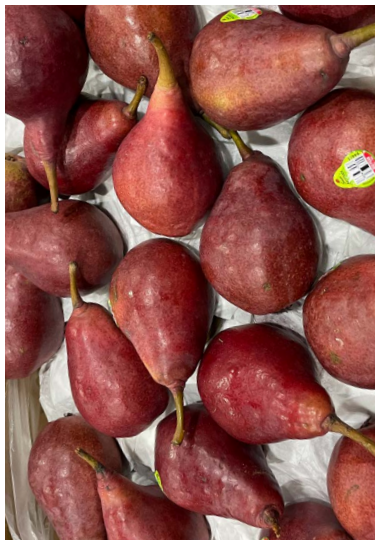

ORGANIC PEAR SEASON BEGINS



GOOD NEWS!

Organic Pear season is ramping up in Oregon and Washington, and a good crop is expected.

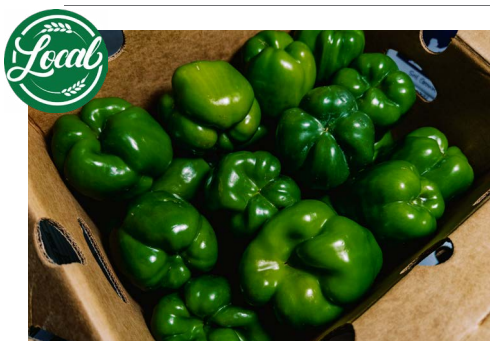
PEAK SEASON!

Organic Bartlett Pears are in promotable supply and quality for September and October. US#1 top grade in 80/90s and 100s will be stocked. For retailers looking to save close to \$10 per 40-44lb case, Fancy grade **Organic Bartlett Pears** are now being stocked as well. Fancy grade shows occasional scars and limb rub but it otherwise the same quality and flavor fruit.

Organic Starkrimson Red Pears are at their best for late summer and early fall too! This variety has vivid color and floral tones to the sweet flesh.

From Columbia Gorge in Oregon, **Organic Asian Pears** (Hosui variety) are getting started, with the first arrivals in stock by 9/7.

The first Washington **Organic Bosc Pears** will be in stock around 9/7 with peak season to follow in October through December.



OG LOCAL VEG

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Organic Green Peppers are in good supply with steady pricing from PA and NJ growers.

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Organic Eggplants are in good supply from Lady Moon Farms, PA, as well as Central PA Produce and King Family Farms in PA. Quality has been nice.

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Organic Green Kale and **Organic Collard Greens** are in good supply from Lady Moon Farms, PA. **Organic Lacinato Kale** is a bit lighter in supply, but we are supplementing with NJ. Quality on all local **Organic Greens** has been nice.

LOCAL Organic Green and **Yellow Squash** supplies have tightened as Lady Moon Farms finishes their PA crop of **Organic Green Squash**. Inconsistent quality from NJ is creating tighter supply. Lady Moon Farms is expected to begin their new crop out of Florida in mid-September.

LOCAL Organic Cucumbers are in shorter supply from East Coast growing regions. NJ is producing, and Lady Moon Farms is expected to begin their Florida new crop in early October. Mexico is beginning to offer better pricing on 36ct **Organic Cucumbers**.

LOCAL Organic Corn from PA provides light volume with challenges due to rain making harvest difficult. California is wrapping up early in due to unstable weather.



OG BERRIES

Organic Raspberries will have steady availability out of California and Baja, Mexico. Quality has been nice, and harvests remain steady. Central Mexico is expected to begin production in early to mid-October.

NOTE: Organic Strawberries are steady to light out of Salinas, CA. Harvests remain modest as we approach the end of the Salinas, CA season over the next few weeks. Quality has been nice, although berries have been smaller in size. We expect to transition to Oxnard in early to mid-October.

NOTE: Organic Blackberries are tight out of California. Mexico volume has begun lightly as weather conditions have been favorable for an early crop. Expect tight availability from both regions through mid-September.

ALERT! Organic Blueberries will be limited with high pricing. Availability out of Peru is expected to remain light, with sporadic arrivals through September. Pints will be more limited than 6 oz, quality is exceptional.



OG APPLES

PEAK SEASON! New crop Washington **Organic Gala** and **Honeycrisp Apples** are in good supply with easing markets.

Washington new crop **Organic Fuji** and **Granny Smith Apples** are expected to begin over the next week or two we may experience a very small gap during the transition.

Washington storage crop **Organic Kanzi Apples** are back in good supply.

The first Canadian **Organic McIntosh Apples** of the season are expected to arrive mid-September. A limited crop is expected.

New Zealand **Organic Dazzle** and **Diva Apples** are expected to finish for the season in mid-September.

Washington **Organic Envy Apples** are expected to finish for the season in mid-September, and then gap until October.



OG PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Organic Pineapple supplies from Mexico have tightened considerably to start September. Pricing is on the rise as available fruit remains limited.



OG FRESH FIGS

PEAK SEASON! Organic Fresh Brown Turkey and Black Mission Figs are beginning to slow down slightly from California to start September. Pricing is expected to move up a tick, but feature this seasonal fruit while it is at it's best!



OG MANGOES

Organic Mangoes will officially transition to California-grown Organic Keitt Mangoes to start September. "Keitt" Mangoes tend to size larger, with some impressive 5ct Jumbo premium fruit expected to be available throughout the season. Four Seasons will also offer a 9/10ct option during September.

NOTE: Prices are higher for this small volume California program.



OG GRAPES

PEAK SEASON! Organic Grapes are in strong supply with top-notch quality and excellent flavor. Look for the Sun Pacific (Air Chief and famous brands) contest starting 9/14.

Organic Autumn Crisp Green Grapes are fantastic!

Organic Thomcord Grapes remain in season too.



OG PURPLE SWEET POTATOES

PEAK SEASON! #1 size Organic Stokes Purple Sweet Potatoes are back in stock in code 41822, to kick off the peak season in California.

12/3lb Organic Bagged Stokes Purple Sweet Potatoes will be in stock by 9/6



OG CITRUS

NOTE: Organic Grapefruit supply out of California is limited. Expect elevated pricing through mid-September, with possible gaps in supply.

NOTE: Organic Lemons are in limited supply out of California and Argentina and remain pricey.



OG ONIONS

Organic Red and Sweet Onions are now from Peri & Sons with the first arrival from their new crop Nevada growing region expected in stock 9/7.

New crop Organic White Onions will be available from Peri & Sons 9/11. **NOTE:** A small gap in Organic White Onion supply may occur.



OG GREENHOUSE PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Colored Bell Peppers continue to flourish as September gets underway, with abundant supplies, outstanding quality, and aggressive pricing. Costs have become even more favorable, creating an excellent opportunity to maintain prominent displays and continue driving additional sales.

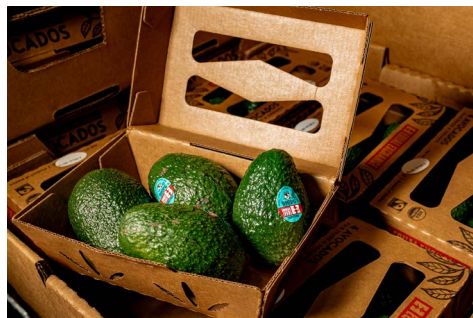
Canadian volume should remain supportive in the near term before gradually easing later in September, setting the stage for a smooth transition into Mexican production in late September or early October.



OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Organic Brussels Sprouts are relying on California limited supply until growing conditions and quality improve on import supply.

Projected around September 20. Markets should begin to normalize then depending on weather surrounding the first harvest, with promotable offerings planned for early October.



OG AVOCADOS

Organic Hass Avocado supplies are steady to start September, with most fruit being offered now from Mexico. A few 48ct California-grown **Organic Avocados** are available as the season winds down.

Equal Exchange **Organic Fair Trade Avocados** are in house, featuring beautiful 48ct and 60ct fruit along with 8/4 ct ReadyCycle trays for convenient grab-and-go merchandising.

Organic Green Skin Avocados are steady from Florida to begin September.



OG ORGANIC SPECIALTY FRUIT

PEAK SEASON! Organic Passion Fruit from California is in available in limited supply to start September. The fruit has been very nice with excellent dark purple color.

PEAK SEASON! Organic Kiwano Horned Melon will be available in a 12/14ct single-layer pack beginning in September.



OG CAULIFLOWER

GOOD NEWS! Organic Cauliflower will be promotable through early September before markets begin to firm and availability becomes less abundant. Depending on West Coast pressure and rising costs, we will rely more on Quebec supply, which is producing beautiful quality as availability permits.



OG BROCCOLI

NOTE: Organic Broccoli Crowns and Bunches are rising significantly due to limited availability, sizing challenges, and quality concerns industry-wide. The extreme market on **Organic Broccoli Crowns** is adding pressure to the 14 ct Bunch market, with relief not expected until late September as new crop yields better quality, insect pressure decreases, and **Crowns** mature to proper harvest size.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli is promotable.



OG LETTUCE

Organic Leaf and Lettuce are relying primarily on Quebec supply, which continues to provide the best combination of price and quality. California supply is being used on **Organic Iceberg Lettuce** and **Organic Romaine Hearts**.

GOOD NEWS! Organic Romaine Hearts from both domestic and Quebec sources remain promotable. The spread between California and Quebec supply is expected to shift in September, with increased reliance on Canadian supply as domestic pricing begins to rise.



OG TOMATOES

NOTE: LOCAL Organic Roma and Vine Ripe Tomatoes have tightened following strong PA production through August, with pricing remaining relatively steady to start September. Pennsylvania volume should briefly improve around mid-September before declining as the Local season winds down in late September and early October. **Organic Roma Tomatoes** will be supplemented with Mexican volume, while **Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes** will finish as Pennsylvania production ends.

NOTE: Organic Beefsteak and Cluster Tomatoes are entering September with significant supply constraints. Quality remains strong on available product, though tightening conditions continue to push costs higher. Supplemental volume from Mexico will help support immediate needs, but limitations and occasional gaps should still be anticipated in the near term. Availability is expected to improve around mid-September.

Organic Scallion pricing has increased slightly and remain in decent supply from Cal-O.

Organic Pomegranates from California are expected to begin making their way to the East Coast around mid to late September.

NOTE: Organic Bin Watermelons winding down for the season out west in CA and locally in PA.

Organic Mini Watermelons are in steady supplies out of CA with great sugar content.

OTHER STORIES

NOTE: LOCAL Organic Green Beans are in light supply, so Mexican product is being sourced to stay in stock.

NOTE: PA growers are in a time of low yields on **Organic Portabella Mushrooms**. Expect occasional fill-rate challenges in September.

NEW CROP APPLES OUTLOOK



New crop USA-grown **Apple** Season has begun! Back to school and post-Labor Day marks a consumer mindset shift towards more apple consumption. Time to start adjusting your counters to the season!

OUTLOOK: The general view for this fall is that some Eastern growing regions will be down in volume due to a devastating April freeze that killed off lots of blooms - with PA and VA losing more volume than NY, which seems to have not suffered quite as much damage. In Washington, the nation's biggest growing area, supplies should be fairly good and generally promotable for the peak times.

PEAK SEASON! Several of the early ripening main-stay varieties have already transition from 2025 storage crop to 2026 fresh-picked and packed new crop. **Gala** and **Honeycrisp Apples** are in peak and have good supply from both **LOCAL** Eastern orchards (loose, bags, totes) and from Washington (loose, **Lil Snapper** pouches).

PEAK SEASON! Stemilt's **Rave** and **Sweetango Apples** are both at their best for September promotion. **Rave** volume is lighter this year and will wrap up long before **Sweetango** which carry on towards the holiday season.

LOCAL Eastern **Ginger Gold Apples**, an all-purpose early season variety known for making excellent applesauce, are in season. **LOCAL** Eastern McIntosh Apples will be in stock for the week of 9/13.

New crop Washington **Fuji** and **Granny Smith Apples** will come into season towards late September with a smooth transition from storage crop followed by new crop Eastern in October.



CV LOCAL VEG

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Eggplants are abundant and promotable between PA and NJ. Varietals from Flaim Farms in New Jersey are also still going.

LOCAL Green Beans remain in good supply with solid quality. Pennsylvania, New York, and Canada are all in production, and pricing is fairly steady.

LOCAL Green Peppers large surplus in the Northeast appears to be winding down. However, pricing remains reasonable, and quality is still good.

Green and **Yellow Squash** have both moved up in price as overall volume has decreased on **LOCAL** crops. Plantings are getting older and are also seeing some heat-related issues in certain arrivals. New crops out of VA and GA are beginning to ship, which should bring better quality and potentially lower pricing as volumes increase.

LOCAL Cucumbers are steady, with NJ beginning some new plantings to supplement available supplies from PA. Pricing is fairly stable to slightly higher.



CV TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Heirloom Tomatoes from PA are favorable, offering steady availability, outstanding quality, and attractive pricing through mid-September.

LOCAL Roma and **Vine Ripe Tomatoes** have tightened as September begins, with PA and NJ production feeling the effects of seasonal demand, declining field volume, and weather challenges experienced throughout the local season. Availability remains limited from these growing areas, though Tennessee and Mexico can provide supplemental volume as needed. Quality continues to hold up well, **NOTE:** while costs have moved higher and additional increases are likely during early September.

Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** are entering September under increasing pressure as supplies continue to tighten, with **Cluster Tomatoes** experiencing the more significant constraints. Local **Tomato** production is declining and has placed additional pressure on the category. Quality remains strong, while costs continue to climb steadily.



CV BERRIES

Raspberry availability is beginning to improve as the Mexico season gets underway with light availability. California supplies continue to be available as well. Expect steady supply through most of September, with promotable volumes expected to come in during October. Quality has been nice, with excellent eating fruit.

Blackberry availability will remain tight as California volume continues to trend down. Mexico has not started with any significant volume, leaving supplies very tight. Expect volume to improve toward the end of October as the Mexican season progresses.

Blueberry availability is steady overall. Higher pricing is keeping demand at bay on Peruvian fruit, while tail-end domestic fruit continues to be available with light volume. Peruvian quality is outstanding, and higher pricing is expected to continue with low supply through September.

Strawberry availability is light out of California. Salinas volumes continue to trend down as the summer crop ends. **NEW!** Santa Maria volume has begun with light volume. Pricing is expected to ease slightly following Labor Day, but tighter availability is expected. Quality has been nice, although sizing is on the smaller side.



CV PEARS

PEAK SEASON! Excellent supplies of Northwest Pears are now available including **Asian, Bartlett, Bosc, and Starkrimson Red**.

OUTLOOK: **Happi, Prism, Comice, Seckel** and **Forelle Pears** are expected by the end of September.



CV STONE FRUIT AND PRUNES

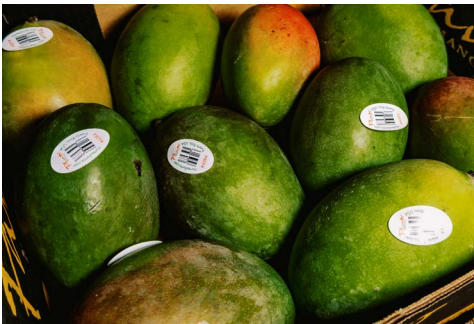
Stone fruit is winding down fast, make sure you finish the season strong by offering a full selection before it's gone.

Prune Plums will finish for the season in mid-September.



CV AVOCADOS

Hass Avocados are in steady supply from Mexico to start September, with pricing coming off slightly. Peru and California volumes are declining as their seasons wind down.



MANGOS

Mangos from Brazil are in stock, with most fruit being the "Tommy Atkins" variety and some "Palmer" variety also available.

Four Seasons is also offering "Green Keitt" **Mangos** from Puerto Rico in 10ct and 12ct sizing options. Larger fruit is more difficult to source at this time.



CV GRAPES

PEAK SEASON! California **Grape** markets will level out as new varieties begin. Expect markets to remain consistent through September. Promote for quality during this timeframe, especially on big, crunch **Autumn Crisp Green Grapes**.

PEAK SEASON! The Grapery full line up of **Cotton Candy, Moon Drop, Gum Drop, and Tear Drop Grapes** will remain promotable through mid-September.



CV MELONS

California **Honeydew, Cantaloupe** and **Specialty Melon** are increasing in price as demand slows and harvest shifts to lighter blocks. Quality remains favorable.

Bin Seedless Watermelons are finishing up in DE and NC and will supply the end of summer and fall with crop out of SC and FL. Expect higher pricing and inventory to shift into mainly cartons by mid- September.

Seeded Watermelons are finished for the season.



CV POTATOES

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL NJ Bagged Potatoes will see a price decrease across the board on the 10/5lb **Red, Yellow, and White Potato** lines. These "Jersey Fresh" **Potatoes** are in good supply with nice-looking quality.

New crop large 50ct and 70ct Idaho **Russet Potatoes** are pricey. Supply on these sizes remains tight for now.



CV PINEAPPLE

Four Seasons continues to offer UPC 'd **Topless Pineapples** in an 8ct box but 6 size fruit, available from Honeybear. **Topless Pineapples** have their tops replanted in Costa Rica to support sustainability efforts, and lower unit price for shipping.

NOTE: **Pineapple** markets have risen considerably to start September, and elevated pricing is expected to continue throughout the month.



CV LETTUCE

Romaine Hearts from California and Quebec sources remain steady and promotable. Canadian supply should become a better value option as domestic pricing begins to rise.

Leaf and Lettuce are relying primarily on Canadian supply, which continues to provide the best price and quality. **Romaine** and **Iceberg Lettuce** markets are firming as both California and Canadian supplies face challenges.



CV GREENHOUSE PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Colored Bell Peppers are entering September in an exceptional position, with abundant supplies, outstanding quality, and aggressive pricing, creating one of the strongest promotional opportunities in the category.

Conditions are expected to remain highly favorable through the first few weeks of September, making this an ideal window to feature **Sweet Bell Peppers!**



CV SPECIALTY TROPICALS

Quenepas and **Rambutan** are now available in bulk options and are expected to remain available through the beginning of September.

Florida **Starfruit**, also known as **Carambola**, will have steady availability through September.

White-flesh **Dragon Fruit** and **Yellow Pitahaya Dragon Fruit** continue to sell great!

Ready to Drink **"Hulas" Young Thai Coconuts** from Frieda's are available in steady supply.



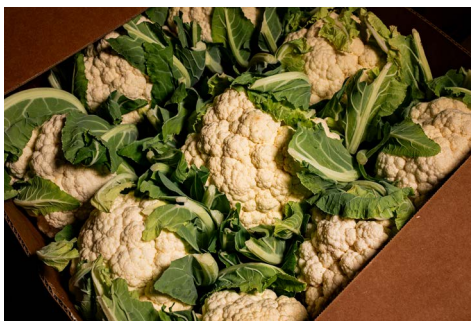
Scallions have moved up in price, with supply issues in Mexico driving the overall market. We are maintaining steady supply between New Jersey and Canada.

California **Fresh Figs** are slowing down slightly, and pricing has increased as well. Extreme heat has shortened picking days, but overall quality remains good to start September. Promote while they in season!



CV GREENHOUSE CUCUMBERS

Euro and **Mini Cucumbers** are entering September with steady availability, strong quality, and favorable costs. September is traditionally a more challenging transitional period for both items, with production expected to gradually tighten and pricing likely to trend higher as the month progresses. Softer demand has helped moderate these seasonal changes, resulting in a slower transition. No significant gaps expected.



CV CAULIFLOWER & BROCCOLI

Jacket Cauliflower, available from East Coast and Canada, are available for a no cello alternative at an even better price point.

Cauliflower market continues to allow for promotional opportunity with beautiful quality.

East Coast **Broccoli** production on broccoli from Maine with some West Coast supply remains steady and promotable. Good quality seen upon arrivals.

Broccoli Rabe is on allocation due to reduced yields and an extended gap on organic broccoli rabe, causing additional pressure to conventional market with relief expected mid-end of September.

OTHER STORIES

NOTE: **Asparagus** continue in light supply with high-ish pricing.

PEAK SEASON! LOCAL Pumpkins and **Ornamentals** are in stock and ready to sell! Recent rain patterns in Pennsylvania have brought some harvest challenges with harvest but supplies are bountiful so far.

California **Grapefruit** supply is limited, and pricing will stay elevated through September.



CV CABBAGE

Green and **Red Cabbages** are in good supply with good quality out of Canada.

LOCAL Green Cabbage from PA are beginning to come back on lightly, with more expected to arrive in mid-September.



CV FALL FRUIT

NEW! Chocolate Fuyu Persimmons will be available for a short season, marking the first **Fuyu Persimmons** of the year from California. The feature variety has a darker "chocolate" center. A 10/2lb Pouch Bag, will be available mid-September in the "Simmis" Midnight Persimmon Pouch Bag.

California **Pomegranates** are steady to start September. The Early Wonderful variety will begin soon, while the Granada variety is currently being offered.

California-grown **Quince** are now in season for your end-of-summer and Fall sets.

Import **Grapefruit** from South Africa may provide a better price/quality play for the coming weeks.

Brussels Sprouts continue to see rising costs as availability dwindles due to undersizing and insect pressure, damaging crops and reducing yields. Import supply is expected to provide relief in late September.

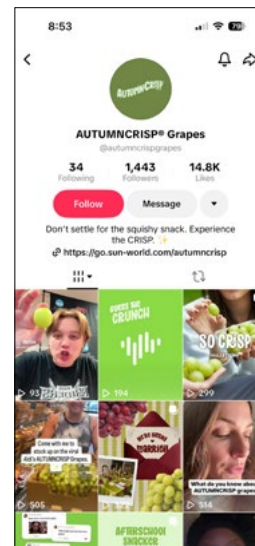
