## ORGANIC APPLE SEASON RAMPING UP



**GOOD NEWS!** New crop Washington **Organic Honeycrisp Apples** have steady supply across all sizes and packs.

Heavy stem bowl russetting is creating lower pack outs, causing markets to remain firmer than initially expected.

**GOOD NEWS!** Washington **Organic Gala Apples** are in good supply with excellent quality and easing pricing across all packs and sizes.

**PEAK SEASON!** Washington **Organic Sweetango Apples** have been limited and are expected to continue in somewhat sporadic supply. Grab this tasty variety when it is available.

The first Canadian **Organic McIntosh Apples** are expected in mid September in limited supply. Sizing is peaking very small, and are expected to run out in early October.

Washington **Organic Granny Smith Apples** will begin to transition from old crop to new crop in mid September.

**OUTLOOK:** Washington **Organic Lucy Glo** and **Lucy Rose Apples** are expected to arrive late September.

Import **Organic Fuji Apples** are sold out for the season. New crop is expected mid September.

Import **Organic Dazzle, Diva, and Envy Apples** are done for the season.



### OG TOMATOES

**LOCAL** PA production is beginning to rebound on **Organic Vine Ripe Tomatoes**, bringing additional volume back into the category following the significant decline from peak August levels. This increase in local supply is expected to be temporary, with volumes likely to turn lighter again later in September as cooler temperatures and late-season growing conditions begin to influence production.

As the **LOCAL** season winds down, **Organic Roma Tomatoes** will increasingly transition toward Mexican supply.

**NOTE:** Availability remains highly constrained and pricey on **Organic Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes**. Mexican production is providing important supplemental volume, but overall coverage remains light and intermittent gaps are still possible. Some relief is approaching as a key supply partner prepares to resume shipments following its summer greenhouse replant.



### OG GRAPES

**GOOD NEWS!** **Organic Grapes** will be part of the Sun Pacific (Air Chief and Famous brands) promo and display contest beginning September 14th. Promote for top-notch quality and flavor!

Markets are rising outside of our promo as growers end several weeks ahead of schedule with harvests into some of their best varieties.

Varieties Four Seasons is shipping for mid-September include "Midnight Beauty" and "Adora" **Organic Black Seedless**, "Timco" **Organic Red Seedless**, and "AutumnCrisp" **Organic Green Seedless**. Bag, Clamshell, combo Clamshell, and bulk loose case packs are stocked.

The last of the **Organic Thomcord Grapes** from California and **Organic Muscadine Grapes** from North Carolina will sell out across mid-September.



### OG BERRIES

**Organic Raspberries** will be steady out of California and Baja, Mexico. Quality has been nice, and harvests continue at steady levels. Central Mexico is expected to begin production in early to mid-October.

**NOTE:** **Organic Strawberries** are lighter out of Salinas, CA. Harvests continue to be light overall as we approach the end of the Salinas season over the next few weeks. Quality has been nice, although Berries have been trending smaller in size. Expect transitioning to Oxnard, CA to begin in early to mid-October.

**NOTE:** **Organic Blueberries** are limited, with pricing remaining high. Peru continues to see light harvests, leading to light and sporadic arrivals. This trend is expected to continue through September and into October. Quality has been exceptional.

**ALERT!** **Organic Blackberries** are tight out of California and unexpected supply gaps occurred. Mexico volume has started lightly, with favorable weather conditions supporting an earlier crop. Expect tight availability through mid-September from both regions. Mexico volume should gradually improve through September, weather permitting.



### OG CITRUS

The California **Organic Grapefruit** harvest has slowly started and so far sizing is very large. Supply is light and is not expected to catch up until late September.

**NOTE:** **Organic Lemons** are limited out of California and Argentina. Pricing is expected to increase as we transition into the full California crop closer to late September.



### OG SEASONAL

Olivia's brand **Organic Cubed Butternut Squash** 6/20oz is back in season for the fall and winter! (code 41568)

**Organic Apple Cider** 9-1/2 gallon from Country Acres is back in season for the fall. (code 226659)



### OG GREENHOUSE PEPPERS

**GOOD NEWS!** **Organic Colored Bell Peppers**, have good availability, outstanding quality, and highly promotable pricing continuing through mid-September.

Canadian production remains plentiful and well positioned to support larger displays and additional promotional activity while current volumes last.



### OG WATERMELON

**Organic Mini Watermelons** are in decent supply out of California. Pricing is rising slowly as vendors move off peak harvests, with sizing favoring 6ct.

**Organic Bin Watermelons** are done for the season.



### OG CUT VEG

**ALERT!** **Organic Broccoli** and **Cauliflower Floret** SKUs will face poor fill-rates of 25-50% from producers due to pin-rot and discoloration quality issues and low yields.



### OG ASPARAGUS

**ALERT!** **Organic Asparagus** is in very limited supply at high prices.



### OG CAULIFLOWER

**NOTE:** **Organic Cauliflower** availability is limited industry wide.

California yields have been down, while quality is beginning to present issues from cool mornings and excessive heat during the day. Quebec shippers are beginning to ramp up production after dealing with their own weather challenges in early September.



### OG BROCCOLI

**NOTE:** **Organic Broccoli Crowns** and **Bunches** continue to hold a premium market due to lack of availability, sizing challenges, and quality concerns industry wide.

**ALERT!** The extreme market on **Organic Broccoli Crowns** is causing additional pressure on the **Bunch** market, while relief has been extended and is not expected for another few weeks. Improved availability is anticipated once new crop produces better quality with reduced insect pressure and **Organic Broccoli Crowns** mature to harvestable sizes.



### OG BRUSSELS SPROUTS

**NOTE:** **Organic Brussels Sprouts** from California remain in low supply at high pricing with only one grower producing. Supplies will improve in October when Mexico begins.



### OG PINEAPPLES

**NOTE:** **Organic Pineapples** are experiencing a seasonal low in volume that is typical for late summer/early fall and prices are higher with lower availability.



### OG SQUASH

Heat and rain have pushed **LOCAL Organic Green Squash** prices up here in late season from NJ and PA.

We are keeping other lines fresh and turning inventory to avoid quality issues.

New crop **Organic Green Squash** is expected to begin from Lady Moon Farms in Florida around September 18th.



### OG PARISIAN CARROTS

**NEW:** **Organic Parisian Bunch Carrots**, code 251538, will be available from Lakeside Organic Gardens in California. These short, round **Organic Carrots** are a nice item to add some variety to a wet wall.



### OG LOCAL GREENS

**LOCAL Organic Collards**, **Organic Red Dandelion**, and **Organic Lacinato Kale**, from Lady Moon Farms PA are experiencing shortages, so expect some of these items to be filled from New Jersey, Ohio, and California as needed for a short time.

The outlook on Fall **Greens** plantings for Lady Moon Farms PA is looking good.



### OG GREEN BEANS

**LOCAL Organic Green Beans** are in limited supply from Pennsylvania.

Some **Organic Green Beans** from Mexico and California are available to help fill the gap.



### OG CABBAGE

**LOCAL Organic Cabbage** is in steady supply from NJ, PA, OH and VT.

**LOCAL Organic Green Cabbage** from Lady Moon Farms PA is expected to start the week of September 13 in a small way then ramps up later in the month.

## OTHER STORIES

**NOTE:** **Organic Stone Fruit** has finished for the season as the last of the Organic Peaches sell out in week 37-38.

**ALERT!** California **Organic Bunch Spinach** remains a challenge with limited volume and elevated pricing.

Washington **Organic Bosc Pears** are expected to have an arrival in mid-September.

**GOOD NEWS!** **Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli** remains promotable and is a great alternative.

**NOTE:** **Organic Corn** is wrapping up for the season.

**GOOD NEWS!** **LOCAL Organic Hard Squashes** are in peak season from PA growers!

**NOTE:** **Organic Mangos** are in season from California on the Keitt variety, but at high pricing and limited quantities. Quality excellent and sizing is big - 9ct and 5ct.

# CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

## LOCAL BROCCOLI AND CAULIFLOWER OUTLOOK



**GOOD NEWS!** Sunrise Acres (Lancaster County, PA) grower is harvesting **LOCAL Stem Broccoli** packed in 110 ct bins available and in house starting September 13. This farm market-style pack in hydrocooled and has trimmed stems and leaves attached.

Volume will increase for the remainder of this month and in full swing as we head into October.

The **LOCAL Stem Broccoli** harvest is 7-10 days ahead of **LOCAL Cauliflower** harvest with **Jacket-cut Cauliflower Bin** availability starting the week of September 20 out of Lancaster County, PA.

Ask your rep about pre-books and more details.



### CV APPLES

**PEAK SEASON!** **LOCAL Eastern Honeycrisp** are now in peak season with good supply and quality. Washington growers are also in peak season with their new crop **Honeycrisp Apples**, but the 2026 crop out there is showing stem-bowl russetting on much of the fruit so expect to see that more this season. Premium grade Washington **Honeycrisp Apple** pack outs will be lighter at slightly elevated pricing, while lower grades (which are just as delicious) will trade at a value.

**GOOD NEWS!** Eastern **LOCAL** and Western **Gala Apples** have fully transitioned from old crop to new crop, with excellent quality and expected availability across all packs. Eastern and Western new crop **Ginger Gold Apples** are now in excellent supply.

The first Eastern **LOCAL McIntosh Apples** have arrived in limited supply, with supplies expected to improve over the rest of September.

Washington **Granny Smith Apples** are expected to transition from old crop to new crop during the rest of September without a gap in supply.

**OUTLOOK:** Red Flesh **Lucy Glo** and **Lucy Rose Apples** are expected to arrive before the end of September.

Washington new crop **Golden Delicious Apples** are expected to begin in a limited way in mid-September. Eastern supply will begin later in October.

Washington **Red Delicious Apples** are very limited, and we are still approximately eight weeks away from new crop. New crop **LOCAL Eastern Red Delicious Apples** are now available in modest supply.



### CV BERRIES

**Blueberry** availability is steady overall. Higher pricing continues to limit demand for Peruvian fruit, while some tail-end domestic volume remains available at lighter levels. Peruvian quality has been outstanding, but continue to expect higher pricing and limited supply throughout September.

**Raspberry** availability is beginning to improve as the Mexico season gets underway with light volume. California and Baja, Mexico supplies also remain available. Expect steady supply through most of September, with promotable volumes anticipated to become available in October. Quality has been nice overall, although an unexpected heat wave may result in some softer fruit arriving.

**Strawberry** availability is expected to increase as a heat wave in California accelerates harvests. Quality has been okay overall, although **NOTE:** some bruising should be expected due to the higher temperatures. Pricing is expected to decrease.

**ALERT!** **Blackberry** availability is tight as California volume continues to decline with some unexpected gaps. Mexico has not yet started with significant volume, keeping overall supplies limited. Expect Mexico volume to begin improving toward the end of September as the season progresses.



### CV TOMATOES

**GOOD NEWS!** **LOCAL Heirloom Tomatoes** remain a bright spot from PA, with steady availability, outstanding quality, and favorable pricing continuing to support promotional opportunities. Local production should remain active through the near term, but volumes across the category are expected to trend lighter as September advances and the season moves closer to its conclusion.

**LOCAL Roma Tomatoes** and **Vine Ripe Tomatoes** remain limited from PA and NJ as production continues to move beyond its seasonal peak. Quality remains strong on available product, though reduced field volume has kept pricing elevated and supply relatively tight. Tennessee and Mexico continue to offer supplemental **Roma Tomato** volume when needed, providing additional coverage.

**NOTE:** Supply pressure continues across greenhouse **Beefsteak** and **Cluster Tomatoes**, with availability remaining limited and **Cluster Tomatoes** presenting the greater challenge. Little relief is anticipated in the near term, and pricing could face additional upward pressure as September progresses and regional production continues its seasonal decline.



## CV GREENHOUSE CUCUMBERS

**Euro** and **Mini Cucumbers** remain in a stable position through early September, with reliable availability, strong quality, and favorable pricing continuing across both items. Seasonal pressure is still expected to build as the month advances, gradually reducing overall volume and placing upward pressure on costs.



## CV GREENHOUSE PEPPERS

**GOOD NEWS!** Promotional opportunities remain exceptional on **Colored Bell Peppers**, as plentiful volume, aggressive pricing, and strong quality continue to provide an ideal combination for retail features and larger displays.

This strength should carry through the near term, though the seasonal transition later in September is expected to gradually reduce available volume and bring an end to the current pricing environment.



## CV MELONS

Melon demand is slowing down, as are **Cantaloupe** and **Honeydew** harvests and yields in California. Pricing is expected to increase through October.

**Specialty Melons** assortment will condense down for the rest of the California season to **Sugar Kiss Melons** and **Tuscan Cantaloupes**.



## CV STONE FRUIT

**NOTE:** Stone Fruit SKUs are ending quickly.

Most items will finish for the season in mid-September, with only some **Yellow Nectarines**, **White Donut Peaches**, and a couple of **Plums** and **Puots** expected to flow into later September.



## CV GRAPES

California **Grape** quality remains strong, demand remains high, and varieties are premium. Promote for some of the best-tasting **Grapes** of the year during the rest of September.

**Grapes** are seeing the October price increase earlier than expected as harvest has been escalated throughout the season.



## CV SWEET POTATOES

**Sweet Potatoes** will see the #1 grade market increasing in price.

Some shippers are beginning to ship new crop "Uncured Green" product out of North Carolina, which is pushing the market down slightly.

However, Four Seasons' **Sweet Potatoes** will continue to be old crop, nicely cured, through early October. Anticipate making the switch to 2026 new crop in approximately a month, once the product is properly cured and has developed a hearty skin set.



## CV PEARS

**PEAK SEASON!** The first **Happy Pears** out of Washington are expected to arrive around 9/13. Good supplies and quality are expected in both pouches and bulk.

The first Washington **Comice Pears** are expected to arrive around September 17.

**GOOD NEWS!** **Bartlett Pears** are in peak season quality and availability!

The first new crop Northwest **Anjou Pears** are expected to be in house around September 20.



## CV POTATOES

Value-play "Jersey Fresh" **LOCAL** 10/5lb **Red**, **Gold**, and **White Potatoes** are still coming out of New Jersey.

All of our bagged "Green Giant" 10/5lb **Gold**, **Red**, and **Russet Potatoes** are coming out of Idaho, with new crop Idaho Potatoes now in full swing. Quality on these lines is expected to be very nice, though pricing is higher than local.

Idaho count **Russet Potatoes** continue to rise in price. **NOTE:** Large counts continue to be in tight supply out of Idaho, while fuel prices are pushing the freight market even higher to get product here.



## CV CITRUS

**GOOD NEWS!** **Cara Cara Oranges**, **Navel Oranges** and **Heirloom Oranges** are in peak season at reasonable prices from Southern Hemisphere growing regions.

**Grapefruit** will see a short transition from California to South Africa to cover daily needs until Desert crops ramp up in California.

**NOTE:** Lime new crop is off to a slow start, with old crop showing quality issues that are creating challenges throughout the supply chain, even with demand remaining low.

Australian **Mega Mandy Dekopons** continue in season with 32 ct fruit.



## CV SOFT SQUASH

**Green and Yellow Squash** pricing has increased as plantings wind down in the Northeast and southern growing-region volumes are not yet at a level to push the market back down.

**LOCAL** Regeneratively grown **Green Squash** from Short Lane Farms in PA is wrapping up for the season.



## CV SPECIALTY GRAPES

The Grapery's **Specialty Grape** season is ahead of schedule and selling well, but this also means availability will wind down earlier than in past seasons.

**Cotton Candy Grapes** and **Moon Drop Grapes** will be available through the end of September. **Gum Drop Grapes** will be around for one last mid-September push. **NOTE: Tear Drop Grapes** are finished for the season and will sell out by during week 38.



## CV PINEAPPLES

**NOTE: Pineapples** are experiencing a seasonal low in volume that is typical for late summer/early fall and prices are higher with lower availability.

**NOTE: Del Monte Honeyglow Pineapples** are in particularly light supply for September. Expect poor fill-rates.



## CV LOCAL VEG

**LOCAL Eggplant** remains abundant in NJ and PA, with good quality and promotable pricing.

**LOCAL Green Peppers** are in good supply, with PA, NJ, and Canada all in production. Pricing is steady, and quality has been good.

**LOCAL Cucumbers** are in good supply, with PA and NJ providing decent volume. Pricing has come down slightly.

**Green Cabbage** pricing has pushed up slightly as Canada sees heavy demand and pulls. **LOCAL Cabbage** from New Jersey is beginning to move into some nice newer plantings as temperatures cool; however, pricing is somewhat higher than the recent lows.



## CV LITTLE LEAF LETTUCE

**NOTE:** Indoor grown greens grower, **Little Leaf Salads**, has seen increased demand this summer as consumers gravitated towards this option amid **Iceberg Lettuce** cyclospora fears and with the abrupt closure of major greenhouse lettuce grower (80 Acres). Their current production is not able to keep up so they are holding customers to their 8 week averages.

**Little Leaf** has a new greenhouse in Tennessee coming online around late September which will supplement their production in Pennsylvania and Massachusetts. Fill-rates are expected to improve in October.



## CV GREEN BEANS

**GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Green Beans** are in steady supply with good quality and decent pricing. PA, NJ, DE, and Canada are all in production.

**Scallions** have come down slightly in price, with NJ and Canada both in good supply.

**NEW: Kiwiberries** are coming into season with the first arrivals at Four Seasons on 12/6oz around 9/17.

## OTHER STORIES

**NOTE:** Taylor Farms has had some unexpected fill rate issues on some **Salads** and **Salad Kits** as they combine production facilities and move equipment in the Mid-Atlantic. This issue is not expected to linger much longer.

**GOOD NEWS!** Driscoll's has excellent supplies of delicious and high quality **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** for promotion in mid-September.
