ORGANIC AVOCADOS FOR CINCO DE MAYO



GOOD NEWS! Organic Hass Avocado supplies are ramping up for a big Cinco de Mayo push!

Start planning now to gain increased volume and sales on this popular Avocado-theme day!

32ct Jumbo, 48ct XL, and 60ct Lg and multiple bagged options will be available. Free Avocados from Mexico Point of Sale bins and materials!

Organic Fair Trade Hass Avocados from Calavo will also be available in limited supplies.



OG BERRIES

Organic Blackberries continue to be steady. Harvests are beginning to increase. A promotable early May is expected with good volume and excellent quality.

Organic Raspberries will be steady in late April. Production and availability are steady with excellent quality fruit coming from Mexico and California.

NOTE: Organic Strawberries will begin the last week of April tight after the California rain, but crops are expected to rebound quickly. Pricing should be steady, and quality has been excellent. Some bruising is expected early in the week, but quality should continue to improve with each arrival.

Organic Blueberries are available with easing prices as availability begins to increase quickly. Southeast growers are beginning harvests, and volume is expected to be large through May. Promotable pricing and volume with excellent quality are expected.



OG STONE FRUIT

GOOD NEWS! The first Organic California **Cherries** are in house. There was heavy rain on Tuesday 4/21, and it is unknown at this time the overall effect to the crop. The first fruit of the season is looking and eating good.

GOOD NEWS! The first California **Organic Apricots** are coming in. Supplies are expected to remain limited and sporadic as the season starts. Then, better supply is expected in May.

OUTLOOK: The first **Organic Yellow Peaches** are expected to arrive the first weekend in May.



OG TROPICALS

Organic Mango volumes have stalled.

The volume decline is especially notable on the popular **Organic Ataulfo Honey Mango** variety. Higher than average pricing for this time of year is expected, along with chances for limited supplies.

Organic Pineapple supplies from Mexico on both 6 ct and 8 ct will be in stock and steady for late April. Limited supply of Costa Rican **Organic Pineapples** are available as well.

Organic Pomegranate Arils will remain steady for late April. **NOTE:** Import **Organic Pomegranate Arils** are limited this season from Peru, and pricing is higher than the domestic season.

NOTE: Organic Papaya are limited.

Organic Dragon Fruit are gapping.



OG SQUASH & EGGPLANT

GOOD NEWS! Organic Green Squash remains abundant and promotable with great quality from Lady Moon Farms in Florida.

Organic Eggplants are coming on from Lady Moon Farms in Florida. Quality looks good.



OG APPLES

NOTE: Due to the Organic Apple crop shrinking supply, pricing will move up through late April.

ALERT! Organic Cosmic Crisp and Organic Honeycrisp Apples supply continues to dwindle, and prices continue to rise. Small sporadic gaps are expected in mid to late May.

Canadian Organic Honeycrisp Apples are done for the season. Some Chilean imports should become available in late May with very strong pricing.



OG CUCUMBERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cucumbers remain steady from Mexico, with good quality and fairly promotable pricing even with higher freight rates coming from Arizona.



OG LADY MOON FARMS VEG

GOOD NEWS! Organic Kales, Collard Greens, and Dandelion Greens remain in good supply from Lady Moon Farms in Florida.



OG SPRING VEG

NOTE: Organic Green Snap Peas, Purple Snap Peas, Purple Snow Peas, Green Snow Peas, and English Peas will see a gap from Coke Farms until early May. Some of the compostable packaging Organic Snap Peas in code 227899 will be in stock.

GOOD NEWS! Excellent supplies of beautiful Organic Rhubarb are available now.



OG BEANS

ALERT! Organic Green Beans remain very scarce. A supply gap is expected through the first week of May.



OG KIWI

NOTE: Organic Green Kiwi supply continues to be tight from Greece and Italy. Pricing is expected to remain higher from now to the end of the season.

OUTLOOK: New Zealand Organic Zespri Kiwi is still a few weeks away. Organic SunGold Kiwi should start sometime in early May, and Organic Green Kiwi will likely not be until closer to late May.



OG LOCAL BUNCH VEG

LOCAL Organic Bunch Veg items from Flaim Farms in New Jersey include Organic Cilantro, Dill, Mint, Parsleys, Bunch Spinach, Chards, Dandelion, and Bunch Radish.



OG LETTUCE

Lady Moon is at the end of their season on Organic Red Leaf Lettuce, Green Leaf Lettuce, and Romaine from Florida until Pennsylvania crop gets started closer to June.

Steady supply from California will be available until LOCAL New Jersey gets started in the coming weeks.



OG CELERY

ALERT! Majority of the industry is in outright gap starting late April due to Yuma season being forced to a close two weeks sooner than planned. Mexico production has a high amount of blight being reported and claiming to see a drop of 50 percent in yield. Santa Maria, CA will have **Organic Celery** supplies available as early as the week of May 11. High pricing levels will continue to rise as availability dwindles over the end of April.



OG CITRUS

This was the last week for FOB shipments of **Organic Mandarins** from California. Inventory is expected to last early May, then gap for much of the summer.

NOTE: **Organic Blood Oranges, Organic Cara Cara Oranges, and Organic Minneola Oranges** are slowly winding down from California, with many shippers finishing harvest and shipping.



OG BROCCOLI

ALERT! **Organic Broccoli** is in a tight supply situation with an elevated market, while **Organic Cauliflower** is enduring a sudden gap industry-wide. Majority of shippers are gapping on **Organic Broccoli Crowns** while Bunch 14s are limited.

The desert transition north into Salinas, CA combined with early harvesting has created a supply gap that will take a few weeks to recover from out West. Elevated pricing and limited availability are expected in the short term on **Organic Broccoli** and **Organic Cauliflower** while East Coast production in North Carolina provides better availability on first arrival set for April 28.



OG ASPARAGUS

ALERT! **Organic Asparagus** supply is very limited industry-wide and will continue until bridge growing regions in Mexico begin producing and the domestic market from California recovers.

Organic Asparagus from Durst Farms in California is very limited due to very low yields. Excess rain is not allowing crews to get into fields and harvest without jeopardizing quality and negatively impacting crop. Crossings are limited due to weather challenges and excess seeding.

LOCAL Eastern Fresh New Jersey **Organic Asparagus** is available in limited quantities as well.



OG PEPPERS

ALERT! **Organic Color Bell Peppers** remain limited, though availability has improved. Pricing continues to run expensive, while quality has been okay across available product. Mexico remains limited. Holland product is beginning to arrive in the United States and will be a strong addition with premium quality, while new crop Canadian production is tracking toward mid-May. Overall conditions are improving, though supply remains limited as multiple regions are relied upon.

NOTE: **Organic Green Peppers** are coming on from Lady Moon Farms in Florida. Quality looks good, but pricing is still high.

Organic Jalapeno Peppers are starting to ramp up from Covilli Organics from Mexico.

NOTE: **Organic Mini Mix Peppers** are going up in price from Mexico, however supplies remain adequate.



OG TOMATOES

NOTE: Modest volumes of Lady Moon Farms **Organic Grape, Cherry, and Rainbow Cherry Tomatoes** are arriving April. Prices are high.

ALERT! **Organic Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes** remain tight, though some limited improvement in supply has started to show. Quality remains strong, but pricing continues to run at elevated levels as demand remains strong across the category. Broader **Tomato** shortages are adding pressure, keeping conditions elevated, with the market holding steady but showing little sign of meaningful improvement.

ALERT! **Organic Roma Tomatoes** are tight, though improved availability has started to come into the market. Quality has improved and is now good across available products, while pricing remains very expensive despite some slight easing. Bagged **Organic Roma Tomatoes** are also expected to return following an extended gap.

OTHER STORIES

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Pears** continue to be promotable. As the domestic season winds down and the import season ramps up, there is plenty of amazing fruit to promote.

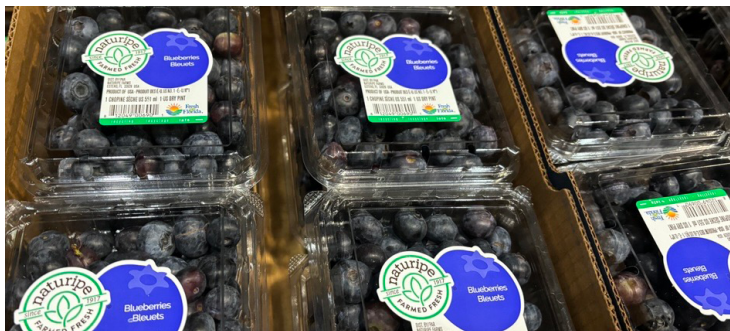
NOTE: **Organic Grape** imports have finished.

New crop Mexico is starting late April on **Organic Green Grapes**. Volume should be ramped up in the start of May.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

APRIL 24 - MAY 1, 2026

BLUEBERRIES RAMPING UP IN SOUTHEAST



Finally, a positive outlook for **Blues!**

Blueberry availability will continue to increase. Southeast farms, including Georgia, are beginning to harvest, and numbers are increasing daily. Pricing will continue to ease, with a promotable month of May expected. Quality should be excellent from the Southeast. 12/1pts and 8/18oz will be good promo items headed towards Memorial Day.

Driscoll's brand **Blueberries** will increase in volume but still command a price premium.



GOOD NEWS! Blackberries will be promotable in late April. Harvests continue to be strong with excellent quality and pricing.

Raspberries remain steady. Pricing and availability remain the same with excellent quality.

NOTE: Strawberries will be tight and short in late April as farms clean up from recent rain. With holiday demand starting for Mother's Day, tighter supplies are expected to continue. Quality has been good, but some bruising is expected early in the week from the rain, with improved quality with each arrival.



CV KIWIFruit

NEW! The wait is finally over Zespri's **Ruby Red Kiwi** is here! **Ruby Red Kiwi** has been in development for over ten years and is finally ready to be sold in the United States.

Ruby Red Kiwi pack size options will be in clamshells in an 8/1 lb and 8/2 lb option. This season is short, so make sure to jump in early and often to get this delicious piece of fruit! Sales from your refrigerated berry set are encouraged for this perishable variety.

Zespri's popular **SunGold Kiwi** will also be back in season. This fruit is also available now in limited supplies until the pipeline fills up!

NOTE: Kiwi from Italy and Greece have been tight on the East Coast, with Chilean fruit also available. This should help pricing until the New Zealand Zespri season starts in late May.



CV ASPARAGUS

LOCAL Asparagus supply is in season on 28 lb packs from New Jersey and Delaware.

Peak harvest numbers are being reported very early, with most domestic shippers producing from New Jersey and Delaware at this time.

Michigan **Asparagus** is ahead of plan and will drive domestic pricing down once in production.

NOTE: Jumbo Asparagus sourced from Mexico and Peru is very limited, and pricing continues to rise with larger sizing being a challenge.



CV STONE FRUIT

California **Cherries** are in house! There was heavy rain on Tuesday 4/21, and it is unknown at this time the overall effect to the crop. The first fruit of the season is looking and eating well.

California **Apricots** are expected to be steady for the start of May despite a shorter crop overall and some rain in California.

The first California **Peaches** arrived in 1-layer euro boxes, and they looked and ate surprisingly well for the first shot.

OUTLOOK: The first California **Nectarines** and **White Peaches** should arrive in house on or about April 28. Smaller fruit is expected out of the gate, but things are expected to ramp up quickly.

Import **Red** and **Black Plum** prices continue to tighten as supplies ramp down. California fruit is expected to begin June.



CV PINEAPPLES

ALERT! Pineapple supplies continue to be tight through late April. Possible prorates on orders and higher market pricing are expected.

Honeybear Topless Pineapples are available with UPC bands! This Pineapple will be in steady supply going forward.



CV CORN

Sweet Corn is finally ramping up in volume from Florida. Prices are dropping on 48ct and 12/4ct Trays will be back in stock. May will be a promotable time for **Sweet Corn!**



CV ARTICHOKES

Artichoke supply is improving and pricing is beginning to ease as Castroville, CA recovers from rain and cold endured at the start of plantings. Steady supply is anticipated from Ocean Mist.



CV MELONS

Mexico and Yuma, AZ **Cantaloupes** and **Honeydews** are coming on strong in late April. Pricing should continue to decrease as supply ramps up and imports finish up.

Florida and Mexico bin **Watermelons** are starting to ramp up for the spring season.



CV CITRUS

GOOD NEWS! Strong quality and great varieties from California on this late season crop of **Mandarins**. Promote!

Limes are coming down from super high prices just in time for Cinco de Mayo. Big box fruit will see more of a decrease from all regions.



CV CELERY

ALERT! Celery has recently pushed into higher market levels as the desert season winds down, and Oxnard, CA becomes the primary growing region. Demand is currently exceeding supply, and additional pressure is coming from disease challenges like fusarium in the region.

Prices are expected to remain expensive in the near term.



CV APPLES

NOTE: Eastern Honeycrisp Apple storage crop supplies continue to dwindle and are expected to be done within early May at best. Limited supplies of Canadian fruit could last a little longer until that dries up in May, leaving just Washington fruit. Prices are expected to rise.



CV WARM VEG

GOOD NEWS! Green and Yellow Squash remain promotable, with overall good quality and good pricing. This should remain fairly steady as Georgia and Florida are both picking now.

Eggplants are slowly coming on in Florida, but pricing is still fairly high and quality is still variable.

Field-grown **Cucumbers** are easing off on pricing as Florida comes in with more volume. Overall, this trend is expected to continue downward in pricing, with some promotability developing.



CV LETTUCE

ALERT! Lettuce, Leaf Lettuce, and Romaine Hearts supplies remain tight across the board.

ALERT! Iceberg Lettuce and Romaine Hearts are the most impacted, with light supplies and expensive prices expected to continue in the near term. Ongoing pressure is coming from soil diseases, insect activity, and earlier-than-normal crop advancement, all of which are impacting yields.

Romaine Hearts in particular are expected to follow the same upward trend already being seen on Iceberg. Florida production is being mixed in to alleviate shortages and ease markets.



CV MANGOS

Ataulfo Honey Mango supplies have tightened from Mexico.

Red Round Mango variety volumes are being helped by off-shore countries like Guatemala, Costa Rica, and Nicaragua aiding in filling up the pipeline.

Despite the snug market, Champagne label **Ataulfo Honey Mangos** will be available in a nice premium size 14 ct and in an 18 ct option through late April.



CV LOCAL VEG

Winter-over plantings and early spring crops of **LOCAL Vegetables** are coming into season in New Jersey! Four Seasons is seeing more items from New Jersey growers Flaim Farms, Nardelli Bros, and Russo Farms including **Cilantro, Parsleys, Leeks, Mint, Bunch Radish, Bunch Spinach, Chards, Kales, and Scallions.**



CV AVOCADOS

GOOD NEWS! Four Seasons is ramping up for what we think could be the biggest Cinco de Mayo party we have ever had! We are stocked up on tremendous Point of Sale materials like bins and racks to support your **Hass Avocado** displays.

Hass Avocados from Mexico will be in great supply and are really hitting their peak in terms of high oil content to make the creamy guacamole we all love! All sizes and various bag options will be available! Vamanos!



CV TOMATOES

ALERT! **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes** remain tight, but availability is steady. Continued pressure from limited supply and strong demand has pushed pricing to historic heights, with markets remaining very elevated. Quality remains strong across available product.

ALERT! **Roma** and **Round Tomatoes** are very limited, though some additional supply has started to come into the market. Pricing continues to run at historic levels, with markets remaining under heavy pressure. Quality has been okay at best across available product. Ongoing supply constraints from Florida and Mexico continue to drive conditions, with no meaningful improvement expected in the near term.

NOTE: **Snacking Tomatoes** remain somewhat limited, though availability continues to improve as supply builds. Pricing is still elevated but has started to ease in certain items.

Cocktail Tomatoes are now in consistent supply with improved pricing from Canada.

Grape Tomatoes have begun to ease as Florida production increases, along with **Medley Tomatoes.**



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: **Broccoli Rabe** and **Sweet Baby Broccoli** are experiencing markets firming up and costs rising. The desert transition north into Salinas, CA combined with early harvesting has created a supply gap that will take a few weeks to recover from out West, while Florida production came to an early end on their season. Elevated pricing and limited availability are expected in the short term while East Coast production gets started from Georgia and North Carolina to alleviate pricing and provide better availability.

ALERT! **Cauliflower** is very limited with most shippers gapping until late April.



CV PEPPERS

Green Peppers are coming down rapidly as Florida comes into good volume. Watch for cost changes, with pricing expected to reach much more promotable levels soon.

Color Bell Peppers are seeing steady availability, with supply neither short nor abundant as the Canadian season continues. Pricing is holding around average levels, with strong quality across the category. While overall conditions remain stable, early signs of tightening are beginning to surface as demand comes in strong, however no meaningful shifts have developed yet.

Jalapeno Peppers, Poblano Peppers, and Long Hot Peppers are coming from Florida, helping to ease pricing.

OTHER STORIES

Pomegranates from Peru are available in a single-layer 6/8 ct option.

Black Mission Figs from Mexico remain tight as volume is down at the end of the season. Peru's season has started, and good supply fruit will be available in late April.

GOOD NEWS! **Green Beans** are in good supply with nice quality from Florida. Pricing is decent with more promotability.

Chilean **Grapes** vessels continue to arrive in small amounts. A switch to Mexico is expected within the next ten to fourteen days.

Washington **Rhubarb** sold out due to its beautiful arrivals. More is expected late April.

ONIONS:

Red or yellow onions will work best, though some shoppers prefer sweet or white onions.

TOMATOES:

Roma/Plum Tomatoes are preferred for their firmness and lower gel content, but all varieties of tomatoes can be included.

JALAPENO PEPPERS:

Kick it up a notch by adding some heat with jalapenos, or REALLY turn up the heat by adding habaneros!

LIMES:

Limes are perfect to squeeze over your guacamole, slice for Mexican beer, or for making fresh margaritas!

MANGOS:

Mangos will be a great sell over the Cinco de Mayo weekend and look great tied into your displays. Four Seasons Produce will have both Tommy Atkins and Ataulfo (Honey) Mangos ready for your displays!
