russet Potatoes are primarily from Wisconsin with 10/5lb and 16/3lb bags in the Alsum brand and 50lb bulk 70/80s - all with solid quality.

Organic Red Potatoes bag and bulk supplies will transition to the excellent muck-soil growing region of Manitoba, Canada in the Poplar Grove brand. **Organic Gold Potatoes** bag and bulk product will be available from Wisconsin and Manitoba with nice appearance expected.

Consumer are in love with mini potatoes and sales continue to grow!

"Tasteful Selections" brand **Organic Mini Potatoes** are in peak season in 1-Bite (small) 12/24oz and Nibble (tiny) 12/16oz packs for **Organic Ruby Sensations**, **Honey Gold**, and **Sunrise Medley** options.

NEW: "Little Potato Co" has come out with an 8/1.5lb pouch bag **Organic Little Yellows** option - now in stock!





OG LETTUCE & SALADS

ALERT! Out west, Organic Iceberg and Romaine are very limited and pricing is rising significantly. Expect challenges to continue into November on Organic Iceberg and Romaine Hearts specifically as growers deal with California rain and growing region transition.

Organic Lettuce is finished out of Quebec, and we'll gradually mix into New Jersey crop on Organic Leaf, Romaine, and Iceberg.

ALERT! Organic Salad shippers are coping with poor quality and low yields on certain Organic Tender Leaf items due to rain in California and growing region transition. Expect wonky Organic Salad fill-rates and iffy shelf-life during October and the first half of November until winter production fully ramps up in Yuma, AZ.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blueberry supplies remain steady overall. A slight increase in production is expected. Overall availability remains consistent with excellent quality

Organic Blackberries remain available. California volume continues to decline quickly, but Mexico is starting to produce more fruit with favorable weather, resulting in very nice quality.

ALERT! Organic Raspberry supplies continue to be short. California harvests are decreasing, and Mexico production remains limited. Pricing is rising, and expect small gaps and limits on some days.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries remain very tight. Production in both California and Mexico is very limited, and pricing is expected to continue increasing. Overall quality has been good.



OG APPLES

New crop Washington **Organic Opal Apples** are now in season, offering amazing quality and excellent supply.

New crop **Organic Pink Lady Apples** have started in limited supply. Expect supplies to ramp up as we move into November.

The end of October will bring in the Rainier proprietary varierty, **Organic Lady Alice Apples**.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Apples are generally in peak season with Gala and Honeycrisp being highly promotable!

ALERT! Washington Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples are now officially in a gap and are expected to be missing from shelves for several weeks until new crop arrives on the East Coast around November 24th. Once the new crop begins, a huge crop of excellent quality fruit is expected.



OG ROOT VEG

GOOD NEWS! New Organic Root Vegetable items are expected to arrive at the end of October from Harmony Valley Farms in Wisconsin. These will include Organic Bagged Burdock Root, Beauty Heart Radishes, Bagged Soup Mix Root Vegetables, and Scarlet Turnips.

Organic Turnips and **Rutabagas** continue in good supply.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts are enduring quality concerns from insect damage out of Mexico, and border delays have caused issues on availability. Expect pricing to rise and minor shortages due to availability. Availability from alternative East Coast growers should alleviate pricing and provide quality with no concern.



OG MANDARINS

OUTLOOK:

New crop California **Organic Mandarins** will begin with early Clementines arriving to the East coast around 11/4.

"Organic Cuties" and "Organic Halos" brand **Organic Clementines** will start in mid-November for their new crop programs.

Organic Satsuma Mandarins will also begin during November. Stay tuned!



OG LADY MOON GREENS

Organic Greens from **LOCAL** Lady Moon Farms in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, are expected to last through the end of October.

Then, harvesting of **Organic Kales** and **Collards** is expected to begin on their Florida farm around the first of November. Quality has been outstanding.



OG CUCUMBERS

Organic Cucumbers continue to be in good supply out of Lady Moon Farms in Florida. They are expected to wrap up production in early November. Quality has been very good.

Then, in November supplies will transition to new crop Mexico grown **Organic Cucumbers**.



OG GRAPES

Heavy rain in California affected **Organic Grapes**, causing some shippers to move up season end dates, while others like SunPacific/Airchief were well-prepared with crop coverage and plan to continue shipments into December. New crop imports are expected to begin arriving by early November.

Clamshell **Organic Autumn Crisp Green Grapes** continue in season, but will transition from 8/2lb clamshells to 10/2lb in code 46689.



OG CABBAGE

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green Cabbage is abundant and promotable. LOCAL Pennsylvania growers, including Lady Moon Farms, Joshua Weaver, and Christ King, continue with strong supplies, and some Organic Red Cabbage is beginning to arrive.



OG CAULIFLOWER

Organic Color Cauliflower is available and producing an eye-catching deep Purple and Orange from one of our LOCAL PA Organic farmers.

LOCAL PA Organic Jacket White Cauliflower is also available in modest supply.

ALERT! Out west, **Organic Cauliflower** pricing moved up quickly and materially, driven by crop volatility and tight availability durring growing region transition and California rains.



OG CHESTNUTS

A small amount of USA Fresh **Organic Chestnuts** are available in 10lb packs. Get them while you can!





OG CUT VEG


ALERT! Taylor/Earthbound and other shippers are facing serious supply issues for late October and early November on input product for their cut veg lines, particularly Organic Broccoli, Cauliflower, and Snow Peas - all due to California rains plus growing region transition. Earthbound expects occasional gaps in supply or pro-rates for Organic Broccoli and Cauliflower Florets, Rice Cauliflower, and Snow Pea SKUs during mid-October. In addition, packaged Organic Green Beans will see some fill-rate hiccups.



OG AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico are in great supply. Promote Organic 48 ct Fruit as a strong feature item. Organic 60 ct fruit is slightly more limited.

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados** are available in 48 ct and 60 ct sizes. The popular 8/4 ct Ready-Cycle Trays are also in stock, so look for opportunities to feature these.



The **Organic Valencia Orange** season has ended in California. New crop **Organic Navel Oranges** are expected to start in the first week of November with smaller sizing and higher pricing to start.



OG ONIONS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Yellow, Red, White, and Sweet Onions, plus Shallots from Peri & Sons have been arriving with excellent ratings! The quality is absolutely outstanding and ideal for promotions headed towards fall cooling season and the holidays.



OG FL PEPPERS & EGGPLANT

Organic Green Peppers are slowly ramping up in volume from Lady Moon Farms in Florida, with availability improving steadily.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Eggplant is starting in promotable volumes out of Lady Moon Farms in Florida. Quality has been excellent so far.



OG FALL FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! Organic Pomegranates and Pomegranate Arils are in peak season! Four Seasons is carrying both a large size and a smaller value option in 2-layer packs of fresh Organic Pomegranates.

Organic Fuyu and **Hachiya Persimmons** are now in season in single layer packs!

GOOD NEWS! Fresh Organic Cranberries are now in peak season for the fall. 18/8oz bags will be available from the OceanSpray growers coop through November

ALERT! Rain in California may have effectively ended the Organic Brown Turkey and Black Mission Fig season. Some growers may have a slightly later Brown Turkey crop, but availability will be limited.



OG BROCCOLI

NOTE: Organic Broccoli pricing is still high but is beginning to ease for late October. West Coast shippers are reporting reduced yields, but the quality issues are improving (pin rot, discoloration).

PA LOCAL 14 ct Green/Purple Organic Broccoli Stalks will be available through November.

ALERT! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli prices have climbed significantly with active prorates. Few shippers have volume. Pricing remains high but is expected to improve in early November.

ALERT! Organic Broccoli Rabe (Rapini) is proprietary to the Andy Boy label and ships exclusively from California. Pricing continues to rise and availability remains limited with prorates being endured from the grower who is the only source for this item. Challenges continue due to excess rain.

OTHER STORIES

Organic Passion Fruit and Organic Kiwano Horned Melons from California are available in limited supply for the remainder of October.

Organic Asparagus supply has been steady and pricing is gradually dropping slightly as availability continues to open. West Coast loading with minimal crossings out of TX and FL are impacting freight costs due to growing regions in Mexico and contracts primarily held on the West Coast.

NOTE: California Organic Keitt Mangos are available in sparse expensive supply, but the season is winding down. A gap may develop in Organic Mangos until Ecuador begins. Small volumes of Ecuador Organic Mangos should start arriving soon, with meaningful availability expected later in November.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

PEAK SEASON PEARS











GOOD NEWS! Late October through Christmas will be the best time of the year to promote a full variety of **Organic Pears** while quality, availability, and affordability are at their peak!

The 2025 crop from the Oregon and Washington has come in with better volume than last year and plenty of options to get behind displays and promos. All varieties are in season for color breaks, texture options, and flavor profiles.

Here are the options available to promote:

Asian: 14-18ct Western, 14-18ct PA LOCAL from Subarashi Kudamono **Green D'Anjou:** 44lb US #1 bulk, 27lb US#1 2-layer, #44lb Fancy grade (occasional limb-rub and scars, priced at value)

Bartlett: 44lb US #1 bulk, 27lb US#1 2-layer, #44lb Fancy grade (occasional limb-rub and scars, priced at value), 9/3lb Lil Snapper Pouch bags **Bosc:** 44lb US #1 bulk, 27lb US#1 2-layer, #44lb Fancy grade (occasional limb-rub and scars, priced at value), 9/3lb Lil Snapper Pouch bags

Comice: 20lb Forelle: 20lb

Happi Pear: 27lb 2-layer, 12/2lb pouch bags

Red Starkrimson: US #1 bulk 20lb, US #1 27lb 2-layer

Seckel: 20lb



CV CITRUS

New crop California **Stem and Leaf Mandarins** in bulk will be available for the last week of October.

Import **Mandarins** continue to deliver strong quality. California **Mandarin Oranges** are expected to begin in the first week of November.

New crop California **Navel Oranges** have started harvesting and coming to market with steep pricing. Imported **Navel Oranges** will remain in steady supply through the first week of November.

The import season for **Cara Cara Oranges** has ended, though some smaller fruit is still available for bagging. California **Cara Cara Oranges** are expected to start mid-December.

Florida Citrus continues to be in strong supply, including Fall Glo Tangerines, Juice Oranges (Hamlin), and Sunburst Pummelos. Florida Grapefruit are starting and will be in stock for November.





CV LETTUCE & SALADS

ALERT! Iceberg and **Romaine** are very limited, and prices are rising significantly. Challenges are expected to continue through the end of October, especially on **Romaine Hearts** and **Iceberg Lettuce** due to poor quality from rain and growing region transition.

NOTE: Leaf Lettuce is winding down out of Quebec as we transition more into New Jersey and rely on California growers.

ALERT! Salad producers are struggling with quality and yields for **Romaine**, **Iceberg** and some **Tender Leaf** based **Salad** products due to California rains and growing region transition.

ALERT! Expect occasional prorates and out-ofstocks on some items across all brands and shorter shelf-life due to the weaker input quality. Fast turns are encouraged during late October and the first half of November until Salad shippers are in their new winter growing regions down south like Yuma, AZ.



CV BERRIES

Blueberries continue to be available out of Peru with excellent quality. Supply has slightly improved, although a significant portion of fruit is still being shipped to Europe and Asia. November promo pricing has been adjusted up as less volume will arrive than anticipated.

Blackberry volume is beginning to slowly increase out of Central Mexico as weather conditions have improved, allowing for better harvests and quality. Pricing is expected to ease slightly with the improved availability.

NOTE: Raspberries remain short out of Mexico. While weather has improved, volume is tight due to crop cycles. Quality has been very nice, and pricing is expected to continue rising.

ALERT! Strawberries continue to be limited out of California and light out of Mexico. Pricing is expected to remain high as volume remains very restricted. Overall quality has improved over the past few weeks, but availability will remain tight well into November.



CV ARTICHOKES

NOTE: Artichokes in 12 ct continue to command high pricing with very limited availability due to temperatures and climate pressures. Some 18 ct are available as an alternative. Pricing is gradually easing and prorates are starting to come off.



CV MANGOS

Some of the first **Ataulfo Honey Mangos** have arrived from Ecuador. This variety is typically the first from a new growing region and is available in limited supply.

Mangos from Brazil continue to command higher pricing than historically typical for this time of year. Ecuador will be starting soon, though overall forecasts indicate supply will be lower than last year.



CV PEPPERS

NOTE: Mini Mix Sweet Peppers remain tight in availability, and pricing is rising to reflect that. Canadian hothouse growers are producing limited volumes, and cheaper product from Mexico has been tight.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

NOTE: Brussels Sprouts, which have been very expensive pricing are showing some relief as primary growers, including Ocean Mist, are easing allocations. Most other shippers are expected to follow, with crop sizing improving and fewer quality concerns reported.



CV EASTERN APPLES

The end of October will bring in a new collection of PA/NY eastern **LOCAL Apples** to the mix. **Evercrisp**, a sweet, crisp cross between a Honeycrisp and a Fuji, and **Ruby Frost**, delivering a sweet-tart flavor from its parents Braeburn and Autumn Crisp, are now available.

Macoun, an old favorite with juicy, firm flesh, and Rome, a predominantly baking apple that develops more flavor as it cooks, have also arrived.

Stayman/Winesap, primarily used in cider and pies, has joined the mix too.



CV VARIETAL APPLES

NEW: **Lemonade Apples**, with their bright yellow skin, are a great color break and offer excellent juiciness.

LucyGlo Apples are in house as well, with their unique tart flavor and reddish interior, the sister variety to LucyRose Apples which also have redflesh with red skin and sweeter flavor.

New crop Envy, Hunnyz, Kissabel, Rave, Rockit, RubyFrost (Eastern), SnapDragon (Eastern), SugarBee, and SweeTango are all in season for premium apple snackers!



CV CAULIFLOWER

LOCAL cello-wrapped 9 ct and 12 ct Cauliflower from Pennsylvania are in the mix with West Coast supply, helping to ease prices while local quality remains excellent.

LOCAL PA **Cauliflower 60ct Bins** will be available into early November. Take advantage of these offerings while supplies last; quality is excellent.

ALERT! Cello Cauliflower prices remain high and well above average due to the crop's volatility, rain in CA, and very limited availability on the West Coast as growing region transition begins.



CV GRAPES

California **Grapes** experienced significant rainfall in mid-October, creating additional challenges for late season varieties. **Green Grapes** will remain tight for the remainder of the season.

The US has already received its first shipment of Peru **Grapes**.

NOTE: "The Grapery" specialty **Grape** season has wound down for the year with only **Moon Drop Grapes** remaining.

New crop **Cotton Candy Grapes** from Brazil are expected 10/26.





CV PREMIUM BERRIES

NOTE: Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** from Peru and Mexico have been in high demand and selling great, but sizing is down and less volume from Peru is making it into the "Sweetest Batch" grade pack.

Jumbo Blueberries 12/9.8oz are available from Family Tree Farms and NorthBay brands out of Peru.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** will be in sporadic supply from Mexico this fall. **Sweetest Batch Raspberries** and **Strawberries** from Driscoll's will gap during much of October and November.



CV SWEET ONIONS

GOOD NEWS! It is peak season for the Peri & Sons **Sweet Onions**. The product is looking gorgeous, and supplies are plentiful. Pricing and product are locked in through at least the month of November, providing excellent opportunities to promote.



CV CABBAGE

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Green Cabbage quality is very nice, and pricing has eased slightly. Pricing on Savoy and Napa Cabbage has also come down a bit with good quality. Production out of Pennsylvania is expected for a few more weeks, with New Jersey slated to continue production through November, weather permitting.



CV POTATOES

GOOD NEWS! Grower-shippers have switched to storage crop Idaho Russet Potatoes from the 2025 harvest in late October. This is a great item to promote with some aggressive pricing with product that will have better quality and shelf life now that it has gone through the "sweat" by releasing excess moisture in storage.



CV AVOCADOS & PINEAPPLE

GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocados from Mexico continue to arrive in strong supply. Border pricing is expected to tick up slightly, but pricing remains very promotable.

GOOD NEWS! Pineapples have finally become more abundant, with many suppliers supplying the East Coast. Pricing is competitive, and 6 ct Pineapples are highly promotable.



CV BROCCOLI

NOTE: Broccoli Crown prices are slowly easing but still elevated.

West Coast shippers continue to deal with reduced yields and quality challenges including pin rot and discoloration.

East Coast shippers out of Maine, Virginia, and North Carolina are helping balance supply with excellent quality and steady availability.

LOCAL PA **Broccoli Stalk 40ct Bins** will run through the remainder of October.



CV FALL FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! California Pomegranates continue to come in strong, with quality remaining very good.

POM POM Wonderful Arils in 4 oz and 8 oz are in stock.

Whole Pomegranates from "POM Wonderful" are in peak season with cartons and display bins.

Fuyu Persimmons are now in stock, along with some Hachiya Persimmons. Both varieties are available in 16/18 ct single layer packs.

GOOD NEWS! Ocean Spray and **LOCAL** Jersey Fresh **Cranberries** are in peak season!

Overall **Asparagus** availability and quality remain steady.

ALERT! Broccoli Rabe, shipped exclusively under the Andy Boy label from California, remains limited with rising prices. Availability continues to be impacted by excess rain, and prorates are in effect from the single source grower.

OTHER STORIES

ALERT! Sweet Baby Broccoli has seen significant price increases due to limited supply from rain. Few shippers have availability, and Braga is being relied upon to supplement prorates. Prices remain high but are expected to improve in the coming weeks.

ALERT! Snow and **Snap Peas** are facing limited availability due to extended rain in Guatemala and port strikes. This has affected **French Beans** as well, with prices expected to remain elevated through November.

Green Squash is available, but not abundant, out of the Southeast. Pricing on **Green Squash** is slightly higher than **Yellow Squash**. Overall quality is good, but pricing and limited supplies reduce promotability.

Green Beans pricing is inching up. Most production is coming out of the Southeast.

Cucumbers from the Southeastern growing regions are in steady supply with overall good quality. Pricing has stabilized for the time being.


