PROMOTABLE ORGANIC STRAWBERRIES



GOOD NEWS! Organic Strawberries are promotable out of Baja and Central Mexico. California harvests are beginning to ramp up gradually. Quality looks excellent and supplies are expected to remain plentiful through mid-late March.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Blackberries remain steady with promotable opportunities available out of Central Mexico on shipper brands. Quality has been solid and supplies are expected to remain steady through early March. Driscoll's brand is more limited.

Organic Raspberries remain steady out of Baja and Central Mexico. Quality has been excellent and pricing remains stable entering March.

ALERT! Organic Blueberries continue to be very limited. Chilean fruit has finished for the season, creating a gap between growing regions. Steady supplies of **Organic Blueberries** from Peru are available, though pricing continues to rise. Overall quality has been excellent.



OG TOMATOES

ALERT! Organic Beefsteak Tomatoes and Organic Cluster Tomatoes are tight with limited supply keeping pricing elevated. Quality remains strong. The category is expected to remain challenging through March, though availability should remain consistent at current modest levels.

ALERT! Organic Roma Tomatoes remain limited with expensive pricing. Quality has been acceptable overall. Conditions are expected to remain tight with gradual improvement anticipated toward late March.

NOTE: Organic Grape, Cherry, and other Snacking Tomatoes are tight with limited availability, keeping pricing up. Quality has remained strong overall. While supply remains constrained in the near term, conditions are expected to gradually improve toward the end of March as additional greenhouse production becomes available.



OG BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

Organic Bunched and **Crown Broccoli** production remain steady with good overall quality. **GOOD NEWS!** Organic Bunch Broccoli will be promotable for mid-March!

Organic Broccoli Rabe harvest conditions have improved and production has stabilized following earlier supply limitations. Availability is expected to remain steady moving forward.

NOTE: Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli supply remains very tight across the market with several shippers experiencing production gaps. Limited harvest volume from West Coast growers is expected to improve slightly through mid-March, though yields remain well below projected levels.

Organic Cauliflower remains tight with ongoing discoloration concerns and smaller sizing.

Organic Romanesco supply is steady with strong quality currently available. Production is expected to tighten slightly through mid-March as harvest volume begins to taper.



OG PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mini Mix Sweet Peppers remain in good supply with favorable pricing and dependable quality.

Organic Colored Bell Peppers are currently supported by consistent supply from Mexico. Availability from Israel remains uncertain in early March due to ongoing Middle East conflict that has disrupted airfreight shipments.

ALERT! Organic Green Peppers have tightened in supply from Mexico, resulting in higher pricing as availability decreases.

ALERT! Organic Jalapeño Peppers are experiencing similar supply pressure with tighter markets developing.



OG MANGOES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Ataulfo Mango pricing has decreased as pipelines continue to fill quickly from Mexico. 16/18ct fruit are especially promotable.

New crop Tommy Atkins Organic Mangoes have fully transitioned to Mexico. 10ct and 12ct options are available to start the season, with some 8ct becoming available during early March.



OG CABBAGE & GREENS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green and Red Cabbage are available in strong supply from Lady Moon Farms in Florida and are expected to remain promotable through the St. Patrick's Day demand period.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Collard Greens and Organic Kale from Lady Moon Farms remain steady with excellent quality and strong availability from Florida.



OG VALUE ADDED

ALERT! Josie's Organic Chop Salad Kits containing Organic Carrots as an ingredient are struggling with poor fill-rates and gaps due to the on-going Organic Carrot shortage.

Improvement! Organic Baby Arugula Salad supplies are beginning to improve with new fields coming into production.



OG SPECIALTY BLUES

NEW: Driscoll's Organic Sweetest Batch Blueberries 8/11 oz are coming into season from Oxnard, CA and Baja, Mexico for mid-March through June. These are big berries with extra sweet flavor!



OG CARROTS

ALERT! Organic Carrots are experiencing on-going supply limitations as cold weather and rainfall delayed harvest schedules further in desert growing regions. Acreage remains light and sizing continues to run smaller than normal, though color and quality remain strong. Growers anticipate improved Organic Cello Carrot production beginning in mid-March as desert fields continue to mature but improvement continues to be delayed and fill-rates are terrible.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Brussels Sprouts from Mexico continue to provide dependable supply with stable quality. 16/11lb cello bags are currently available.



OG HONEY-GOLD POTATOES

NOTE: Organic Honey Gold Potatoes from Tasteful Selections are entering a supply gap beginning in early March that is expected to last through early April. Historically, this gap can extend into late April or early May depending on remaining inventories.

Some limited supply of smaller sized Organic Honey Gold Potatoes may remain available in select pack codes, though the 10/3 pack is expected to experience the most significant shortage during this period.



OG HARD SQUASH

The final arrivals of Row 7 Organic Koginut Squash are expected to move through distribution in early March, marking the end of availability for the season. This specialty Organic Squash program will conclude until new crop production resumes in the fall.

Organic Hard Squash markets have eased slightly through early March with supply continuing to arrive from Mexico. Organic Delicata Squash, Organic Spaghetti Squash, and Organic Kabocha Squash have seen the most noticeable price decreases recently as additional volume entered the market.



OG CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Mandarins from California remain in strong supply with exceptional quality, providing an excellent opportunity for promotion leading into the Easter demand period.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Oranges including Organic Cara Cara Oranges and Organic Navel Oranges are currently available in abundant supply, with favorable quality and pricing.

Organic Minneola Tangelos are approaching the end of their season with supplies expected to conclude around late March.

ALERT! Organic Limes continue to see elevated prices through March due to limited supply conditions.



OG CELERY

NOTE: Organic Celery supply is expected to tighten as a temporary desert production gap develops in mid-March. Mexico will help supplement supply until new crop production begins harvesting in late March.

NOTE: Organic Celery Hearts are experiencing similar supply conditions to Organic Celery Stalks, with lighter availability expected during the mid-March transition period.



OG ASPARAGUS

Organic Asparagus remains in peak season with promotable volume available under Hippy Organics label. Supply conditions remain steady as the industry prepares for increased Easter demand.

Some Organic Fair Trade Asparagus lots will be sourced from Hippy Organics whenever available.

NEW: Organic Purple Asparagus will be available as a specialty item beginning mid-March from Durst.



OG CUCUMBERS

NOTE: Organic Mini Cucumbers and Organic Euro Cucumbers remain somewhat limited in supply, though availability has been sufficient to support current demand. Markets remain above typical seasonal levels while quality continues to perform well. As greenhouse production builds, conditions are expected to gradually improve through late March.

NOTE: Organic Cucumbers remain steady with other supply continuing from Mexico at high-ish pricing and overall quality holding strong.



OG GRAPES

NOTE: Organic Grapes are experiencing high prices and tight supply for the remainder of the imported season, with relief expected once Mexico production begins ramping up in May.



OG LETTUCE

NOTE: West Coast Organic Romaine Hearts remain very limited due to mildew pressure that impacted yields along with ongoing growing region transitions. Fill rates are expected to remain reduced until Salinas production begins harvesting in early March. Organic Romaine Hearts from Florida production by Lady Moon continue to provide critical supply support during this period.

Organic Green Leaf, Red Leaf, and Romaine Lettuce from Lady Moon continue to provide dependable supply with excellent quality from Florida production.

NOTE: Organic Iceberg Lettuce availability is expected to tighten in the early March with reports of aphid pressure affecting some fields. Supply will remain controlled until the next regional transition helps stabilize production later in March.



OG PEARS & APPLES

GOOD NEWS! New crop Argentine Organic Bartlett Pears have arrived. Despite a smaller overall crop due to hail earlier in the growing season, current availability provides a good opportunity for promotion while supplies are fresh in the market.

NOTE: Organic Cosmic Crisp Apples remain limited and sporadic for the remainder of the season as demand continues to exceed supply.

NOTE: Organic Fuji Apples remain in very tight supply as limited small fruit is available. Some larger fruit is being packed into bags to help meet demand.

NOTE: Organic Honeycrisp Apples are extremely limited. Canadian storage imports are beginning to enter the market in early March to help relieve some supply pressure, though both markets are expected to continue strengthening as overall supplies dwindle.

Organic Rockit Apples are expected to finish for the season by mid to late March.

OTHER STORIES

ALERT! Organic Red Bunch Beets have become increasingly scarce out of California, resulting in modest pricing increases as supplies tighten.

NOTE: Organic Mini Seedless Watermelons remain limited across the market, though dependable vendor supply continues to support availability.

ALERT! Organic Yellow Squash remains very tight with elevated pricing and variable quality. Scuffing and scarring from Mexico has been present on many recent arrivals.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Avocados (48ct and 60ct) remain promotable from Mexico on the Calavo brand. Equal Exchange label Fair Trade Organic Avocados are available as well in 48ct, 60ct, and ReadyCycle 4ct tray options.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Pineapples from Mexico are in excellent supply. Steady availability is expected through mid-March on 6ct and 8ct.

Organic Green Kiwi has tightened slightly in both Volume Fill and 16/1lb clamshell packs from Italy and Greece. Pricing in rising.

ALERT! Organic Pomegranate Arils are currently in a gap period while the Peru import programs ramp up, with availability expected to begin later in March.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

MARCH 6 - MARCH 13, 2026

PEAK SEASON MANGOES FROM MEXICO



GOOD NEWS! New crop **Mangoes** from Mexico are ramping up for the season.

Four Seasons is fully switched over to **Tommy Atkins Round Mangoes** from Mexico, avoiding the last of the season Peru fruit which has quality challenges. Our spring and summer's program will be supported by Continental's "Water For All" brand which supports clean water initiatives in developing countries. 9ct, 10ct, and 12ct Water For All brand **Mangoes** are in stock now.

Honey Ataulfo Mangoes from Mexico are starting peak season. Shipper brand 18ct are in stock at a value.

XL 14ct **Ataulfo Mangoes** in the "Champagne" brand will also be offered starting the week of 3/8 and continuing through the season. **Champagne Mangoes** lend themselves to March, April and May promos and display builds.



CV TOMATOES

NOTE: **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes** remain steady, though some limitations are beginning to develop. Pricing is higher as shortages across other **Tomato** categories shift additional demand toward these items.

ALERT! **Roma** and **Round/Vine-Ripe Tomatoes** are expensive and limited, though beginning to show early signs of improvement. Current supply is coming from Mexico with the high pricing starting to ease as availability stabilizes. Quality has remains strong. Overall market conditions are expected to stay elevated through late March due to reduced acreage in Mexico and continued limited production from Florida due to the previous freeze.

NOTE: **Snacking Tomatoes** continue to see constrained supply across the category, with **ALERT!** **Cocktail Tomatoes** remaining the most difficult to source. Markets remain firm overall, though **Grape Tomatoes** are beginning to show early signs of relief as supply gradually improve. Broader availability is expected to build through the second half of March, though **Cocktail Tomatoes** may remain tight into April.



CV APPLES

NEW: The first arrivals of the new season **Moxxi Apple** are beginning in early March. This relatively new variety is only in its second commercial season and is expected to remain available through April. **Moxxi Apples** are a proprietary variety marketed by Stemilt growers and are a cross between "Honeycrisp Apples" and "Crimson Crisp Apples", offering a sweet-tart flavor profile and strong consumer appeal.

GOOD NEWS! **Envy Apples** remain available in promotable volumes with excellent quality.

Eastern **Gala** and **Honeycrisp Apples** remain in firm supply with strong and rising markets as demand continues to exceed available supplies.

Eastern **Granny Smith Apples** have concluded for the season.

Cosmic Crisp Apples continue to remain in firm supply as shippers attempt to stretch the season to maintain availability for an extended period.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! **Strawberries** are promotable out of Florida with strong supply and attractive pricing. Florida quality has been arriving excellent. California **Strawberries** are also beginning to increase in volume, with the market expected to gradually transition to California fruit later in March.

Blackberries remain steady overall out of Central Mexico. Supply and pricing remain consistent with great tasting, excellent eating **Blackberries**.

NOTE: **Raspberry** supplies have tightened quickly out of Central Mexico as crop transitions have reduced availability. Pricing is increasing while overall quality remains excellent.

ALERT! **Blueberries** continue to be limited as all growing regions are reporting extremely light harvests. Expect high prices and limited availability through the remainder of March and possibly longer.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blackberries** also remain available with excellent quality. **NOTE:** **Driscoll's Sweetest Batch Blueberries** are now limited.



CV WARM VEG

Mini Cucumbers and **Euro Cucumbers** continue to see steady movement in the market, though overall supply is not particularly abundant. Conditions have been inconsistent in recent weeks, but the category is expected to gradually improve through late March.

ALERT! Cucumbers have tightened in supply, particularly Super Select from Mexico. Prices have risen sharply and supplies may remain uneven through mid-March.

Eggplant remains steady with decent supplies from Mexico. Quality is so-so

Green Squash has remained fairly steady, while **Yellow Squash** has tightened in supply with pricing rising as a result.



CV POTATOES

The Green Giant **Red** and **Gold Potato** market is pushing higher out of Idaho as the industry moves past Potato Lovers Month. Both **Red** and **Gold** 10/5lb Green Giant brand **Potatoes** are expected to increase by a couple of dollars in early March.

10/5lb Green Giant **White Potatoes** are also seeing a modest increase in price as supplies tighten slightly.

GOOD NEWS! Shipper brands on 10/5lb **Potatoes**, all varieties, remain promotable.



CV ARTICHOKES

NOTE: **Artichokes** are entering a challenging transition period as the Coachella deal concludes faster than anticipated while new crop Castroville, CA production remains behind schedule. This has created a temporary supply gap between growing regions, tightening overall availability through late March.

Shippers are advising against promotional activity until after Easter as the market adjusts to reduced field volume. Smaller sizes may be used to help supplement supply depending on harvest yields during this transition.



CV PINEAPPLE

Honeybear Topless Pineapples are now available! This pineapple will be in steady supply going forward! The tops are being re-planted in Costa Rica and shipping without tops affords more pineapples per case and increased shipping efficiencies!

Pineapple supplies and pricing are overall steady to start the month of March.



CV STONE FRUIT

Chilean **Stone Fruit** continues to offer an excellent selection with strong quality reported throughout the season. **Nectarines**, **Peaches**, and **Donut Peaches** remain available along with a wide range of **Plums** including **Black**, **Red**, **Lemon**, **Watermelon**, and **Sugar** varieties.

Imported **Cherries** have wrapped up for the season. The new crop California **Cherry** season is expected to be one of the earliest in recent history. Stay tuned!



CV CABBAGE

GOOD NEWS! **Green Cabbage** has been showing very nice quality out of Florida, with good supplies and favorable pricing anticipated for the St. Patrick's Day promotional period.



CV MELONS

GOOD NEWS! **Cantaloupes** are showing favorable market condition with solid quality available.

Honeydews remain the highest priced **Melon** across all growing regions due to tighter supply.

Seedless Watermelons from Mexico remain steady, with the industry largely moving past the impacts of cartel activity. Florida fruit is expected to begin arriving at the end of March and continue into April.

NOTE: **Mini Seedless Watermelons** have tightened in supply out of Guatemala due to a transition between growing fields. Very limited availability is expected through early March. Mexico will continue to offer product, though pricing will be higher.



CV LETTUCE

Iceberg Lettuce has seen significant price relief following a period of extremely tight supply. Production levels have improved and availability is moving closer to seasonal norms as new acreage enters harvest.

Romaine Hearts supplies are stabilizing and harvest yields are gradually improving.

West Coast **Green Leaf**, **Red Leaf**, and **Romaine Lettuce** remain stable, while Florida production continues to supplement market availability and help moderate average pricing.



CV BEANS

ALERT! **Green Beans** remain in tight supply, with Mexico currently serving as the primary growing region. Quality has been fair and pricing remains elevated, with little change expected through mid-March. Packaged **Green Bean** fill-rates are impacted too.



CV GRAPES

Import specialty **Grapes** from The Grapery will be available for March and April selling the week of 3/15 with branded **Cotton Candy**, **Moon Drop**, and **Gum Drop Grapes** in their high graphic bags.

GOOD NEWS! **Red Grapes** remain promotable with good availability, and **Black Grapes** are also showing steady supplies to support promotions.

Green Grape markets are moving higher as supply tightens.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! **Mandarins** from California continue to show excellent quality on Halos brand, with varieties expected to remain strong through May. Imported fruit is also providing value in the market as Morocco volumes increase.

Texas **Rio Star Grapefruit** supplies are winding down, prompting a transition into California fruit meanwhile Florida **Grapefruit** remain available until the end of its season. Markets should become more favorable once the full transition to California is completed.

GOOD NEWS! **Heirloom Navel Oranges**, **Navel Oranges**, and **Cara Cara Oranges** are showing promo opportunities, especially on Jumbo/XL sizing. **Blood Oranges**, **SUMO Citrus Dekopons**, and **Minneola Tangelos** all continue in peak season.

ALERT! **Limes** continue to see lower than normal crop volumes, with markets expected to rise through March. Disruptions in Mexico have also contributed to delays and additional upward pressure on pricing.

Kiwiberries have transitioned to New Zealand with the Tahiti variety. Availability should continue through mid-March with a slight increase in pricing. The New Zealand crop is expected to deliver a premium eating experience.

ALERT! **Corn** from Florida has continued to rise in pricing while availability declines due to freeze damage. **Tray Pack Corn** will not be offered until growing conditions improve, while 48ct crate **Corn** will be in very sporadic supply.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

GOOD NEWS! **Brussels Sprouts** production has moved into a strong domestic supply window with consistent sizing and quality across most shippers. Fields are producing well and availability is expected to remain strong through late March. Current market conditions present a favorable opportunity for promotional activity leading into the Easter demand period.



CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! **Broccoli Crowns** supplies continue to improve as Florida production returns to steady levels with only minimal West Coast product. Overall supply is supportive of promotional activity, and excellent quality is being produced from Florida.

Broccoli Rabe production has rebounded following earlier field limitations.

NOTE: **Sweet Baby Broccoli** availability continues to be limited. Supply is expected to gradually improve through late March.

Cauliflower supply conditions are beginning to improve following recent quality and sizing challenges related to weather in desert growing regions. Discoloration pressure has eased somewhat and additional volume is entering the market, though sizing remains slightly smaller than normal. Market pricing has improved significantly.

OTHER STORIES

NOTE: **Pomegranates** from Israel have finished for the season and the market is awaiting the start of Peru fruit. Expect a short gap between these two seasons.

ALERT! **POM Wonderful Pomegranate Arils** are in gap during transition to their Peru Import season to start. Fruit should arrive for the middle of March.

Green Kiwi volumes tightened from Greece and Italy due to some container delays. Prices have increased.



CV CELERY

NOTE: **Celery** supply remains somewhat inconsistent and expensive due to winter weather impacts earlier in the growing cycle. Larger sizing remains more abundant while overall production continues to recover gradually. Availability is expected to improve through late March as additional fields come into harvest and markets begin to ease.



CV PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! **Mini Mix Sweet Peppers** continue to show good availability and pricing out of Mexico.

GOOD NEWS! Mexican **Colored Bell Peppers** and 15lb **Elongated Red Peppers** are well supplied with strong availability and quality. Markets are favorable and supporting good retail movement. Additional 11lb production from Canada is expected to begin entering the market in early to mid-April, which should help maintain steady supply as the category transitions toward spring.

ALERT! **Green Peppers** have tightened in supply, with production coming from both Florida and Mexico, though neither region is producing in large volumes. Pricing has risen accordingly.

ALERT! **Cubanelles**, **Shishito Peppers**, **Long Hot Peppers**, and **Red Fresno Peppers** have all become more difficult to source, with pricing increases most notable on **Cubanelles** and **Long Hots**.

GOOD NEWS! Mexican **Hass Avocados** continue to be in good supply and are promotable.

Scallions are beginning to show increased supply and easing pricing from Mexico.

Asparagus supply across the industry remains constrained as production transitions through Baja and into Caborca, Mexico. **NOTE:** As many growers approach the end of their peak production window, overall volume is expected to trend downward heading into the Easter demand cycle.


