LOCAL ORGANIC HARD SQUASHES BEGIN



Late summer means the start of of **LOCAL Hard Squash** peak season!

Four Seasons Produce is partnered with cooperatives of Plain-community growers in Pennsylvania that are packing a full lineup of varieties with PLU stickers in the box. Quality is looking great so far as we head into peak season now through early November.

The most familiar and popular varieties that anchor the category are **Organic Butternut**, **Spaghetti**, and **Green Acorn**.

Organic Delicata sells great and it's shell is actually edible when roasted at high heat. **Organic Pie Pumpkins** are ideal for making your own pie filling and purees.

The culinary darling varieties of recent years are **Organic Koginut**, which crosses butternut and kabocha for a rich, sweet, nutty flavor and creamy texture, and **Organic Honeynut**, which is a smaller, sweeter, more flavorful version of butternut. **Organic Koginut** are in stock now, while **Organic Honeynut** will come into season later during September.

Two Japanese hard squashes that sell well are **Organic Red Kuri**, which has smooth texture and chestnut-like flavor, and **Organic Kabocha** which is also known as **Japanese Pumpkin** and has a blend of sweet potato and pumpkin taste.



OG BERRIES

Organic Strawberry volumes continue to be light from Salinas, CA as the season continues to wind down. **NOTE:** Volume remains light, and pricing will continue to increase as volume from the Southern California regions is much lighter. Quality has been nice, but expect smaller berries.

Organic Raspberry volumes are light to steady from California. **NOTE:** Harvests continue to come in under projections, leading to prorates and shortages. Pricing will hold firm, and quality has been nice overall from Baja and California.

Organic Blackberry supplies will be tight from California as the season begins to finish. Harvests are limited and much lower than projected. Early Central Mexico fruit will begin and become available right around Labor Day. Quality has been nice and eating well.

ALERT! **Organic Blueberry** pricing is beginning to surge as domestic season is now over. Peruvian imports are expected to be very limited through most of September due to effects of the Super El Niño weather patterns. Temperatures have been much warmer than expected, causing very light yields. Quality has been nice, but expect strong pricing and light availability.



OG TOMATOES

PEAK SEASON! LOCAL Organic Roma and Vine Ripe Tomatoes remain in a favorable position, with dependable availability, stable pricing, and strong quality as August ends. Overall volume from Lancaster County, PA growers has begun to ease; however, additional production is coming online from other growers in PA and NJ which should provide added support as the calendar turns to September.

PEAK SEASON! LOCAL Organic Grape, Cherry, Cherry Medley, Sunburst Gold, and Golden Grape continue in peak season from Lady Moon Farms' fields in Chambersburg, PA. **LOCAL Organic Heirloom Slicing Tomatoes** are also at their best!

Organic Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes are becoming increasingly tight, with available volume falling short of demand even as overall movement remains relatively soft. September is traditionally a challenging period for both greenhouse products, and intermittent gaps or limited availability are likely as the month progresses. Costs have already begun to edge higher and are expected to remain under upward pressure through much of September.



OG LOCAL ONIONS

LOCAL Organic Jumbo Red Onions and Jumbo Sweet Onions from Lancaster County, PA will be in peak season through September.

High graphic **Organic Bagged Red and Sweet Onions** are being sourced from Peri & Sons out west since our local growers in PA do not have advanced bagging equipment.

Peri & Sons is transitioning from their California grown **Organic Onion** program to their main Nevada crop over the start of September. Minor supply hire up are possible on **Organic Medium Red, Jumbo White, and Jumbo and Medium Yellow Onions** during this transition. Peri is expected to be in full swing from Nevada by mid September.



OG SWEET POTATOES

Pricing on #1 **Organic Japanese Sweet Potatoes** will drop as better supply comes from the fields on the new crop product.

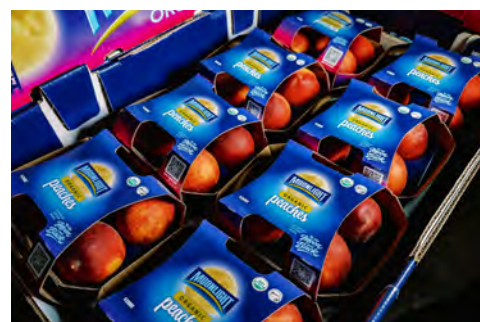
New crop California **Organic Stokes Purple Sweet Potatoes** are expected to arrive in early September.



OG GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! California **Organic Grapes** are at peak season with premium varieties, high-profile flavor, and abundant supply. Promote into September on all colors!

One of the most popular new grape varieties, **AutumnCrisp**, is now in peak season. This big, sweet, crispy-crunchy variety is being stocked at Four Seasons in our **Organic Green 19lb (43885)** and **8/2lb clamshell (42690)** lines!



OG STONE FRUIT

Washington **Organic Peaches** and **Nectarines** are in firm supply and expected to be in season until mid-September.

A small shot of **Organic Italian Prune Plums** is expected, with the season expected to finish within 1-2 weeks. Get them while available.



OG MANGOS

NOTE: **Organic Mangos** are winding down from Mexico, finishing that season by early September.

Four Seasons will immediately begin with a California **Organic Keitt Mango** option, available in a 10 ct size and a massive 5 ct piece of fruit to start. Pricing will be higher.



OG SPINACH

Organic Bunch Spinach supplies have improved a bit, with Lakeside being the main supplier. Pricing remains high.



OG PEARS

New crop Washington **Organic Bartlett Pears** are now available in US #1 (premium) and Fancy (value grade) for merchandising and price point options.



OG APPLES

NEW: Premium **Organic Sweetango Apples** started earlier than expected, with first arrival now in. Give this Honeycrisp and Zestar crossbreed a try.

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Gala** and **Honeycrisp Apples** have fully transitioned to new crop from Washington, with excellent quality and supply expected along with easing pricing.

New Zealand **Organic Dazzle** and **Diva** have virtually ended for the season. A random pallet here or there may arrive, but nothing conclusive at the moment.

Strong Crop **Organic Kanzi Apples** are back in stock.



OG LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Romaine Hearts** remain promotable for early September with excellent quality, mixing primarily domestic California supply and some Quebec. There will likely be more supply of Quebec product sourced to hold steady, promotable pricing as the California market begins to firm on availability.



OG CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

Organic Cauliflower will remain promotable for another week before pricing begins to firm and availability is less abundant in early to mid September. Pending West Coast pressure and to alleviate rising costs, Four Seasons will rely more on Quebec supply as availability permits.

Organic Broccoli Crowns and **Bunches** are rising significantly due to lack of availability, sizing challenges, and quality concerns industry wide. Extreme pricing on **Organic Broccoli Crowns** is causing additional pressure on the bunch market, while relief is expected around the start of September as new crop yields better quality and crowns mature in size to harvest.



OG AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocado supplies are steady as September begins. Most fruit being offered is coming from Mexico. There are still opportunities on a few 48 ct California fruit available.

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Avocados** are in house for early September, featuring beautiful Fair Trade 48 and 60 count fruit along with a ReadyCycle 8/4ct tray program for convenient grab-and-go merchandising.

PEAK SEASON! **Organic Green Skin Avocados** are steady from Florida for early September. Get these on shelves for the fall.



OG PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Greenhouse **Organic Color Bell Peppers** continue to be a bright spot, with abundant supply, outstanding quality, and attractive pricing creating promotional opportunities. Take advantage of current conditions with strong displays and additional promotions while volume remains plentiful into early September.

LOCAL Organic Green Peppers are in good supply from Lady Moon Farms and Central PA Produce Coop, with steady to slightly improved pricing.

Plenty of **LOCAL PA Organic Hot and Specialty Peppers** are around right now, including **Organic Habanero, Long Hot, Anaheim, Cubanelle, Serrano, Poblano, Shishito,** and limited **Red Fresno Peppers**.

Organic Grapefruit has limited supply in California. Mexico and South Africa will slowly enter the marketplace soon, but for the coming 2-3 weeks, expect limited availability and very elevated pricing.



OG ASPARAGUS

NOTE: **Organic Asparagus** is in low supply with expensive pricing likely lasting deep into September.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

NOTE: **Organic Brussels Sprouts** are available in modest supply at higher pricing from California. Packaged product in a gap.



OG MELONS

GOOD NEWS! **Organic Cantaloupes** and **Honeydew** have strong supply from California with top-notch quality and flavor. Promote into Labor Day.

Organic Mini Watermelons from California are in good supply and great eating quality.

Organic Watermelons will be wrapping up for the season in California. **LOCAL** Pennsylvania crop will supply any needs for Labor Day week-end with improved pricing and good sugar.



OG LOCAL VEG

Organic Eggplant supplies have improved a bit from **LOCAL** Lady Moon Farms, Pennsylvania, with **LOCAL** Flaim Farms, New Jersey helping to supplement.

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Lady Moon Farms is in good supply on **Green Kale, Red Kale,** and **Collard Greens**. **Lacinato Kale** supplies are improving from **LOCAL** Lady Moon, with **LOCAL** Flaim Farms, New Jersey helping to fill the gap.

LOCAL PA Organic Fennel is in season from Lady Moon Farms!

Lady Moon continues in season with high quality **LOCAL Organic Green Squash** from PA!

OTHER STORIES

PEAK SEASON! **Organic Passion Fruit** from California is available in limited supplies as September begins. The fruit has been very nice with good dark purple color.

PEAK SEASON! **Organic Brown Turkey** and **Black Mission Figs** are steady in a 12/8 oz option from California.

NOTE: **Organic Pineapple** supplies from Mexico have tightened considerably. Pricing is on the rise since fruit is limited.

PUMPKINS & ORNAMENTALS SEASON OUTLOOK



GOOD NEWS! Now is the time to start planning for a successful fall selling season! First of the season inbound arrivals are hitting our docks from PA and OH growers from 8/27 through 9/4 to be ready to fill your displays with **LOCAL Pumpkins, Mini Pumpkins, Gourds, Indian Corn, Straw Bales, Corn Stalks**, and more!

One of the great ways to build shopper engagement and create a buying atmosphere is to inspire seasonal home and office decorating with displays of Pumpkins and Ornamentals. Top performing retailers get an initial display up with these items just before or after Labor Day to kick off the season, and then build a bigger dynamic display, often in the vestibule or out in front of the store, for prime time decorative selling around late September to sell down by late October.

OUTLOOK:

Our main **LOCAL** Lancaster County, PA grower of **Face Pumpkins** bins, Harnish Farms, is reporting strong quality and good supply. Pricing will be similar to last year with minor increases due to the higher cost of input materials.

LOCAL Lancaster County, PA **Specialty Pumpkins**, like the popular **Autumn Mix** bin (**Blue Jarrahdale, Pink Porcelain, Peanut**) and **Fall Fantasy** bin (**Fairytale, White Flat, Cinderella**), are expected to be in steady supply with reasonable pricing.

Gourds and **Mini Pumpkin** varieties allow shoppers easy to take home options from **LOCAL** growers. **Jack-be-Little, Baby Boo White, Pumpkin Little, Sparkler, and Tiger Stripe** should be as popular as ever.



CV BERRIES

Blueberries continue to see a split market between new crop Peru and domestic end of season.

Domestic **Blueberries** continues to be available with light supply, and pricing is substantially less than Peru.

Fresh new crop Peru **Blueberries** continues to command a premium as volumes are very light as well. El Niño weather patterns are keeping harvests light. **NOTE:** Expect very tight supplies heading into September and October. Pricing will continue to rise.

Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** remain promotable from Peru.

Strawberries are tight from California. Northern District fields are finishing for the season, and volume remains light. Quality has improved, but expect some light bruising and smaller fruit. New crop Santa Maria fruit is just getting started with very light supplies available.

NOTE: Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Strawberries** are finished for the season.

Blackberry supplies will be light. California supplies are slowing down, and Mexico has not yet started. Pricing will rise and quality has been nice overall.

Raspberry supplies will be light from California. Fields are beginning to slow much quicker than anticipated, and Mexico has not yet started.



CV APPLES

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Eastern and Western **Gala Apples** have fully transitioned to new crop, with excellent quality and supply expected.

LOCAL Eastern new crop **Honeycrisp Apples** are now available in 40 lb bulk, 8 ct tote bags, and 12/3 lb poly bags.

Washington new crop **Rave Apples** are in season for late August and September.

SweetTango Apples are coming into season for September.

New "Bluey" branded bagged Eastern **Ginger Gold Apples** are available by request in 12/2 lb pouches for a healthy back-to-school snack.

Washington storage crop **Red Delicious Apples** are very limited with strong pricing and expected to run out for the season within a few weeks, then gap until November.



CV LOCAL VEG

LOCAL Cucumbers are in adequate supply, with pricing steady to slightly increased. Most volume is from Pennsylvania or New Jersey right now.

Kirby Cucumbers are also in decent supply for summer pickling.

LOCAL Green Beans remain in steady supply with pricing down slightly and fairly promotable. Most volume is from Pennsylvania and New York.

LOCAL Green Pepper pricing has strengthened a bit with the glut from New Jersey mostly passed, but still remain affordable and promotable. Quality remains nice.

LOCAL Sweet Corn is in great supply from Delaware, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey with stable pricing and sharp quality.

LOCAL Hard Squash from Pennsylvania growers has begun with great quality.



CV SPECIALTY

GOOD NEWS! White-flesh **Dragon Fruit** is promotable and sweeter **Yellow Pitahaya Dragon Fruit** are steadily available.

PEAK SEASON! **Starfruit (Carambola)** will be steady from Florida for early September.

PEAK SEASON! **Quenepas** and **Rambutan** are now available in bulk options and will be available through early September.



CV MELONS

California **Cantaloupe** and **Honeydew** supply and quality will remain strong for Labor Day sales; however, pricing is expected to see a gradual increase as the industry moves into September.

Bin Watermelons are tightening as East Coast grower slows in production. Pricing is up but quality remains good for Labor Day.

Mini Watermelons are in good supply from Kentucky and California.



CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! East Coast **Broccoli** production continues to ramp up from Maine and NY, mixing minimal West Coast. Promotable pricing and excellent quality are being seen upon arrivals.

GOOD NEWS! **Cauliflower** pricing continues to allow for promotional opportunity. Beautiful quality and **Jacket Cauliflower** are available from East Coast and Canadian shippers for a no-cello alternative at an even better price point.



CV MANGOS

New Crop **Mangos** from Brazil are in stock. Most fruit is the "**Tommy Atkins**" variety, with some "**Palmer**" variety also being shipped.

Four Seasons is also offering a green "**Keitt**" **Mango** from Puerto Rico in 10 and 12 ct sizing options. Larger fruit is not as easy to get right now.



CV CITRUS

NEW: **Heirloom Navels** from South Africa are now available in high graphic boxes and 3lb bags.

New crop bulk and 3lb bag **Navels** and **Cara Cara Oranges** have strong supply at promotable pricing from the Southern Hemisphere. Look to push through September.

Mandarins have limited arrivals due to weather challenges in Chile in June and July. Pricing rapidly escalated and will remain high through early September.



CV GRAPES

GOOD NEWS! **Grapes** are at peak season from California with excellent supply on all colors and a full range of sizing. Quality is excellent and supply is at promotional levels.



CV PINEAPPLES

Four Seasons continues to have UPC's **Topless Pineapples** available from Honeybear brand, where every top is re-planted in Costa Rica to aid sustainability efforts. Ask your sales associate for more details.

NOTE: Overall, **Pineapple** supplies have tightened considerably as September begins.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

NOTE: **Brussels Sprouts** availability is tightening due to undersizing and Diamondback Moth larvae presence, damaging crop and reducing overall yields. Steady availability is being maintained as pricing continues to rise. Relief will be seen closer to mid-September as growers work to prevent the infestation from spreading and new crop offers better quality with reduced insect pressure risk.



CV FALL FRUIT

California-grown **Pomegranates** are steady. The "Early Wonderful" variety will start soon; currently the Grenada variety has been offered. POM Wonderful estimated their season will start in early to mid-October.

California **Fresh Figs** are steady. Extreme heat has shortened picking days, but overall quality remains good.

California-grown **Quince** are now in stock for end-of-summer and fall sets.



CV PEARS

Asian Pears have fully transitioned to new crop California fruit in both bulk and clamshells. Add this sought-after novelty to your mix for added sales.

Bosc Pears also started a little earlier than expected. Transition from California to Washington will occur through mid-September.

Both Pacific Northwest **Bartlett** and **Red Starkrimson Pears** are joining the mix in premium pack 27 lb euro boxes.



CV GREENHOUSE CUCUMBERS

Euro and **Mini Seedless Cucumbers** are beginning to tighten following an extended stretch of plentiful supply and promotional pricing. Reduced production, combined with a seasonal pickup in demand, is beginning to push costs higher as August comes to a close. Quality remains good, but the heavy promo seen through much of the summer are expected to fade heading into September.



CV SPECIALTY GRAPES

The Grapery's lineup of specialty varieties continues in peak season which is running earlier this year. Now through mid-September will be the best time of the year to promote interesting looking and tasting branded varieties: **Cotton Candy**, **Moon Drop**, **Gum Drop**, and **Tear Drop Grapes!**

AutumnCrisp have become a sought after green grape variety thanks to it's crispy-crunchy texture, sweet taste, and large size. Four Seasons Produce is offering premium **AutumnCrisp Green Grapes** in our **Jumbo Green** 19lb (10585) and **Green** 6/3lb clamshell (211276) lines.



CV STONE FRUIT

Plumcots and **Pluots** are currently available in **Red**, **Black**, **Green**, and **Mottled** varieties, great tasting items for kids' lunchboxes or at work snacking.

California **Plum** pricing is on the rise, and supplies are dwindling fast. Expect stronger pricing and some sporadic out-of-stocks until the season ends in September.

White and **Yellow Nectarine** and **Peach** pricing is firming as the end of the season nears. Expect pricing to rise and some sporadic out-of-stocks until the season wraps up for good in September.

About two weeks remain on the **Italian Prune Plum** crop. Some Empress variety is expected for a week or two after that before the season wraps up for good in September.



CV LETTUCE

Iceberg and **Romaine** pricing is rising quickly due to weather challenges leading to lower yields in Quebec, while West Coast California shippers report below-budget harvests. **Romaine** follows a similar trend with less demand and a more subtle rise. Quebec supply continues to provide the best price and quality as new fields are harvested and quality improves.

Romaine Hearts are steady and promotable as California continues to compete with Quebec supply.



CV TOMATOES

LOCAL Roma, **Vine Ripe**, and **Heirloom Tomatoes** continue to see steady availability from Pennsylvania and New Jersey as the **LOCAL** season carries into September. Quality remains strong, with pricing holding at reasonable levels for now. Heavy rainfall through August could begin to affect production as the season moves into its later stages, particularly by mid to late September.

Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** remain steady despite lower yields from Canadian greenhouses. Lighter summer demand has kept pricing favorable, while quality remains strong.

OTHER STORIES

ALERT! Industry continues to gap on larger **Artichoke** sizing (12-18 ct) until new crop offers better yields and conditions normalize. Larger sizing being offered has reached expensive costs at subpar quality.

NOTE: **Asparagus** from Mexico is starting to fall below projections earlier than anticipated, creating sudden supply shortages due to yield, seasonality, and quality. Steady rain in the region for several weeks has Central Mexico winding down, while Peruvian volume continues to run below projections from El Niño effects, creating a supply shortage heading into September.

NOTE: **Snap Peas** are dwindling in supply through mid-September due to El Niño effects in Peru, and domestic availability lands at a much higher price point.

NOTE: **Broccoli Rabe** is on allocation due to reduced yields with relief **NOTE:** expected by mid-September.
