

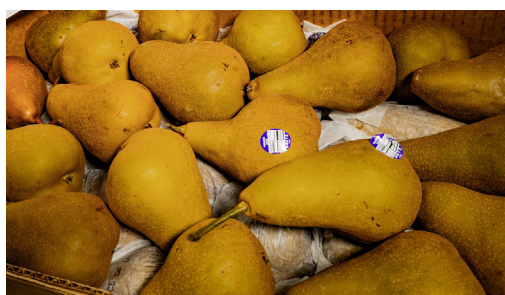

PROMOTABLE ORGANIC PEARS



GOOD NEWS! Organic Pears from the Pacific Northwest are in excellent supply and highly promotable for January. With strong availability and outstanding eating quality, now is the perfect time to build impactful displays and drive sales in your Organic fruit section.

Varieties available this month include **Organic Green Anjou**, **Gold Bosc**, **Comice**, **Concorde**, **Forelle**, **Red Anjou**, and Stemilt's new **Organic Prism Tri-Color Pears** 12/2lb bag. The vibrant color variety and flavor profiles offer something for every customer - whether they're snacking, baking, or packing lunches for the new year.

Take advantage of peak season conditions to promote **Organic Pears** with creative signage, secondary placements, and cross-merchandising.



OG TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Snacking Tomatoes - including **Organic Cherry**, **Orange Cherry**, **Grape**, and **Medley** packs from Lady Moon Farms in Florida are holding excellent quality with promotable pricing and consistent harvests.

Organic Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** are continuing from Quebec greenhouse programs with good sizing and consistent quality. Mexico is increasing volume and promotions will be available as production rises in January.

Organic Roma Tomatoes are improving from Mexico. Good color and firmness are noted, though demand remains strong and pricing is still slightly elevated.

Covilli **Organic Fair Trade Heirloom Tomatoes** from Mexico are now in season for winter, along with purple-black **Organic Darkloom Tomatoes** in 10lb cases.



OG MANDARINS

ALERT! Organic Mandarins out of California are also facing challenges. Ongoing rain is affecting the "Clementine" variety, a thin-skinned variety, causing excessive puffiness. Conditions will remain difficult until new variety harvests begin in early to mid January.

Retailers should focus on fast inventory turns and frequent shelf culls since **Organic Mandarins** are so prone to skin breakdown and decay showing up post-harvest after so much December rain.



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries from Mexico are plentiful to start off January. There will be spot deals to promote!

Organic Raspberries harvests are improving out of Mexico with great weather and good yields. There are some spot deals for early January.

Organic Blueberries out of Peru are tightening up and Chilean fruit is expected to arrive shortly after the new year.

NOTE: Driscoll's **Organic Blueberries** will be expensive and in low supply for much of January.

Organic Strawberries out of Mexico are a steady offering apart for some recent cold spells. Supplies and quality are still great. Prices are still on the higher side especially on Driscoll's brand but fill-rates are good.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cucumbers from Mexico are in steady supply with good quality and promotable pricing. Packs have remained consistent.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Euro and Mini Seedless Cucumbers pricing is promotable for early to mid-January once the supply chain refills post-holiday.



OG HARD SQUASH

NOTE: Organic Delicata Squash is tightening this week and may become extremely limited as we move further into January. Supply gaps are possible later in the month.

NOTE: Organic Acorn Squash and Spaghetti Squash are also beginning to tighten. Supply gaps may emerge toward the end of January if trends continue.



OG WARM VEG

GOOD NEWS! Organic Eggplant from Lady Moon Farms in Florida is in strong supply with great quality. Availability is meeting current demand and markets remain stable.

Organic Green Bell Peppers, also from Lady Moon Farms in Florida, continue to arrive with excellent quality and consistent supply. Demand is steady and pricing is holding firm.



OG PINEAPPLES

Organic Pineapples from Mexico will be in steady supply with Mexico supplementing Costa Rica's shortages as the year begins. Pricing remains high.



OG POMEGRANATES

NOTE: A very small amount of Organic Pomegranates from California will be available for the first week of 2026 but will not last beyond that.

Organic Pomegranate Arils are in steady supply packed in 4oz containers under the "I Love Pomegranate" label.



OG COLOR BELL PEPPERS

Organic Red, Orange, and Yellow Bell Peppers are coming primarily from Israel with some volume out of Mexico.

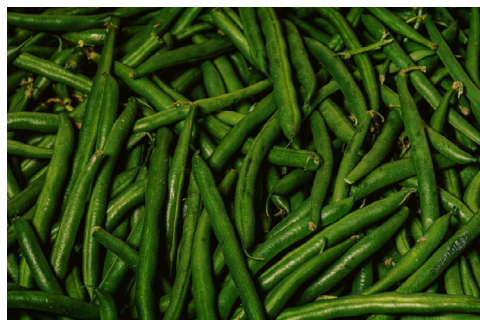
Overall supply remains limited with strong demand, but quality is outstanding and expected to remain high into the New Year.



OG GRAPES

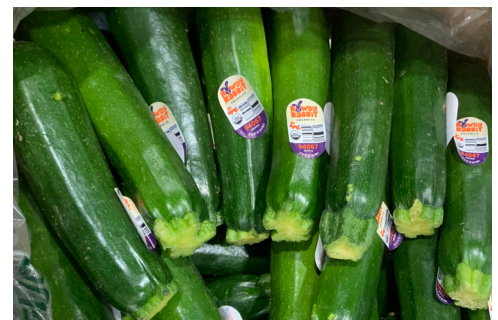
Organic Grapes out of Peru are in strong supply.

Premium Organic Red Grapes ("Sweet Celebration") and Organic Green Grapes ("Sweet Globe" and "Autumn Crisp") are all available with promotable quality and sizing.



OG GREEN BEANS

NOTE: Organic Green Beans are being sourced primarily out of Mexico with good quality. However, supply remains limited, and strong demand is keeping pricing elevated moving into early January.



OG SQUASH

GOOD NEWS! Organic Zucchini is in strong supply with favorable pricing.

NOTE: Organic Yellow Squash is tighter and pricing remains closer to average.

Organic Zucchini and Yellow Squash from Mexico are done holding good quality.



OG APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Envy Apples are promotable for January!

NOTE: Washington Organic Kanzi, SweeTango Apples, and McIntosh Apples, will finish for the season this week.



OG SCALLIONS

ALERT! Organic Scallions remain tight across the market with limited availability. Quality is generally good, but elevated demand is driving pricing higher entering January.



OG SPECIALTY FRUIT

Organic Feijoa, Passion Fruit, and Kiwano Horned Melons from California will be in stock in limited volumes to begin the year.



OG CITRUS

NOTE: California rains are slowing harvests and weakening shelf-life on Organic Navel Oranges. Generally supply is good still and sizing is trending to XL and jumbo.

Organic Cara Cara Oranges are in season but off to a slower start.

NOTE: Organic Blood Oranges are delayed as well. Harvest is expected to begin in early January following recent rain and fog.

NOTE: California Organic Lemons are extremely limited due to recent rain and fog, compounding existing issues from District 3's crop reduction and District 1's inability to meet demand. Expect shortages to persist through mid-January.

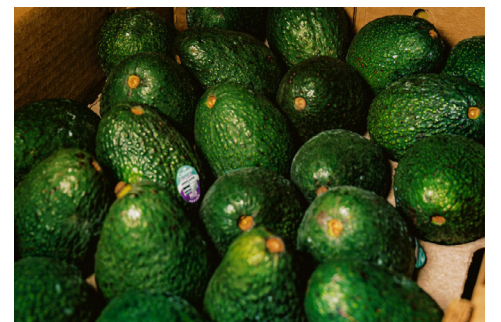


OG KIWIFRUIT

Organic Red Kiwifruit from California will also be available in 8/1lb clamshells.

Organic Mammoth Kiwifruit in clamshells from California will be available to start January but may not last through the entire month due to limited volume.

Organic SunGold Kiwifruit from Zespri will be available from Italy in both clamshell and VF bulk packs.



OG AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocados will be promotable to start the year. All sizes are available, including bagged and loose fruit.

NOTE: Equal Exchange Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados will be limited or unavailable during weeks 1-3 of January, but should return by the end of the month. Calavo Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados will bridge that gap.



OG MICROGREENS

ALERT! Gilbertie's Organics, our local supplier of Organic Microgreens in Connecticut, experiencing a heating system failure in late December in their greenhouses that wiped out all of their crop.

Gilbertie's replanted as soon as the problem was fixed, but supplies will gap on all Organic Microgreens until January 7 when the first harvests resume.



OG BABY ARUGULA

ALERT! Wet, rainy weather in the Southwest salad growing regions is impacting Organic Baby Arugula salad green yields with mildew, yellowing, and post-harvest decay.

All major organic salad brands are severely pro-rating or gapping all together on Organic Baby Arugula salad items across late December and into early January. Expect out-of-stocks from Olivia's, Earthbound, and organicgirl.

OTHER STORIES

Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons are continuing out of Mexico with limited but high-quality supplies.

NOTE: Organic Fuyu and Organic Hachiya Persimmons are now finished for the season.

Organic Mangos from Peru are beginning their season with larger sizing. Expect 7-8ct fruit to be the primary pack for early January with very little 12ct available.



CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

PREMIUM SNACKING APPLES



GOOD NEWS! The Washington **Envy Apple** and Pacific Northwest Display Contests begin this week. Take advantage of promo prices and point of sale materials too. Build large, eye-catching displays to drive healthy-eating sales volume and earn a chance for your store to win thousands of dollars in prizes.

Envy Apples are a premium sweet variety with lots of juiciness, crisp texture, and low acidity.

New crop **Aura Apples** are expected to arrive the second week of January. **Aurora Apples** are a limited edition variety from Stemilt with glowing yellow skin, sweetness, flavor notes of melon, and crisp texture from Honeycrisp parentage.

Other high-quality snacking varieties available for January "New-Year, New-You" demand include: **Wild Twist**, **Snap-Dragon**, **Ruby Frost**, **LudaCrisp**, and **Evercrisp** from PA and NY; plus **SugarBee**, **Rockit**, **Lucy Rose**, **Hunnyz**, and **Cosmic Crisp** from Washington.



CV TOMATOES

Roma and **Round/Vine Ripe Tomatoes** are experiencing mixed availability. East Coast supplies remain somewhat limited while Mexico's volume increases. Pricing is anticipated to drop as more production comes online.

Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** remain steady with consistent sizing and strong quality. However, pricing is expected to become elevated by mid-January.

Snacking Tomatoes supply remains stable from greenhouse sources, though some field programs have finished. Pricing is average, with promotional opportunities on certain pack styles.



CV PEARS

GOOD NEWS! Pears from the Pacific Northwest are the name of the game in January. The USA Pears Display Contest is in full swing, giving you the chance to win some fantastic prizes.

Take advantage of the peak supply and outstanding quality with very promotable markets. Expect excellent availability of both top-grade US#1 and Fancy grade **Anjou**, **Bartlett**, **Bosc**, and **Starkrimson** Pears all month long.

Additionally, look for limited volumes of premium varieties such as **Comice**, **Forelle**, and **Seckel**. Stemilt's new **Prism Pears** (Tri-Color 12/2lb bags) will also be available - this is a great opportunity to feature something eye-catching and premium for your customers.

LOCAL PA Asian Pears will also be available, though that season will wrap up in February, with continued volume from the Pacific Northwest.



CV BERRIES

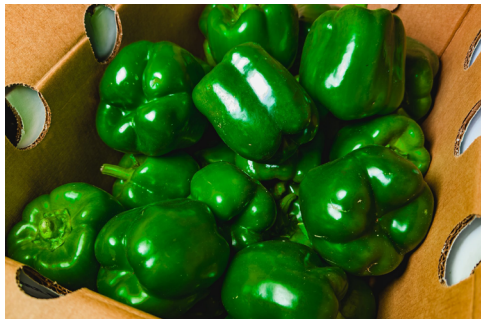
GOOD NEWS! Strawberries from Florida remain as a high-quality option as customers can take advantage of reasonable pricing. The cheap, cheap deals are over but price points are still promotable.

GOOD NEWS! Blackberries are in steady supply from Mexico on Driscoll's brand. There are some spot deals on shipper brands to promote for early January too.

Blueberries are remaining available as availability is shifting from Peru to Mexico and soon to be Chilean.

Raspberries are continuing to tighten and production slows down. Quality maintains in recent arrivals.

"Driscoll's Sweetest Batch" high-flavor packs are available with 12/10oz **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** from Mexico, 8/14oz **Sweetest Batch Strawberries** from Florida, plus promotable volumes of big and delicious 8/11oz **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** from Peru and Mexico.



CV WARM VEG

Green Bell Peppers are primarily Florida with some Mexican product in the mix. Quality and sizing are strong, and availability is meeting demand to keep markets steady.

Eggplant continues to come mainly from domestic production with some support from Mexico. Quality and availability are good, with favorable pricing.



CV CUCUMBERS

Mini and Euro Seedless Cucumbers continue to arrive with excellent quality and dependable volume from greenhouse programs in Mexico and Canada. Strong demand has kept pricing slightly elevated, but easing is expected soon.

Cucumbers are shipping from Florida and Mexican programs. Quality is strong and supply well-aligned with demand, supporting favorable market conditions.



CV STONE FRUIT

Chilean **Stone Fruit** is in excellent supply including **Apricots, Cherries, Nectarines,** and **Peaches**. Flavor is not on the same level as USA summer production, but much improved over years past, especially on **Cherries**.



CV KIWIFRUIT

Italian **SunGold Kiwifruit** from Zespri remains in strong supply, offered in 8/1lb clamshells and volume-filled options.

Red Kiwifruit in a 16/1lb clamshell from California is also in stock.

Green Kiwifruit is available from Italy and Greece on the East Coast.



CV COLOR BELL PEPPERS

Color Bell Peppers are primarily sourced from Mexico as Canadian production winds down.

Quality on **Red, Yellow,** and **Orange Peppers** remains strong. Slight price relief is expected post-holiday with further reductions into January.



CV SQUASH

GOOD NEWS! **Green Squash** is in greater supply than **Yellow Squash**, but both are shipping from domestic and Mexican programs.

Overall quality is strong and pricing remains favorable.



CV POMEGRANATES

Pomegranate Arils will be in steady supply in all sizes, including the new 2x8oz Twin Pack format.

NOTE: A small amount of 22ct **Pomegranates** from California will be available as the season winds down. POM Wonderful **Pomegranates** will remain available just into the New Year.



CV GREEN BEANS

Green Beans are in good supply from domestic sources. Volume is sufficient and demand manageable, helping maintain favorable pricing as January begins.



CV GRAPES

Grapes from Peru and Chile continue to ramp up.

Promotional opportunities on **Red** and **Green Grapes** are expected in early to mid-January.



CV SCALLIONS

ALERT! Scallions from Mexico are extremely limited. Tight availability is causing elevated pricing with little flexibility in the near term.



CV SWEET CORN

NOTE: Bi-Color Sweet Corn from Florida is beginning to tighten due to colder temperatures. Expect pricing to rise next week even with easing freight rates.



CV SWEET POTATOES

Sweet Potato pricing is expected to rise slightly as we begin the new year. Increases are forecast across all sizes and packs.



CV MANDARINS

ALERT! California **Mandarins** (including Halos and Cuties brands) are tight in supply for early to mid-January due to a month of excessive rain impacting harvests on the late crop "Clementine" variety. More rain is in the forecast. Quality will be weak with skin breakdown and decay emerging frequently, especially on occasionally puffy mandarins where the rain caused the skin to more easily separate from the flesh.

The next California **Mandarin** new crop varieties are expected to be harvested during the 2nd week of January and make their way into the supply chain later in the month with what is hoped to be stronger quality.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Navel Oranges remain in strong supply, especially XL and Jumbo fancy fruit. This is a great time to promote both bagged and bulk **Navels** despite the California rains as harvests have been kept ahead.

Blood Oranges and **Cara Cara Oranges** are available, though not exactly abundant quite yet due to rain.

ALERT! Limes remain extremely tight. Recent rainfall, cooler weather, and the holiday schedule have restricted harvest activity. Supply will likely remain constrained for the next two to three weeks.



CV MELONS

ALERT! Honeydew production remains extremely limited due to weather impacts during the growing cycle. Expect tight markets through mid-January. 8ct will be the main size available.

Seedless Watermelons are wrapping up in Florida, with one final full harvest expected. Mexico continues to ship good-quality fruit with reasonable pricing.

Mini Seedless Watermelons from Guatemala remain consistent in pricing and quality.



CV PINEAPPLES

Pineapple markets will edge up slightly, but volumes are expected to be solid. **PinkGlow** and **HoneyGlow Pineapples** from Del Monte will also be available.

New **Colada Royale Pineapples** from Dole are here. This exclusive, non-GMO varietal has a balance of sweet and tangy with coconut tones.



CV MANGOES

Mango supply has been variable, but Peruvian **Kent Mangos** are building. Steady volume is expected as we move through January.



CV AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Hass Avocados will open the New Year in good supply and promo pricing! Four Seasons will carry 36ct, 48ct, and 60ct fruit, along with several bagged options. Pricing is expected to tick up slightly but remain promotable in weeks 1 and 2.

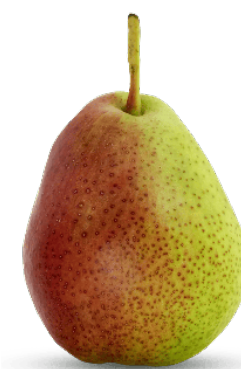
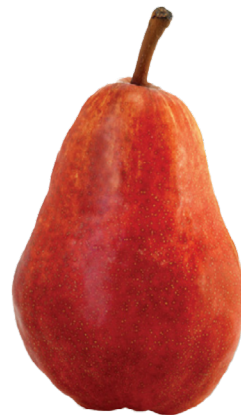
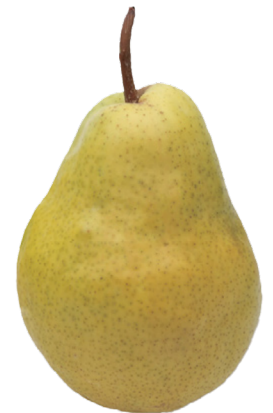
