LAST BIG PUSH ON ORGANIC GRAPES



GOOD NEWS!

The last two weeks of September will be ending promotional push of the 2026 California **Organic Grape** peak season.

The Sun Pacific (Air Chief / Famous brands) California **Organic Grape** promo and display contest is live for Four Seasons Produce retailer partners through October 4. Demand is very active and inventory is fresh, so get behind this category with confidence.

Markets are rising outside of our promo as growers end several weeks ahead of schedule with harvests into some of their best varieties. Varieties Four Seasons is shipping for mid-September include "Midnight Beauty" and "Adora" **Organic Black Seedless**, "Timco" **Organic Red Seedless**, and best-of-the-best "**Autumn-Crisp**" **Organic Green Seedless**. Bag, Clamshell, combo Clamshell, and bulk loose case packs are stocked.

Organic Black Muscadine Grapes from North Carolina be around through late September. **Organic Thomcord Grapes** from California are sold out for the season.



OG TOMATOES

GOOD NEWS! LOCAL Organic Vine Ripe and Heirloom Tomatoes are currently seeing the anticipated mid-September rebound in production, with improved PA volume providing a welcome boost following lighter supplies experienced earlier this month. Quality remains strong, and additional production has helped keep conditions stable during the current flush. **LOCAL** volume should gradually ease again heading into early October.

Organic Roma Tomatoes will transition toward Mexican supply as domestic production fades.

Organic Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** have turned a significant corner in mid-September as new Canadian production has begun, bringing substantial improvement in availability. Supplies are now strong and pricing continues to move lower as additional volume enters the pipeline. Quality from the new crop has been exceptional, providing an excellent start to the Quebec program.

Savoura brand **Organic Mini Aperio Cherry On-Vine** and **Aperio Cocktail On-Vine Tomatoes** are back in season from new crop greenhouse production in Quebec!



OG BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Raspberries will be promotable by mid-September as harvests increase from Baja and Central Mexico. Quality has been exceptional.

Organic Strawberries will remain steady from Salinas and Watsonville, CA. Recent warm temperatures have brought good supplies, leading to a temporary pricing decrease. Quality has been good despite light bruising from recent warm temps, with fruit eating excellent.

Organic Blackberry supplies are beginning to improve as California crops rebound and Central Mexico harvests improve slightly. Quality has been nice, and pricing will be steady.

NOTE: Organic Blueberries continue to be very limited. Peruvian supplies are short and are expected to remain very limited through October. Expect high pricing and possible out-of-stock conditions from time to time waiting for container arrivals. Quality has been exceptional on what does come in.



OG APPLES

GOOD NEWS! Organic Gala Apples are in peak season and promotable!

GOOD NEWS! New crop Washington Organic Fuji Apples are now in season!

Organic Granny Smith Apples will be transitioning from old crop to new crop through late September.

COMING SOON! Organic Lucy Glo and Lucy Rose red-flesh Apples are expected in house around September 24th in both bagged and bulk fruit.

Organic McIntosh Apples from the Pacific Northwest are in very limited supply and peaking on small fruit, expected to finish for the season by early October.

Organic Sweetango from the Pacific Northwest are in season but in limited supply and peaking on small fruit.



OG MANGOS

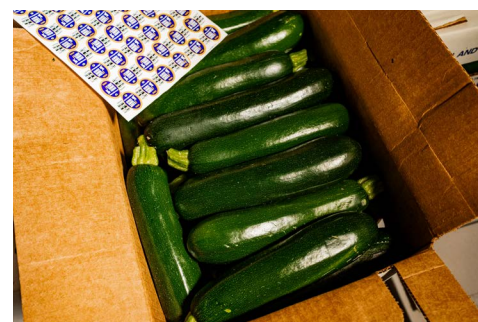
Organic Mangos are in peak season from California through September on the green-skin, non-stringy **Keitt** variety. This small volume, last North American crop of the season program is pricey, but the quality and flavor is amazing, and the sizing is broad: 5ct Jumbo, 6ct Jumbo, 9ct XL, 12ct LG.



OG FRESH FIGS

PEAK SEASON!

California's crop of **Organic Fresh Figs** is still in peak through mid-fall with excellent eating quality on both "Black Mission" and "Brown Turkey" varieties. Volumes are not as abundant but an occasional day or two gap in supply helps keep this delicate fruit fresh and turning for everyone.



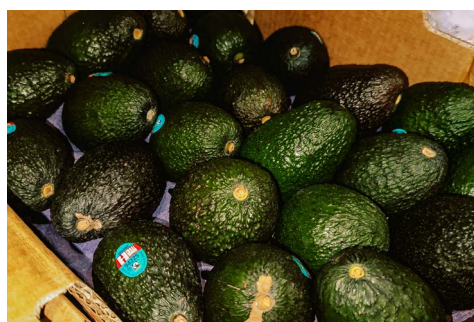
OG GREEN SQUASH

Lady Moon Farms will begin their Florida crop of **Organic Green Squash** the week of September 20, with volume increasing soon after.



OG KALE

Lady Moon Farms, Pennsylvania has had a bit lower volume on **LOCAL Organic Lacinato Kale**. Four Seasons will supplement mostly with New Jersey. They have good volume on **LOCAL Organic Green Kale** with excellent quality.



OG AVOCADOS

With the California crop ending, supplies have fully transitioned into fall crop **Organic Hass Avocados** from Mexico, including on Organic Fair Trade product in the Equal Exchange lines.

GOOD NEWS! 48ct sizing will be excellent through at least mid-October on **Organic Avocados**, and with the nice quality, this is a promotable item!



OG CITRUS

NOTE: Argentina **Organic Lemons** are dwindling and new crop California is slowly ramping up in supply. Expect elevated pricing through the remainder of September until supply catches up to demand.



OG ONIONS

Supplies are now fully transitioned to new crop, premium Nevada-grown Peri & Sons **Organic Onions**.

Organic Red, White, Sweet, and Yellow Onions are all now the Peri & Sons label for the rest of Fall. Quality is outstanding and expected to get even better as skins set up nicer. Pricing from Nevada will be steady.



OG ROW 7 VARIETIES

New crop **LOCAL PA/NY Organic Upstate Abundance Potatoes** from Row 7 are starting, with first arrival in code 251232. This product will be packed in a new 12/1.5 lb configuration. This product will be available through the fall.

Bred for flavor **Organic Sugar Cone Cabbage** and **Garleeks** from Row 7 are in better, more steady supply. Check them out in code 250964 (**Cabbage**) and 250965 (**Garleek**).



OG PURPLE SWEET POTATOES

Organic Ben Yagi Purple Sweet Potatoes are back in with first arrival of new crop for the season by mid-September in code 234694. This was the last variety to get started from AV Thomas in California, marking "full swing" and "full stock" on new crop California **Organic Sweet Potatoes** across the board!

Organic Stokes Purple Sweet Potatoes are also in peak season with high graphic bags available in addition to the bulk.

Purple-flesh **Sweet Potato** varieties have been growing in popularity due to their high anti-oxidant content and affiliation as a "blue zone" food.



OG ASPARAGUS

ALERT! Mexican **Organic Asparagus** is limited due to pressure on the conventional market and unfavorable weather causing quality concerns upon recent arrivals. Quality will be a challenge through the remainder of September until the fall Sonora growing season begins.



OG BROCCOLI

GOOD NEWS! Organic Sweet Baby Broccoli remains promotable!

NOTE: Organic Broccoli Crowns and Bunches continue to hold a premium market due to lack of availability, sizing challenges, and quality concerns industry wide.

ALERT! Extreme pricing on **Organic Broccoli Crowns** is causing additional pressure on the bunch market. Relief will not be seen for another few weeks, once new crop yields better quality with a reduction in insect pressure and crowns mature in size to harvest.

OUTLOOK: East Coast **Organic Broccoli** production from North Carolina begins in October, providing definitive relief if weather continues to be unfavorable on California production.



OG CELERY

California **Organic Celery** pricing is beginning to firm as demand increases due to seasonality and added pressure with a few shippers enduring quality concerns and reduced yields. Transitions are underway, and a gradual pricing rise will occur until new growing regions have a more definitive outlook.



OG LETTUCE

Organic Romaine Hearts are in decent shape, mixing California and Quebec supply.

Supplies are steady on **Organic Red, Green, and Romaine Lettuce**.

NJ is approaching their fall **LOCAL Organic Lettuce** harvest in the coming weeks and will have good volume on **Organic Romaine, Green Leaf, Red Leaf, Boston, Endive, and Escarole** for October.



OG CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: California **Organic Cauliflower** yields are down while quality continues to present issues from dewy mornings to excess heat throughout the day. Four Seasons plans to utilize more Quebec product for freshness and quality mixing in **LOCAL** PA grown supply, gradually ramping up and in full swing the week of September 28, weather permitting.



OG COLOR BELL PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Organic Color Bell Peppers continue to offer excellent promotional opportunities through September, supported by abundant Canadian production, outstanding quality, and highly favorable pricing. Canadian production is expected to gradually ease as September winds down, with the transition toward Mexican supply becoming more prominent in early to mid-October.



OG SEASONAL

Olivia's brand **Organic Cubed Butternut Squash** 6/20oz is back in season for the fall and winter! (code 41568)

Organic Apple Cider 9-1/2 gallon from Country Acres is back in season for the fall. (code 226659)



OG CUT VEG

ALERT! Organic Broccoli Floret SKUs will face poor fill-rates of 25-50% from producers due to pin-rot and discoloration quality issues and low yields.



OG POMEGRANATES

BACK IN SEASON! Organic Pomegranates will arrive by 9/23 from California on Extra Fancy grape 26ct and 36ct two layer packs to kick off the season.

CONVENTIONAL MARKET NEWS

FALL FRUIT SEASON BEGINS



Late September through fall brings the opportunity to get your fruit-heads and aficionados that shop your store excited about some fruit varieties that are typically only around for a short part of the year.

PEAK SEASON! Oregon grown **Kiwiberries** are now in season. Sold in 12/6 oz "Little Pranksters" packs, these miniature **Kiwifruits** ripen to soft then are ready to eat whole for sweet-tart snacking. Merchandise in your berry or grape sets. Sampling of soft-ripe fruit drives purchases.

PEAK SEASON! Fresh **Figs** from California are in season and tasting great! Supplies will continue at a lower pace each week until mid-to-late October.

Quince from California is in season for fall baking and cooking.



California **Pomegranates** are in season with early varieties and available in 30 ct and 36 ct option for late September, plus **Pomegranate Arils** in 12/4 oz cups are selling well. **OUTLOOK:** The best of the season "Wonderful" variety and the full POM Wonderful program with display bins and larger sizes will arrive later in October through the holidays.

PEAK SEASON! Midnight variety **Chocolate Simmis Persimmons** in 10/2 lb pouch bags are in season. This variety does NOT taste like chocolate, but gets its name from the cinnamon-brown flesh color with rich sweet-spice flavor.

Fuyu Persimmons are now in stock to kick off the California season. This flat variety can be eaten when firm & crunchy or soft & juicy. **Hachiya Persimmons**, the cone-shaped variety that must ripen to soft, will get started in late September to early October as size builds.



CV LOCAL VEG

LOCAL Green Cabbage pricing eased off a bit as supplies ramp up from PA, NJ, and Canada. Good quality and availability should make this a fairly promotable item!

LOCAL Cucumbers have eased down a bit in pricing, with NJ back into some volume and southern volume building with new crops.

LOCAL Eggplant has pushed up a bit in pricing, as the large shot of volume from NJ is winding down.

LOCAL Green Peppers may see pricing inch up as heavier volume in and Northeast growing regions slows. Southern growing regions have not started up yet, which could bring pricing back down if it coincides with supply timing.

LOCAL Green Squash has eased off a bit on pricing, with volume coming from North Carolina and Georgia alongside NJ, PA, and Canada. **Yellow Squash** is a good bit tighter, with pricing pushing upward.



CV APPLES & PEARS

COMING SOON! **Lucy Glo** and **Lucy Rose Apples** are due in by September 24th. Both of these varieties feature partially to fully red flesh. **Lucy Glo** are tart-sweet with yellow skin, while **Lucy Rose** are sweet with red skin.

Washington **Granny Smith Apples** are expected to transition from old crop to new crop without a gap through late September.

 PA/NY **LOCAL Eastern Cortland and Empire Apples** are expected to start by late-September.

NY **LOCAL Snap Dragon Apples** are coming back into season for fall promotion!

Beautiful California **Asian and Apple Pears** are back in stock in clams and bulk.

Pacific Northwest grown Green Anjou and **Comice Pears** are coming into season. **Forelle and Seckel Pears** are expected by early October or sooner.

Sweet with bright & zesty bite, **Happi Pears** from Stemilt are back in peak season! **Happi Pears** can be enjoyed when green or yellow.



CV BERRIES

GOOD NEWS! **Strawberries** will be very promotable this week. Warm temperatures have ripened all the fruit at once, leading to an unexpected flush of product. Expect to see some light bruising, but quality overall has been good with great tasting fruit available.

GOOD NEWS! **Raspberry** availability will increase as Central Mexico harvests begin to increase. California and Baja also continue to harvest, and pricing has eased off slightly to keep fruit moving. Quality has been excellent.

Blueberry availability remains steady from Peru. Supply overall is light from Peru, but demand has been soft. Quality remains exceptional.

GOOD NEWS! Driscoll's **Sweetest Batch Blueberries** remain very promotable with excellent quality and aggressive pricing for a premium pack!

ALERT! **Blackberry** availability continues to be limited. California and Mexico harvests remain extremely light due to weather. Continue to expect elevated pricing with light supply.



CV PINEAPPLES

NOTE: Pineapples are in light supply for late September and into October. This is not a promotable category at this time.

ALERT! High-shell-color **HoneyGlow Pineapples** from Del Monte are in especially low supply. Expect significant out of stocks and low fill-rates in this premium pack.



CV CITRUS

Mandarins are in good supply from the Southern Hemisphere, including **Halos** brand.

Navel Oranges from importers should supply us through mid-October, then transition into an accelerated early California **Navel Orange** crop by late October.

ALERT! Limes have a challenging market with sharp increases on new crop **Limes** on top of constrained early volume.



CV ARTICHOKE

NOTE: Current crops are near completion in Salinas, CA while heavy insect pressure from Diamondback Worms continues to be a challenge, especially on larger sizing (12-18 ct).

Artichoke plantings and availability remain on schedule for early October in Huron and Oxnard, CA, with no issues to report.



CV BIN BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

LOCAL Stem and Leaf Broccoli 110 ct Bins (code 631) from Sunrise Acres, in Lancaster County, PA, are in season! Historically, **Broccoli** harvest is 7-10 days ahead of **Cauliflower** harvest.

Higher temps are pushing **Jacket Cut Cauliflower 60 ct Bin back** from first yield, with availability beginning the week of September 28.



CV GRAPES

Grapes have active demand, fresh inventory, and outstanding quality. Continue to promote **Grapes** through October.

"Best of the best" **AutumnCrisp Green Grapes** will be available through September, then Jumbos and other high end packs will transition to Autumn King.



CV TAYLOR FARMS SALAD KITS

NOTE: Taylor Farms has had some unexpected fill rate issues on some **Salads** and **Salad Kits** as they combine production facilities and move equipment in the Mid-Atlantic. This issue is not expected to linger much longer.



CV MANGOS

Mangos have transitioned into new crop Brazil product in the Water For All brand. Quality and appearance is excellent, though the variety is not a top tier eating experience. Volumes are light from Brazil, keeping prices somewhat elevated.



CV BRUSSELS SPROUTS

NOTE: Brussels Sprouts are holding elevated pricing as availability remains limited due to undersizing and Diamondback Moth larvae presence, damaging crop and reducing yields. Import supply entering the market within the coming weeks will provide relief to current conditions with better quality and pricing.



CV LETTUCE

GOOD NEWS! Romaine Hearts remain steady and promotable.

Iceberg pricing remains elevated and will hold firm due to both California and Canada enduring challenges and increased demand.

ALERT! Artisan Lettuce (Sweet Gem, Romaine) from Tanimura & Antle is enduring heavy allocations through late September due to crop failure and reduced yields.



CV GREENHOUSE PEPPERS

GOOD NEWS! Color Bell Peppers remain in an excellent position through September, with plentiful supplies, strong quality, and highly favorable pricing continuing across the category. Current volume provides an ideal opportunity for re-tailers to stay aggressive with promotions, build larger displays, and drive additional movement while conditions remain this attractive.



CV GREENHOUSE CUCUMBERS

Euro and Mini Cucumbers have tightened considerably as September has progressed, with increasingly limited supplies creating significant upward pressure on pricing.

These challenging conditions are expected to continue through the remainder of September and into October, with meaningful relief unlikely until Mexican production begins contributing stronger volumes.



CV PUMPKINS & ORNAMENTALS

Now is the time to build your outdoor and indoor displays of **Pumpkins** and **Ornamentals** to get you shoppers in the fall decorating and buying mood.

LOCAL Pumpkins from PA growers are rolling along well and overall quality has been nice. Recent heavy rains causes some issues on a few specialty varieties, but overall, build and promote with confidence! **Minis, Gourds, Heirloom** varieties, and **Decoratives** are all selling well in addition to the **Face/Carving Pumpkins**.



CV SWEET ONIONS

About two weeks remain of **LOCAL PA Simply Sweet Onions**, with the last arrival expected by late September. This applies to both **LOCAL** bulk 40 lb **Jumbo Onions** and the 14/3 bags in codes 4106 and 4628.

Once this **LOCAL** program ends during October a smooth transition is expected to domestically-grown Nevada Peri & Sons **Sweet Onions** in both bulk and high -graphic bags. Reasonable pricing is expected from new crop Nevada, while Peru imports are down sharply at higher pricing.



CV BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

NOTE: East Coast **Broccoli** supply from Maine and NY is at a halt on production due to high temps and quality concerns seen in the field. Prices are up as sourcing must supplement with product from California and Mexico with higher freight costs.

NOTE: Cauliflower is following the same trend as **Broccoli** and remains limited industry wide. California yields have been down while quality continues to present issues from dewy mornings to excess heat throughout the day. Sourcing will blend California, Pennsylvania, and Quebec product for best price and availability.

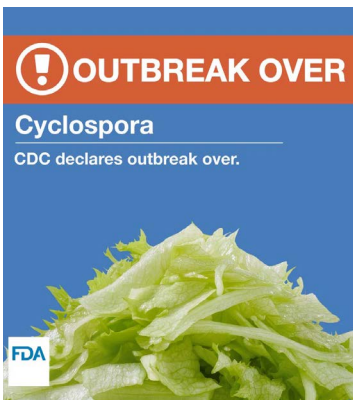


CV TOMATOES

LOCAL PA Vine Ripe and **Roma Tomatoes** are around, just in modest volumes, so supplies will integrate new crop product from other growing regions.

LOCAL Heirloom Tomatoes from PA are winding down in volume and sourcing will be supplemented with greenhouse product in the coming weeks.

Beefsteak and **Cluster Tomatoes** have found some relief through mid-September, with improved supplies and a significant drop in demand helping ease the pricing pressure seen earlier in the month. Both items are currently in a similar position, with costs moving lower while quality remains strong.

DIESEL PRICES DRIVE UP FREIGHT COSTS

ALERT! The national average price of diesel fuel hit \$6.40/gallon on Friday 9/18/26, up from \$3.75 the same time last year.

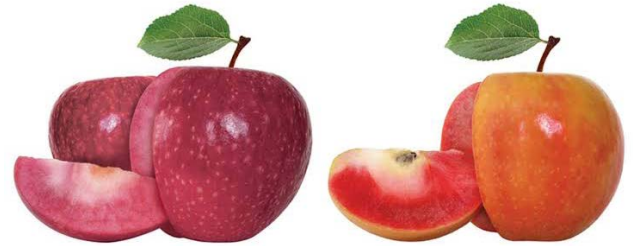
Additionally, FMCSA rules and enforcement policies around non-domiciled CDL restrictions and driver-training school decertification has taken many drivers off the road.

This combination is leading to an expensive freight market with cross-country trips costing around \$4000 more per load from CA and WA to PA this September vs last.

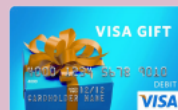

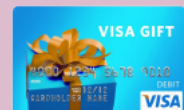

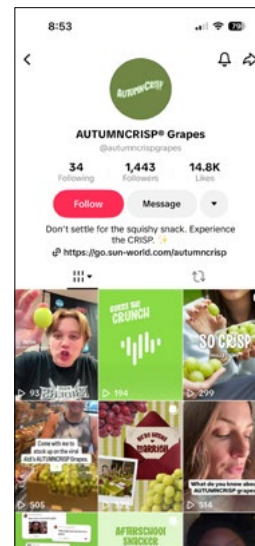
