ORGANIC AVOCADOS PROMOTABLE THROUGH HOLIDAYS



GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocados from Mexico remain in excellent supply with strong oil content. Slight discoloration from recent rains may appear.

48ct and 60ct **Organic Hass Avocados**, plus some side deals on Jumbo 36ct will be available. **Organic Hass Avocados** 14/4ct bags are selling great!

December will feature a "Hass-i-day" promotional and display contest in partnership with Avocados from Mexico and Calavo at Four Seasons.

Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados from Equal Exchange will be available in 48ct and 60ct sizes entering December, including the popular 8/4ct Ready-Cycle Trays.









OG HARD SQUASH & POTATOES

Kreher Farms of Western New York introduces new **Organic Regenerative Hard Squash** offerings as the season winds down. These late-season items include **Organic Honeynut** and **Organic Spaghetti Angel Hair Squash**. Both expected to arrive on November 22.

Row 7 Seeds **Organic Koginut Squash** arrives November 23, continuing the same specialty seed line previously grown by Central PA Produce.

Row 7 Seeds **Organic Upstate Abundance Potatoes**, known for their naturally creamy texture without the need for butter, will arrive 11/22 in a biodegradable 24/24oz bag.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries remain promotable out of Central Mexico on shipper brands, with strong quality and favorable pricing. NOTE: Driscoll's brand fruit is more limited as production transitions from California to Central Mexico, and early harvests remain light.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blueberries remain promotable with strong supply and excellent quality. Pricing is expected to rise in early to mid December as volume begins to slow.

Organic Raspberries remain steady on shipper brands, with volume from Central Mexico beginning to increase and promotable markets anticipated in early December. **NOTE**: Driscoll's brand availability is tight as their Central Mexico crops remain limited during transition.

ALERT! Organic Strawberries are very limited with elevated pricing. Volume from Central Mexico continues to be constrained across all shippers. Florida growers are beginning harvests in mid-November, though initial volume will be extremely limited as the season opens. It will be a rough road until mid-December, at least.



OG LADY MOON FLORIDA VEG

GOOD NEWS! Organic Snacking Tomatoes have good supply with strong color and shelf life across Organic Cherry, Organic Grape, and Organic Medley varieties. Pricing remains favorable to average as Lady Moon Farms in Florida increase their harvest volumes later this month.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Eggplants, Organic Collard Greens, Organic Green Kale, and Organic Lacinato Kale from Lady Moon Farms remain abundant and promotable with excellent quality headed into December out of Florida.

NOTE: Organic Zucchini from Lady Moon Farms in Florida is entering the final stages of harvest in mid-November. Upcoming volume will shift largely to Mexico with pricing expected to increase due to higher freight costs from.



OG GREEN BEANS

Organic Green Beans are in okay supply from Mexico and Florida, providing steady volume and nice quality for late-November.



OG SWEET PEPPERS

Organic Color Bell Peppers sourced from Canada, Mexico, and Israel remain lighter in availability, keeping pricing elevated due to strong demand and smaller plantings.



OG CUCUMBERS

Greenhouse Organic Mini Cucumbers and Organic Euro Cucumbers continue steady production and quality from greenhouse programs, with average pricing and balanced supply.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cucumbers are now fully sourced from Mexico and are showing consistently strong quality as the season progresses. Prices are reasonable.



OG GRAPES

California **Organic Green Grapes** will transition to new crop Peruvian supply in late November.

NOTE: Organic Red Grapes will have a supply gap until mid-December when imports start arriving. California rains have basically ended the season.



OG SALADS

ALERT! organicgirl and Earthbound brands continue to deal with quality issues on raw input product amidst the rains out West and growing region transition. Pro-rates and occasional out of stocks are expected on some Organic Salad SKUs through November with improvements beginning in December.



OG CAULIFLOWER

ALERT! Organic Cauliflower in 12ct cello packs remains tight with high markets until stronger desert harvest eases fluctuation.

Organic Romanesco is available in sporadic supply.



OG PEARS

Stemilt's new **Organic Tri-Color "Prism" Pears** in a 2 lb poly bag are now available. Add this exciting new SKU to your pear lineup to capture additional holiday sales.

Organic Red Pears will transition from Organic Starkrimson to Red Anjou and Red Bartlett varieties in late November. Supplies are expected to remain steady through the changeover.



OG CELERY

Organic Celery from Salinas, Santa Maria, and Yuma shows limited availability. NOTE: Organic Sleeved Celery markets remain marginally higher, while naked celery holds steady.

Organic Celery Hearts remain firm under holiday demand with an increasing market until desert fields lift supply post-holiday.



OG TOMATOES

Quebec greenhouse Organic Cherry On-Vine (Mini Apero) and Cocktail On-Vine (Apero) are in good supply and featuring impressive flavor.

Organic Beefsteak and Organic Tomatoes Onthe-Vine show dependable quality and steady availability from greenhouse programs. Pricing remains average to slightly elevated.

Organic Roma Tomatoes show consistent sizing and quality from Mexico and Canada, with steady movement and average pricing.



OG BROCCOLI

NOTE: Organic Broccoli remains firm as supply transitions from East Coast to West Coast. Quality remains good with slight variability in bead tightness, and marginal cost increases are expected until desert production expands in early December.

NOTE: Organic Broccoli Crowns volume is tightening as East Coast fields finish. Markets remain higher until desert volumes increase.

Organic Broccoli Rabe continues to show light volume and variable texture through the transition from West to desert, with market increases until new fields ramp up.

Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli supply is beginning to improve.



OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! California Organic Mandarins, Halos and Cuties brands, are in full swing with strong quality and well-sized fruit available. "Clementines" are what is in most bags. Bulk Organic Satsuma Mandarins are available.

NOTE: Organic Navels continue to show elevated markets as delayed harvest from early rain events has kept supplies tight.

Organic Specialty Citrus harvests were slowed by the November California rains, but will trickle back in around Thanksgiving and early December: OG Meyer Lemons, OG Limequats, and OG Pummelos.

NOTE: Organic Brussels Sprouts remain tight from Wisconsin and California with mixed sizing through the holiday period. Minor improvement is expected as temperatures cool.

Organic Carrots from Bakersfield maintain good quality. Bolthouse is filling gaps, while Bunny-Luv product remains limited. Marginal cost increases continue into December.

OG TROPICALS

Organic Mangoes from Ecuador have begun the season with 10ct and 12ct fruit. Pricing remains above last year but well below California domestic levels.

Organic Feijoa, Organic Passion Fruit, and Organic Kiwano Horned Melons from California begin availability around Thanksgiving, with the season expected to continue into December.

ALERT! Organic Pineapples will be very tight from Costa Rica, with Mexico also experiencing limited supplies, creating an extreme market.



OG CRIMINI MUSHROOMS

ALERT! PA Mushroom growers are dealing with some bad spores, mold issues, and raw growing material shortages this fall that are impacting Organic Crimini (Baby Bella) Mushroom yields industry wide.

All other varieties are well-supplied, but expect light suppliers and pro-rates on **Organic Crimini Mushrooms** until conditions improve.



OG LETTUCE

OUTLOOK: Good news is coming on **Organic Leaf** and **Romaine Lettuce** with Lady Moon Farms' new crop Florida crop coming into season at the end of November. Quality and supply will be excellent and Four Seasons will be fully stocked with this product during the first week of December.

ALERT! Organic Leaf, Butter, Romaine, and Romaine Hearts from Western regions remain very limited with low weights and firm to very expensive pricing. Desert production in Yuma and Huron will gradually improve availability into early December.



OG FALL FRUIT

Organic Pomegranate Arils remain steady in 4oz packs under the I Love Pomegranate label, offering consistent quality.

California **Organic Pomegranates** are tightening as rain has affected long-term fruit quality. Supplies dwindled after Thanksgiving.

Organic Fuyu and **Organic Hachiya Persimmons** are winding down and expected to finish their California season in early December.

Organic Brown Turkey Figs from California continue to be available sporadically for holiday use with strong flavor and quality. This season will end soon.

Fresh **Organic Cranberry** supplies will last through Thanksgiving then finish for the season in early December.

OTHER STORIES

LOCAL 25LB Organic Red Beets from Central PA Produce and Eagle Shadow Farms in Pennsylvania continue in promotable supply with excellent quality.

Organic Endive and **Escarole** from California and New Jersey remains tight with higher markets through transition.

Organic Fennel continues with smaller bulbs though flavor remains excellent. Improved sizing is anticipated as desert fields open, with higher markets in the meantime.

ALERT! Organic Artichokes remain almost unavailable with minimal acreage and small sizing. When available, markets remain elevated.





CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

NOVEMBER 21 - DECEMBER 5, 2025

MANDARIN SEASON RAMPS UP



GOOD NEWS! Mandarins from California are showing strong quality to open the season, while imported fruit from Chile remains available at promotable values.

The new crop California **Mandarin** season is rolling along with the **Clementine** variety in the "Halos" brand. 10/3lb and 15/2lb bags, plus 4/5lb gift boxes are in stock along with FREE point of sale display material and bins for retailers sourcing through Four Seasons.

In December there will be an exciting "Halos" **Mandarin** promotion and display contest. Check it out!

GOOD NEWS! For price-value retailers, import Mandarins are available are deal pricing from late crop Chile arrivals and will transition to new crop Clementine Mandarins from Morocco in December in 10/3lb and 15/2lb bags.

Stem & Leaf Satsuma Mandarins are in peak season from California. These easy-peelers will be at their best in the first half of December in 22lb bulk and 6/3lb Clamshells.



CV FALL FRUIT

Pomegranates from California remain steady through Thanksgiving, though rains have shortened the season and may limit availability for December.

NOTE: Fuyu Persimmons and Hachiya Persimmons are winding down rapidly with a lighter crop this year. Supplies are expected to hold through Thanksgiving.

Ocean Spray and Jersey Fresh **Cranberries** will be in good supply for Thanksgiving and will carry into December.

Black Mission Figs from Mexico and Peru will begin ahead of Thanksgiving and will be offered in a 12/8oz clamshell.

Quince from California is in season for Thanksgiving menus.



CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

Broccoli and **Broccoli Crowns** are in decent supply for Thanksgiving. Prices are okay and supplies should build in December with new availability staring in the Southeast and Western desert.

Broccoli Rabe is finally improving as desert acreage fills in, with prices easing.

Sweet Baby Broccoli harvests are improving in late November.

Cauliflower has been pricey but is showing signs of improvement for December.

NOTE: Colored Cauliflower remains limited with selective color specs and modest increases in cost until desert plantings expand availability.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Raspberries remain available out of Mexico. Volume has been strong, creating promotable supplies. Volume is expected to taper off in early to mid December. Quality has been outstanding.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries remain extremely promotable out of Central Mexico. Quality has been exceptional with strong supplies and aggressive pricing.

Blueberries pricing will start to increase as supplies out of Peru begin to slow later this month as we move past peak. Quality has been excellent. Jumbos remain available with excellent quality.

Sweetest Batch Blueberries from Driscoll's also remain available with exceptional quality.

ALERT! Strawberries remain extremely limited. The California rain has canceled harvests in mid-November, and the Central Mexico crop remains very limited due to added demand. Florida growers expect a few limited pallets available as harvests start slowly. Pricing will continue to be high with very limited product.



CV POTATOES

GOOD NEWS! Potatoes in all bagged lines remain fully stocked and ready for steady holiday demand.

GOOD NEWS! Idaho Russet Potato Bags 10/5lb and 5/10lb are plentiful.

Maine-grown 10/5lb Red and Gold Potatoes are now shipping under the updated value codes with improved pricing.

LOCAL White Potatoes in the 10/5 packs have transitioned to Pennsylvania, offering good quality and strong value.



CV LUDACRISP APPLES

Be sure to try the new crop LOCAL NY Ludacrisp Apples, which have a Honeycrisp parentage and outstanding flavor, juicy, fruity, with excellent crunch. These are available now in pouch bags, 4-pack cardboard trays, and euro cartons.



CV CELERY

Celery from Salinas and Santa Maria, CA transitioning toward Yuma, AZ shows consistent quality though demand remains heavy. Desert volume will increase after Thanksgiving with marginal cost adjustments.

Celery Hearts follow the same pattern with elevated trim on older lots and marginal increases expected until desert fields strengthen supply later in the month.



NOTE: Grapes from California have been impacted by unusual rain events, causing Green and Black Grapes to finish abruptly. California Red Grapes continue to show good quality from storage.

Green and Black Grapes will shift from 19lb California lines to 15lb Peruvian product starting the last week of November.



CV PEARS

This month also brings the exciting addition of Stemilt's new Tri-color "Prism" Pears in a 2 lb poly bag. Make sure to add this new SKU to your Pear lineup to help capture extra holiday sales.

GOOD NEWS! Pears overall are in great supply. Promote!



CV GREENS

GOOD NEWS! Kales, Collards, and Cabbages from New Jersey growers Flaim Farms and Nardelli Farms remain in strong supply for the Thanksgiving holiday with very good quality.



CV PEPPERS

Colored Bell Peppers are tightening as Canadian output winds down and Mexico becomes the primary source. Demand remains steady and pricing is elevated.

Mini Mix Sweet Peppers continue to inch upward in price as field-grown product posts higher FOB levels and hothouse output remains limited.



GOOD NEWS! Pineapples are finally easing in the market, creating promotable conditions with strong opportunities on the popular 7ct size heading into the Thanksgiving holiday.



Florida grown **Autumn Honey Tangerines** are coming into season for December and will arrive with 40ct (80sz) bulk and 10/3lb bags from Noble around 11/29.

California Navel Oranges are delivering excellent early-season quality with a favorable size profile. Rain is slowing picking.

Cara Cara Oranges have begun a slow harvest, and first arrivals are expected in late November.



CV AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocados from Mexico are positioned for strong December promotions as preparations continue for a major Hass-i-day celebration display contest and promotion supported by Avocados from Mexico and Calavo.

Volume from Mexico remains excellent, and December programs will include aggressive pricing and merchandising contests with premium prizes.



CV MANGOES

Mangoes from Ecuador are entering the midpoint of their season. Supplies are steady though sizing is running larger than anticipated, tightening availability on 10ct and 12ct fruit. 9ct will be more promotable.

Ataulfo Mangoes from Ecuador remain consistent in quality and flow.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

ALERT! Brussels Sprouts from California and New York remain short with prorates and frequent poor quality challenges. Small sizing continues to push a firm-to-extreme tone, with only gradual relief expected as temperatures cool in early December.



CV TOMATOES

Canadian Beefsteak and Tomatoes On-the-Vine are in steady supply with good quality. Demand is consistent heading into the holiday pull, and pricing is holding at average levels.

GOOD NEWS! Roma and Round Tomatoes from the East Coast and Mexico are improving in volume, helping stabilize the market. Quality is solid and pricing is currently at average levels.

GOOD NEWS! Snacking Tomatoes remain well-supplied with strong quality and favorable pricing across Cherry, Grape, and Medley Tomato varieties. After a brief shortage and increase in cost, Grape Tomatoes are returning to normal conditions.

Chestnuts from Italy are available to elevate holiday tables. Four Seasons now offers premium Italian-grown Chestnuts from Bella Vita in a bulk 25lb jute pack and a 20/1lb jute bag with excellent branding and quality.

NOTE: Radicchio remains limited with occasional outer-leaf burn. Modest improvements are expected as desert harvest expands with marginal cost increases in the meantime.



CV BEANS & PEAS

Green Beans remain tight on the market with elevated pricing, but strong partnerships with growers have positioned supplies well for the Thanksgiving period with decent costs and dependable volume.

French Beans from Guatemala face uneven arrivals and shelf-life sensitivity due to air freight and weather impacts.

English Peas from Guatemala show inconsistent arrivals and sensitive condition. Later-month relief is possible, but costs remain elevated.

ALERT! Snow Peas and Sugar Snap Peas from Peru and Guatemala remain very limited as Peru winds down and Guatemala faces pressure. Quality ranges fair to good, and markets remain firm to extreme with significantly higher costs.





CV LETTUCE & SALADS

ALERT! Lettuces, including Iceberg, Romaine, Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and Romaine Hearts, remain very light as coastal harvests finish with lower weights and occasional mildew pressure. Yuma is providing early cuts, but volume is inconsistent, keeping costs high until desert acreage expands in late November.

NOTE: Boston Lettuce, Butter Lettuce, and Artisan Lettuces show tight volumes and delicate quality during the coastal-to-desert transition. Consistency is expected to improve late November, though markets remain elevated.

ALERT! Iceberg, Romaine, Romaine Heart, and Butter Lettuce bases retail and foodservice Salads continue to see pro-rates, occasional outs, and shorter shelf life due to California rains and growing region transition. Conditions are expected to improve in December.

OTHER STORIES

Mini Cucumbers and Euro Cucumbers continue to show strong quality and consistent arrivals from Mexico and Canada. Pricing remains favorable with steady movement.

Artichokes in the Jumbo 12ct size remain limited as sizing skews small. Wind rub and scarring continue, with improved sizing anticipated into early December while costs trend marginally higher.

NOTE: Escarole and **Endive** from California and New Jersey remains tight with weather-related outer-leaf scuff and light weights, keeping markets marginally higher.

Asparagus from Mexico in both Jumbo and Standard packs continues to improve as more districts open. Jumbos remain tighter, while Standard sizing is well covered, with markets steady to slightly lower.

Fennel continues with smaller bulb profiles though flavor remains good. Desert expansion will improve consistency, with marginally higher costs in the short term.
